**C1 - PRIX DE NAUCELLES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR €
23,000**

1. MULTIPASS - Not reliable but was a good third in class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 January. Quite capable of beating these rivals

2. MARQUIS MARANDAIS - In good shape and was fourth at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 December. Tries barefoot and should challenge for top honours

3. MILLENIUM BOND - Unreliable and finished 9th in class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Capable of better but others are preferred

4. MISSION DU GILET - Consistent and finished third in a class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Can be competitive once again

5. MEMORY STAR ELGE - In good form and was fourth in class C at this track over 2950m on 22 January. Remains barefoot and can make the frame

6. MISTER DU CHOQUEL - Finished 6th in class A at Vincennes over 2700m on 9 February. Returns from a lengthy break and could need this run

7. MINIE CAUSSANEL - Successful in a class E at this track over 2150m on 30 January. Remains barefoot and could follow up this distance

8. MARIE BLACK - A winner of her last three starts, the latest in class D at Villeneuve-sur-Lot over 2625m on 13 July. Returns from a break and should need this run

9. MAD DREAM - Not reliable and finished 6th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 10 February. Needs to do a bit more to score

10. MAC DUEM - Disqualified in class E at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Had some fair form before that but others make more appeal

11. MIAMI DREAM - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class B at this track over 2325m on 11 April. Returns from a break and could need this run

12. MATIN D'AVRIL - Remains in good form and was runner-up in class E at Lyon La Soie over 2050m on 19 January. Can go one place better

Summary: MULTIPASS (1) has not been reliable but did put up a good performance at Cabourg at the beginning of the year and can win a race at this level. MARQUIS MARANDAIS (2) is in good shape and is racing without shoes, making him an obvious danger. MATIN D'AVRIL (12) is also in good form and should be involved in the finish once again. MINIE CAUSSANEL (7) was a good winner last time out, but she will need to prove she is as effective over this distance.

C2 - PRIX D'ESPINAT - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class D Amateur Riders - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. KEEP COOL** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class E at this track over 2950m on 7 February. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. KLASSICA DESBOIS** - In good form and finished third in a class G mounted race at this track over 2950m on 22 January. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish this shorter distance
- 3. KHALIFE DELALANDE** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 4 January. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
- 4. JACK REACHER** - Very consistent and finished third in class E at this track over 2750m on 7 February. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it
- 5. KIKI** - A winner of his last two starts, the latest in class A at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 18 November. Returns from a break but can score if fit enough
- 6. JAS DU TRUFIER** - Off form and was unplaced in class E at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 2 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 7. KAMIL VAN HALBEEK** - Not disgraced when fifth in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 12 February. In good form before that and has claims at a victory
- 8. KERNO** - Consistent and finished third in class B at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 16 January. Can be a threat yet again
- 9. KAROUZO** - Disqualified in class D at this track over 2950m on 30 January. Reverts to barefoot and is can upset f staying in stride
- 10. KERNOLENN** - Did not show her best when 6th in class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne over 2725m on 25 January. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance
- 11. KIANNICK OF NOUIC** - Disqualified in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 6 February. Capable of doing better and has a place chance if smart
- 12. JAVA DE ROUAISSE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in class E at this track over 2950m on 7 February. Remains barefoot and might earn some minor money

Summary: VAN HALBEEK (7) remains in good shape and should make a bold bid to beat these rivals. KLASSICA DESBOIS (2) is very consistent and is coming off a good run at this track, so must be respected. KIKI (5) has two good wins to his name but is returning from a break, and his fitness will need to be taken on trust. JACK REACHER (4) is very consistent and should be involved in the finish once again.

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**C3 - PRIX DE VINCENNES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
24,000**

- 1. KATMAI** - Finished 7th in a class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 10 February. Capable of being a threat for David Békaert
- 2. KRISTAL DU PALAIS** - Not reliable and was fifth in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 3. KEVERT** - Finished 10th in a class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 10 February. Capable of better and is not out of it in this line-up
- 4. KINGSTON DU GOSIER** - Consistent of late and was third in class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish one again
- 5. KALINEO PENEME** - Not disgraced when fourth in class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 9 February. A winner of his penultimate start and can score again
- 6. KER MIEL** - In good shape and was third in class F at Challans over 2900m on 8 February. Could earn some more money
- 7. KAISER TURGOT** - Not reliable but was a good third in class F at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 February. Capable of winning a race of this nature
- 8. KEOPS DU CHATAULT** - In good form and finished fourth in class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 28 January. Should be competitive in this line-up
- 9. KELAS DU CEBE** - Much improved last run when third in class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 February. Remains barefoot and can earn some minor money
- 10. KURLING ATOUT** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Remains barefoot and more is needed to score
- 11. KUNTA KINTE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a class F mounted race at this track over 2325m on 15 January. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 12. KITALPHAR** - Unreliable and finished fifth in class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role
- 13. KRYPTON D'EPONA** - Finished 6th in class F at Agen-le-Passage over 2575m on 9 February. Remains barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: A very open-looking race. KAISER TURGOT (7) put up a good performance at Maquenchy earlier this month and, with improvement likely, can score. KATMAI (1) and KEVERT (3) have been only moderate of late, but both are capable of winning at this level and must be respected. KEOPS DU CHATAULT (8) remains in good form and will not go down without a fight for top honours, being well suited to this track and trip.

