

R1 MARSEILLE-BORELY [L-H]

C1 - PRIX DU PETIT CERCLE - 1200m (a6f) - TURF - Claiming - Flat - EUR € 14,400

1. NYMPHENBURG - Ran well to be 4th at Tarbes over 1100m in a conditions race on debut on May 11th. Open to improvement and has a good deal more to come

2. MELLO MELLO - Two decent 4th place runs, the most recent over 1200m at this track in a Class 3 race on May 6th. Promise on both starts and looks ready to win

3. DICANTO - Unplaced on the last two runs, 2nd previously over 1000m at this track on March 18th. Has the talent to make the frame

4. STRELLING - Two good runs, 4th on the most recent over 1200m at Bordeaux Le Bouscat on May 5th in a Class 3 race. Among the leading chances

5. AMORE BELLA - Three unplaced runs, 6th at this track over 1000m in a claiming race on April 27th last time out. Looks vulnerable

6. OBSIDIAN GLORY - Showed ability when 7th on debut over 900m at Lyon Parilly on March 29th. Up in distance today and has outside place claims

Summary: MELLO MELLO (2) has been supplemented for this race and has shown a nice amount of talent in her two starts at this track, when fourth on each start. She can score from NYMPHENBURG (1), who showed ability at Tarbes on his debut when finishing fourth on Mat 11th and will know more this time. STRELLING (4) has been placed on both starts and looks best of the remainder.

C2 - PRIX DES LAURIERS - 2600m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 19,200

1. **HUGO CABRET** - Placed on the last two runs, 2nd on the latter over this track and trip on April 27th in a maiden race. Key player
2. **SKALI** - Two 5th place runs, the latest over 2000m at this track in a maiden race on May 6th. Supplemented for this event and has solid claims
3. **MISTRALOU** - Poor form with numerous unplaced runs, 7th over the track and trip on April 27th on the latest. One to pass over
4. **ELMY** - Three tame efforts this year, 7th over 1850m at Hyeres in a claiming race on April 25th. Unlikely to trouble some of these
5. **CALICO ROCK** - Placed on all three runs in Italy. 2nd at Milan over 2200m on May 1st when last seen. French debut and looks good each way
6. **BEDDA VITA** - Finished in the rear on her only run this year over 2000m on May 6th, 2nd before that in November at Salon Provence over 2000m. In the mix
7. **PUPPET** - Improved effort to be 4th on her second start over this track and trip in a maiden on April 27th. Looks progressive and warrants respect
8. **TULLIS** - Failed to make the frame over 1800m at Salon Provence on April 18th on her sole start. She needs vast improvement to make the frame
9. **BAVAROISE** - Two unplaced runs, the latter over 2000m at this track in a maiden event on April 10th. She has to show more to be considered
10. **OVER THE SKY** - Colt by Circus Maximus, the dam never ran. Some good aspects to his profile and from a leading trainer. Bold show can be anticipated
11. **L'ARMENIENNE** - Filly by Gleneagles, she was placed once from two starts. Likely to need this run unless the betting vibes are strong

Summary: HUGO CABRET (1) has been in form with two placed runs recently, his latest when second over the track and trip in late April in a maiden race. He can get off the mark at the expense of PUPPET (7), who showed an improved effort to be fourth in the same race and looks like the main threat. SKALI (2) has been supplemented for this event and looks like a sensible option each way. CALICO ROCK (5) has been placed in Italy on all three runs and is one to consider on his French debut.

C3 - PRIX DE VIEILLE CHAPELLE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 - Flat - EUR € 20,100

1. FEL - Good win on debut over the track and trip in a maiden race on March 18th. Looks like a smart prospect and can follow up with progress expected

2. LOHENGREEN - Decent 2nd on his penultimate start over this track and trip in a Class 1 race on April 10th. Hard to rule out

3. PAS DE VAGUES - He has four unplaced efforts of late, 5th over 1700m at this track in a Class 2 race on April 27th on the latter. Look elsewhere

4. PELIGROSO - Placed on all four runs, 3rd on the most recent over 2400m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 2 race on April 29th. Ought to be in the shake-up

5. CARCAGNY - Three good efforts this year, 4th on the latter over 2000m at this track in a Class 1 race on April 10th. Needs a few to falter

6. JUST FOR MEME - Below par last time on May 5th, 3rd before that over the track and trip in a Class 1 race on April 10th. Capable of being involved

Summary: FEL (1) won nicely on his debut over the track and trip in March and he is open to improvement from that success. He has a live threat in LOHENGREEN (2), who has more experience and was a good second on his penultimate start in a Class 1 race in early April over this track and trip. PELIGROSO (4) has strong credentials and has been consistent in all four starts. He can once again give another good account of himself.

