

MONDAY, 19/01/26

C1 - PRIX D'AUFFAY - 2200m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR € 33,000

- 1. NESSICA PLANCHETTE** - A three-year-old filly by Heart of Gold out of Fée De Planchette who is making her debut. Her mother was unraced. Others are preferred
- 2. NIKITA VICI** - A three-year-old filly by Dragon des Racques out of Diva Vici who is making her debut. Her Dam was unraced. Watch the betting
- 3. NAYAMA BERRY** - Has not show much in two starts and finished 9th in a Class D mounted race over this track and trip on 29 December. Needs major improvement to win
- 4. NORDIC GIRL** - Has not shown much so far and finished 8th in a Class C harness race at this track over 2850m on 12 December. Tries a mounted race and could improve
- 5. NOCTALIE MADRIK** - Has not shown much and finished 6th in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2700m on 13 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 6. NAGINATA** - A good runner-up on debut in a Class D mounted race over this course and distance on 10 December. Big chance in this line-up
- 7. NOUMBA AS** - Showed some improvement when 4th in a Class B mounted race at this track over 2700m on 13 January. Should contest the finish again
- 8. NOSTALGIE DAIRPET** - Remains in good shape and finished 4th in a Class D mounted race over this track and trip on 10 December. Can get involved with the finish once again

Summary: NAGINATA (6) only found one better on the day on debut in this discipline. With improvement likely, she can beat these rivals. NOSTALGIE DAIRPET (8) has improved of late and will try to make her experience count. She looks the biggest threat to the selection. NOUMBA AS (7) is improving and could enjoy this shorter distance, so can get involved with the finish. NORDIC GIRL (4) tries a mounted race and is capable of vast improvement, so can make the frame.

**C2 - PRIX NOVILLE - 2850m (a2m) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR €
18,000**

- 1. NIKITA DE BULIERE** - A three-year-old filly by Niky out of Evacash who is making her debut. Her mother won 2 of her 27 starts. Tough task on debut
- 2. NOUBA CASTELETS** - Has not shown much so far and was 10th in Class R reclamer at this track over 2100m on 3 December. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 3. NIDORINO DU COTIDA** - Disqualified at Mons on 10 December. Not easy to trust but is capable of doing better and has a place chance if smart
- 4. NATIF DU MANOLET** - Disqualified in three of four starts so far, including at Rouen-Mauquenchy on 12 January. Capable of a surprise if staying on the trot
- 5. NEXT DANCE KALOUMA** - Disqualified at Argentan on 14 December. Not easy to trust but is capable of vast improvement dropping to a claimer
- 6. NEW ANNA'S PROJECT** - Only modest so far and finished 6th in Class F at Toulouse over 2150m on 9 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. NEMO DE BEYLEV** - Not disgraced when 4th in a claimer at this track over 2100m on 3 December. Be right there at the finish
- 8. NEW YORK D'OYSE** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class C at Vincennes over 2100m on 9 January. Capable of earning some money
- 9. NEBBIO DU LIAMONE** - Showed some improvement and finished 5th in Class B at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Should contest the finish
- 10. NINJA DE L'ENVOL** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class C at this track over 2100m on 17 December. Did win a claimer before that and can bounce back to win
- 11. NINO TOSCA** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class A over this track and trip on 24 December. Can be a real threat in this division

Summary: Claimers are difficult races to find winners. NINJA DE L'ENVOL (10) is not reliable, but he did win at this level in his penultimate start and is capable of scoring again over this longer distance. NEXT DANCE KALOUMA (5) showed improvement in this division lately and can have more to offer this time around. NEBBIO DU LIAMONE (9) is progressing and can be a real danger to these rivals. NINO TOSCA (11) is another trying a claimer and is quite capable of winning.

C3 - PRIX D'ORLEANS - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 46,000

