## R4 CHERBOURG [L-H]

**C1 - PX DE SAINTE-MARIE-DU-MONT/HORSETURFPRO - 2625m (a1 5/8m)  
- Class F - Mounted - EUR € 17.500**

- 1. JOALINE MOUROTAISE** - Left a good impression behind JOY DES GARENNES (4) last month on her only appearance in the code. Is barefoot this time and could pleasantly surprise
- 2. JETSIE SOMOLLI** - Debuts in the code after some modest efforts under harness and is unlikely to shake things up
- 3. JOYEUSE DU RIB** - Moderate sort in the other code but hails from a stable with great success in the monté discipline and should not be underestimated
- 4. JOY DES GARENNES** - Gave a very good account here last time when unshod all four. Same configuration and can repeat
- 5. JOIE DE LESPI** - Has taken particularly well to her new vocation. Expected to make amends for her recent fault and can go close
- 6. JALISKA** - Has shown potential under the saddle but below par in three this term. Hind shoes off but still no more than a minor place chance
- 7. JEUNESSE DOREE** - Delicate sort that has won two of the three races when not sanctioned. If ability transitions, she should not be too far off the mark
- 8. JAVA DE BRASSE** - Classy filly in the other code. Off since the winter but looks a serious proposition on her monté debut
- 9. JAVA DU CHERISAY** - Not the most reliable filly here but has ability and is not incapable of doing well in this code
- 10. JOLIE FLEUR OR** - Decent but unexceptional type taking her first steps in the discipline but in this company will have her work cut out

**Summary :** Twice a winner in three starts in the harness code, JAVA DE BRASSE (8) takes her first competitive steps under the saddle after over six months off but is unshod behind for the occasion and can get straight down to business. She can still expect to encounter some resistance from the good, but difficult, JOY DES GARENNES (4) who is barefoot again after reassuring here last month, and the promising JOALINE MOUROTAISE (1) who is first time unshod all four. JOIE DE LESPI (5) has made the frame in two of three starts in the monté discipline and similarly appears to be in with a decent shout.

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## C2 - PX FEDERATION FRANCAISE DE RECONVERSION - 2625m (a1 5/8m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 19.500

- 1. KALINE DE DUSSAC** - Untried filly that qualified in good order. Eric Raffin in the wagon and must be duly respected
- 2. KRILLE ELLIS** - On course for victory on debut at Landvisiau a fortnight ago but subsequently broke stride. Should not be too hastily judged and expected to make amends
- 3. KAMELA FLIGNY** - No closer than 4th in five starts to date and will have few friends
- 4. KUBA DE REVE D'OR** - Placed just once from three over the winter. Unseen since and chances limited
- 5. KISMIE DE MEMARTIN** - Heavily campaigned filly that has looked very ordinary so far and has no realistic chance
- 6. KOKINE BECO** - Solid in first two before faulting at Meslay. Unlikely to spring any surprises here but can still get a look in
- 7. KADELIA DU CALOU** - Unexceptional filly that has yet to show anything out of the ordinary and will have too much to do
- 8. KINTE ROYALE** - Has done nothing but improve since her mid-April debut. Not an obvious choice but is sure to generate some interest
- 9. KHALEESI D'ALESA** - In the frame in both starts to date. Unlikely to get off the mark but can still give another competitive account
- 10. KALITY D'ERABLE** - Met her team's expectations first time out. Will have come on for the run and has a realistic chance of doubling her money
- 11. KATINKA DU MOUCHEL** - Facile winner on debut before encountering some bad luck at Caen next time out but with a clear run should be able to redeem herself
- 12. KADENCE DU PERCHE** - Tricky type that took some time to come to hand, but made good on her promise late last month and if behaved should not be far off the mark
- 13. KELLA MADRIK** - Got her career off to a slow start but made up for that last time when outclassing the opposition and the double is not beyond her reach
- 14. KALLYPIGE** - Pleased here on debut last month before losing her maiden tag in less-competitive company and chances of a repeat appear slim
- 15. KALINE FOUR** - Showed a different side to herself when winning at Saint-Omer early last month but faces a considerably stiffer test on this occasion and others preferred

**Summary** : Winner on debut before suffering interference at Caen ten days ago, KATINKA DU MOUCHEL (11) will be out to set the record straight, but nevertheless faces stiff opposition from the promising KALITY D'ERABLE (10) who was an impressive winner on her debut last month. KELLA MADRIK (13) romped up at Le Neuborg three weeks ago and with application will be no pushover. KRILLE ELLIS (2) had the race won recently before losing her action and deserves to be given another chance.