C4 - PRIX LOUIS BRUNET - 2000m (a1m1/4) - TURF - Class 2 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 50,900

1. **KOURPLUVIX** - Placed on three of his four runs this year, 4th on the latest over 1700m at this venue in a Class 1 race on May 6th. Enters calculations
2. **CAROMB** - Better effort to be 4th at Toulouse over 1600m in a Class 2 race on April 19th. Can give a good account of himself and gets the vote
3. **STARNBERG** - Ran well to be 3rd over 2400m at Saint-Cloud in a Class 3 race on March 29th. One to pay close attention to
4. **ALLURRE** - Tad below par on May 3rd last time, a win before that over 1900m in a Class 3 handicap at Deauville on April 7th. She needs a few to falter
5. **RAKHIM** - Two tame efforts since a win over 1600m at Pau on the artificial surface in a Class 3 handicap on February 20th. Capable of being competitive back on turf
6. **AMERICAN GLORY** - Fair 5th over the track and trip last time on April 10th and a win before that on March 17th in a Class 3 race over 1800m at Fontainebleau. Has work to do
7. **CLEOD'OR** - Nice win two runs back over 1600m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 handicap on April 13th. Hard to rule out of the top four
8. **MAX VERST** - Ran with encouragement when 3rd over 2000m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 race on April 29th. Outside place claims
9. **AMEDRAS** - Two 4th placed efforts recently, the latter over 2000m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 race on April 29th. Faces a stiff task
10. **MARCHEMALO** - Placed on three of his four runs this year, 3rd at Salon Provence over 2000m in a Class 3 handicap on April 10th. Among the leading chances
11. **DAMASK BLADE** - Better effort to be 2nd over 2600m in a claiming race on May 6th when last seen. More needed back in handicap company
12. **GOWAY** - Below par on his three runs since a win at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a Class 4 claimer over 1600m on January 20th. Needs to bounce back to form
13. **PORTUCALE** - Back on track when scoring over 2000m at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 race on April 29th. Might find this more challenging
14. **LINFASOMMER** - Good effort to be 2nd at Parislongchamp over 1800m in a Class 2 handicap on May 3rd. Well handicapped and has solid each way claims
15. **GO LOVE** - Recent success over 2000m at Salon Provence in a Class 3 handicap on April 16th. Has more to do under a penalty but should not be ignored
16. **NOCE DE RUBIS** -

Summary: CAROMB (2) ran an encouraging race when fourth at Toulouse in a Class 2 race in mid-April and can get back on track back in handicap company. His main threat could be LINFASOMMER (14), who has a good racing weight and can make the selection work hard for success. RAKHIM (5) is versatile and won at Pau in February three runs back. He is a winner on turf and can be involved, as can MARCHEMALO (10), who was third at Salon Provence in April on his latest start. CLEOD'OR (7) is also worth a mention.

C5 - PRIX DU ROVE - 1700m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Maiden - Flat - EUR € 19,200

