C1 - PRIX DE SAZERET - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 29,000

- 1. MAMJACK SACHA** - Disqualified in two of last three starts, including last time out at Vincennes on 12 December. Returns from a break but could be a threat if fit enough
- 2. MUST DREAM** - Successful in his last two starts, the latest in a Class B at this track over 2950m on 11 May. Capable of completing the hat-trick
- 3. MUSCDARCHE** - May have needed his last run when 8th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 April. Has won over this course and distance and is not out of it
- 4. MOTTEAUX DAIRPET** - In good form and finished 3rd in a Class B at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 16 February. Not fully barefoot this time but might play a minor role
- 5. MAGIC INSTINCT** - Back to his best and was victorious last time out in a Class D at this track over 2950m on 4 May. Can double up
- 6. MODESTO** - On a long losing run but finished 4th in a Class C at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 7 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. MEDEE DU CONROY** - Unreliable but was successful in a Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 8. MELCHIOR JAMES** - Holding form and finished 5th in a Class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 April. Should challenge for top honours this track and trip
- 9. MADONE DU TRIEUX** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Argentan on 13 April. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
- 10. MAESTRO CELO** - Holding form and was barefoot when 4th in a Class D at this track over 2950m on 4 May. Not this time but might earn some more money

Summary: MUST DREAM (2) comes here on the back of two good successes, the latest gained with ease at this track, and looks capable of completing the hat-trick. MELCHIOR JAMES (8), who produced an encouraging effort at Vincennes last time is also consistent and clearly a threat. MAMJACK SACHA (1), returns from a break but would not be a surprise winner. MAGIC INSTINCT (5), a recent winner here, can also contest the finish.

C2 - PRIX DE CRESSANGES - 2950m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **KALINKA KOP** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 3 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
2. **KEYSTONE OAKS** - Disqualified in two of last three starts, including last time out at this track on 4 May. has a place chance on best form
3. **KILL BILL MARGOT** - Has only been modest this year and finished 9th in a Class F at Agen-La Passage over 2625m on March. Needs to find a few lengths to score
4. **KESSY MADRIK** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class F at Vire over 2825m on 8 May. Has yet to win a race and others make more appeal
5. **KATIEU DE COUZAN** - Disqualified in a Class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 1 May. Not easy to trust but can earn some money when staying in stride
6. **KILT DU RADON** - Not reliable and was unplaced last time out in Class F at Vire on 9 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
7. **KAHID D'EPUISAY** - Disqualified at Senonnes-Pouance over 3000m on 3 May. Fitter this time and could be the surprise package of the race
8. **KEEP YOUR LOVE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2950m on 4 January. Might play a minor role at very best
9. **KASTEL LOVE** - Successful in his last two starts, the latest in a Class F at Monpazier over 3125m on 3 May. Capable of completing a treble
10. **KID PADDLE** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in a Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 3 May. Might play a minor role at very best
11. **KYSKO DE FAEL** - Finished 4th in a Class E at this track over 2800m on 4 May. Has some fair form and is capable of making the frame
12. **KUZCO** - Disqualified at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 November. Returns from a break but is capable of scoring if fit enough
13. **KAPITANO DE LOU** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in a Class F at this track over 2800m on 11 May. Can be competitive once again
14. **KOMAN** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class E at this course over 2800m on 4 May. Should contest the finish
15. **KEOPS DE JUMILLY** - Not reliable and finished 5th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 April. Has claims in a very open looking race
16. **KENZA KALOUMA** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a Class F at this track over 2800m on 11 May. Capable of doing better and is a lively danger

Summary: A very open contest in which KEOPS DE JUMILLY (15), who posted a good effort at Vincennes recently gets a narrow vote to scorer. KOMAN (14) only found one betetr ot this course last time around and will be a threat once again. KAPITANO DE LOU (13), is a recent runner-up on this track, and can go well. KYSKO DE FAEL (11) shaped encouragingly on his reappearance here and fitter this time has to be considered a possible winner.

