## C1 - PRIX ISOPANI - 3600m (a2m1/4) - TURF - Newcomers - Hurdles - EUR € 50,000

**1. MARIUS** - Two unplaced runs on the flat, the latter over 2500m on September 28th at Nancy. Tries hurdles for the first time and faces a stiff task

**2. MATADOR ALLEN** - Gelding by Gemix, the dam was placed from only two starts. From a shrewd trainer who knows the time of day. Any market support could be an indication of expected performance

**3. MISSISSIPPI RIVER** - Two good efforts on the flat, a win on debut in April over 2450m and a 3rd at Vichy on May 25th over 2400m. Bred to do well over jumps, and he warrants respect

**4. MAKAO'K** - 6th on the one run over 2300m at Le Mans on the flat on September 12th. Likely to find a few of these too smart for his hurdle race debut

**5. MATTHEW** - Unraced gelding by Yeats, the dam was placed in a Grade 3 hurdle—nice profile and from a top yard. Can be expected to play a lead role

**6. MON FILS MADY** -

**7. MIATCHU** - He was 7th on the one run over 2300m at Le Mans on the flat on September 12th. Hurdle race debut, and is best watched for the time being

**8. MON MARCEL** - Gelding by Headman, the dam was placed once. Looks good on paper and he is best watched in the betting for any market support

**9. MAK CALAM** - Gelding on debut by Pour Moi, the dam was placed on the flat. Looks good on paper, and he is best watched for any market support

**10. MOULINS ROUGE** - Gelded son of No Risk At All, the dam was placed over hurdles and fences. Likely to improve for this debut run unless the betting says otherwise

**11. MISTERDOC** - Flat winner two runs back over 2400m at Vittel on August 15th. Hurdles debut and is one to keep onside

**12. MR KELL** - This gelding boasts a nice pedigree, being by Pour Moi. Although the dam never raced, he is from a respected trainer who will ensure he is well educated. One to consider on debut

**13. MILLEETUNEVICTOIRE** - Two unplaced efforts so far on the flat, the latter over 2400m at Moulins on September 17th. Hurdle race debut and others seem more likely

**14. MES CHERS FRERES** - He won nicely by 2L on his debut at Saint-Brieuc over 2400m on May 29th. Tries hurdles for the first time, and he will be well schooled. Live chance

**15. MURRAYFIELD PARK** - Unraced gelding by Great Pretender, the dam won 2 races on the flat, including a Group 2 AQ race. One to watch in the betting for any market interest

**Summary:** MES CHERS FRERES (14) made a good impression when scoring on his debut run at Saint-Brieuc on May 29th in a conditions race. He will be well schooled for this and can remain unbeaten. MATTHEW (5) could be the one who gives the selection the most to think about. He has a nice pedigree and will know what is required. MISSISSIPPI RIVER (3) has performed well on the flat and warrants respect on his hurdling bow. MISTERDOC (11) is a flat winner who should have a say on his hurdling debut.

**C2 - PRIX PIERRE DE LASSUS - 3900m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Gr3 - Hurdles -  
EUR € 125,000**

**1. SAIN D'ESPRIT** - He has won his two races this year, the most recent a Grade 3 hurdle over 3600m at this track on September 27th. Leading contender

**2. KIVALA DU BERLAIS** - Good winner over 3900m in the Prix Alain Du Breil (Grade 1) hurdle at this track on May 18th. He returns from a break and will be hard to beat

**3. DJIN'S** - Recent 2nd over 3600m in a Grade 3 hurdle over this track behind SAINT D'ESPRIT (1) on September 27th. He can play a lead role

**4. NIKKALUOKTA** - Useful effort to win over 3600m in a Listed hurdle at this track on September 18th. Can play a prominent role

**5. IT'S WIN O'CLOCK** - Ran well to be 2nd in a Listed hurdle at this track over 3600m behind NIKKALUOKTA on September 18th. Has a few lengths to find

**6. LORD RAFFLES** - He has won his three races, on the flat on debut and the last two over hurdles. The latest success was over 3600m at this track in a Class 2 hurdle on October 1st. Improving gelding and warrants respect

**Summary:** SAIN D'ESPRIT (1) has won his last three starts—two of them this year. His latest victory came over this course in the Grade 3 Prix de Maisons-Laffitte hurdle on September 27th, by 2 lengths. He appears to be a progressive and may have a fitness edge over KIVALA DU BERLAIS (2), who returns from a break following his Grade 1 win in the Prix Alain du Breil over this track and trip. DJIN'S (3) finished runner-up to the selection on September 27th and is expected to give another solid performance.