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**C3 - PX BIEN-ETRE EQUIN OSTEOPATHIE MASSAGES - 2625m (a1 5/8m)  
- Class E - Harness - EUR € 19.500**

- 1. KEYFAN** - Racecourse debutant that qualified respectably but nevertheless faces a stiff test
- 2. KARNET DE VOYAGE** - Looked rather unremarkable on his sanctioned debut last month and must show another side
- 3. KILLER BECO** - Showed a different side to himself earlier in the month. Steps up in category but looks to have the class to take it in his stride
- 4. KITO DU BOUILLON** - Sanctioned 50% of the time but encouraging 3rd to KING TIME TO ME (9) at Vire and will generate some interest
- 5. KANDJAR RANAIS** - Has placed just once in 5 starts to date and even with front pads fitted is still unlikely to spring any surprises
- 6. KAMEL TENDRE** - Showed excellent progress recently when second to KOUTBOL (10). Unlikely to repeat this time but can still trot his way onto the podium
- 7. KANSAS STYLE** - Pleased in first two before being forced out of the race at Graignes. Unlikely to impose but without interference can still finish in the mix
- 8. KONRAD DE CORDAY** - Won smartly in the provinces first time out. Takes on better colts this time but is still in with a realistic shout
- 9. KING TIME TO ME** - Sanctioned in first two but made good on his promise with a stylish victory at Vire and will be no easy touch
- 10. KOUTBOL** - Was not stretched when winning on debut two weeks ago and looks to have every chance of keeping his perfect record intact

**Summary** : A small field but an interesting race nonetheless. KOUTBOL (10) was a very impressive winner at Meslay earlier this month and is not incapable of repeating. Runner-up to him that day, KAMEL TENDRE (6) looks a tenacious sort and still has a lot of improvement in him, but may first have to defer to KILLER BECO (3) who looked significantly better last time out, and the more delicate KING TIME TO ME (9) who opened his account at Vire last month.

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## C4 - PRIX JULIEN COLLAS SAFTI IMMOBILIER - 2625m (a1 5/8m) - National - Class F - Harness - EUR € 17.500

- 1. JOYCE BECO** - Showed promise last season but lacklustre since the winter break and unlikely to shake things up
- 2. JESSY LUCKY** - Quality element that has looked very professional to date. Raffin takes over at the helm and once again looks a realistic place chance
- 3. JALISCA FLIGNY** - Sanctioned as often as not but has merit. Takes on some good fillies this time though and no more than a minor place chance
- 4. JOUVENCE DE KACY** - Has merit but as capricious as they come and can expect to generate little to no support
- 5. JORENZA** - Winner on turf during the spring but has been struggling with stride issues and will not be easy to trust
- 6. JAYA KALOUMA** - Never far from losing her action and even though having reassured last weekend is still not an obvious choice
- 7. JAKARTA DU TRIO** - Solid as a rock since returning to competition. Unlikely to get off the mark here but should still acquit herself competitively
- 8. JASKA DES LANDES** - Moderate filly that has placed just three times in 16 outings and current form does nothing to inspire confidence
- 9. JACEE MARQUANDERIE** - Has demonstrated decent aptitude lower down the class ladder but in this company will have too much to do
- 10. JAVA DE BANVILLE** - Decent future prospect that imposed on her first start after a long layoff. Has had time to freshen up and shod for competition this time looks a serious player from the front row
- 11. JOYEUSE DU LORAUULT** - Impressed more than once at 3 before losing her way and recent re-entry run did nothing to convince
- 12. JAVA DES ISLES** - Tricky type but is better than the numbers would suggest and will not be far off the mark if she can keep her action together
- 13. JANGA DU PERCHE** - Showed promise late last season but has not been seen out for 4 months and will need the run
- 14. JUNE D'ERABLE** - Showed a different side to herself at Saint-Malo when first time barefoot. Shoes off again and despite the handicap still looks a leading prospect
- 15. JADE D'ERABLE** - Got her career off to a flying start before coming off the boil but goes unshod behind on this occasion and can make up for lost time
- 16. JAZZ SESSION** - Took no time getting back to her best this season. Opened her account last month and even though incurring the penalty still looks good enough to challenge JAVA DE BANVILLE (10) for victory

