R5 PONT DE VIVAUX [L-H]

**C1 - PRIX DU CASTELET - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers -
Harness - EUR € 6,000**

1. ICK DU VIVIER - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 8 January. Be right there at the finish

2. KEOPS DU CHATAULT - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class F mounted race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Big chance back in a harness race

3. JULES ET JIM - Battling to find best form and faulted last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 13 January. Others make more appeal

4. JACOBS CREEK - Disqualified last time out in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 13 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win

5. KEONA DELALANDE - In good form and was runner-up in Class E over this course and distance on 4 December. Not barefoot this time but can earn some money

6. IMOKO MADRIK - Did not show his best when 9th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Capable of making the frame

7. IDEAL DU BRIEU - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 2 January. Capable of contesting the finish when smart

8. FILOU RIEZAIS - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 11 January. Needs to do more to score

Summary: KEOPS DU CHATAULT (2) did not shine last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer. He does his best work with this shoeing and can bounce back to beat these rivals and take out this opening event. ICK DU VIVIER (1) is threatening to win and should contest the finish yet again. IDEAL DU BRIEU (7) is not easy to trust but can get into the mix when smart. IMOKO MADRIK (6) is also not reliable but is capable of making the frame.

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**C2 - PRIX DE POMEQUES - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR €
28,000**

1. HORACE - Kept to harness races of late and was unplaced in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 5 January. Has run well in this discipline before and could make the frame

2. ICARE DU POMMEREUX - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 18 December. Hard to trust and others are preferred

3. HEPICETOU - Battling to find best form and was unplaced in a Class F harness race at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2950m on 2 September. Returns from a break and could need this run

4. GALVESTON - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class D harness race at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 November. Can be a threat

5. ILLICO JULRY - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class E mounted race over this course and distance on 11 December. Likes this track and is capable of scoring

6. ILLICO DE BOUTEAU - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 10 January. A winner at this track before that and can win again

7. JOLIE DE L'AUMANCE - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Class E mounted race over this course and distance on 11 December. Capable of doing better and is not out of it

Summary: A small field but a difficult race. ILLICO JULRY (5) has not been the force he was of old but is capable of bouncing back to win a race in this division. ILLICO DE BOUTEAU (6) is best judged on his win at this track in his penultimate start and has claims. JOLIE DE L'AUMANCE (7) is not reliable but has enough ability to win when in the right mood. HORACE (1) has yet to score under the saddle but could be competitive.

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C3 - PRIX MASINA - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 19,500

- 1. MAELLIA** - Finished fourth on debut in Class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Can contest the finish again
- 2. MYSTESS DE CANI** - Disqualified last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 13 January. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 3. MONEYPUS DUCAMPUS** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in Class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 3 August. Can be a lively danger if fit from a break
- 4. MISTER DES THUYAS** - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 5. MAE DU RILER** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 18 December. Could be the surprise package of the race
- 6. MONEY SIXTY ONE** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 13 January. Can make the frame when smart
- 7. MON BEAU MEC** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Might play a minor role
- 8. MAKHILA D'HERIPRE** - Improving and finished third in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Big chance in this line-up

Summary: MAKHILA D'HERIPRE (8) is improving and is coming off a good performance at Cagnes-sur-Mer, where he ran third last week. Barefoot this time, he could score but faces some talented rivals. MONEYPUS DUCAMPUS (3) returns from a break but gets a healthy start and could win if fit enough. MONEY SIXTY ONE (6) is not easy to trust but should challenge for top honours if staying on the trot. MAELLIA (1) was not disgraced on debut and could earn some money with improvement likely.

