

## R3 CAEN [R-H]

### C1 - PRIX DE FEUGUEROLLES - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. LOKA LOKA** - Most impressive winner of a 2150m Vichy Class F 3 weeks ago. Ran 2nd on sole association with his apprentice and looks the one to beat
- 2. LOVE ME ALWAYS** - Imposed at Gournay-en-Bray in early-May but has twice failed to confirm. Is back on a hard surface though and cannot be ruled out
- 3. LAURA SISSI** - Tough mare that gave a good account of herself on her Argentan comeback on 11 May. Has had ample time to improve and from the 3 slot will be expected to apply the pressure on LOKA LOKA (1)
- 4. LUTTE IMPERIALE** - Has taken her game up a notch this season. Has yet to open her 2026 account but has a lot going for her here and Lilas Viel can be quietly confident of a spot in the picture
- 5. LOUMIA CASTELETS** - Put a number of poor performances behind her when 4th in a Class E at La Capelle 3.5 weeks ago. Enjoys a good spot behind the car but others still preferred
- 6. LA MOME DE CAHOT** - Comes to Caen on the back of 5 straight eliminations, but is undeniably capable when focused and, if applied, can give this a good go
- 7. LOVELY KOOL** - Held back for this after being eliminated at Elbeuf in early-May. Is better than recent figures would suggest and, at just 20 Euros from elimination, must be taken seriously
- 8. LIO DE PIENCOURT** - Has raced well for the most part this year but takes on a tougher lot this time and will struggle to make her mark
- 9. LIZY DE LA SALETTE** - Modest mare making first start since last November and under these conditions has no realistic chance
- 10. LIZENN D'ERQUY** - Acquitted herself well on re-entry but looked very ordinary at Amiens and will need to find significantly more
- 11. LINEA DE L'ALBA** - Showed encouraging signs at Graignes in April before disappointing at Vincennes early last month. Races shod this time and best to keep one's powder dry
- 12. LOLITA DU STADE** - Has been a bit of handful this year but has buckets of ability. Sports a new configuration and, on good behaviour, could pleasantly surprise
- 13. LEANE DU PARC** - Has been very hard to knock over recent weeks, latterly 4th in a Bernay Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Is confirmed at the venue and can play an important role if Leo Guenet successfully navigates the start

**Summary:** Third on re-entry at Argentan, LOKA LOKA (1) romped up at Vichy next time and is easy to fancy for a repeat. LAURA SISSI (3) has a race under her belt since the layoff, is better-placed on the front line, and Kévin Brossard will be keen to take advantage of the excellent entry. LUTTE IMPERIALE (4) has been acquitting herself well and from the 4 slot should prove competitive for a place in the frame. LEANE DU PARC (13) may not have won the draw lottery but she has been knocking at the door and her only victory was secured under these very conditions.

## C2 - PRIX DE MANERBE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 21,000

1. **MIRACOLO DU CHENE** - Eliminated on career debut under harness at Strasbourg 11 days ago. Goes barefoot for monte bow and with Paul Ploquin in the saddle should not disappoint
2. **MOZART DU ROYAL** - Modest individual that has yet to make any impact and is not about to start now
3. **MATUVU** - Has looked just as ordinary under the saddle as has done under harness and can be confidently written off
4. **MOJITO PLANCHETTE** - Has placed just once in 7 starts under the saddle and recent Caen performance did little to assuage connections
5. **MINAO DE MAJEBE** - Takes first competitive monte steps after 3 straight harness sanctions. Victor Saussaye aboard for the occasion but still not a priority
6. **MOONLIGHT QUANDO** - Was going well when eliminated in a 2875m Argentan Class E a month ago. Sports fresh shoeing and will be no pushover if focused
7. **MILORD DREAM** - Got back in the game when 4th in 19 May race of reference. Sports a new configuration for his Caen debut but is unlikely to create an upset
8. **MON DE CHEVALERIE** - Hardy individual with solid monte references, latterly 3rd in an Argentan Class E on 19 May. Goes well for Alexiane Lepage and can challenge for a place on the podium
9. **MOGADOR** - Not the easiest of horses to use but has shown some promise in this branch of the business and was by no means disgraced last time here. First 5
10. **M'AVEZ VOUS VU** - Clearly in race-mode following his comeback run at Les Sables earlier in the month. Mathieu Mottier gets the nod this time and will be eyeing victory
11. **MERCENAIRE D'ECHAL** - Quality colt that excels with Adrien Lamy. Has no clockwise credentials but benefits from a good entry and can make this his own if he turns

**Summary:** Winner of 2 from 3 before being eliminated at Les Sables-d'Olonne, MERCENAIRE D'ECHAL (11) goes right-handed for the first time, with Adrien Lamy back in the irons, and can set the record straight. M'AVEZ VOUS VU (10) has displayed a particular flair for the discipline and, shod to preference for his first objective of the season, can make a big splash. MOONLIGHT QUANDO (6) was unable to confirm his Graignes victory when eliminated at Argentan, but his form is sure and should be afforded respect. MON DE CHEVALERIE (8) got back in the game that day and is easy to recommend.

