- **1. ASTREA -** Comes into the race fresh off a win at Marseille Borely over 1200m and can certainly follow up. Big danger to the top ones
- **2. GOLDEN BREEZE -** Will need to do way more than recent 4th at La Teste over 1200m on the 4th of this month and others are preferred. Can easily be passed by
- **3. WANA CHOPE -** Won against a lot weaker last time at Dieppe over 1000m and might battle to beat this lot. An outsider that can be ignored
- **4. CATH HOCHE** Caught the eye in Listed company last time at La Teste over 1200m finishing 5th and should be hard to beat. Solid winning chance
- **5. OSHIA -** She was 5th at her last start over 1350m at Lyon Parilly and has shown ability before. Strong each way claims and a must for all bets

- 2. HAPPY AGAIN Current form has been on the decline and this one has become hard to predict and assess. Others preferred
- **3. LADY NAGIN** She was a winner three starts back and lined up in a Listed race last time. Others preferred and would be a surprise winner
- **4. EXPERTISE** Was not far off in 5th place at Aix Les Bains over 1200m on the 9th of this month in a Handicap and could improve to get closer. Quartet inclusion
- **5. HOUBI -** Was a winner three starts back but has let the team down thereafter which makes this one difficult to predict and assess. Can be ignored

- **3. TOMAKAY** Won over 1350m at Cholet on the 30th of last month and might find it tough to follow up but should run well. Outside place chance
- **4. TEN HORNS -** Won penultimate and followed up with a promising 5th at Deauville over 1200m in a Group 3 on the 6th of this month. Serious contender for a place