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**C4 - PRIX D'ALLAUCH - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
24,000**

- 1. JIVAGO DE BEYLEV** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 10 September. Remains barefoot but could need this run returning from a break
- 2. JACQUIE DU GARDEN** - Not reliable and finished 8th in class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Returns barefoot and could pop up in a place
- 3. ILLUSTRE BLUE** - Finished 6th in class F over this track and trip on 13 January. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 4. JAIZKIBEL** - Not reliable and finished 4th in class F at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 30 November. Capable of making the frame
- 5. JACK DU TRUFIER** - Usually competitive and was 4th in class G at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 14 December when barefoot. Can earn some more money
- 6. JANTALINE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 30 December. Can be competitive this time around
- 7. JOB DE CORDAY** - Only modest of late and was 8th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 15 November when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
- 8. JOLI CHARMEUR** - Disqualified in class F over this course and distance on 4 December. Races without shoes and can bounce back to score
- 9. JOLI MEC D'AMOUR** - Victorious in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 23 December when barefoot. Not barefoot this time and others are preferred
- 10. IBERICO** - Finished 7th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 18 December. May need to find a few lengths to score
- 11. JINGALO BABEL** - Finished 10th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Victorious in October and is not out of it
- 12. JAGUAR JENILOU** - Did not show his best when 9th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 13 December. Victorious in November and could earn some money
- 13. JALAPENO** - Not reliable and was 6th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 8 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 14. JUST FOR YOU** - Disappointing last run when 6th in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 27 December. Had some nice wins before that and has claims

Summary: A very open race. JOLI CHARMEUR (8) fluffed his lines over this course and distance when last seen at the beginning of December. He is barefoot this time and could make amends. JANTALINE (6) also races without shoes and is in good form, so she must be respected for that. JUST FOR YOU (14) had some nice wins before her modest last run and has claims in this line-up. JINGALO BABEL (11) is also capable of bouncing back to score at this level.

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C5 - PRIX DE CAZAN - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 28,000

- 1. REDBULL PELLINI** - Not reliable and was 6th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 2. ILOUMAX** - Unreliable and was 7th in class G over this track and trip on 13 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 3. INDESKAYA BIRD** - Victorious in Class F over this track and trip on 11 December. In good form and is clearly not out of it
- 4. INTERMEDE DU RIL** - Not reliable but was 3rd in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 5 January. Can contest the finish
- 5. JUST D'HERIPRE** - In good shape and was 3rd in class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 30 December. Could play a minor role
- 6. DINGO (ITY)** - Victorious at Milan over 1600m on 8 January. Consistent and could be capable of getting involved with the finish
- 7. JAMAIQUE TURGOT** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in class G over this course and distance on 13 January. Can fight out the finish again
- 8. HATOUT DE CONNEE** - Disqualified in class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 30 December. Remains barefoot but has major disqualification issues and others make more appeal
- 9. JUST VERY NICE** - Holding form and finished 3rd in class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 26 December. Big chance in this line-up
- 10. EVEN STEVEN** - Not reliable and was 5th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 8 December. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
- 11. HELIOT DE GACHERE** - In good shape and was 3rd in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 5 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 12. HANA D'OCCAGNES** - Only modest of late and was 6th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 5 January. Remains barefoot but needs to improve to score
- 13. ILLICO DU JAS** - Consistent and was runner-up in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 5 January. Not out of it
- 14. IDEM DU PONT** - Not disgraced when 5th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 January. Victorious in October and is capable of an upset

Summary: A very competitive race. HATOUT DE CONNEE (8) is holding his form nicely enough. He could have a winning turn over this course and distance. JAMAIQUE TURGOT (7) is threatening to score and can challenge for top honours once again. DINGO (ITY) (6) has proven capable of winning in France and is not out of it. INTERMEDE DU RIL (4) is not reliable but is one of a couple of other rivals that are capable of victory.

