## Race 1 - PRIX UNE DE MAI - 2700m WALK-UP RST Harness. Purse EUR €120,000.

- 1. **KALIE GLYCINES** Wore first-time pads when DQ in the G3 Prix Vourasie here 22 days ago. Positive driver booking but others look stronger.
- 2. **KEEN OF THE NIGHT** Yet to score in six outings and will need more than when runner-up in a Class B at this venue latest.
- 3. **KINASSE DE VIVOIN** Placed in the G3 Prix Marcel Dejean here earlier in the season but looks up against it following a Class B fourth at this venue last-time-out.
- 4. **KABAKA DE GUEZ** Produced a solid effort when a 0.75L third behind both Katchina de Simm and Kana de Beylev in the G3 Prix Vourasie last start. Obvious appeal with further progress likely for a top yard.
- 5. **KARLA DE MAI** Won a Class A at this venue before being DQ in the G3 Prix Vourasie here 22 days back. May prove best watched.
- 6. **KLASSIC WAY** DQ when sent off a huge price behind plenty of these in the G3 Prix Vourasie at this track. Opposed.
- 7. **KYRIELLE** Certainly outran her price when beaten 2.5L into fourth behind a trio of these in the G3 Prix Vourasie. Frame contender if building on that.
- 8. **KATCHINA DE SIMM** Made it three from three when battling on tenaciously to take out the G3 Prix Vourasie by 0.25L from Kana de Beylev. Major claims.
- 9. **KALAMITY D'HERIPRE** Dictated matters when winning the G3 Prix Marcel Dejean prior to being DQ in the G3 Prix Vourasie here last outing. Dangerous to discount.
- 10. **KANA DE BEYLEV** Suffered a 0.25L defeat by Katchina de Simm in the G3 Prix Vourasie just over three weeks ago. Remains an exciting prospect and hard to think she will not be on the premises.

**Summary**: A race that looks to revolve around the G3 Prix Vourasie that took place here twenty-two days ago. KATCHINA DE SIMM (8) made it three from three when battling on tenaciously to beat KANA DE BEYLEV (10) by 0.25L. The former looks to have all the credentials of a high-class filly and is selected to keep her unbeaten record intact. The latter remains an exciting prospect and should be firmly in the mix with a similar effort. KABAKA DE GUEZ (4) shaped well when third in that event and makes for obvious appeal with further progress likely for a top yard. KALAMITY D'HERIPRE (9) enters calculations based on her G3 Prix Marcel Dejean success before being DQ in the aforementioned G3 Prix Vourasie.

No shock were he to bounce back and play a major role. JELYSON (13) is capable of featuring having finished a sound fourth in the G1 Saint Leger des Trotteurs two back. JOYEUSE (9) is considered.

- 1. INA DU RIB Unlikely to feature upped sharply in grade on the back of a Class D mounted win here.
- 2. **ILE AUX MOINES** Happy to look elsewhere in this grade.
- 3. **ILIADE MESLOISE** Ran a huge race behind two of these in the G2 Prix Philippe du Rozier here. Could sneak into the frame once more.
- 4. **IRINA DE BAILLY** Four-time mounted scorer who won a Class B International event here last outing. This is tougher.
- 5. **INSHORE** Races barefoot for the first time on the back of a 1.75L success in the G2 Prix Philippe du Rozier mounted contest here. Interesting.
- 6. **I LOVE ME** Six-time driven winner who makes her mounted bow following a sound fourth in the G2 Swc 5 Ans Q2 Prix Ariste Hemard at this venue eight days ago. Market check needed.

IDEALE DU CHENE (9) continues to find a few too good at this level but looks rock-solid on the back of a good second to INSHORE (5) in the G2 Prix Philippe du Rozier two weeks ago. The latter mentioned would be interesting if backing that up racing barefoot for the first time.

HIRONDELLE DU RIB (12) raced in shoes when third in the aforementioned G2 Prix Herve Ceran-Maillard. Interesting back barefoot (two from six). HATCHET MAN (9) heads the remainder.

BOMBER DI NO (2) is lightly raced in France and won at Enghien in a Class D when last seen. Cannot be ruled out. HURELLA (14) should be in the mix following a sound Class C second at this track.
