C1 - PRIX WERINGIA - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. LIVE YOUR DREAMS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Cabourg over 2775m on 23 October. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 2. LOVI CADENCE** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class D at this track over 2175m on 21 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 3. LUCKY BOY VERTRAC** - Not reliable but was third in Class E at this track over 2100m on 3 November. Capable of playing a minor role again
- 4. LUTIN DES ARRIS** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in Class E over this course and distance on 31 October. Can complete a hat-trick
- 5. LAKOS DE BERLES** - Holding form of late and was fourth in Class D at this track over 2175m on 21 October. Could make the frame
- 6. LUCKY MESLOIS** - Not disgraced when fourth in Class D over this track and trip on 7 November. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 7. LUCIANO ROYAL** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class A at Argentan over 2875m on 2 November. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 8. LONGWOOD D'HERIPRE** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in E at Enghien over 2875m on 27 September. Can complete the hat-trick
- 9. LORD DE BRION** - Returned to form and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2100m on 3 November. Can go one place better
- 10. LAY UP** - Unreliable and was 5th in Class D over this track and trip on 7 November. More is needed to win this race
- 11. LINDSTEDT** - Disqualified at over this track and trip on 7 November. Unreliable but is capable of earning some minor money
- 12. LORD DES FANES** - On a long losing run and finished 9th in Class D at Divonne-les-Bains over 2700m on 14 August. Needs major improvement to win
- 13. LASCAR PILE** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in Class A over this track and distance over this course and distance on 7 November. Not out of it
- 14. LIMO DE MER** - Consistent and was third in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 6 October. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 15. LOCO FLIGNY** - Showed some improvement when third in Class D over this track and trip on 7 November. Could earn some minor money
- 16. LAHIRE DE NAPPES** - Still improving and was runner-up in Class A at Le Croisse-Laroche over 2825m on 8 November. Can score again
- 17. LONDON RECALL** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in Class B at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 16 May. Could need this run returning from a break

18. LAUSSAC DU BUISSON - A bit of a disappointment when 6th in Class C over this course and distance on 14 October. Can contest the finish

Summary: LORD DE BRION (9) defends a very good record when racing without shoes and should make a good bid at beating these rivals. LAUSSAC DU BUISSON (18) seems better than a modest recent performance and can get involved with the finish once again. Remains in very good form and can follow up with more success. LASCAR PILE (13) is clearly capable of better and is not out of it over a course and distance that suits.

40,000**

1. MELANCHOLY MAN - Showed some improvement and was third in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 18 October. Might play a minor role

2. MAESTRO MUSIC - Has only been modest of late and was 9th in a Class C harness race at Caen over 2450m on 11 October. More is needed to beat these rivals

3. MYSTIC PARKER - Two wins in his last three starts, including last time out in a Class E mounted race at Enghien over 2250m on 8 October. Can follow up

4. MAMBO DE LA VALLEE - Did not show his best when 7th in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2700m on 14 October. Can bounce back to beat these rivals this distance

5. MIDNIGHT DREAM - Did not show his best when 6th in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2700m on 14 October. Capable of better and is not out of it

6. MICH D'OCCAGNES - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class D mounted race at this track over 2700m on 16 September. Be right there at the finish

7. MUST D'HERMES - In good form and finished third in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2700m on 14 October. Can contest the finish again

Summary: A very open race for a small field. MAMBO DE LA VALLEE (4) likes this shorter distance and could be a start-to-finish winner if showing his best form. MICH D'OCCAGNES (6) drops in class, so a better run is expected and he should be a threat. MUST D'HERMES (7) remains in good form and can contest the finish again. MIDNIGHT DREAM (5) has won at this track and is capable of making the frame once again.