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C6 - PRIX D'ANGERS - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **KENJY BEL** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in Class F over this course and distance on 13 January. Might play a minor role
2. **KECOU DE VILLABON** - Showed vast improvement when runner-up in Class F over this course and distance on 13 January. Not easy to trust but can go one place better
3. **KEOPS JUTH** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, the latest in Class F over this track and trip on 13 January. Capable of winning when smart
4. **KAPTAIN DE CRISTAL** - Not reliable and finished 5th in Class F over this track and trip on 13 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
5. **KALL ME SIXTY ONE** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class F over this track and trip on 11 December. Can get into the mix of things once again
6. **KRAC DE CAZOULENE** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class D at argentan over 2150m on 14 December. Can be a threat once again
7. **JOJO DE BOURGOGNE** - Successful in Class G at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 7 December. Has disqualification issues but can double up
8. **JOYAU DE FAEL** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class D at Agen-La Gaeonne over 2575m on 11 January. Needs major improvement to win
9. **KAWESAQUEL** - Faulted last time out in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2725m on 11 November. Capable of earning some money when smart
10. **KING KONG SMILE** - Usually competitive and finished third in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Should contest the finish
11. **KENDO JIEL** - Unreliable and faulted last time out in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Has a place chance on best form
12. **JAVERT** - Non runner
13. **KERNEL DE NUIT** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in Class G at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2950m on 8 January. Can play a minor role at very best
14. **JUST SIXTY ONE** - In good form and finished third in Class F over this course and distance on 29 October. Returns from a break and could need this run

Summary: KEOPS JUTH (3) clearly has the ability to win a race of this nature and gets the narrow vote to score, but he is very hard to trust. JOJO DE BOURGOGNE (7) also has disqualification issues but was a good winner at Salon-de-Provence last time and can follow up. KING KONG SMILE (10) has not scored for some time but is consistent and clearly capable of winning again. KECO DE VILLABON (2) can go one place better on the good last performance.

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C7 - PRIX DU CHATEAU D'IF - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. KORIGANE DE LARA** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out in Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 4 October. Could need this run returning from a break
- 2. KAMELIE DU CAMPUS** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. Capable of an upset on best form
- 3. JOIA DE PIENCOURT** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, including last time out in Class F over this course and distance on 13 January. Others make more appeal
- 4. KOOKEY MELODY** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, the latest in a Class E mounted race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2950m on 2 January. Can make the frame when smart
- 5. KOUROUKA BLUE** - Faulted last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 20 December. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. JUST PRETTY ONE** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 4 January. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 7. KALIE WOOD** - In good form and finished third in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 5 January. Should contest the finish
- 8. KAICHA** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 11 January. Has claims in this line-up

Summary: A very open race. KAICHA (8) has been consistent of late, is barefoot, and could be ready for a winning turn. JUST PRETTY ONE (6) has only been modest of late but is capable of winning a race of this nature. KALIE WOOD (7) remains in good shape and would not be a surprise winner over this track and trip. KOOKEY MELODY (4) has some ability and can be a lively threat if staying on the trot this time around.

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**C8 - PRIX DE COURCHEVEL - 2650m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
19,500**

- 1. L'OCEAN** - In good shape and finished third in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 30 December. Barefoot and is a threat
- 2. LA QUICK** - Unreliable and finished fourth in Class E at Nimes over 2750m on 16 November. Might earn some money
- 3. LUCINDA WELL** - Battling to find best form and was 7th in Class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 30 December. Others make more appeal
- 4. LAURA DE CREPIN** - Successful in Class E at Graignes over 2700m on 30 November. Remains in good shape and can score again
- 5. LIBERTY FRANCE** - Victorious in Class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 10 January. In good form and is quite capable of doubling up
- 6. LETTY DE BEYLEV** - Unreliable and finished 8th in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 December. Might play a minor role at best
- 7. LISBETH** - Very consistent and finished third in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 2 January. Be right there at the finish
- 8. L'AMIRAL DARLING** - Showed improvement when fourth in Class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 2 January. Can make the frame
- 9. LAVAMA** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class G at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 17 October. Can get involved with the finish if fit enough

Summary: A very open lucky last race. LISBETH (7) is very consistent and gets a narrow vote to score. She does, however, give a 25m start to some recent winners in LAURA DE CREPIN (4) and LIBERTY FRANCE (5), so it will not be easy for her. LAURA DE CREPIN (4) returns from a short break but can win if ready enough. LIBERTY FRANCE (5) is fit and in good form and will not go down easily. L'OCEAN (1) is barefoot for the very first time and is another to consider.