- 1. INTRIGUING** - Unplaced on both starts, the latter over 2000m at this track in a maiden on May 6th. Might find this challenging
- 2. KRISTAL** - Numerous unplaced runs, 7th at this track over 2000m in a maiden on May 6th. He needs to show a good deal more to make the frame
- 3. HADITOUNI** - Ran with some promise when 7th on debut over 1600m in a maiden at Lyon Parilly on May 8th. He should know more this time and warrants respect
- 4. SMALL MOON** - Made no show on debut over this track and trip in a maiden race on April 27th. She needs a good deal more to be involved
- 5. RUE MADON** - Three runs, and unplaced on each of them, the latter over the track and trip on April 27th in a maiden race. Look elsewhere
- 6. AVENUE OF HONOUR** - Creditable effort to be 6th on debut over 2100m in a maiden at Dax on May 1st. Open to a good deal of improvement and is worth considering
- 7. POSSI** - Two unplaced runs this year, the most recent over 2000m in a claimer on May 2nd on the PSF. Place contender
- 8. MELODIE ITALIENNE** - Two runs at this track, 6th on the latter over 1200m in a maiden race on May 6th. Capable of making the top three
- 9. BRIGHT MILLIE** - Good debut 2nd at Salon Provence in a conditions race over 1800m on April 16th. She will step forward from her run and is hard to ignore
- 10. OTONIA** - Two unplaced runs, the latter over 1700m at this venue in a maiden race on April 27th. Hard to recommend
- 11. RAQAT** - Colt by Golden Horde, the dam won 1 race and was placed in a Listed and Group 3 race. He will be ready to go on debut and play a leading role

Summary: RAQAT (11) has the assistance of Cristian Demuro, and will be well tuned by his shrewd trainer. His dam was placed in Pattern races and he can score on his first day at school. His main danger could be BRIGHT MILLIE (9), who showed a good deal of promise when second at Salon Provence in mid-April at Salon Provence and will be wiser from that experience. MELODIE ITALIENNE (8) has each way aspirations having shown promise in two previous starts at this track. HADITOUNI (3) heads the rest.

C6 - PRIX KAID POUS - 1700m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 16,300

- 1. NOBLE AMBER** - Two unplaced runs since a 4th over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap at Lyon Parilly on March 15th. Respect despite top-weight
- 2. PREMONITION** - Better effort to be 4th over this track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on April 27th. Her best run of this year last time and can not be ignored
- 3. ATAVAMADA** - Out of form recently, 7th at Lyon Parilly on April 29th in a Class 4 handicap over 2000m. Needs to bounce back to form
- 4. DON FALCO** - Recent success over 1700m at this track on April 27th in a Class 4 handicap. In form and is worth considering
- 5. DEUXMILLE** - He has been unplaced on all four runs, well beaten over 2150m in a Class 3 handicap on January 15th on turf. One to avoid
- 6. TIBERIANA** - Five solid runs this year, two wins and a recent 2nd over the track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on April 27th. Track winner in March over 2000m. Key chance
- 7. PIERRE LE GRAND** - He has been placed on the last two runs, 4th on the latter over this track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on April 27th. Each way must
- 8. SLEEPY SUZY** - Two placed runs of late, 4th on the latter over this track and trip in a Class 4 handicap on April 27th. Ought to be thereabouts
- 9. MAITRE DU JEU** - Got off the mark over 1850m at Hyeres in a conditions race on April 25th by 2.5L. More required in what could be a stronger race
- 10. SANKA CHOP** - Two tame efforts since a 3rd on the PSF on March 4th in a Class 4 handicap over 2000m. Hard to be enthusiastic about

Summary: TIBERIANA (6) has been in top form this year with two wins and three placed runs from six starts. Her latest second was over the track and trip late in April and she is given the vote over PREMONITION (2), who was just over a length back in fourth in the same race on April 27th. PIERRE LE GRAND (7) also ran well at this track when fourth in April and has each way aspirations. NOBLE AMBER (1) is looking for her tenth success and can be competitive despite top-weight.

C7 - PRIX DE VITROLLES - 1700m (a1m1/8) - TURF - Class 4 Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 14,400

- 1. SPIRIT GREY** - He has been 2nd on the latest two runs, both over track and trip in Class 4 handicaps, the latter on April 27th. Looks ready to win
- 2. OLAF THE BIG ONE** - Back in the winners circle last time over 2000m at Marseille Vivaux in a Class 4 handicap on May 2nd. Seems better suited to the PSF
- 3. ELUSIVE NELSON** - Finished 6th last time over this track and track in a Class 4 handicap on April 27th. Previous track and trip winner who is hard to ignore
- 4. LOGIS** - Nice win last time over 1600m at Cavaillon in a Class 4 race on May 10th. Placed form at this track and has each way credentials
- 5. BECHO** - Recent winner over 1800m in a Class 4 race at Langon- Libourne on May 1st. She will full of confidence after her last success and has strong claims
- 6. ILLOIS** - Credible effort to be 4th over 2000m in a Class 4 handicap on May 2nd at Marseille Vivaux. Has work to do
- 7. RED COUNTESS** - Two 4th placed runs recently, the latter over 1600m in a Class 4 race at Cavaillon on May 10th. Others rate higher
- 8. JUSSIFER** - Well beaten last time on November 13th over 2150m in a Class 4 handicap at Lyon La Soie. Looks vulnerable
- 9. MIGUELITO** - Two placed runs of late, 4th on the latter over 2200m at Cavaillon on May 10th in a conditions race. Might find this difficult