1. **KADO SHINING** - Finished 9th in a Group 3 at this track over 2175m on 16 August. Capable of better and might play a minor role
2. **KRAKEN CASTELETS** - Very consistent of late and was runner-up in Class B at this track over 2700m on 14 October. Can be competitive once again
3. **KAZY MERITE** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in Class C over this course and distance on 24 October. Be right there at the finish
4. **KHARNAS** - Unreliable of late and finished 7th in Class C at Laval over 2875m on 1 November. Better over further but is not out of it
5. **KOALA BLUE** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class C over this track and trip on 24 October. Capable of making the frame
6. **KINGSMAN D'EOLE** - Victorious last time out in Class C at this track over 2700m on 30 October. Quite capable of following up this shorter distance
7. **KIKI AND CO** - Very unreliable and was fourth in Class C at this track over 2850m on 30 October. Has disqualification issues and others make more appeal
8. **KEN FERFAY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class A at Le Croisse-Laroche over 2850m on 8 November. Might play a minor role
9. **KING GEORGES** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in Class B at this track over 2700m on 7 November. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
10. **KOVES DU PONT** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class in Class C at this track over 2700m on 30 October. Capable of better and has a place chance
11. **KENTUCKY FIRST** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2700m on 23 September. Capable of better and might play a minor role
12. **KEMPEL DE GUEZ** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class D at this track over 2850m on 21 October. Others are preferred
13. **KORSIKO** - Did not show his best when unplaced in Class D at Graignes over 2725m on 30 October. Capable of an upset on best form
14. **KAZAR** - Unreliable and finished 9th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 19 September. More is needed to beat these rivals
15. **KAMOUR** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class B at this track over 2700m on 7 November. Needs to do more to win
16. **KELLOU DES BRUMES** - Victorious last time out in Class D at Caen over 2200m on 19 October. Unreliable but is capable of following up

Summary: A competitive race. KINGSMAN D'EOLE (6) showed what he is capable of with a good finishing burst when scoring at this track last month. He can double up if in the same mood over this distance. KAZY MERITE (3) is threatening a win and can go one better this time over this track and trip. KRAKEN CASTELETS (2) is usually competitive and should be in the mix once again. KOALA BLUE (5) did not run badly over this course and distance last month and is another to consider.

- 1. LUCKY DU BOUFARD** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Laval over 2850m on 7 Noember. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- 2. LARGO WIND** - Disqualified las time out in a Class E harness race at Laval over 2850m on 7 November. Very consistent in mounted races and should be right there at the finish
- 3. LAURO FLIGNY** - Has improved of late and finished third in Class F at Reims over 255m on 10 November Might play a minor role
- 4. L'ONCLE SAM** - Not reliable but did finish third in a Class B mounted race over this course and distance on 16 September Can get involved with the finish again
- 5. LYNX D'URZY** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Class D mounted race at Enghein over 2250m on 13 October. Can earn some more mony
- 6. LIGHTNING JIEL** - Victorious last time out in a Class F mounted race at Reims over 2500m on 10 November. Not out of it in this line-up
- 7. LILIUS DE GUEZ** - Barefoot and third in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 28 October. Consistent under the saddle and can scoe

Summary: LILIUS DE GUEZ (7) has a good record in mounted races and was a good third last time out. He gets a confident vote to score. LARGO WIND (2) is also very consistent under the saddle and can be very competitive once again. L'AS DE COEUR (8) is very hard to trust but is capable of getting involved in the finish. L'ONCLE SAM (4) is unreliable but could make the frame when in the right frame of mind.

- 1. MALKO MESLOIS** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in Class D at this track over 2700m on 30 October. Capable of making the frame when smart
- 2. MAGNUS TOR** - In very good shape and was runner-up in Class E over this track and trip on 28 October. Be right there at the finish
- 3. MACAREUX DU TRIEUX** - Unreliable and finished 5th in Class B at Les Sables L'Dollone over 2775m on 20 October. Might play a minor role
- 4. MY DREAM MESLOIS** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in Class D at this track over 2700m on 30 October. Capable of an upset when staying in stride
- 5. MALIUM** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class D at this course over 2700m on 30 October. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 6. MALUMA D'ANGIS** - Unreliable but did run well when third in Class E at this track over 2200m on 3 November. Can be competitive once again
- 7. MAESTRO DES SARTS** - Did not show his best when 7th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 30 October. Place chance in this line-up

- 15. MEETING MESLOIS** - Disqualified at this track over 2175m on 8 November. Hard to trust but is capable of earning some money when smart
- 16. MEYOU DU CAMPUS** - Disqualified at le Croisse-Laroche over 2700m on 27 October. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal

Summary: MONTENEGRO (11) was a good winner after being gelded and can follow up if in the same mood. MAGNUS TOR (2) is in very good form and can go one better on his latest course-and-distance performance. MALUMA D'ANGIS (6) is not reliable but did run well over this track and trip at the beginning of the month and is clearly not out of it. MALKO MESLOIS (1) is hard to trust but is also capable of winning when smart.