### C3 - PRIX DE ROSEL - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **MERRY DAY** - Made up for Alencon run when 4th in a Class F over course and distance late last month. Is not about to create an upset but has a lot going for her here and will not be sent out at 50-1 this time
2. **MAYFLOWER DULONRAY** - Moderate element that has looked rather ordinary so far this term and recent 6th behind MERRY DAY (1) here did little to convince otherwise
3. **MONONOKE DE BRETT** - Put in a good effort to finish 5th in a 2300m Chateaubriant Class F on 7 June. Is well-placed behind the car here and can figure more prominently this time
4. **MA PASSION** - Has evident ability but is not the most reliable. Will be fully-fit for her barefoot bow and the draw will only work to her advantage
5. **MAYWENN DU GUERET** - 6th of 16 in a 2450m Class E here 3 weeks ago despite early traffic problems. Leading driver takes over in the bike and will be eager to put things right
6. **MONA VILI** - Tricky type that left a good impression at Chateaubriant 11 days ago despite being eliminated. Is plainly in fine shape and will be no easy touch if Alexis Collette manages to keep her focused
7. **MAIN ABSOLUE** - Was making first start since December, and was first-time barefoot, when imposing at Laon a month back. Top driver at the helm this time and from the front row can confirm
8. **MARIE DE L'AUNAY** - Ran 3rd over course and distance 3 months ago but has done nothing noteworthy since. Starts wide on front line and others easier to back
9. **MADISHA JOSSELYN** - Is no slouch but has been completely off the boil this term and must first get her house in order
10. **MARGATE** - Blows hot and cold but reverts to a formula which served her well at La Capelle earlier in the season and despite the 2nd row start can get in on the action
11. **MY QUEEN BLUE** - Surprise 3rd in a Savigny-sur-Braye Class F on 14 May but was soundly beaten at Sablé-sur-Sarthe 2.5 weeks ago, and will have nothing to contribute
12. **MISS WINNER** - Has ability but also quite a temperament. Ran 3rd in a Vichy Class F mid-May but failed to repeat when eliminated at Rambouillet, and the draw only compounds matters
13. **MADRAGUE GALI** - Unexceptional filly making first appearance since 12 December and is not about to set off any fireworks
14. **MAESTRIA DE PADD** - Showed encouraging signs at Graignes last month but was well-beaten at Chateaubriant next time and will struggle to make her presence felt
15. **MADONA DE VILLABON** - Lost her maiden status 3 months ago but has made little to no impact since and even though fitted with pads this time still looks an outsider
16. **MANGALYA** - Ran 2nd to MAYWENN DU GUERET (5) at Amiens on 16 May but was unable to confirm when eliminated at Carpentras a fortnight later, and has pulled a rough number
17. **MONDAINE** - Has not been seen out since running 4th in a Bihorel-lès-Rouen Class F in early-April. Is barefoot for the occasion but has been allocated a rough number and can be passed over

**Summary:** MAIN ABSOLUE (7) left quite the impression on re-entry last month when comfortably lifting a Laon Class F; she will have progressed for the run and from the front row can confirm. MAYWENN DU GUERET (5) failed to pull off the hat-trick when suffering interference here late last month and, entrusted to Mathieu Mottier for the occasion, can set the record straight. MONA VILI (6) was going strong when eliminated at Chateaubriant recently and can redeem herself if kept out of trouble. Fifth that day, MONONOKE DE BRETT (3) takes her chances at Caen for the first time and will not be far off the mark if she takes to the new conditions. MA PASSION (4) goes barefoot for the first time and will be expected to show another side.