## C3 - PRIX GENERAL DONNIO - 4400m (a3m) - TURF - Listed - Steeple Chase - EUR € 88,000

- 1. KENITO** - He won over track and trip in a Class 1 chase on February 24th. Back from a layoff and can not be discounted if ready to go
- 2. KIND LOVELY** - Good won over 4100m at Lyon Parilly on September 28th in a Class 3 chase by 1.5L when beating a classy operator in Gex. Can be involved at the finish
- 3. KING CONTI** - Unplaced last time, 3rd previously over track/trip in a Listed chase on May 3rd. Hard to rule out on a track and trip he has won over previously
- 4. KING PINEAU** - Fair effort to finish 3rd over the track and trip on September 23rd in a Listed chase. Course and distance winner who can feature
- 5. CHANCE DE BALLON** - 5th on his last run over 3600m in a Listed hurdle at this track on May 27th. 3rd over track/trip in April in a Class 2 chase. Consider
- 6. KING SAINT** - Fair 3rd over 3500m at this track in a Class 2 chase on September 18th and a win over hurdles previously in July. Each way player
- 7. KILT ECOSSAIS** - He scored over 3500m at this track in a Class 2 chase on September 18th by 9L. He is improving and can not be ruled out
- 8. SAGA GIRL** - 5th on the one start this year over 3500m in a Class 2 chase on September 18th at this track. Unlikely to trouble the principles
- 9. ADRENALYNE** - Unplaced last time, a win previously over 3900m at Compiegne on April 22nd in a Class 2 chase. Has work ahead to be involved
- 10. KOUCA DE THAIX** - Recent success over track and trip on October 1st in a Class 3 chase. This is a much stiffer test and others are preferred

**Summary:** KENITO (1) has been off the track since a narrow success in a competitive Class 1 chase over course and distance in late February. He runs well fresh and is a marginal choice ahead of the progressive KILT ECOSSAIS (7), who scored by nine lengths in a Class 2 chase over 3500m on September 18th at this track. KIND LOVELY (2) is also worth looking at after a win in a Class 3 chase at Lyon Parilly late last month, beating the smart Gex into second that day. CHANCE DE BALLON (5) heads the rest.

## C4 - PRIX LE PARISIEN (PRIX DU PRINCE D'ECOUEN) - 3900m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Listed Divided Handicap - Hurdles - EUR € 98,000

