

# R5 VICHY [R-H]

## C1 - PRIX DE LIMOISE - 2950m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. LOLLIPOP PICDOM** - Disqualified in class F at Vichy over 2950m on 10 June. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 2. LADY ROCK** - Finished 8th in class F at Vire over 2800m on 8 May. Capable of doing better but others make much more appeal
- 3. LASKA CAD** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class F at Durtal over 2825m on 25 May. Might play a minor role at very best
- 4. LA MILA** - Off form and finished 9th in class H at Senonnes-Pouance over 3000m on 3 May. Unreliable and others are much preferred
- 5. LADY DU JOUR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Nort-sur-Erde over 3100m on 31 May. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 6. LABLETTE JIHEM** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F over this track and trip on 13 June. Not easy to trust but can score if smart
- 7. LADY MESLOISE** - Unreliable and was 13th in class F at Vannes over 3200m on 19 April. Battling to find best form and makes little appeal
- 8. LAMAGISTERE** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in class F at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 25 May. Others make more appeal
- 9. LIVINE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in class F at La Capelle over 2700m on 25 July. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 10. LOLITA GIRL** - Victorious in class G at Caen over 2450m on 12 November. Completed a hat-trick and could be a real threat returning from a break
- 11. LEYLI DE LA VALLEE** - Disqualified in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 14 April. Victorious back in April and could be the surprise package of the race
- 12. LA BELLE AFFAIRE** - Off form and finished 8th in class F over this course and distance on 10 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 13. LANA DU LION** - In good form and finished 4th in class F at Orleans over 3400m on 7 June. Victorious back in May and can make the frame
- 14. LORETTE D'ERABLE** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Amiens over 2400m on 23 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 15. LADY OH** - Needed the last run when 8th in class F at Nimes over 2750m on 17 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 16. LADY MASTER** - Victorious in class E at Nantes over 3000m on 1 June. Has shown improvement and could double up if in the same mood

**Summary:** LADY MASTER (16) returned to form in an apprentice race earlier this month. The richest in the field, she could not have asked for a better opportunity to record another success. LOLITA GIRL (10) was given a break after ending last season on a high note. Prepared for this return, she warrants plenty of respect from the outset. Likely to improve on her comeback run, LADY OH (15) is next best ahead of LORETTE D'ERABLE (14) wh can also make the frame.

## C2 - PRIX DE GROSBOIS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 22,000

1. **MASCOTT DU CHOQUEL** - Disqualified last time out at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Capable of earning some money when staying in stride
2. **MAX D'OLMEN** - Victorious last time out in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Continues to improve and could follow up
3. **MUSE DE VANDEL** - Only modest of late and was fifth in Class E over this track and trip on 13 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
4. **MARSTON VICTORY** - In good form and was runner-up in Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Might earn some minor money
5. **MUST PLEIN CHENE** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class E at Caen over 2450m on 10 June. Capable of better and might earn some minor money
6. **MANA MIX** - Successful in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2625m on 15 May. In good shape and could follow up
7. **MATCHO LOUANGES** - In good form and was runner-up in Class E at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 21 May. Can contest the finish once again
8. **MOISSON DE LA COTE** - Disqualified last time out at Salon-de-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Returns from a break and could need this run
9. **MORNY DE TROUVILLE** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in Class F at Argentan over 2800m on 6 February. Could need this run returning from a break
10. **MALINE DE JED** - Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. Others make more appeal
11. **MARCEL SEVEN** - Victorious in Class F at Laon over 2850m on 7 June. In good form and can be competitive once again
12. **MAHATMA DANICA** - Unreliable but was runner-up in Class F at Châteaubriant over 2800m on 7 June. Can be a lively danger once again
13. **MYSTERE DE POULINE** - Has struggled of late and finished tenth in Class E this course over 2800m on 10 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
14. **MAESTRO DE LOU** - Unreliable and was runner-up in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Might earn some minor money
15. **MIAMI DES BROUETS** - Consistent and finished fourth in Class E at this course over 2150m on 28 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
16. **MAKITA BERRY** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E over this track and trip on 13 June. Needs to do a bit more to score