**C4 - PRIX DE BAZENVILLE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 21,000**

1. **LOVE MONEY DU LUOT** - Modest individual that has done nothing noteworthy in either code for some time and can be confidently disregarded
2. **LUCASSHADEL** - Has never shown any real flair for the monte code and returns to the discipline with nothing to contribute
3. **LE MANERET** - Debuts in the discipline following a pair of modest return runs under harness. Shoes fitted this time and is unlikely to shake things up
4. **LIBERATOR PHEDO** - Back under the saddle following a pair of harness conditioners. Has demonstrated fine monte aptitude and, if applied, could well contest the finish
5. **LATINO BOY** - Respectable 5th in a Class E under these conditions mid-May before being eliminated at Le Neubourg. Is useful on a good day and although not a priority is still worth monitoring
6. **LUCKY DU BOUFARD** - Won his first 3 monte starts but has come significantly off the boil since and can expect to have few friends
7. **LOVELY ONE** - Hardy element that produced some good performances here last autumn. Will have come on for his return run, will be competitively-shod under the saddle at Caen for the first time and must be considered a player
8. **LOS PACOS** - Excellent campaigner when focused and has nothing to prove at this level. Imposed on his only start with Jean Ferron who will be mindful to keep that fact relevant. Claim
9. **LOUIS GAILLARD** - Useful type that made up for Argentan clinker when 3rd in an Amiens Class F mid-May. In better company this time but enjoys a good entry and is unlikely to go home empty-handed
10. **LYNX ATOUT** - Has imposed just once and placed just once in 20 career starts. Is unraced since last October and is not about to spring any surprises
11. **LE RIB** - Like a horse reborn since returning to the ridden discipline. Won smartly at Gournay-en-Bray and even though stepping up in category still looks competitive for a place in the picture

**Summary:** Wonderfully capable but as capricious as the wind, LOS PACOS (8) ran 2nd here late last month before losing his action in Vichy last week, but has been reconfigured and can more than make amends if Jean Ferron keeps him trotting. Failing that, the race can play out between the somewhat tricky but eminently capable LIBERATOR PHEDO (4), and the well-engaged LE RIB (11) who has done nothing but excel since returning from his winter break. Back under the saddle after pleasing on comeback under harness at Vichy, LOVELY ONE (7) has a particular liking for these conditions and, freshly re-shod, is unlikely to let the side down.

## C5 - PRIX DE SAINT-MARTIN - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **MYTHE D'ERABLE** - 7th of 13 on re-entry in a Saint-Malo Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Placed on sole start here and racing barefoot may be just the ticket. Claim
2. **MAJOR DE CHOC** - Showed improvement when 4th of 12 in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is well-placed on front line and in the hands of Alexis Collette will be afforded every chance. First 5
3. **MONACO DU LIVET** - Unthreatening 6th of 11 in a 2400m Amiens Class E 10 days ago. Has otherwise been acquitting himself honourably and should not be overlooked
4. **METALO DE PLAY** - Not always the easiest of horses to use but has decent right-handed references and can get a look in if he deigns to keep his action together
5. **MYTHIQUE RENKA** - Has looked very ordinary since the turn of the year. Has placed just once in 5 Caen runs and can be passed over
6. **MANCHESTER** - Opened his French account at Reims in March but has struggled somewhat since and needs to get his house in order
7. **MIRAGE DU CAIEU** - Not always the most reliable but ran out commanding winner of a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche on 1 June, and with form maintained can repeat
8. **MATRIX SAUTREUIL** - Sent for a rest just over 2 months ago following a modest stint on the track. Stays shod for comeback and can be ruled out
9. **MUSCAT DES EPINES** - Started to come good again in April but was eliminated when going well at Amiens 10 days ago. Entrusted to Yoann Lebourgeois this time and can play a prominent role
10. **MAKE A WISH** - Encouraged at Reims in March but recently eliminated at Saint-Malo. Leading driver back in the bike though and should prove competitive at the business end of the race
11. **MODEVY** - Useful element but eliminated in last 2, latterly a Vichy Class F a month back. Is arguably better on turf but the engagement of Paul Ploquin can make all the difference
12. **MEADOWLANDS** - Tricky but well-regarded colt making first appearance since last November. Is clearly in conditioning-mode and is not about to spring any surprises

**Summary:** Given an easy comeback at Saint-Malo late last month, MYTHE D'ERABLE (1) will be competitively-shod for the first time and has a realistic chance of imposing. MIRAGE DU CAIEU (7) was most impressive at Le Croise-Laroche though and, barefoot for the occasion, will be no soft touch. MUSCAT DES EPINES (9) showed his form at Amiens recently after his early elimination and can make amends if Yoann Lebourgeois gets him off on the right foot. Well-backed at Saint-Malo, MAKE A WISH (10) will be reunited with Mathieu Mottier who will be expecting to put things right.