- 1. POLYRISK** - He won over 3900m in a Listed hurdle at this track on September 27th when beating two of his rivals who re-oppose. Among the leading chances
- 2. LOU FAST** - Placed 2nd on his last two runs, the most recent over 3900m in a Listed hurdle at this track on October 7th. Hard to overlook
- 3. ROCK AND ROLL** - In form with two recent 3rd placed runs at this track, the latter over 3900m in a Listed hurdle on September 27th. Player
- 4. UNDENIABLE ALIBI** - Good effort to score over 3900m in a handicap hurdle at this track on September 27th. Hard to rule out of the top four
- 5. REVE DE PRINCE** - Unplaced last time out, 4th previously over 3900m in a Listed hurdle at Auteuil on March 30th. Unlikely to be involved
- 6. IGLOO IGLOO** - Unplaced last time, 4th previously over 3900m in a Listed hurdle at Auteuil on May 18th. He needs to be more reliable
- 7. JACKSON VILLE** - Credible 4th last time on September 27th behind POLYRISK (1) over 3900m in a Listed hurdle at Auteuil. Course winner on September 9th over hurdles and is hard to ignore each-way
- 8. INSTAR DE REVE** - 6th over 4400m in a handicap chase at this track on September 23rd last time out. Placed before that twice when 3rd. Has work to do in a good race
- 9. JUMPER BAIE** - Unplaced on the last two starts, 3rd before that over 3600m in a Listed hurdle at this track on May 31st. Capable of making an impact
- 10. BLEKOLINA** - She won over 4200m in a Class 2 handicap chase at Toulouse on April 7th on her last start. Back over hurdles, and others make more appeal
- 11. FURIOSO** - Five unplaced efforts since a win over 3600m at this track in a Class 2 handicap hurdle on February 15th. Capable of a better run than his latest efforts
- 12. EXUPERY** - Placed on his last three runs, 4th in a Class 3 chase at Auteuil on May 18th on the most recent. Opposable
- 13. DINOZAURE** - Fair effort to be 4th over 3600m in a handicap hurdle at Auteuil on October 12th. He will not lack for fitness and is one to consider
- 14. HENRY BRULARD** - Two unplaced runs of late, the latter when 6th at this track over 3900m in a handicap hurdle on September 27th. Opposable

**Summary:** ROCK AND ROLL (3) could be the one to beat in this competitive contest. He has been in solid form, finishing third in his last two starts at this track, most recently in a Listed hurdle on September 27th. LOU FAST (2) finished second in that same race and has since followed up with another runner-up effort in a Listed hurdle here just 11 days ago. He looks like a strong challenger. POLYRISK (1) won the September 27th Listed hurdle but meets his rivals on less favourable terms this time, which makes it a stiffer test. JUMPER BAIE (9) is worth another chance and appears better than his last two runs suggest, while UNDENIABLE ALIBI (4) looks best of the remainder.

**C5 - PRIX HEROS XII - 4400m (a3m) - TURF - Gr3 - Steeple Chase - EUR €  
152,000**

- 1. GRAN DIOSE** - 5th last time, a win previously over track and trip on April 26th in the Prix Ingre Chase (Grade 2). Capable performer and can not be ruled out
- 2. JUNTOS GANAMOS** - 7th last time, 2nd previously over 5500m in the Prix La Haye Jouselin (Grade 1) Chase on November 17th at this track. Classy operator, although prone to mistakes
- 3. HASARD DE BRION** - Unplaced last time, 4th previously over track and trip in the Prix Ingre (Grade 2) chase at this track on April 26th. Unlikely to be a threat
- 4. TOSCANA DU BERLAIS** - Placed on his last three runs, 4th on the latter over track/trip on September 27th in a Grade 3 chase. Consider each-way
- 5. KAADAM** - 5th last time over track and trip in a Grade 3 chase on September 27th, when making a few mistakes. Won the Prix Maurice Gillois-Grand Steeple-Chase (Grade 1) last November. Class act if back to his best
- 6. BON GARCON** - Decent 2nd over track and trip in a Grade 3 chase on September 27th and a win before that over the same on May 31st in the Prix Des Drags (Grade 2) chase. Live contender
- 7. AMY DU KIFF** - 5th on his last run in a Listed chase at Compiègne over 3800m on September 10th. Useful gelding, but others seem better equipped
- 8. INCOLLABLE** - Fair 2nd on his last start over 3500m in a Class 3 chase at this track on September 13th. Unlikely to trouble some of the main protagonists
- 9. SEL JEM** - Good effort to be 3rd in a Grade 3 chase over track and trip on September 27th. Former Grade 1 winner (Grand Steeple-Chase de Paris). He can be expected to strip fitter for that run and play a lead role
- 10. ALCYONE ROUGE** - Not seen since a 3rd in the Prix Georges Courtois Chase (Grade 2) on December 8th over track and trip. Might improve for this outing

**Summary:** BON GARCON (6) has solid form over course and distance, a win in May of the Prix Des Drags (Grade 2) chase, and a recent second over the same journey in a Grade 3 chase last month. He can be too smart for some strong rivals. SEL JEM (9) ran well on his return to action when 6L behind the main selection in third last month. He should be fitter today. JUNTOS GANAMOS (2) has plenty of talent and can feature with a good round of jumping. KAADAM (5) is a top-class on his day and should not be ruled out.