1. **KEIGHT BLESS** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 31 December. Capable of a surprise when staying on the trot
2. **DESIDERIO (GER)** - Successful in his last three starts, the latest at Straubing over 2400m on 15 January. Not out of it
3. **EDWIN KRIS** - Winner at Aversa over 1660m on 10 December
4. **ESPADA (ITY)** - Finished 3rd at Avenches over 2350m on 17 November. Probably needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
5. **PATTON (SWE)** - A winner of his last 5 starts, the latest at Axevalla over 2140m on 31 December. Can add another win to his tally
6. **KEPI DEL** - Has struggled of late and finished 12th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 2 December. Needs to find a few lengthsh to score
7. **ELAND** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class B at Enghien over 2875m on 29 September. Returns from a break and could need this run
8. **NEVADA LOBELL** - Unreliable and was runner-up at Wolvega over 2600m on 20 December. Has disqualification issues and can contest the finish when smart
9. **PURE STEEL** - Not reliable so far and finished 4th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 28 September. Returns from a break but could earn some money
10. **THE LION** - Disappointing last run and finished 11th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 28 September. Capable of doing better and might play a minor role
11. **NOAH NEWPORT** - Has some fair form and finished 4th at Berlin-Mariendorf over 2520m on 21 December. Might play a minor role at very best
12. **KERRO DE HOUELLE** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 6 January. Capable of contesting the finish
13. **KOOL DU CHATELET** - Showed improvement and finished 3rd in Class D at this track over 2700m on 6 January. Should be competitive once again
14. **ERES DORIAL MAIL** - Unreliable and finished 9th in a Class D at this track over 2100m on 28 September. Could need this run returning from a break
15. **KILLER DE CAHOT** - Not reliable and finished 8th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 2 December. Not out of it on best form
16. **EHLERT PAR** - Much improved last run and was runner -up at Florence over 1600m on 23 December. Could prefer that shorter distance and others are preferred

Summary: An interesting race. PATTON (SWE) (5) has hit a purple patch of form. He has won his last five starts in Sweden and can add this race to his tally. KERRO DE HOUELLE (12) is unreliable but does have talent and is capable of winning when in the right mood. KOOL DU CHATELET (13) showed some improvement in his last run and could have more to offer this time around. NEVADA LOBELL (8) has disqualification issues but is also capable of shining brightly.

**C4 - PRIX D'ARGENCES - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class B - Harness - EUR €
52,000**

- 1. MAMOUNIA SEVEN** - Has some fair form and finished 4th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 5 January. Can be competitive once again
- 2. MADNESS SAM** - Disqualified at this track on 10 January. Off form at the moment and does need major improvement to win this race
- 3. MY GIRL PIYA** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class C at this track over 2700m on 30 December. Capable of making the frame
- 4. MISSLADY DU VICLAU** - Disqualified at this track on 19 December. Battling to regain best form and is probably best watched for now
- 5. MY HAPPY STORY** - Disqualified at Argentan on 2 November. Has lost the way of late and is probably best watched until improvement is shown
- 6. MA AM CHENU** - Disqualified at this track on 10 January. Very unlucky last time out and is quite capable of bouncing back to score if smart
- 7. MUNIA** - Disappointing last run when 6th in Class B at this track over 2700m on 12 December. In good form before that and has claims
- 8. MAGIE MESLOISE** - Successful in Class E over this course and distance on 1 January. Not reliable but does have the ability to follow up
- 9. MY DARLING DU RIS** - In good form and was runner-up in Class D at this track over 2700m on 5 January. Not out of it this shorter distance
- 10. MYSTERY QUEEN** - Disqualified at this track on 14 November. Battling to regain best form and others are preferred
- 11. MODE DU VALLON** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 10 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred

Summary: MA AM CHENU (6) looked very likely to win when faulting 200m from home last time out at this track. She should make amends if staying in stride this time around. MUNIA (7) seems better than her last run would suggest and would not be a surprise winner. MAGIE MESLOISE (8) is not reliable but was a good winner over this track and trip at the beginning of the year and can double up.

**C5 - PRIX DE CARCASSONNE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted -
EUR € 40,000**

1. MARIA - Has disqualification issues and faulted at this track on 13 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred

2. MAYA DES CAILLONS - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 January. Did win her penultimate start and is not out of it

3. MATA HARI - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Cabourg on 2 January. Hard to trust but is capable of winning if smart

4. MAJUSCULE - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class D at this track over 2200m on 5 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win

5. MINILADY DE CHOC - Disqualified at this track on 5 January. Remains barefoot and could be a lively danger on best form

6. MAGGIOTTA - Usually competitive and finished 3rd in Class D at this track over 2200m on 5 January. Can earn some more money

7. MAHIZ DE GUEZ - Improving and won a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2675m on 14 August. Returns from a break but can double up

8. MERYTATON - Only modest of late and finished 8th in Class B at this track over 2700m on 26 September. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: A very competitive-looking race. MAHIZ DE GUEZ (7) is returning from a break but was improving and can double up on her good last success if fit enough. MINILADY DE CHOC (5) faulted last time out but remains without shoes and can be a real threat if smart this time. MATA HARI (3) is very hard to trust but can win when staying in stride. MAYA DES CAILLONS (2) is best judged on her good win in her penultimate start and is another to consider.