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**C4 - PRIX DE GROSBOIS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR €
35,000**

- 1. JOOST D'OLERON** - Victorious in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 January. Has shown improvement of late and can follow up
- 2. GRANIT DU FRESNE** - Did not show his best when 10th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 7 February. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- 3. IPSON DU VERNAY** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class E at this track over 2950m on 7 February. Reverts to barefoot and can earn some more money
- 4. HUMANITY PELLINI** - In good shape and finished third in class B at Vincennes over 2850m on 22 January. Remains barefoot and can fight out the finish
- 5. KINGSLAYER PELLINI** - Successful in class B at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 17 January. Remains barefoot and is capable of doubling up
- 6. IGGY ROCK** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up in class B at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 17 January. Can go one place better
- 7. JOIE DE LA COTE** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 January. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- 8. JASMIN DU VALLON** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in class E at Aix-les-Bains over 2700m on 27 July. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 9. JOKER GEMA** - Finished fourth in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February. Remains barefoot and can make the frame

Summary: A competitive-looking race. KINGSLAYER PELLINI (5) is in good form and produced a solid win at Agen-le-Passage last month, suggesting a follow-up victory is likely. HUMANITY PELLINI (4) remains in good shape and can challenge for top honours once again. JOOST D'OLERON (1) looked impressive when scoring at Vincennes and can also be a threat to these rivals. IGGY ROCK (6) is showing strong potential to win and must be respected, making him another to consider.

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C5 - PRIX DE MURET - 2950m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 28,000

- 1. IMPEC DE BERTRANGE** - Not reliable and was 6th in class G at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 14 February. Victorious before that and is capable of an upset
- 2. JOURNEE A LA GRAVE** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class E at Agen-le Passage over 2050m on 9 February. Battling to find best form another's make more appeal
- 3. JUNTA DES THIRONS** - Only modest of late and was 6th in class E at this course over 2750m on 7 February. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 4. JOYAU DE LA COTE** - Disqualified in class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2050m on 9 February. In good form before that and is not out of it
- 5. JURELLA DE PALM** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class F at Vire over 2800m on 8 February. Hard to trust but can make the frame when smart
- 6. IGGY RUDLAND** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class G at this track over 2750m on 7 February. Can be a threat to these rivals
- 7. HADES DE SUCE** - Off form and was 14th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
- 8. I SANTO DUSSAC** - Showed some improvement when 5th in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 February. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- 9. HO MEDOCAIN** - Unreliable and was 5th in class F at Castelsarrasin over 2375m on 9 November when barefoot. Needs to do more to score
- 10. JALTO DU TREMONT** - In very good form and was runner-up in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 January. Should be right there at the finish
- 11. JOB DES LOUANGES** - Unreliable and finished 10th in class D at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 1 February. Can contest the finish on best form
- 12. INVICTUS DU DOLLAR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 8 February. Not easy to trust but is capable of scoring when smart

Summary: A very tricky race in which anything is possible. INVICTUS DU DOLLAR (12) has been a disappointment of late due to some costly disqualifications, but he is capable of bouncing back to win a race of this nature. JALTO DU TREMONT (10) remains in good shape and should be involved in the finish once again. JOB DES LOUANGES (11) is unreliable but can be a threat on his best form. JURELLA DE PALM (5) is very hard to trust but is also capable of scoring if staying in stride.