## C6 - PRIX DE PLACY - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class G - Mounted - EUR € 25,000

- 1. KANARDO FOR CLARA** - Ran 4th at Le Mont-Saint-Michel mid-May before faulting early at Amiens. Showed his form though and is unlikely to disappoint if he gets off on the right foot
- 2. KINGALO DU CHENE** - Put in quite the performance to run 2nd in a Nancy Class F late last month, on his first start for over a year, and Paul Ploquin can be confident of another big run
- 3. ISPANO BELLO** - Has fine monte credentials but eliminated in last 4 starts under the saddle and is unlikely to upset the status quo
- 4. KADO SURPRISE** - Has little monte experience but did place in 1 of 2 starts. Sports a fresh configuration for the occasion and, considering his form, can give this a good go
- 5. KRACKSMAN** - Has failed to make much of an impact since returning this season. Has decent ridden references but still represents no more than a minor place chance
- 6. JENKA DE MORMOULIN** - Debuts in the discipline after some particularly modest harness efforts and can be disregarded
- 7. JO DIBAH** - Returns to the code after reassuring under harness at Lisieux a month back but will need to find more this time
- 8. JAGUAR PIYA** - Has not been seen out since July 2025 but is competitively-shod for the occasion. Has won twice under the saddle here and should not be underestimated
- 9. JANEIRO TURGOT** - Sprang a 62-1 surprise when 4th in a Graignes Class G on 22 May, however a repeat looks decidedly unlikely
- 10. JIKITA MELRIC** - Failed to confirm Alencon performance when well-beaten behind JANEIRO TURGOT (9) at Graignes last month and is unlikely to spice things up
- 11. JUST PACHA** - Runner-up at Meslay-du-Maine before making short work of a Lisieux class F 11 days ago. Is well-in here and will be expected to bring the fight to KENTUCKY DANICA (12)
- 12. KENTUCKY DANICA** - Has taken no time getting back to his best following the winter break. Was beaten only by a very good horse at Laval and will be well-backed to win this

**Summary:** An excellent campaigner that seldom puts a foot out of line, KENTUCKY DANICA (12) enjoys a superb entry, has yet to disappoint at Caen, and can expect the lion's share of support. Mathieu Mottier will still be mindful of a revitalised JUST PACHA (11) who romped to victory at Lisieux earlier in the month. KINGALO DU CHENE (2) ran second on re-entry at Nancy 3 weeks ago and, barefoot this time, clearly has the wherewithal to finish close once more. KANARDO FOR CLARA (1) is never the easiest of horses to handle but he is plainly in shape and won his only Caen start.

## C7 - PRIX D'OSMANVILLE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. KEOPS BEGONIA** - Unremarkable trotter that was eliminated on comeback at Niort 11 days ago. Starts on the inside but in this company can expect to find the going tough
- 2. KRONO DU TRIO** - Useful type returning to racing clockwise after having run 5th at Le Mans last month. Sports a fresh configuration and with Gilles D'Haenens in the bike can give this a good go
- 3. KAISER DE MORTREE** - Has done nothing but improve over recent weeks, latterly 3rd in a Vincennes amateurs Class G 9 days ago. Benefits from an excellent draw but faces a much stiffer challenge this time
- 4. KRICK DE CONDE** - Placed twice on turf before being eliminated at Angouleme last Sunday. Benefits from a good spot on front line and will not be far off the mark if kept focused
- 5. KRONOS D'ERPION** - Eliminated at Vincennes last week after having suffered interference. Has otherwise been firing on all cylinders and returns to the professional ranks with a potentially good hand to play
- 6. KRUGER DU NORD** - Has looked decidedly ordinary since returning from his winter break and can expect to have few friends
- 7. KING DE LARRE** - Encouraging 4th over track and trip 3 weeks ago but failed to confirm at Feurs late last week and can be passed over
- 8. KAID DEL GREEN** - Got straight down to business at Amiens last week when entrusted to Paul Ploquin for the first time. Has yet to make his mark at Caen but a similar performance would see him double up
- 9. KAISER TURGOT** - Eliminated when going well in an Amiens Class E 10 days ago. Is unbeaten in 2 starts over course and distance and represents main danger to KAID DEL GREEN (8)
- 10. KORSIKO** - Put in a fine performance to run 3rd in a 2300m Chateaubriant Class E on 7 June. Will be close to peak fitness and even though forced to start on 2nd line, still looks a player
- 11. KAFE CREME** - Modest trotter that made no impact on re-entry mid-May. Barefoot this time but is still a rank outsider
- 12. KENOR DESBOIS** - Showed improvement at Salon-de-Provence last month only to lose his action here 8 days ago. David Thomain reining this time but still no more than a minor place prospect
- 13. KENAVO TUILERIE** - Gave a good account over 2450m here last week when 3rd in a Class E. Has pulled a tough number but with Mathieu Mottier in the bike will be no soft touch
- 14. KAZAN DE VANDEL** - Has placed just once in 7 starts this term, latterly 5th in a 2450m Class E here late last month, and the draw only compounds matters
- 15. KANKAN** - Has been a complete write-off since last September and has shown no sign of an imminent return to form

