C1 - PRIX DE LA COTE D'OR - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

1. MYSTERE CERIZE - 4th of 8 finishers in a 2175m Vincennes Class D on 9 September. Will appreciate the even surface here and will not be far from the action if Franck Nivard keeps him out of trouble

2. MATCHO MESLOIS - Imposed at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne mid-August before running 3rd of 10 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D a fortnight later. Comes to Enghien fresh and is unlikely to be far off the mark

3. MUST DU BELLAY - Won 2 of last 3, latterly a 2850m Laval Class E a fortnight ago, after 2.5 months off. Is ideally-placed behind the car and can impose

4. MARQUIS SOMOLLI - Progressive sort that won a 2525m Class D at Les Andelys on 14 September. Takes on a better bunch here but is patently improving with every run and cannot be ruled out

5. MISTHOS CHRISTAL - Imposed at Les Sables-d'Olonne before quickly losing his action in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class D on 10 September. Form is not in question though, is well-placed in front, and with application can go far

6. MARLEY DE BAILLE - Missed out by a head in a Class E over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Has buckets of untapped potential and will be competitive for the win

7. MIKADO CASTELETS - Returns to racing left-handed after finishing 6th of 7 in a 2950m Vichy Class B in late-August. Has evident ability and even though breaking wide still looks competitively well in

8. MILLESIME STAR - 5th of 8 finishers in a 2875m Enghien claimer 9 days ago. Is not the most performant of horses and is unlikely to create an upset

9. MORETIME DU CAMPUS - Eliminated when preparing for this over 2350m in Waregem early last month. Would have preferred a better draw but is useful when focused and is not incapable of picking up a cheque

10. MANNINEN SEVEN - Makes first appearance since running 5th of 7 finishers in a Class D over track and trip on 13 August, and is not about to be given a hard race

11. MADE IN CASTELETS - Last of 8 on re-entry here before being eliminated in a 2100m Vincennes Class D on 7 October. Is not devoid of ability but others still preferred

12. MOONLIGHT DANICA - Last of 9 on re-entry in a 2275m Nantes Class D 3 weeks ago. Will have progressed for the run but still represents an outside chance at best

Summary: It took a couple of runs to get him focused but MUST DU BELLAY (3) has since shown considerable promise and the nature of his re-entry victory augurs well for his chances of doubling up. Eric Raffin will still be mindful of the less-experienced, but no less talented, MARLEY DE BAILLE (6), and MYSTERE CERIZE (1) who should appreciate the Enghien profile. MISTHOS CHRISTAL (5) is plainly in excellent shape and will be no pushover if Matthieu Abrivard gets him off on the right foot.

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C2 - PRIX DE LA PLACE SAINT-CHARLES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 41,000

- 1. KASA DJANGA** - Unable to confirm good Vincennes performance when eliminated in a 2850m Class E at Nuillé-sur-Vicoin last Monday, and is not about to spring any surprises
- 2. KISS ME DE MADKER** - Missed out on the hat-trick in a 3000m Nantes Class E 3 weeks ago when losing her action when clearly full of running. Benjamin Rochard at the helm this time and must be respected
- 3. KINO DAB** - Would have finished closer than 3rd of 13 in a 2875m Class E here 9 days ago had she been afforded a run. Is well-positioned this time and Damien Bonne will be keen to put things right
- 4. KELOMA DREAM** - Rewarded with a well-deserved victory late last month when securing a 2050m Laval Class E. Is barefoot again and the draw will do her chances no disservice. Chance
- 5. KALICINE** - Made up somewhat for a pair of eliminations when 5th of 13 in a 2700m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche on 1 October. Well-placed on front row and even though just unshod-behind will still generate some interest
- 6. KANAILLE ROYALE** - Sprang a 57-1 surprise when 5th of 13 behind KINO DAB (3) in a 2875m Class E here 9 days ago. Barefoot this time, with Paul Ploquin maintaining faith, and although not a priority is not to be written off either
- 7. KAI LA SHA** - Courageous 6th of 13, a place behind KALICINE (5), in a 2700m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche on 1 October. A repeat seems improbable though
- 8. KUNZITE D'EM** - Unplaced in both since the summer break, latterly 8th of 13 behind KALICINE (5) in a 2700m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche on 1 October, and can be passed over
- 9. KIRA DE CAHOT** - Back under harness after being eliminated in a 2875m monte Class E here late last month. Has little love for Enghien though and can be passed over
- 10. KAPELLA DAIRPET** - Runner-up in last 2, latterly 2nd of 13 in a 2725m Cabourg Class E on 22 August. Has freshness on her side and is unlikely to disappoint
- 11. KYRA D'ESSARTS** - Showed moderate improvement when 6th of 10 finishers to KELOMA DREAM (4) in a 2050m Laval Class E late last month. David Thomain in the bike this time and is worth keeping an eye on
- 12. KARLA MELODY** - Useful sort that finished last but one, on return from a spell, in a 2875m Class E here 9 days ago. Is in conditioning mode though and best to hold off
- 13. KAMELIYA** - Won 5 of the last 6 races she finished, latterly a 2650m Class F at Les Sables-d'Olonne early last month. Unbeaten in 3 starts with her driver and is easy to fancy for the win
- 14. KINOHA D'OURVILLE** - Imposed at Graignes before running 3rd of 16 in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle on 22 September. In marginally better company this time and is not ideally-drawn, but is clearly in form and must be taken seriously
- 15. KENZA D'AMOUR** - Has not been seen out since being eliminated in a 2775m Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 9 July and will have nothing to contribute
- 16. KALAMATA BEACH** - Eliminated in 3 of last 4, most recently a 2700m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche early this month, and can expect to have few friends