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**Summary** : Like a horse reborn on her return to competition following the winter break, JAVA DE BANVILLE (10) flew up at Rânes. She is shod to preference on this occasion and from the front line is eminently capable of confirming. That said, the dependable JAZZ SESSION (16) opened her account in good company at Lisieux and even though 25m worse off still looks a serious threat. The benefit of racing barefoot was evident at Saint-Malo where JUNE D'ERABLE (14) went close and, similarly unshod, she too will be no soft touch. JESSY LUCKY (2) has enjoyed a sterling start to her career and the engagement of Eric Raffin speaks for itself.

**C5 - PRIX CSE NAVAL GROUP - 2625m (a1 5/8m) - National - Class F -  
Harness - EUR € 17.500**

**1. JOYAU DU VIVIER** - Appears to have left his stride woes behind him. Opened his account a fortnight ago and even though in better company this time still looks good enough to finish in the mix

**2. JANGO DU HOULEY** - Modest individual that has never excelled here and can expect to find himself lonely in the markets

**3. JAG DE ROZEVIC** - Generous colt that is still chasing that elusive first win and while unlikely to find it here, he should nevertheless give another competitive account

**4. JAD DES ELIES** - Has never made any impression racing left-handed and current form leaves a lot to be desired

**5. JULIO DU RIB** - Showed considerable promise at 3. Just one race in him since the break though and expected to need the run

**6. JUNIOR DU THENNEY** - Erratic sort that seldom makes his presence felt and is not about to spring any surprises

**7. JUANITO BELLO** - Lightly raced and still rather green, but has ample ability. Sanctioned early last time but is on the front line and can play an important role if he assures his initial strides

**8. JALISCO SI** - Got the year off to a decent start but has since come off the boil

**9. JAM DES LANDES** - Never the most dangerous of trotters but always gives his best and is not incapable of making the first five

**10. JOAL DU RIB** - Tricky character that outclassed the field here last month. Incurs the handicap this time but still looks, marginally, the horse to beat

**11. JOKER DU DOLLAR** - Occasionally loses focus but is better than recent results would suggest and with his mind on the game should logically go close

**12. JO LA CLASS** - Already 32 starts to his name and not a score in sight. Disregard

**13. JIVAGO DE LA COUR** - Yet to get his nose in front this term but is clearly in excellent shape. Leading driver in charge this time and can give JOAL DU RIB (10) a run for his money

**14. JAG DES MONTIERS** - Debuts in the discipline for reasons of conditioning and will pose no danger

**Summary** : Although sanctioned as often as not, JOAL DU RIB (10) has more than once shown his ability. Highly impressive winner over course and distance last time out, he may be 25m worse off on this occasion but is not incapable of repeating. Dersoir will nevertheless be mindful of the in-form JO LA CLASS (12) who will be driven by Eric Raffin this time around. JOKER DU DOLLAR (11) stays shod but should have the measure of most here and, together with the better-positioned JUANITO BELLO (7), represent the best of the place chances.

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## C6 - PRIX PMU LE MONTMARTRE LA GLACERIE - 2625m (a1 5/8m) - National - Class E - Harness - EUR € 23.000

