- **13. MELUSINEDARCHE** Back under the saddle after being sanctioned in a 2675m Lisieux harness Class F on 3 July. Mathieu Mottier aboard this time and must be afforded respect
- **14. MISS TAHITI** Unexceptional filly returning to the ridden code after being sanctioned in a 2300m Marseille-Borely harness Class D on 10 June, and will not be troubling the judge
- **15. MELODIE DE BLARY -** Showed a different side when 2nd of 12 in a 2450m Caen Class D in late-May. Comes here fresh and looks a serious proposition
- **16. MIMI D'AUVILLIER -** Makes her ridden debut after being sanctioned in a 2625m Cherbourg harness Class E mid-June and will struggle to make her presence felt

Summary: Second on debut, under the saddle, before losing her action under harness, MAHIZ DE GUEZ (7) returns to the ridden code, with Alexandre Abrivard in the irons, and should have the measure of the field. They can nonetheless expect to feel some heat from MELODIE DE BLARY (15) who produced a very good effort at Caen last time out. The complicated MELUSINEDARCHE (13) was sanctioned that day but with application can figure prominently, but may first have to see off MUSEA (12) whose recent monte debut did not go unnoticed.