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Summary: She may not always be the easiest of horses to handle but KAMELIYA (13) has tonnes of ability, has never failed to deliver for Eric Raffin, and with application can secure her first hat-trick. Better-positioned on the front row, KINOUBAB (3) gave a fine, but unlucky, account over longer here recently and looks dangerous. KELOMA DREAM (4) starts upsides, won smartly at Laval, and with application will have her chances. KAPELLA DAIRPET (10) comes here fresh and will not be far off the mark if Robin Lamy successfully navigates the start.

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C3 - PRIX DE LA PLACE DES VOSGES - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 53,000

1. JAB DE MYE - Won a Vincennes Class E at 94-1 before running 6th of 11 behind JERZINHO SPORT (11) in a 3125m Angers Class D on 1 October. Can be confidently brought back into the fold and can finish closer this time

2. JAGUAR D'OBRET - Excellent 3rd to JACOMO BELLO (7) at Mauquenchy before coming 3rd of 11 in a 3000m Nantes Class F 3 weeks ago. Pleased in last 2 Enghien starts but would have better prospects a level down

3. JAVA DES CAILLONS - In cracking form for past 2.5 months, most recently securing victory in a Class D over course and distance late last month. Takes on a marginally better lot but can still expect the lion's share of support

4. JENNY DE JOUDES - 5th of 10 in a 2825m Chartres Class F on 12 September. Consistently gives her best but may just be taking on too much this time

5. JUNKIES MINDS - Runner-up in last 2, latterly a 2100m Vincennes Class E 8 days ago. Put in a fast time that day, is nicely-positioned in front, and will be no pushover

6. JASMIN PRECIEUX - 6th of 16 when being conditioned in a 2875m Class D here 10 days ago. Goes barefoot this time and is worth keeping an eye on

7. JACOMO BELLO - Comfortable winner of a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E on 11 September. Starts relatively wide but will still be expected to give JAVA DES CAILLONS (3) something to think about

8. JEREMY D'AS - Returns to a track he likes after winning a 2875m Class E at Meslay-du-Maine on 10 September. Seldom disappoints when barefoot and seldom disappoints with Matthieu Abrivard reining

9. JEU COQUIN - Encouraged at Francheville but failed to impress when last but one to JACOMO BELLO (7) in a 2150m Mauquenchy Class E on 11 September, and chances appear limited

10. JAGUAR DE LAUMAC - 2nd of 12 to JAVA DES CAILLONS (3) in a Class D over track and trip on 29 September. Trainer back in the bike and the draw does him no favours

11. JERZINHO SPORT - Easily imposed at Les Sables-d'Olonne before running 3rd of 11 in a 3125m Angers Class D on 1 October. Is clearly close to winning another but the draw may limit him to a place cheque

12. JOKER D'OCCAGNES - Respectable 5th of 11 behind JERZINHO SPORT (11) in a 3125m Angers Class D on 1 October. Takes on a tougher challenge this time and will have few takers

13. JAMAIS - Rewarded with success in a 2950m Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne in early-September. Has done everything asked of him lately, appreciates the venue, and even from the back line can make first 5

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Summary: Three times a winner in her last 4 starts, including twice over course and distance, JAVA DES CAILLONS (3) enjoys a terrific draw and even though stepping up in category still looks the one to beat. Winner of his only start under these conditions, JACOMO BELLO (7) returns to the venue in excellent shape and can double his money if he replicates his Mauquenchy performance. JUNKIES MINDS (5) similarly secured his lone appearance over 2150m here, sports modified shoeing, and in current condition must be considered a contender. JAB DE MYE (1) beat the latter 2 at Vincennes in late-August and warrants considerable respect.