**C6 - PRIX CARMARTHEN - 4300m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Gr3 - Hurdles - EUR € 125,000**

- 1. LOSANGE BLEU** - Nice effort to be 2nd over 3900m in a Grade 3 hurdle behind GALLIPOLI (3) on September 27th when beaten by 12L. He will be sharper this time
- 2. JET BLUE** - 9th over 4800m in the Albert Bartlett Novices' Hurdle (Grade 1) at Cheltenham (UK) on March 14th on his latest start. He will improve for this outing after a prolonged absence
- 3. GALLIPOLI** - Two nice wins recently, the latter was by an easy 12 lengths over 3900m at Auteuil on September 27th in a Grade 3 hurdle. Capable of a leading role
- 4. EL CLAVEL** - Nice win of the Grand Course de Haies D'Auteuil Hurdle (Grade 1) on May 17th on his last start over 5100m. He can be expected to be ready for his return run
- 5. KANDY PARK** - Decent win over 4300m in a Grade 3 hurdle on May 31st when last racing. He can never be ruled out at this racecourse
- 6. LE ROI DAVID** - Success over 3900m at this track on October 7th in a Listed hurdle when last racing. This will be a lot more challenging
- 7. HELOY DELABARRIERE** - 5th on his last run over 5100m in the Grand Course de Haies D'Auteuil Hurdle (Grade 1) on May 17th behind EL CLAVEL (4). Look elsewhere
- 8. IMBATABLE DU SEUIL** - Unplaced last time, 3rd before that over 5100m in the Grand Course de Haies D'Auteuil Hurdle (Grade 1) on May 17th behind EL CLAVEL (4). Look for an alternative
- 9. ISIS D'INOR** - Ran well to be 3rd over 3900m in a Grade 3 hurdle at Auteuil on September 27th behind GALLIPOLI (3). She has a good bit of ground to make up, but warrants respect
- 10. KENTUCKY WOOD** - Placed 4th on his last two runs, the latter over 3900m in a Grade 3 hurdle on September 27th. Each way possibilities

**Summary:** EL CLAVEL (4) won the Grand Course de Haies D'Auteuil Hurdle (Grade 1) on May 17th on his latest start over 5100m at this track. The drop back in distance and lack of a recent outing will not stop him from following up. GALLIPOLI (3) could be the main danger, with two wins in September. The latter was a Grade 3 hurdle at this track over 3900m. LOSANGE BLEU (1) was second behind GALLIPOLI (3) late last month and is hard to rule out. ISIS D'INOR (9) is also worth a mention.

**C7 - PRIX ORCADA - 4400m (a3m) - TURF - Gr3 - Steeple Chase - EUR €  
140,000**

**1. LANIVTSI** - He has won his last three races, the most recent over 4400m at this track in a Grade 3 chase on September 23rd, and a Grade 1 success in May of the Prix Ferdinand Dufaure Chase. Key chance

**2. HACKER DU BERLAIS** - Fair 4th over track/trip in a Grade 3 chase on September 23rd when last seen. Class operator and is capable of making an impact at nice odds

**3. MAGUELON** - Solid win over track/trip in a Grade 3 chase on May 31st. Back from almost 5 months away, and can play a prominent role

**4. COEUR D'AMOUR** - Ran a credible race to be 3rd over 3500m in a Class 2 chase on September 18th at Auteuil. This will be more of a challenge

**5. LUCKY D'AUBRELLE** - Placed on all five runs this year, two wins in January and February over hurdles and fences at Pau, his latest effort when 4th at this track over 3500m in a Listed race was a decent performance. This requires a lot more

**6. LEADER SPORT** - Ran well to be 2nd over 3500m in a Class 2 chase on September 18th at this track. Lightly raced and has more to come

