C1 - PRIX AGRICOL ROUX - 2525m (a1 9/16m) - Amateurs-Autostart - Class G - Harness - EUR € 6.000

- **1. HOLGA DES CHAMPS -** Confirmed in this category, winning twice and finishing 2nd in her three starts at this level. Has a role to play
- **2. HISTORY TIKA -** Struggling to regain her form or spark the improvement needed to be competitive, so is not likely to trouble the judge
- **3. ESCROC DE VILLABON -** Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **4. GAETAN -** Has formed a formidable partnership with Gisèle Ambrogio, winning 17 times and finishing 2nd four times in their 23 associations. One to beat
- **5. FICTOR DES ROMAINS -** Seldom finishes far off the mark and could get into the picture here but has no more than a place chance
- **6. FALCO DA VINCI -** Ultra-consistent performer in good form and physical conditions. Runner-up in three of his last five starts and should be a factor here
- **7. GAZELLE VOGOULIERE -** Has made improvement recently, finishing 2nd and 3rd in her last two starts, and could get a look in here if confirming that form
- **8. GALEO VENUS -** Consistent sort who has already himself in this category. Ought to be competitive back in this grade

Summary: Consistent last-start winners GAETAN (4) and HOLGA DES CHAMPS (1), a winner at this venue recently, are likely to fight for victory in this opening event and it could go either way. GALEO VENUS (8) has held his own in better races/company and is proven at this level, so ought to fare better here on his return to this category. FALCO DA VINCI (6), after finishing 2nd in three of his last five starts, wouldn't be winning out of turn and should have a role to play too.

- **2. HAMAZONE -** Disappointed at Cagnes recently but has a good opportunity here to set the record straight. Worth another chance
- **3. GLAMOUR MONTAVAL** Has been in good form recently in the harness category and returns to this specialty in peak physical condition. Not taken lightly
- **4. GOOD BYE ANGOT -** At the top of his game and arrives in rude health after consecutive wins in July and back-to-back 2nd place finishes recently. Keep safe
- **5. HELLO EL SOL** Has made just one of his 58 starts in this discipline and was disqualified on that occasion, so is hard to make a case for
- **6. FENILA -** Seldom finishes far off the mark so could get into the picture, but has no more than a place chance
- **7. FASCINANT -** Struggling to regain any form/consistency for some time now so is not likely to trouble the judge. Can be ruled out
- **8. FERRERO DU LOISIR -** Narrowly beaten when last seen under the saddle at Vichy in July and ought to be competitive on his return to this specialty

Summary: HAMAZONE (2) let the side down on her return to the mounted code at Cagnes last time but remains capable of winning a race of this nature and is worth another chance here. She will, however, have to thwart FERRERO DU LOISIR (8) who is likely to fight for victory back under the saddle after two preparatory harness races. - **2. GALWAY DU VIVIER -** Enjoys a favourable commitment and races unshod on all four feet, which brought success when last tried with this shoeing configuration. One to beat
- **3. EXTRA DE LUNOJO -** Capable veteran who usually does well when avoiding disqualification. Need only remain wise to get into the picture
- **4. FOREVER DU JOUAN -** Out of sorts and is on a long losing run in this code with his best recent effort (3rd) coming under the saddle. Others preferred
- **5. GAWANI DU BOCAGE -** Nothing noteworthy to his name for a considerable period and, as such, can be easily ruled out. Overlook

GEORGIO THE FOL (1), runner-up last time out, should also make his presence felt.

- **2. IMPERATRICE VITELA -** Maintaining a respectable level of form/consistency and unlucky not to have achieved better than 6th last time. Keep safe
- **3. INDIAN DANEHILL** Has struggled to make an impression in his each of his last three outings so needs to reaffirm. Others preferred
- **4. HOUPETTE ROSE -** Ultra-consistent mare with sound form references. Lines up here in good form and physical condition so has claims
- **5. I AM DES MOTTES -** Consistent sort, proven at this level and is in very good form, so is more than capable of reconnecting with success
- **6. HANI BIRD -** Consistent for the most part and boasts solid references, including a last-start 3rd. Dangerous to dismiss
- **7. HOLLY GREEN -** Has rediscovered her form of late and ought to be competitive here on the evidence of her last two starts. Beware
- **8. INFINITY JET -** Has shown signs of improvement recently and could get a look in if confirming that form. Not taken lightly

- **2. KABYLIE -** Runner-up in her last two starts, in this category and under the saddle last time. Needs to reproduce a similar performance
- **3. KETTY ANGANO -** Has struggled to find any form or consistency for some time now so is unlikely to trouble the judge
- **4. KASTILLE -** Struggling to regain her form or spark the necessary improvement, so is unlikely to trouble the judge
- **5. KIND OF YOU -** Finished a pleasing 4th on her reappearance and would have achieved even better if not faulting. Will be factor

- **2. JOYEUSE MAB -** Seldom finishes far off the mark and could get into the picture here but has no more than a place chance
- **3. JASMINE WINNER -** Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- **4. JAMOURE DEPE -** Maintaining a respectable level of form/consistency and could get into the picture racing unshod in front
- **5. JUVE D'HERIPRE -** Quickly jeopardised her chances after faulting at the start last time but does have the means to make amends if applied

Last-start winner JURAE VET (11) as well as consistent JANDICE STAR (15) ought to remain competitive too. JAGUAR'S EYES (6) completes the shortlist.

- **2. HOLLY DOLL** Rewarded for her consistency with victory in an amateur race last time. Should remain competitive here
- **3. HERMES DE GIRONDE -** Ideally committed to the ceiling of earning and has maintained a good form/consistency recently. Will be a factor
- **4. MYSTIC MOM -** Undeniably capable but has been off the boil for some time now so will need to reaffirm. Best just to watch for now
- **5. HUGO DE JEMAX** Has been in poor form in codes recently and that does not augur well for his chances here. Overlook
- **6. GAMICHEL LUDOIS -** Struggling to regain his form or spark the necessary improvement, so is unlikely to trouble the judge