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C4 - PRIX DE LA PLACE DES FETES - 2250m (a1m1/2) - Class E Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 37,000

- 1. DEVIL OP** - Last but one in a Class E over course and distance 10 days ago. Front shoes off this time but still not a concern
- 2. JUNKO SEPT** - Failed to confirm Les Andelys performance when 8th of 13 in a 2700m Segre Class F on 6 October, and in this company will have too much to do
- 3. JAFF DE MESLAY** - Unraced since finishing last of 10 in a 2950m Saint-Malo harness Class F on 12 August. Not the most dependable of horses but has a point to prove for his new yard. Place chance
- 4. JACANA DE BLARY** - Ran 2nd at Cabourg earlier in the month but lost her action in a 2850m Class H at Nuillé-sur-Vicoin last weekend. Is patently in decent shape though and with application can trot her way onto the podium
- 5. DALI'DEL RONCO** - Switches code for first time after being eliminated in a 2150m harness Class D here late last month. Is not devoid of ability and can play a leading role if he keeps his action together
- 6. ZIVA** - 9th of 12 finishers in a 2750m Angouleme harness Class E on 5 October. Pleased on lone monte start at home in Sweden but others still preferred
- 7. JILANZA DU MOULIN** - 5th of 15 in a 2150m harness Class E here 9 days ago. Won over course and distance on sole monte start here and must be considered a leading contender
- 8. JANICK DU VIVIER** - Dependable mare that ran 3rd of 11 in a 2750m Angouleme Class F a fortnight ago. Reverts to racing barefoot but looks more a minor place chance this time
- 9. JEEP DES CHARRONS** - Eliminated in last 2, most recently a 2850m Vincennes harness amateurs Class G 2.5 weeks ago. Is proven under the saddle but latest numbers do little to inspire confidence
- 10. JONQUILLETE CREPIN** - Won an amateur event at Rambouillet before finishing last of 9 in a 2700m Vincennes Class C on Tuesday. Blows hot and cold but runs barefoot as she did in the provinces and is best retained
- 11. JAGUAR DE VILLETOT** - 5th of 10 in a 3175m Saint-Omer Class F last Sunday. Could not have asked for a better entry and can pick up some prizemoney

Summary: Very effective in this branch of the business, and with 3 runs under her belt, JILANZA DU MOULIN (7) won under these conditions almost exactly 2 years ago and will be favoured to repeat. On paper, DALI'DEL RONCO (5) may not be an obvious choice, but considering what he has produced in the other code, the change of discipline may be just what the doctor ordered. Barefoot for his return to the code, JAFF DE MESLAY (3) debuts for his new trainer with a decent chance of getting straight down to business. JACANA DE BLARY (4) will not be far from the action if Charline Blaizot keeps her focused.

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C5 - PRIX DE LA PLACE MAUBERT - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 35,000

- 1. LISON DES GLENAN** - 5th of 10 behind LOU DU DONJON (7) in a 2725m Graignes Class E on 25 September and will struggle to make her mark
- 2. LA FEE MARGOT** - Complicated filly making first appearance since being eliminated in a 2925m Cagnes Class E in early-August and is going to need the race
- 3. LITTLE STAR** - Well-beaten in last 2, most recently 12th of 13 in 7 October race of reference, and needs to get her house in order
- 4. LOZA** - Out of the picture in last 3, most recently 8th of 14 in a 2650m Alencon Class E early last month, and will not be troubling the judge
- 5. LUDMILLA HAUFOR** - 9th of 13 behind LAHANNA DESBOIS (13) in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 7 October. Has 2 runs under her belt and should prove more competitive this time
- 6. LAVEZZI PEJI** - Competitive 3rd of 9 finishers in a 2850m Laval Class E on 25 September. David Thomain gets the nod this time and with form maintained can again figure prominently
- 7. LOU DU DONJON** - Encouraged twice in the provinces before coming 6th of 13, a place behind LAHANNA DESBOIS (13), in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 7 October. Confirmation, however, seems unlikely
- 8. LELIZIA** - 10th of 15 in a 2700m Vincennes Class E early last month. Can prove difficult but has had time to freshen up and the new configuration may be just the ticket
- 9. LIPSKA** - Showed form in the spring but disappointing since, latterly eliminated in a 2850m Laval Class E a fortnight ago, and others easier to trust
- 10. LILY PEEL** - Ran 2nd at Amiens before coming 8th of 13 behind LAHANNA DESBOIS (13) in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 7 October. Was not afforded a run that day but still represents a minor place chance at best
- 11. LOLA DE VILLARD** - Good 4th at Carentan before being eliminated in a 2850m Laval Class E a fortnight ago. Should not be too hastily-judged though and with her trainer back in the wagon can start to make amends. First 5
- 12. LEONTINE CASH** - Quality element that was eliminated on re-entry early this month in a 2700m Class E at Le Croise-Laroche. Franck Nivard in the bike this time and while not a priority should not be written off either
- 13. LAHANNA DESBOIS** - 5th of 13 in a 2100m Vincennes Class E 11 days ago. Is plainly in good shape but with shoes on is unlikely to make any waves
- 14. LEGENDE INDIGO** - Imposed at Ecommoy in mid-September then ran 2nd of 14 in a 2750m Angoulême Class E 3 weeks later. Steps up in category but has been entrusted to Mathieu Mottier for first time and can pick up a cheque
- 15. LILI BROAY** - Never dangerous when eliminated in a 2700m Class E on comeback at Le Croise-Laroche on 1 October. Barefoot for the occasion, with Alexis Collette in the bike, and can bring the fight to LADY ANGELE (16)