C3 - PRIX DE VAUMAS - 2800m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 26,000

1. **L'ANGE AIMEF** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Hyeres on 1 May. Hard to trust but is capable of winning when smart
2. **LISANDRO DE LOU** - Returned to form and finished 3rd in a Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
3. **LE COSSE** - Disqualified at Fougères over 3200m on 8 May. Barefoot this time and is capable of being victorious when in the right mood
4. **LUPIN DE LA VALLEE** - Disqualified at this track on 11 May. Has yet to win a race but is capable of earning some minor money when staying on the trot
5. **LARABELLO DE LOU** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 4 May. Was in third position when faulting last time out and could score for Eric Raffin
6. **LAPIN AGILE** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in a Class F at Arras over 2900m on 10 May. Might need to do more to beat these rivals
7. **LORD BLACKWOOD** - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class F at Vannes over 3200m on 19 April. Successful with this shoeing in his penultimate start and has claims
8. **L'INDIEN PEARL** - Has won his last two starts, the latest in a Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 19 April. Capable of completing the hat-trick
9. **LIVRE BLANC** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Cluny on 8 May. Hard to trust and others are much preferred
10. **LEWIS DAMACA** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Paray-Le-Monial on 12 April. Hard to trust and is probably best watched for now
11. **LOOK D'AIMTE** - Has struggled of late and was disqualified at Argentan on 11 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race
12. **LUCCIANO D'OMAHA** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class D at Vichy over 2950m on 4 May. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal

Summary: LARABELLO DE LOU (5) was still in third place when making a mistake at this course on 4 May. With Eric Raffin booked, he can make amends. LORD BLACKWOOD (7), returning in the same configuration as for his last victory, L'ANGE AIMEF (1), if keeping his stride can be a threat to these rivals. LISANDRO DE LOU (2), judged on his recent outing, also has the ability to shine brightly over this course and distance.

C4 - PRIX DE SERBANNES - 2800m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- 1. IL PLEUT BERGERE** - Has struggled of late and finished 11th in a Class F at Amiens over 2900m on 25 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 2. IDAO NAY** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 17 April. Likely to do a lot better this time and should be involved with the finish
- 3. JAMES DE LA VALLEE** - Did not show his best when 11th in a Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. In very good form before that and can bounce back to score
- 4. JEDI DES BROUETS** - Disqualified at Cavaillon on 7 April. On a long losing run but does have a place chance in this line-up
- 5. JASPE DU DOLLAR** - Often competitive and finished 4th in a Class E at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 4 May. Capable of making the frame
- 6. JOB DES LOUANGES** - Not reliable and was a runner-up in a Class E at Castillonnes over 2450m on 25 April. Can go one place better
- 7. HASHTAG DE TAGOR** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Toulouse on 10 April. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 8. INVICTUS DU DOLLAR** - Unreliable and finished 12th in a Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 24 April. Has disqualification issues but is also capable winning when smart
- 9. IRIS INTENSE** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, the latest at Vincennes on 25 February. Returns from a break, barefoot and capable of a victory
- 10. JANDICE STAR** - Did not show her best when 6th in a Class F at Montluçon - Nérès-les-Bains over 3025m on 19 April. Might play a minor role at very best
- 11. JUDOPOCK** - Only modest this year and finished 8th in a Class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 1 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 12. HELLO BOY DU PIC** - Battling to find best form and finished 11th in a Class E at Avignon over 2650m on 14 May. Needs major improvement to score
- 13. ISIS DE POULINE** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out at Hyeres on 1 May. Capable of a surprise when staying in stride
- 14. JUMBO D'AUVILLIER** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 27 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: JAMES DE LA VALLEE (3) failed to show his true form at Lyon-Parilly but, judged on his previous efforts, he holds strong claims in this line-up. IDAO NAY (2), can be a threat to these rivals on best form, JOB DES LOUANGES (6), with Matthieu Abrivard aboard, is not reliable but is capable of contesting the finish. IRIS INTENSE (9), barefoot on his return, is another contender in this open looking event.