1. **INCROYABLE KYRN** - A total write-off so far this year and has no realistic chance
2. **IN LOVE WITH PUCH** - Gives a good account of himself for the most part and is currently in decent shape but takes on better this time and chances limited
3. **IDOLE HORSE** - Unremarkable mare that seldom makes her presence felt and is not about to break the mould
4. **INESS DE BELLANDE** - Placed in just 2 of 9 this season. Form headed in wrong direction and can be ruled out
5. **ILLICO PRESTO FAC** - Has looked decidedly ordinary so far this season and must get his house in order
6. **IGGY Fafa** - Has struggled with both stride issues and form this season and will have few friends
7. **IMMIX PONT VAUTIER** - Imposed at Méral on his last appearance under harness but shoes back on and appears to have other priorities
8. **ISIMONEY DU CHENE** - Hardy sort that gave a fine account on his re-entry last month. Will have come on for the run and from the front row looks a major player
9. **INCROYABLE MORGAN** - Got the season off to a respectable start but below-par in last two and chances slim
10. **IDEE SMART** - Not the easiest to handle but left a good impression at Mansle on just her second start back and in similar form can get a look in
11. **ISARIO VENESI** - Seldom disappoints when he can keep his action together. Well-positioned in front and on good behaviour should figure prominently with Eric Raffin in the sulky
12. **ISOLEE DU BOUILLON** - Has been enjoying a productive run of form over recent months. Scored just her 2nd career win last weekend and while unlikely to repeat can still get in on the action
13. **IBANA DE MONTI** - Never far from faulting but otherwise useful when applied. Three straight sanctions do nothing to inspire confidence though
14. **IDEAL FOUR** - Dependable trotter that returned to winning ways three weeks ago but incurs the penalty this time and more a minor place chance this time around
15. **IVOIRE DAIRPET** - Took some time to reach his best this season but stamped his mark at Meslay last month and in similar form can repeat
16. **INDIGO DU PERCHE** - Faithful servant for the most part that recently gave a reassuring account in the provinces and with form maintained can play a leading role
17. **IDEAL DU RUEL** - Considerably better horse in the other code and chances of making any impression improbable



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**18. ISLA DE BANVILLE** - Not the most dependable of mares and has not been seen out for 4 months but benefits from an excellent entry and going barefoot for the occasion does her prospects no disservice

**Summary :** On paper, it looks like this contest will be played out between IVOIRE DAIRPET (15) who has been in cracking form for the past two months, INDIGO DU PERCHE (16) who latterly reassured at Gournay, and the tricky but useful ISIMONEY DU CHENE (8) who benefits from a 25m advantage. The delicate but talented ISARIO VENESI (11) also starts on the front line and will have his chances if he can maintain stride.

## C7 - GRAND PRIX RACE AND CARE - 2625m (a1 5/8m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 29.000

- 1. GITAN DE GUEZ** - Solid this time last year and is confirmed here but has been off the boil for some time
- 2. FOREVER STONE** - Returns to the harness code after delivering twice from 3 under the saddle and should not be ruled out
- 3. GENERAL D'AMOUR** - Dependable sort that has been very hard to knock this year. Gets a David Thomain drive this time and is sure to garner support
- 4. FAKIR DES LANDES** - Tends to show more at an inferior level these days and chances limited
- 5. FABULEUX D'ECHAL** - Showed he is back at the top of his game after winning in style a fortnight ago. Breaks in front here and can repeat
- 6. GRETA DU CHATELET** - Has never finished closer than 6th under harness and is not about to change her ways
- 7. GENTLEMAN PIYA** - Has been in excellent shape so far this season. Runner-up to FABULEUX D'ECHAL (5) last time out and can again finish in the mix
- 8. EASY DES FLICS** - Hardy element that has been showing his form in better company lately. Drops back in class and looks a solid prospect from the front row
- 9. GOLD DAIRPET** - Classy, versatile trotter that missed the start last time out but unlikely to repeat and even from the back line will be able to apply the pressure on FABULEUX D'ECHAL (5)
- 10. EXTRA DU CHATELET** - Nothing noteworthy on his formcard for an extended period and can be confidently disregarded
- 11. FLAUBERT GEDE** - Good class of trotter with references at a superior level. Will have come on for his return run and should not be far off the mark
- 12. EVEIL DU LUPIN** - Tricky character that reassured in a decent bunch at La Rochelle last time out. 25m worse off here but worth monitoring all the same
- 13. ERODE LUDOIS** - Reliability not his strong suit but can trot when focused and if fully fit can get a look in

**Summary** : Convincing winner at Pontchâteau earlier in the month, confirming his charge forward, FABULEUX D'ECHAL (5) will be piloted by Eric Raffin this time and can double up. There will be opposition though from the ultra-consistent FABULEUX D'ECHAL (5) even though 25m worse off, and GENTLEMAN PIYA (7) who has hardly put a foot wrong this season. EASY DES FLICS (8) has a superb entry and the drop in category stands him in good stead.