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C6 - PRIX DE LA FEDERATION DU SUD-OUEST - 2950m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 27,000

- 1. LAISSEZ PASSER** - Unreliable but was runner-up in class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 January. Capable of being competitive once again
- 2. LUKYA CHOISIE** - Showed improvement when runner-up in class E at this course over 2750m on 30 January. Remains barefoot but is on a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 3. LE LAUREAT DU PARC** - Not reliable but was successful in class D at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 17 January. Quite capable of following up
- 4. LAMIE QUICK** - Only modest of late and was 6th in class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 January. Victorious back in July and can make the frame
- 5. LOTHBROCK** - Showed some improvement and was 5th in class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 7 February. Returns barefoot and might play a minor role
- 6. LORKY RED** - In good shape and was third in class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 February. Should be competitive once again
- 7. LOLA D'AMOUR** - Showed improvement and was 3rd in class C over this course and distance on 15 January. Could earn some more money
- 8. LE MAGICIEN** - Victorious in his last three starts, the latest in class E over this track and trip on 7 February. Returns barefoot and can win again
- 9. LOUP INDIEN** - Victorious in class C over this track and trip on 15 January when barefoot. Is in decent form and can score again

Summary: LOUP INDIEN (9) beat some of these rivals when scoring over this course and distance last month and has every chance of following up. LE LAUREAT DU PARC (3) is not the most reliable but won well at Agen-Le-Passage a month ago and would not be a surprise winner. LORKY RED (6) has been very competitive of late and clearly has claims of winning. LAMIE QUICK (4) seems capable of better than she has shown recently and can make the frame.

C7 - PRIX DU COMITE REGIONAL DU TROT - 2950m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 24,000

- 1. KIO JOSSELYN** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 2. KIRIKOU DU DROPT** - Bounced back with a victory in a Class F mounted race at this track over 2325m on 30 January. Has major disqualification issues but might well follow up
- 3. LILI** - In good form and finished fifth in a Class F mounted race at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 9 February when barefoot. Not this time, but can earn some minor money
- 4. LOUISIANE KERYVON** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class E mounted race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 January. Barefoot this time and can make the frame
- 5. LADIVA DE VILLABON** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Vincennes over 2700m on 31 January. Not easy to trust but can earn some money when smart
- 6. LOCKWOOD EFJI** - Holding form and finished third in a Class F harness race at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 9 February. Could win trying a mounted race
- 7. KILT** - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 4 February. Hard to trust but capable of playing a minor role
- 8. KAISER DU CHATELET** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class G mounted race over this track and trip on 22 January. Barefoot and can go one better
- 9. JASMIN LUDOIS** - Has really struggled of late and finished 12th in a Class F harness race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 18 January. Needs major improvement to win
- 10. KING DE BOUTEAU** - Battling to find best form and was 13th in a Class E harness race at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. More is needed under the saddle this time

Summary: LOCKWOOD EFJI (6) has shown good recent form in harness races. He is trained by a capable trainer who expects him to win on his mounted race debut. KAISER DU CHATELET (8) improved last time out and is racing without shoes for the first time, so he could go one place better. LILI (3) is difficult to trust but won at this course in his latest start and could double up. LOUISIANE KERYVON (4) is barefoot and capable of challenging for the finish.

**C8 - PRIX DE POLMINHAC - 2950m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR €
22,000**

- 1. NUWA DU PATURAL** - Successful on debut in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 1 February. A slight step up in distance and can follow up
- 2. NOUIC DI PALBA** - Continues to improve and finished third in Class C at this track over 2150m on 7 February. Can earn some minor money
- 3. NEW YORK D'ATOUT** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at this track over 2150m on 7 February. Capable of contesting the finish when staying in stride
- 4. NACRE D'ALBRET** - In good form and finished third in Class E at this course over 2750m on 30 January. Should contest the finish once again.
- 5. NARNIA PAN** - Victorious in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 8 February. Shows promise and can get involved with the finish
- 6. NARRETEPAS GIO** - Did not show her best when sixth in Class C at this course over 2150m on 7 February. Likely to do better over this distance and has a place chance
- 7. NABUCCO JIJI** - Improving and was a winner last time out in Class C at this track over 2150m on 7 February. Steps up in distance but may well score again
- 8. NATIF DES CAILLONS** - Returned to form and finished third in Class B over this course and distance on 5 January. Should be a threat to these rivals
- 9. NO RISK FLIGNY** - A runner-up four times in a row, the latest in Class D at this track over 2150m on 22 January. Can go one place better
- 10. NISLANDA** - Faulted last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 26 January. A good winner before that and can bounce back to score

Summary: A very interesting "lucky last" race with many recent winners. NISLANDA (10) is highly regarded but made a mistake last time out at Cagnes-sur-Mer; she gets the vote to make amends for that error. NUWA DU PATURAL (1) did all that was asked of her when winning on debut and can remain undefeated. NARNIA PAN (5) has shown talent and could be a threat as well. NO RISK FLIGNY (9) has a string of runner-up finishes and might even go one better this time around.