C5 - PRIX DE BOST - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 19,500

1. **MISTER CITY** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in Class H at La Roche-sur-Yon over 2600m on 10 May. Might play a minor role
2. **MIGNON DU LOISIR** - Not disgraced when third in Class B at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. Can be competitive once again
3. **MODEVY** - Disqualified last time out at Fougères over 3200m on 8 May. Not easy to trust but is capable of making the frame when smart
4. **MALICIEUX SAMCOF** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Toulouse over this distance on 17 October. Barefoot returning from a break and could score
5. **MARQUIS D'ARM** - Has needed both starts this year, the latest when 8th in Class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 3 May. Barefoot and could contest the finish
6. **MYSTERE DU LEARD** - Returned from a break and was disqualified last time out at Castillonès over 2450m on 8 May. Did win a couple of races last year and is not out of it
7. **MAVRIK CHICHEVET** - Disqualified last time out at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. In good form before that and is capable of earning some money
8. **MORNINGSUN DU RHIN** - Yet to win a race but did show improvement when runner-up in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 3 May. Keeps that shoeing and might play a minor role
9. **MATADOR DU PERSIL** - Has only been modest of late and finished 5th in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
10. **MUFASA ACE** - Showed some improvement when 6th in Class F at Le Mans over 2950m on 8 May. Has disqualification issues but others are preferred
11. **MOCKINGJAY** - Not reliable and was disqualified last time out at Cavaillon over 2600m on 10 May. A winner before that and is capable of an upset

Summary: MALICIEUX SAMCOF (4) returns to the scene of his only victory and is set to run barefoot for the first time. With Théo Briand in the sulky, he could take all the beating. MARQUIS D'ARM (5), also barefoot is a danger fitter this time around. MODEVY (3), if keeping his stride together, is likely to provide some opposition. MIGNON DU LOISIR (2), on the strength of his latest effort, has the means to also contest the finish.

**C6 - PRIX DE CHATEL MONTAGNE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR €
29,000**

1. **JENJOY MAYBE** - Finished 5th last time out in a Class F mounted race at this course over 2150m on 4 May. Did win a mounted race before that and is a lively danger
2. **ILEX DE CABERT** - Knocking very hard at the door and was runner-up in a Class F mounted race at this track over 2950m on 4 May. Should be right there at the finish once again
3. **JADE VENESI** - Returned to form with a barefoot win in a Class F mounted race at Fougères over 3200m on 1 May. Usually competitive under the saddle and can double up
4. **JUPITER PLANCHETTE** - Off form and was 11th in a Class D mounted race at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 22 April. Did better last year and is not out of it
5. **IDAGANI POINT ONE** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in a Class F harness race at Marseille-Borély over 2400m on 24 April. Capable of an upset back in a mounted race
6. **JAGUAR DE KARA** - Not disgraced when fourth in a Class E mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 27 April. Big chance in this line-up
7. **IQUEM NARCY** - Disqualified last time out at Argentan over 2875m on 11 May. Capable of being a threat over this shorter distance when smart
8. **IGNACE GUENESERIE** - Disqualified last time out at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 May. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal

Summary: JAGUAR DE KARA (6) arrives on the back of a solid effort at Enghien and meets a field well within his compass. He looks the one to beat. JADE VENESI (3) was an easy winner on the grass at Fougères and is an obvious danger if repeating that form. JUPITER PLANCHETTE (4) is not the easiest to trust but, on a going day, is capable of making life difficult for his rivals. IQUEM NARCY (7), on his best form is another that can get involved with the finish.

C7 - PRIX DE SAINT REMY EN ROLLAT - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR € 12,000

