PREVIEW: MARSHALL FIELD trounced his rivals over 2200m under a big weight last time and shoulders a hefty 61kg having earned a 6-point penalty. He is maturing and could follow up off a career-high mark. Well-bred DAIMYO has improved over 1600m but on pedigree should have more to offer over this trip, being out of a mare who won the Grade 1 Fillies Classic over 1800m as well as the Grade 2 Oaks over 2450m. SUDDEN SONG has the form and experience to pose a threat, while Silvano geldings PRIME VENTURE and BLUE BAY are also open to improvement trying 2000m for the first time. MISTER MONOCLE could earn.
