C1 - PRIX ANDRE ADELE - 3800m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Class 1 - Steeple Chase - EUR € 45,000

- **1. PAINT FOR FUN -** Has done little wrong so far and was runner-up in a Conditions chase over this track and trip on 1 December. Big chance
- **2. NUIT DE L'HOMME -** Holding form and was third in a Conditions chase over this course and distance on 1 December. Should be competitive once again
- **3. GEMMA INVICTA -** Not reliable but was victorious in a Conditions chase over this track and trip on 1 December. Could follow up if in the same mood
- **4. BOULEVARD BOURDON -** Unreliable but was third in a Listed hurdle at Auteuil over 3600m on 15 November. Should be involved with the finish again
- **5. NO LIMITS STEVE -** Consistent so far and finished third in a Conditions race at Fontainebleau over 3550m on 2 December. Can contest the finish again
- **6. HELIOS DU LUY -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a handicap hurdle at this track over 3400m on 11 December. Yet to win and others are preferred
- **7. BISTROT PARISIEN -** Finished 7th in a Listed hurdle at Auteuil over 3600m on 7 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race

Summary: Trainer David Cottin has a decent hand in this race. PAINT FOR FUN (1) is very consistent and was only narrowly beaten by his stable companion GEMMA INVICTA (3) last time out. The change of weights could see the positions reversed. GEMMA INVICTA (3) is not as reliable as that rival, but she did win last time out and should be very competitive once again. BOULEVARD BOURDON (4) has been placed in a Listed hurdle and could be a lively danger on his chasing debut. NUIT DE L'HOMME (2) has held his form well and can make the frame.

- **2. MULOUGHBOY -** Continues to improve and was third in a Conditions chase at Lyon-Parilly over 3400m on 22 November. Should be right there at the finish
- **3. PADDOCKWOOD** Victorious in a Conditions hurdle at this course over 3300m on 1 December. Looked good that day and can follow up
- **4. THE PRINCE -** A winner of a Conditions hurdle at this track over 3300m on 1 December. Shows promise and is capable of doubling up
- **5. BANDJO -** Returned to form with a win in a Conditions hurdle at this track over 3400m on 3 December. Not out of it
- **6. MAKAO'K -** Improving and was runner-up in a Conditions hurdle at this course over 3400m on 3 December. Has a place chance
- **7. MELINOS DE CHARNIE -** Not disgraced on hurdle debut when 4th in a Conditions race at this course over 3300m on 1 December. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: A very interesting race. PADDOCKWOOD (3) was a good winner at this track last time out and could follow up, but this is a tougher race. THE PRINCE (4) also won that day and will not go down without challenging all the way to the line. MULOUGHBOY (2) is improving and can get into the mix of things once again. BANDJO (5) could have more to offer after a solid enough win at this track and is another to consider.

- **2. HILL OF BAMBOO** Knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up in a Conditions chase at this track over 3800m on 1 December. Can go one place better
- **3. ICARE DU SEUIL -** A winner of three of his last four starts, including a Conditions chase at this track over 3800m on 3 December. Can win again
- **4. ANGE PITOU** Holding form and finished fourth in a Conditions chase at this track over 3800m on 3 December. Can contest the finish
- **5. JOST -** Yet to win this year and was 7th in a Group 1 hurdle at Auteuil over 4800m on 15 November. Not out of it in this line-up
- **6. VEZZANA** Did not show her best when 7th in a handicap hurdle at this track over 4000m on 8 December. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: ICARE DU SEUIL (3) continues to improve and win races. He looks hard to oppose and should take out this Listed race. His stable companion HILL OF BAMBOO (2) tried his luck unsuccessfully in Group 1 company at Auteuil last time out but will do much better at this level and could be the biggest threat. ANGE PITOU (4) has held his form nicely and can contest the finish again.

- **2. KEL STORY -** Bounced back to form with a handicap hurdle win over this track and trip on 3 December. Can double up
- **3. MOHICAN** Has only been modest of late and was 6th in a handicap hurdle over this course and distance on 3 December. Might play a minor role
- **4. KAJA -** Completed a hat-trick when winning a Conditions chase at this track over 3800m on 1 December. Must be respected for that win and win again
- **5. GOLDEN BEACH -** Victorious last time out in a Conditions hurdle at this track over 3500m on 3 December. Should be right there at the finish
- **6. WINSTONPRESIDENT** Returned to form with a win in a Conditions chase at Pisa over 3500m on 11 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **7. MOTU FAREONE -** Showed some improvement when third in a Conditions hurdle at this track over 3500m on 3 December. Might earn some minor money

Summary: A competitive race. KAJA (4) has won her last three starts, including a chase over this particular course and distance. She is in a tougher race but does look the one to be with. KEL STORY (2) indicated his well-being with a good handicap hurdle win and can fight it out again. GOLDEN BEACH (5) was a good winner at this course and would not be a surprise winner. LE ROI DAVID (1) is unreliable but is another in this small field who is quite capable of doubling up.

- **3. MARECHAL DESJY** Unplaced in a handicap chase at this track over 4200m on 8 December. Capable of better and can bounce back to score at this level
- **4. MON EMPEROR -** Not disgraced when fourth in a Claiming chase at this track over 4200m on 8 December. Can be competitive once again
- **5. THE GALAHAD KID -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a claiming hurdle at this track over 4000m on 11 December. Can surprise if at best
- **6. JILAIJONE** Showed some improvement when third in a claiming hurdle at this track over 4000m on 11 December. Can contest the finish

JILAIJONE (6) attracted betting support when showing improvement last time out and could do better over these fences. MARÉCHAL DESJY (3) is also capable of winning at this level.

- **4. APRIL FLOWER -** Finished 9th in a handicap hurdle at this track over 3400m on 11 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win

FUJI HANA (5) is very consistent and would not be a surprise winner over this course and distance.

- **2. COOKYNELLE -** Unplaced in a Condition hurdle over this track and trip on 3 December Did run some fair races before that and could play a minor role
- **3. MAGIC TANIT** Has lost the way and was unplaced in a Claiming chase at this track over 3800m on 11 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **4. POURQUOI PAS SOLO -** Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in a handicap hurdle at this track over 4000m on 8 December. Needs major improvement to win
- **5. L'AZIZA DES PLACES -** A winner of a claiming chase at Fontainebleau over 3600m on 2 December. Tougher task but can contest the finish

BEAUTIFUL EYES (6) showed some improvement at Fontainebleau and can contest the finish again. FÉE DU VIVIEN (12) is likely to improve and is not out of it.

- **4. ESCORT'JET -** Unplaced in a handicap hurdle over this course and distance on 8 December.. Capable if playing a minor role on best form
- **5. ESPRIT TRANQUILLE -** Victorious in a Conditions hurdle at Strasbourg over 3800m on 11 November. Not reliable but can follow up
- **6. ROYAL MOON -** A winner of a handicap hurdle over this track and trip on 1 December.. Carries a penlaty but can double up
- **7. GUETTA -** Has struggled of late and finished 9th in a handicap hurdle over this course and distance on 8 December. Capable of an upset on best form