1. **LABEL TURGOT** - Not reliable but was 4th in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 17 April. Is barefoot and can get involved with the finish
2. **LANCELOT VENESI** - In good shape and was runner-up in a claimer at Montlucon over 3050m on 19 April when barefoot. Not this time but can contest the finish
3. **LOU D'ECHAL** - Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 3 May when barefoot. Remains barefoot but is battling to find best form and others are preferred
4. **LOLITA DES CHAMPS** - Unreliable of late and finished 5th in class E at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 May. Victorious back in April and is capable of scoring
5. **LET IT OUT** - Disqualified twice in his last three starts, including last time out in class F at Alencon over 2650m on 10 May. Does run well with this shoeing and has claims
6. **LOUNA CHIC** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, including last time out in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 8 April. Capable of a surprise when staying in stride
7. **LIO RENKA** - Not reliable and finished 8th in class E at Cholet over 2800m on 27 April. Is barefoot and is capable of earning some money
8. **LINO DU POMMEREUX** - Disqualified twice in a row, including last time out in class F at Thouars over 2725m on 14 May when barefoot. Not this time and others make more appeal
9. **LOVE ME PASS** - Has struggled this year and was 10th in a claimer at Montlucon over 3050m on 19 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
10. **LUNE ROSE D'ALESA** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in class F at Evreux over 2725m on 1 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
11. **LOUNA LA TRIGALE** - Unreliable and was runner-up in a claimer at Paray-Le-Monial over 2650m on 6 April. Has a place chance in this line-up
12. **LOOK DAIRPET** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and 3rd in a claimer at Les Andelys over 2525m on 5 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
13. **LEREVEUR D'HERIPRE** - Off form and finished 8th in class F at Paray-La Monial over 2625m on 12 April. Needs to find a few lengths to score
14. **LYPSTIC ATOUT** - Disqualified in his last three starts, the latest in class F at Chatelaillon-La Rochelle over 2500m on 1 May. Returns barefoot and can score if staying in stride
15. **LISE DES CHAMPS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class H at Avignon over 2025m on 18 April. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now

Summary: If he keeps his stride, LYPSTIC ATOUT (14) has the means to make his mark in this claiming race. He is however, very hard to trust. LET IT OUT (5), who is effective in this grade also arrives for this with disqualification issues. LANCELOT VENESI (2), partnered by Eric Raffin, is in good form and a clear threat LABEL TURGOT (1), who posted an encouraging effort last time, can also be competitive at this level.

C8 - PRIX DE VILLEFRANCHE D'ALLIER - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

- 1. NINA DES VALLEES** - Disqualified in her last three starts in class G at Montlucon over 2300m on 14 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. NEVER GIVE UP** - Disqualified in three of four starts so far, including last time out in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 26 April. Might earn soem money if staying in stride
- 3. NOBEL CAMP** - Victorious on debut in class G at Savenay over 2600m on 3 May. Tries a shorter distance and can make the frame
- 4. NOISETTE LUDOISE** - Victorious on debut in class G at Villedieu-Les-Poeles over 2800m on 6 April. Drops in distance but is clearly not out of it
- 5. NO MORE ABRIGIO** - Victorious on debut in class F at Tours over 2200m on 12 April. Showed soem ability and is quite capable of doubling up
- 6. NUSTY BERRY** - Successful on debut in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 22 April. Capable of doubling up on that so must be respected
- 7. NINETY EIGHT** - In good shape and was 3rd in class G at Fougères over 3200m on 8 May. Should fight out the finish once again
- 8. NEMO LUDOIS** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 2 May. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 9. NUIT DES LOUANGES** - Showed some improvement when a runner-up in class E at saint-Galmier over 2025m on 18 March. Has yet to be victorious and is unreliable
- 10. NORMAND KISS** - Has hit the crossbar twice in three starts, the latest when runner-up in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 13 April. Can earn some more money
- 11. NOISETTE MIKA** - Disqualified twice in her last three starts, the latest in class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 May. Others make more appeal
- 12. NAVIDA PURA VIDA** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 May. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: A very tricky lucky last race with most of them capable of vast improvement. A good winner on his debut at Tours, NO MORE ABRIGIO (5) will be aiming to double up. However, he will need to be wary of NINETY EIGHT (7), partnered by Eric Raffin, as well as NUSTY BERRY (6), and NOISETTE LUDOISE (4), all who were successful on their debut. NINETY EIGHT (7) takes a big drop in distance this time. NUSTY BERRY (6) won over a similar distance. NOISETTE MIKA (11) will also have to prove herself over this shorter trip.