C6 - PRIX DE COURBEVOIE - 2875m (a2m) - Class R Claiming - Harness - EUR € 18,000

- 1. MY TOP GIFT** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 11 January. Barefoot and could be the surprise package of the race
- 2. MAGNUM DE RATILLY** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2100m on 30 December. Has a place chance this distance
- 3. MANZANA** - Much improved of late and was 3rd in a claimer at this track over 2100m on 30 December. Not out of it
- 4. MANON BLONDE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E at this track over 2700m on 13 January. Might earn some minor money
- 5. MOONLIGHT DJOC** - Successful in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 4 January. Distance suited and is capable of doubling up
- 6. MAZERATI PAJJ** - Disqualified at this track on 30 December. Not easy to trust but does have ability and can contest the finish
- 7. MASSILIO BLOND** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Cabourg on 2 January. Not easy to rust but can score if smart
- 8. MY JIBAY** - Not reliable but finished 5th in a claimer at this track over 2100m on 30 December. Can play a minor role at best
- 9. MY DESTINY QUEEN** - Only modest of late and finished 9th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 1 January, Capable of an upset on best form
- 10. MACLANDER** - In good form and was runner-up in a claimer at this track over 2100m on 30 December. Can go one place better this distance
- 11. MILLESIME STAR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at Vincennes on 11 January. Yet to win a race but is capable of earning some money

Summary: A very open-looking claimer and it is not safe to write off any of them from winning. MACLANDER (10) is in very good shape and has already won in this division. MOONLIGHT DJOC (5) scored over a similar distance last time out at Cordemais and is capable of doubling up. MASSILIO BLOND (7) has three faults in a row but is capable of bouncing back to win if smart. MAZERATI PAJJ (6) is also not easy to trust but is capable of being successful.

**C7 - PRIX DE PONTRIEUX - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Mounted - EUR €
46,000**

- 1. KALICO JACK** - Disqualified at this track on 31 December. Unreliable but is quite capable of getting involved with the finish when smart
- 2. KA FACTOR** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted at this track on 25 December. Improvement expected and can be a threat
- 3. DEVIL OP** - Not reliable and finished 9th in Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 21 December. Might play a minor role at very best
- 4. KAVIVE** - Unreliable and finished 3rd in a Class E at Graignes over 2700m on 30 December. Should contest the finish
- 5. KYSKO DE FAEL** - Only modest and finished 6th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 6 January. Has a place chance on best form
- 6. KAVIASE** - Not reliable but was successful in a Class D mounted race over this track and trip on 20 December. Can double up
- 7. KRONOS DE VANDEL** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest at this track on 31 December. Can be a danger if staying in stride
- 8. KATIA DE MUZE** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a Class D at this track over 2700m on 17 November. Capable of improvement trying a mounted race

Summary: KAVIASE (6) was a good winner last time out over this course and distance last month. She is not reliable but should follow up in this line-up. KA FACTOR (2) is very hard to trust but can be a threat on her best form. KRONOS DE VANDEL (7) is another that is not trustworthy but is quite capable of scoring if applied. KATIA DE MUZE (8) looks capable of improvement under the saddle this time and can be given some consideration.

C8 - PRIX DU LION D'ANGERS - 2850m (a2m) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 40,000

- 1. LUNE LUMALO** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class E over this track and trip on 9 December. Needs to do a bit more to win
- 2. LETTRE D'ERABLE** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in Class E over this track and trip on 9 December. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 3. L'ILE D'HAUFOR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this track on 4 January. Not easy to trust but does have a place chance
- 4. LAURENE DE BAILLY** - Has struggled of late and finished 10th in Class D over this course and distance on 4 January. Others are preferred
- 5. LITTLE DU RIB** - Nor disgraced when 5th in Class D at this track over 2850m on 4 January. Capable of better and is not out of it
- 6. LESDY MAGODA** - Holding form and finished 4th in Class D over this track and trip on 4 January. Be right there at the finish
- 7. LOLLIPOP DU CEBE** - A winner of two of her last three starts, including last time out in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 23 December. Can win again
- 8. LORA SCOTIA** - Has improved of late and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2700m on 17 December. Can go one place better
- 9. LITTLETON LANDING** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 5 January. Races without shoes and could score
- 10. LOVINA PERRINE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in Class D at 2850m on 28 November. Might play a minor role at very best

Summary: An open-looking lucky last race. LITTLETON LANDING (9) races without shoes after two runs and could strike a victory. LORA SCOTIA (8) is in good form and looks likely to be involved with the finish yet again. LESDY MAGODA (6) continues to hold her form and deserves a winning turn one of these days. LOLLIPOP DU CEBE (7) is currently at the top of her game and would not be a surprise winner over a distance that clearly suits.