**Summary:** Clearly talented, MAX D'OLMEN (2) should be well suited by this course. Faultless since his debut, he will look to follow up. Beaten by him last time, MATCHO LOUANGES (7) is set to lead the opposition alongside MANA MIX (6), who won last month ahead of a colt that has since franked the form. MARCEL SEVEN (11) scored with authority in his latest start; despite a second-line draw, he should not be overlooked.

### C3 - PRIX DU LOUROUP-BOURBONNAIS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **JOHN ANGOT** - In good shape and finished 3rd in a Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 31 May. Can be a threat to these rivals
2. **JAKA DU RUEL** - Successful twice in a row, the latest in a Class H at Gournay-en-Bray over 2550m on 24 May. Can complete the treble
3. **JERIMOW** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in a Class E at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 31 May. Has a place chance on best form
4. **JUSTE PARFAITE** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Villeneuve -sur-Lot on 6 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
5. **JAGUAR DU GITE** - Off form and finished 9th in a Class E at Niort over 3575m on 7 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **JOYAU DE MORTREE** - Unreliable and finished 5th in a Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 31 May. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
7. **JACKPOT DES BORDES** - Showed some improvement and finished 4th in a Class F at Granville over 3100m on 24 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
8. **JAVA DE ROUAISSE** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in a Class F at Agen-La Passage over 2050m on 30 May. Capable of making the frame
9. **JOYCE PILE** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in a Class G at Graignes over 2700m on 6 June. Can be ompetitive in this line-up
10. **JOJO DE BOURGOGNE** - Disqualified in four of last five starts, including at Bollene on 7 June Hard to trust and makes little appeal
11. **JUAN D'OCCAGNES** - Disqualified three times in a row the latest at Lignieres on 31 May. Hard to trust and is best watched for now
12. **JURELLA DE PALM** - Unreliable and finished 5th in a Class E at Durtal over 2825m on 25 May. Capable of earning some money
13. **JUNON DES ROSES** - Disqualified at Amiens on 8 June. Capable of doing better and has a place chance in this line-up
14. **JIPSY DES AIRES** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class E at Chatillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2675m on 25 May. Might play a minor role
15. **JUAN LES PINS** - Victorious in his last four starts the latest in a Class D at Hyeres over 2850m on 5 June. Can win again

**Summary:** Several runners look capable of playing leading roles, starting with JUAN LES PINS (15), who comes here on the back of four consecutive victories. Despite his second-line draw, he is preferred to JOHN ANGOT (1), carefully prepared by his trainer, and JOYCE PILE (9), a winner over course and distance in her only appearance at Vichy. Blessed with plenty of speed, JAVA DE ROUAISSE (8) is another to consider.

## C4 - PRIX DE LA SOCIETE HIPPIQUE FRANCAISE - 2800m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 23,000

1. **KALINE DU CORTA** - Has struggled of late finished 8th in a Class F at Carpentras over 2650m on 31 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
2. **KOPALINE DE CHENOU** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 9 June. Might play a minor role
3. **KANGAE DE GUEZ** - Disqualified at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 28 May. Very hard to trust but is capable of winning a race of this nature
4. **KELLY DE CERISY** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a Class E at Montlucon-Neris-les-Bains over 3025m on 7 June. Capable of an upset on best form
5. **KALITY LOVE** - Unplaced in a Class F at Thouars over 2700m on 14 May. Very hard to trust but is capable if scoring if staying in stride
6. **KLOE DU ROUEZO** - Victorious in a Class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 24 May. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of doubling up
7. **KEATANA DU METZ** - Off form and finished 8th in a Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 31 March. Returns from a break but could need this run
8. **KIYOHA DE NAPPES** - Disqualified at Nimes on 17 May. Not easy to trust but is capable of fighting out the finish when smart
9. **KAZEG TALVA** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in a Class E at Reims over 2650m on 31 May. More is needed to score
10. **KELINA SUPREME** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, the latest at Lignieres over 2825m on 17 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
11. **KAYA KYDE** - Disqualified at Caen on 10 June. Has disqualification issues and needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
12. **KSARYA DE CHENU** - Disqualified at Ecommoy on 31 May. Not reliable but can earn some money if staying on the trot this time around