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16. LADY ANGELE - Quality element that defied her 20-1 on comeback when 3rd of 11 finishers in a 2850m Laval Class E 2 weeks ago. Failed to deliver on sole start here but looks a different horse and can open her autumn account

Summary: Excellent on her re-entry at Laval earlier in the month, LADY ANGELE (16) will have come on for the race and considering the entry can run away with this. Also well-engaged following one comeback run, LILI BROAY (15) is barefoot for her first objective of the autumn and looks the main danger. LELIZIA (8) is not always the most dependable but on a good day she is easy to like, and the new configuration will be expected to pay off. Sporting front pads after putting in a good effort at Laval, LAVEZZI PEJI (6) is one for the shortlist.

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**C6 - PRIX DE NEUILLY EN THELLE - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Mounted -
EUR € 40,000**

1. MALOU DE DIGEON - Debuts under the saddle after having been disqualified in a 2625m Saint-Omer Class F last Sunday. Hard to make a case for and is easily passed over

2. MODELE GEMA - 6th of 10 finishers behind MAXOU DIGEO (8) in a 2250m Class E here 10 days ago. Has yet to place in five starts and will have limited aspirations

3. MONTANA BLUE - 4th of 7 finishers in a 2200m Vincennes Class D 3 weeks ago. Won in this code in August at Les Sables d'Olonne and is not out of it

4. MILORD DAIRPET - Unraced since finishing last but one, a place behind MAURICIO DU DERBY (6) in a 2200m Vincennes Class C mid-August. Has claims on previous form but could be in need of a run

5. MELANCHOLY MAN - Pulled-up, on return to competition, in a 2050m Cabourg Class D on Wednesday in a harness race. Back in his preferred discipline and expected to go well

6. MAURICIO DU DERBY - Disappointing in last 3, most recently 6th of 9 finishers in a 2700m Vincennes Class D on 16 September. Placed just once in eight starts and has work to do here

7. MOJITO D'HERFRAIE - Opened monte account at Cabourg in August but disqualified in a 2700m Vincennes Class D in mid-September. On a redemption mission and cannot be discounted

8. MAXOU DIGEO - Second of 10 finishers in a 2250m Class E here 10 days ago. In similar form will be hard to get passed

9. MAMBO THORIS - Switches code for first time after running 6th of 14 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Warrants serious attention

Summary: MAXOU DIGEO (8) is a reliable trotter in this code and his last effort is good enough to think that he can come in top in a race like today. He gets the vote ahead of MOJITO D'HERFRAIE (7), who had shown plenty of promise in this code prior to his last sanction. MELANCHOLY MAN (5) is back in the mounted code after a much needed comeback run four days ago and can make his presence felt. MAMBO THORIS (9) is a useful trotter under harness and is worth a mention on debut under the saddle.