**7. LE RIVAGE** - Three unplaced efforts of late, the latter over 4400m in a Grade 3 chase at this track on September 23rd. Unlikely to feature

**8. HANI BAL** - Placed on his last three runs, 4th on the most recent over 3500m in a Class 2 chase on September 18th at Auteuil. Can be opposed

**9. LECOEURDESHOMMES** - Ran well to be 2nd over 4400m at this track in a Grade 3 chase on September 23rd behind LANIVTSI (1). He will be sharper today and warrants respect

**10. KIRAKINE** - Two 3rd placed runs of late, the latter over track and trip in a Grade 3 chase on September 23rd. Listed chase winner in April over track/trip. Enters calculations

**11. OLYMPIC STORY** -

**12. LA PALMERAIE** - 5th on her last run, 2nd previously over track and trip in the Prix Jean Stern (Grade 2) Chase on April 20th. In the mix

**13. MARTHA CANNARY** - 7th last time out, 2nd previously over track and trip in the Prix Ferdinand Dufaure (Grade 1) Chase behind LANIVTSI (1). Among the leading each way player

**Summary:** LANIVTSI (1) has scored in his last three starts. He won the Prix Ferdinand Dufaure Chase (Grade 1) in May and then returned to action last month after a break to win a Grade 3 over track and trip on September 23rd. He sets the standard. LECOEURDESHOMMES (9) can be a threat. He was second behind the selection last month and can improve for that outing. MAGUELON (3) is another to keep safe after success in May over track and trip in a Grade 3 chase. LA PALMERAIE (12) makes up the shortlist.

## C8 - PRIX SOULANGE-BODIN - 3900m (a2m1/2) - TURF - Divided Handicap - Hurdles - EUR € 60,000

- 1. ILIVA DES OBEAUX** - Good effort to be 2nd over 3900m in a handicap hurdle at this track on September 27th. Capable of going one place better this time
- 2. FORZA** - Three unplaced efforts since a 4th over 3600m at Auteuil on May 31st in a handicap hurdle race. Look for an alternative
- 3. STORM DES FLOS** - Placed on his last two runs, the latter when 3rd over 3900m in a handicap hurdle on September 27th. Ought to be in the shake-up
- 4. JAN** - Two solid 4th placed runs over fences recently, the latter over 3800m in a claiming chase on September 29th at Bordeaux Le Bouscat. Can be expected to be on the premises
- 5. JIKITO** - 5th last time over 3900m in a handicap hurdle at Auteuil on September 27th. Capable of a top-four finish
- 6. ROYAL MOON** - Credible effort to be 4th over 3900m on September 27th in a handicap hurdle last time out. Each way must
- 7. LOUTATHIR** - Not seen since a 2nd over 4100m at Royan in a claiming hurdle on August 18th. Likely to need this return run
- 8. GALET D'OUDAIRIES** - Unplaced last time out, 2nd previously over 3600m at this track on May 31st in a handicap hurdle. Enters each way calculations
- 9. CAITLIN'S COURT** - Three unplaced runs of late, 7th on the latest over 3900m at Auteuil in a handicap hurdle. She needs to show more reliability
- 10. CHICHI DE LA VEGA** - Out of form with several unplaced runs, well beaten over 3900m in a handicap hurdle at this track on September 27th when last seen. Pass over
- 11. JOSIE D 'AJONC** - Unplaced on her last four runs, the latter over 3900m at this track in a handicap hurdle on September 27th. More is needed to get involved
- 12. SPINOZZAR** - Only two runs last year, 2nd on the most recent of them at Jallais in a Class 5 hurdle on May 5th. Back from a prolonged absence, and it is best avoided

**Summary:** ILIVA DES OBEAUX (1) could be the most likely winner despite heading the weights. She was a pleasing second over the course and distance on September 27th and can confirm placings with STORM DES FLOS (3), who was less than a length behind in third in the same race, with ROYAL MOON (6) a close-up fourth that day, the race could be between the three of them. JAN (4) has been fourth over fences on his last two runs and can be involved on the switch back over hurdles today.