- 1. MELODY MUSIC** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class D at Salon-De-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Can make the frame
- 2. MISS BELGRAVE** - Victorious in Class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2875m on 27 October. Improving and can follow up in this line-up
- 3. MAGIC ROSE** - Victorious in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 7 November. Improving and is capable of earning some more money
- 4. MORGANE DE HOERDT** - Victorious in Class F at Strasbourg over 2825m on 24 October. Not reliable but is not out of it in this line-up
- 5. MULANE DU BOCAGE** - Did not show her best when unplaced in Class D at this track over 2700m on 23 September. Capable of better and could earn some money
- 6. MONNAIE COURANTE** - In good shape and was third in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 26 October. Capable of making the frame

MAYA DU POMMEAU (9) has a tricky draw to overcome but is quite capable of winning a race of this nature. MAJESTE DAB (13) is another that is hard to trust but is clearly not out of it if smart. MONANZA CASTEL (14) is knocking hard at the door and could go one better over this particular course and distance.

1. **JUMBO D'AUVILLIER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 7th in Class C at Vichy over 2975m on 13 September. Can win trying a claimer
2. **JEU MAJYC** - In good form and finished fourth in Class F at Enghien over 2150m on 2 July. Might need this run returning from a break
3. **JUBY DE BAILLY** - Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in a claimer at Enghien over 2150m on 16 October. Unlikely to win
4. **JOLIE QUEEN** - Did not show her best when 9th in Class F at Maquenchy over 2850m on 9 November. In good form before that and can make the frame
5. **JARDIN D'ERABLE** - Disappointing last run when unplaced in Class E at La Capelle over 2725m on 22 September. Could earn some money
6. **JAMES MADRIK** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class E at Argentan over 2875m on 2 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win
7. **JACK DES MALBERAUX** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 26 October. Has a place chance in this line-up
8. **JOCE JISCE** - On a very long losing run and was 6th in Class F at Saint-Omer over 3175m on 12 October. Needs major improvement to win
9. **JEAN MADRIK** - Has not been at his best of late and was unplaced in Class E at Toulouse over 2150m on 17 October. Can be competitive at this level

Summary: A very competitive race. JUMBO D'AUVILLIER (1) was not disgraced over further at Vichy and should be a real threat over this distance, dropped to a claimer, so gets the vote to score. JADESKA (11) showed some improvement last time out and is capable of winning a race of this nature. JET DES MALBERAUX (12) is not easy to trust but can win dropped to this level. JEAN MADRIK (9) is one of many more that can shine in a claimer.

- 1. NUEVO CASH** - Disqualified last time in Class B at Enghien over 2875m on 13 October. In good before that and can bounce back to score
- 2. NAPOLEON AS** - Consistent and finished fourth in Class D at this track over 2850m on 10 November. Can be a threat in this line-up
- 3. NOVO SUPREME** - Unreliable and was runner-up in Class C at Enghien over 2150m on 27 September. Can earn some more money
- 4. NICKNAME** - Showed what he is capable of with a Class D at Caen over 2450m on 19 October. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 5. NOVECENTO** - Consistent and finished third in Class C at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 1 November. Might play a minor role
- 6. NAMOUR DAB** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class B at this track over 2200m on 3 November. Did better in his first two and has claims

NAPOLÉON AS (2) has held his form nicely so far and could have that rewarded with a victory soon enough. NANO UP STAR (9) has improved and is capable of doubling up. NAMOUR DAB (6) is best judged on some good early performances and is not out of it.