Summary: SPIRIT GREY (1) has been knocking at the door with two second placed efforts recently, both over this track and trip. He can get deserved success. BECHO (5) will try to make life difficult for the selection after scoring at Langon-Libourne earlier this month in a Class 4 race. ELUSIVE NELSON (3) is a previous course and distance winner and looks solid each-way. LOGIS (4) scored at Cavaillon 8 days ago and completes the shortlist.

- 1. FILLE D'ARGENTINE** - Below par last time, 2nd previously over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap on April 11th at Fontainebleau. Others seem better equipped
- 2. I'M A BELIEVER** - Out of form recently with four unplaced runs, 5th on the latter over 2600m at this track in a Class 4 claimer. Capable if in the mood
- 3. LADY VITESSE** - Out of sorts with five unplaced runs this year, well beaten at Salon Provence over 2000m in a Class 3 handicap on April 16th. Look elsewhere
- 4. LA MAZZI GOGO** - Two good runs of late, 3rd on the latter over 2600m in a Class 3 handicap on April 10th at this track. One to pay attention to
- 5. HUNGRY HEART** - Well beaten last time on April 22nd, 2nd previously over 2200m at Lyon Parilly on March 29th in a Class 3 handicap. In the mix
- 6. NOBLEMAN** - Good winner two runs back over 2200m in a Class 4 race at Cavaillon on March 29th. Outside place contender
- 7. EASTMAN** - Two good wins at this track recently, the latter over 1700m in a Class 4 handicap on April 27th. Hard to ignore at this racecourse
- 8. ROCQUEMONT** - Better effort to be 2nd over 2000m at Salon Provence on April 16th in a Class 3 handicap last time. Looking for win number 17 and can not be overlooked
- 9. SPORT COUPE** - Below par this year, 7th at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 handicap on May 8th when last seen. He has lost his way at the moment
- 10. MELBORA** - She has dropped in the handicap after a few unplaced runs, the most recent at Parislongchamp on May 3rd over 1800m in a Class 2 handicap. Down in class and has to be respected
- 11. KERNO QUATZ** - Out of form with several unplaced runs this year, 6th on the PSF in a Class 4 claimer on May 2nd last time out. His better form has been on the PSF and he has work to do
- 12. THORGALLE** - Below par with three runs this year out of the frame, the latter over 2000m at Salon Provence in a Class handicap on April 16th. Hardly inspiring
- 13. DENIA** - Pleasing effort when 3rd at Fontainebleau in a Class 3 handicap over 2000m on April 20th. Previous course and distance winner who is well handicapped
- 14. CHOP VAL** - Finished 2nd last time out over 1700m at this track in a Class 4 handicap on April 3rd. He is racing off a fair handicap rating and is one to keep onside
- 15. SEVENDAY** - Five tame efforts recently, 8th at Lyon Parilly over 1600m in a Class 3 handicap on the latter on May 8th. Look for an alternative
- 16. MARINER BOY** - Two unplaced runs this year, well beaten at Lyon Parilly in a Class 3 handicap on March 29th when last seen. He won his maiden at this track over 1800m in June 2025 and needs to get back on track

Summary: EASTMAN (7) has been in terrific form at this track with two wins recently. He is versatile distance wise and has strong claims of a hat-trick. DENIA (13) could be the one that gives the selection the most to do, having won over the track and trip before. She is well handicapped and was a decent third last month in a Class 3 handicap at Fontainebleau. MELBORA (10) has eased in the ratings and is capable of having a say dropping down in class today. ROCQUEMONT (8) makes up the shortlist.