**Summary:** KLOE DU ROUEZO (6) arrives for this after a comfortable victory and looks a serious threat to follow up. KIYOHA DE NAPPES (8) has been carefully managed since her debut and has never finished worse than third when staying in stride, making her a leading contender. KANGAE DE GUEZ (3) is not the easiest to handle but is capable of a big run if her driver can keep her under control. KALITY LOVE (5) can also get involved with the finish if smart.

## C5 - PRIX DE SAINTE THERENCE - 2950m (a2m) - Class B - Harness - EUR € 33,000

- 1. NIEHKU** - Has held his form well and was third in Class D over this track and trip on 4 May. Should contest the finish once again
- 2. NEUVILLOISE** - Victorious in Class D at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 12 March. In very good form but is returning from a short break. Utmost respect
- 3. NEMO DES BROUETS** - Successful last time out in Class B at Marseille-Borély over 3000m on 3 June. Capable of following up
- 4. NO LIMIT DELO** - Did not show her best when unplaced in a Group 2 at Vincennes over 2175m on 26 May. Can contest the finish
- 5. NANO UP STAR** - Has lost his way of late and was unplaced in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 June. Capable of scoring of best form
- 6. NAVY SEAL** - Remains in good form and finished fourth in Class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 19 May. Should be right there at the finish
- 7. NO TIME DU DONJON** - Has improved of late and was successful in Class B at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2575m on 23 May. Capable of following up

**Summary:** They may be few in number, but the choice is far from straightforward. NO TIME DU DONJON (7) left a very good impression when winning at the end of May at Beaumont de Lomagne and should play a leading role. NAVY SEAL (6) is held in high regard by Tony Le Beller and will challenge for top honours. NO LIMIT DELO (4) drops in class and the trip could prove worthwhile. Clearly improving, NEMO DES BROUETS (3) cannot be ruled out.

## C6 - PRIX ANDRE LERENARD - 2950m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 25,000

1. **NUMENOR'S FELLA** - Has run well in both starts so far and was runner-up in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Should fight out the finish
2. **NERON ERGEE** - Faulted last time out at Royan-Atlantique over 2475m on 24 May. Capable of making the frame when smart
3. **NO LIMITS QUICK** - Bounced back to form with a victory in Class F at Strasbourg over 2150m on 7 June. Can follow up if smart again
4. **NORMAND DEBELGRAVE** - Consistent so far and finished 3rd in Class F at this course over 2150m on 1 June. Can earn some more money
5. **NITCH DE REVE D'OR** - Finished 3rd in Class E at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on 30 April. Showed a return to form and has claims in this line-up
6. **NABUCCO JOSSELYN** - Threatening to win a race and was runner-up in Class E at Cholet over 2800m on 9 June. Can go one place better
7. **NO LIMIT DREAM** - Victorious in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 31 March. Not reliable but cannot be ruled out
8. **NABAB DE CHENU** - Successful in Class F at Vichy over 2200m on 28 May. Can follow up this longer distance and must be respected
9. **NOWAK DE BUSSET** - Successful last time out in Class F at Strasbourg over 2800m on 13 May. Improving but does have disqualification issues
10. **NOBLE WINNER** - In good form and finished fourth in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 9 June. Capable of getting involved with the finish

**Summary:** NABUCCO JOSSELYN (6) is an improving colt. It was a convincing return to form last time out, he could get the better of them all. The task is not straightforward, however, with NITCH DE REVE D'OR (5), sent out with confidence by his trainer, and NABAB DE CHENU (8), who scored impressively on this track at the end of May, standing in his way. Continually progressing, NUMENOR'S FELLA (1) also has every chance of finishing in the mix.