**Summary:** Already a winner at Mauquenchy in April, KAID DEL GREEN (8) went on to impose with authority at Amiens 10 days ago and even though drawn wide still looks a marginally better bet than the in-form and Caen-loving KAISER TURGOT (9) who was full of running when eliminated that day. KORSIKO (10) has taken little time to get back in shape, imposed last time at the venue, and must be taken seriously. Barring last month's Vichy blip, KENAVO TUILERIE (13) has been enjoying a productive run of form, tends to go well for Mathieu Mottier, and is unlikely to let the side down.

## C8 - PRIX D'HOULGATE - 2450m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. JEEP DE DALINE** - Erratic mare with a pair of runs under her belt so far this spring. Reverts to a previous formula but still not a concern
- 2. JARYCA** - Previously a good sort but lost her way 18 months ago. Has 3 runs under her belt this term, sports a new formula, but still not a player
- 3. JOYCE DREAM** - Not the most striking of horses but has been acquitting herself respectably this term. Has no particular love for Caen though and looks a minor place chance at best
- 4. JAINA D'ESSARTS** - Imposed at Lisieux on 17 May, then repeated at the same venue 3 weeks later. Ran 2nd last time at Caen and the three-timer looks to be well within her reach
- 5. JADE D'ERABLE** - Four times a winner in 5 Caen runs. Is reunited with David Thomain who is responsible for 3 of them and despite the hike in category still looks competitive
- 6. JOLIE QUEEN** - Showed signs of encouragement at Graignes on 22 May but failed to confirm at Agen 8 days later, and can expect to have few friends
- 7. JIVA** - Pleased in 2 of last 4, most recently 4th of 10 in a Toulouse Class F on 5 June. Is confirmed under these conditions and is unlikely to be far from the action
- 8. HYSIS VENESI** - Handy sort but has not been seen out since last November and is going to need the race
- 9. JOFESCA BUISSONAY** - Has placed just twice in 6 starts this year but is reunited with Yoann Lebourgeois who excels with her, and should be good enough to pick up a first-5 payout
- 10. JUVAMINE RENARDIER** - Has 3 runs under her belt this term but has yet to show any form. Has placed twice here but others still easier to support
- 11. JOLIE SMART** - Sprang a 41-1 surprise when 4th in a Rambouillet Class F 11 days ago. A repeat, however, seems most improbable
- 12. ISENGRINE ABSOLUTE** - Has placed just once in 4 starts this term. Particularly disappointing in last 2 and even though fitted with 4 pads for the first time will have little to offer
- 13. IDOLE STAR** - Has taken time to come to hand this term but ran 3rd in a Vichy Class E on 1 June. Is nicely-entered here and, with form maintained, can contest the finish
- 14. HATALANTE DE FLO** - Below-par in all 5 starts this term and appears to have no realistic chance
- 15. JEUNE ORANGE COTON** - Was unable to confirm Le Mont-Saint-Michel success when eliminated at Durtal 3.5 weeks ago. Benefits from a good entry though and will be able to capitalise if she keeps her action together
- 16. JOYCE DU VAL** - Generous mare that was surprisingly lacklustre at Carpentras 2.5 weeks ago. Has otherwise been in fine shape this spring and, considering the entry, cannot be discounted

**Summary:** Simply superb since returning to competition in April, JAINA D'ESSARTS (4) returns to Caen on a hat-trick and can wrap this up if she manages to stay in stride. Francois Lagadeuc will still want to be wary of IDOLE STAR (13) who gave a reassuringly good account at Vichy early this month, and the tricky but talented, and well-engaged, JEUNE ORANGE COTON (15) who will have her chances if Antonin Andre keeps her focused. JIVA (7) returns to a track she likes after having encouraged at Toulouse a fortnight back and must be respected.