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**C7 - PRIX DU MAINE - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR
€ 18,000**

1. MAESTRO BILOU - Makes maiden claiming start after finishing last but one in a 2700m Vincennes Class D 3.5 weeks ago. Takes a notable dip in category and is not incapable of picking up a first-5 payout

2. MACLANDER - 6th of 8 finishers in 9 October race of reference. Is no slouch at this level and over this shorter trip can get in on the action

3. MAESTRIA GALAA - Got back in the game when 2nd of 14 in a 2100m Vincennes claimer 2.5 weeks ago. Has a lot going for her here and is easy to like for the win

4. MARIA DE VALNY - 7th of 8 finishers behind MILADY MADRIK (7) in a 2875m claimer here 9 days ago. Imposed under these conditions in August and should not be ruled out

5. MY WAY LEAGABIN - Back in the claiming category after finishing 6th of 8 finishers in a 2700m Vincennes Monte Class C on 2 September. Seldom finishes in the money and is not about to start now

6. MILORD D'IRAI - Made it 3 straight eliminations after quickly losing his action in a 2700m Graignes Class B last Sunday. Has won at this level, and will be reined by Eric Raffin, but others still easier to trust

7. MILADY MADRIK - Made up for Vincennes effort when 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2875m claimer here 9 days ago. Breaks somewhat wide but in present shape is easy to recommend

8. MONA GALAA - 13th of 14 behind MAESTRIA GALAA (3) in a 2100m Vincennes claimer late last month, and would be preferred under the saddle

9. MAZERATI PAJJ - Confirmed Vincennes performance when 3rd of 8, a place behind MILADY MADRIK (7), in a 2875m claimer here on 9 October. Is clearly in her category and should not let the side down

10. MOTLEY CRUE - Unplaced in last 2 starts, most recently 8th of 11 finishers in a 2100m Vincennes Class D earlier this month, and will have nothing to contribute

11. MAYA DES BAUX - 5th of 8 finishers in a 2200m Strasbourg Class E on 28 August, and even at this level is unlikely to shake things up

12. MA REINE - 4th of 14 behind MAESTRIA GALAA (3) in a 2100m Vincennes claimer late last month. Will have come on for the run and can go closer this time if Pierre-Yves Verva positions her early

13. MASSILIO BLOND - Last of 8 behind MILADY MADRIK (7) in a 2875m claimer here on 9 October, and already looks out of his depth

Summary: MAESTRIA GALAA (3) looked a different horse when 2nd in a Vincennes claimer late last month and from the 3-spot seems thoroughly capable of imposing this time. MAZERATI PAJJ (9) has not been so fortunately-drawn but has demonstrated decent aptitude at this level and can apply the pressure. That said, MILADY MADRIK (7) had her measure here recently and will not be easily disposed of. MA REINE (12) has pulled a tough number but held her own last time and can challenge for a place in the frame.

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**C8 - PRIX DU CHAMP DE MARS - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness -
EUR € 38,000**

- 1. NELATI DE MORGANE** - Returns to Enghien after finishing 9th of 11 behind NICKY DU VERGER (3) in a 2200m Vincennes Class C a month ago. Is better than recent results would imply but still faces a stiff test
- 2. NINO VERO** - 4th of 10 in a Class C over course and distance 3 weeks ago. Is learning his trade well and can trot his way into the money
- 3. NICKY DU VERGER** - Respectable 5th of 11 in a 2200m Vincennes Class C a month ago. Will not be sent out at 77-1 this time but is unlikely to be as competitive either
- 4. NEMO DU VARLET** - Opened his account in a 2100m Lyon-Parilly Class E a fortnight ago. Takes on a better lot here but is well-placed behind the car and should not be overlooked
- 5. NON STOP MESLOIS** - 2nd of 8 in a 2050m Cabourg Class D early this month. Is new to racing left-handed but is well-placed in front and will not be far off the mark if he turns
- 6. NICE TO SEE YOU** - 4th on debut at Evreux 3 weeks ago then won a 2050m Cordemais Class F a week later. Is the choice of Eric Raffin here and will be expected to repeat
- 7. NIKKEI PONT ROYAL** - Debuted 3rd at La Capelle before winning over 1750m in Mons on 20 September. A repeat, however, seems most improbable
- 8. NAPOLEON AS** - Qualified in 1'15"8 last month before running 3rd of 11 in a 2100m Cholet Class D 3 weeks ago. Has considerably more to give and can play a leading role
- 9. NAMOUR DAB** - Solid 2nd of 13 in a 2050m Laval Class F on 25 September, first time out. Put in a fine finish that day and it will not be long before he gets off the mark
- 10. NECTAR DE CHANLECY** - 6th of 7 finishers, on debut a month back, in a 2200m Vichy Class E on 20 September, and will need to find considerably more

Summary: These juvenile races are never as easy to decipher as one might like but it is still difficult to ignore recent Cordemais winner, NICE TO SEE YOU (6), who will be reined by Eric Raffin for the first time. He will still want to be wary of NAMOUR DAB (9) who left a very good impression at Laval on his career bow, and NAPOLEON AS (8) who was simply dynamic in qualification. Courageous at Cabourg earlier in the month, NON STOP MESLOIS (5) is not to be underestimated.