## C7 - PRIX DU PERCHER - 2975m (a2m) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR € 12,000

- 1. MISTER CASTELLE** - Has not shown much so far and was 8th in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 9 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. MONTANA SOLO** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest at Orléans over 3400m on 7 June. Hard to trust and needs major improvement to win
- 3. MOOREA BOND** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Mondoubleau over 2825m on 14 June. Can make the frame if smart
- 4. MAGIC PEGASUS** - Has yet to win a race and was unplaced in Class F at Carpentras over 2100m on 31 May. Needs to do more to score
- 5. MERVEILLE DU JOUR** - Disqualified in three of her last four starts, including last time out at Bernay over 2800m on 31 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 6. MUST D'AURALIE** - Unreliable and finished third in a claimer at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 1 June. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 7. MUSE LIGERIENNE** - Off form and finished 9th in Class F at Lignières over 2775m on 31 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 8. MINNIE THE MOOCHER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class F at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne over 2700m on 25 May. May need to do more to beat these rivals
- 9. MALONG** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class E at this course over 2950m on 16 May. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal
- 10. MARELLA DALEO** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class A at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Capable of bouncing back to score
- 11. MAGNUS ROMO** - Battling to find best form and was unplaced in Class F at this course over 2800m on 10 June. Others make more appeal

**Summary:** MARELLA DALEO (10) drops back into a category where she has already proven herself. Given the overall quality of the field, victory looks within reach. From two starts at this level, MUST D'AURALIE (6) has finished on the podium each time and represents a solid betting proposition. MUSE LIGERIENNE (7) posted two notable performances in this class earlier in the spring and must be respected. It could be all or nothing with MOOREA BOND (3)!

## C8 - PRIX DE MARIOL - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 29,000

1. **HARIBELO DE NUIT** - Disqualified last time out at Vitteaux over 2625m on 24 May. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
2. **ICARE D'ASNOIS** - Kept to harness races of late and was unplaced in Class E at this course over 2150m on 1 June. Needs to find a few lengths back under the saddle
3. **I LOVE ELDE** - Did not show her best when 6th in a Class E mounted race at Vichy over 2975m on 10 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
4. **ILEX DE CABERT** - In very good form and was third in a Class D mounted race at Vichy over 2950m on 1 June. Should fight out the finish once again
5. **JHERE DU PORET** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this course over 2950m on 1 June. Should be competitive if smart
6. **IDEAL DE BANNES** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class F mounted race at this course over 2975m on 4 May. Can earn some more money
7. **JOBALASKO BLEU** - Disqualified last time out in a harness race at this course over 2975m on 10 June. Did win his last mounted race and can bounce back to score
8. **JADE DU PARC** - Unreliable but was third last time out in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 27 May. Can be competitive in this line-up
9. **JAGUAR DE KARA** - In good form and was successful last time out in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 27 May. Quite capable of following up
10. **IN YOUR EYES** - Off form and was 7th in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. Returns from a break and others make more appeal
11. **INSIDE MAN** - Disqualified last time out in a harness race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 1 June. Can bounce back to win a mounted race
12. **JAMES OF CARLY** - Victorious last time out in a Class D mounted race at this course over 2950m on 1 June. Can double up over this shorter distance

**Summary:** A very competitive lucky last race. JAGUAR DE KARA (9) will look to follow up on his recent success and gets the vote to score. JHERE DU PORET (5) is not the most reliable, but if he stays focused from start to finish, he can give the selection plenty to think about. A recent winner on this track, JAMES MADRIK (12) is also a leading contender, along with ILEX DE CABERT (4), who scored at course a month ago.
