C1 - PRIX MASINA - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Mounted - EUR € 20,000

- 1. KALOUMA CASH** - Unplaced in a class F at Ecommoy over 2750m on the 23rd of July. Had a long break and might need the run-back
- 2. KONQUERANTE MESS** - Finished 7th in a class G at Saint-Brieuc over 2575m on the 3rd of March. Others are preferred in this line-up
- 3. KEEP IT TOGETHER** - Finished 8th in a class E at Cabourg over 2750m on the 1st of August. Tries barefoot and is yet to place
- 4. KARMA JIEL** - Fourth in a class F at Caen over 2450m on the 11th of March. Improved latest effort and similar can be expected
- 5. KELFLORA BELLA** - Winner in a class F at Cordemais over 2825m on the 1st of March. A recent winner under the saddle and she can make it two in a row
- 6. KARMEL JOYEUX** - Disqualified in a class F at Amiens over 2400m on the 6th of March. Remains barefoot and could be a surprise package on the best form
- 7. KASHMIR JADOR** - Was second in a class E at Graignes over 2700m on the 15th of February. Tries barefoot and returns to the saddle. In form but hard to trust
- 8. KETMAL** - Was fourth in a class E at Enghien over 2875m on the 8th of March. Competitive last two efforts and similar can be expected
- 9. KALLISTO DE LASTEL** - Was 5th in a class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on the 12th of February. Tries the saddle and is best watched
- 10. KINA DU RIB** - Disqualified in a class E at Caen over 2450m on the 14th of March. Ignore the latest effort in a Harness event. Back under the saddle and can go close

Summary: KELFLORA BELLA (5) has just opened her account and will go close again. The main danger will be KINA DU RIB (10) who returns to the Mounted trot and will have ambitions of winning. KETMAL (8) gets his chance and won't be far off them. Barefoot for the first time. KASHMIR JADOR (7) deserves to be respected and Mathieu Mottier takes the reins.

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**C2 - PRIX DES MIMOSAS - 2875m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
20,000**

- 1. KING DE CHANLECY** - Finished 8th in a class F at Pontchateau over 2800m on the 8th of March. Unplaced since the last victory and others are preferred
- 2. KISS AND FLY** - Disqualified in a class E at Laval over 2850m on the 13th of March. Uninspiring form and others are preferred
- 3. KIKOU D'ALEXIANE** - Finished 6th in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on the 1st of March. Only other previous right-hand attempt resulted in a disqualification.
- 4. KARAIELLA BOND** - Was 6th in a class E at Cordemais over 2825m on the 1st of March. Being the third run back from a break, should be ready
- 5. KEKOA** - Fourth in a class E at Caen over 2450m on the 11th of March. Remains barefoot and a similar run can be expected. Track winner in October last year
- 6. KANCAENNAISE** - Was 8th in a class B at Nantes over 3000m on the 8th of November. Probably will need it after the absence
- 7. KAYNE RICHER** - Fourth in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on the 1st of March. This will be the third run back and should be involved in the finish
- 8. KENTUCKY FIRST** - Finished 5th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on the 20th of February. Performs well on right-hand track and deserves to be respected
- 9. KING GATE** - Disqualified in a class C at Vincennes over 2100m on the 6th of October. Probably will need the run back after the absence
- 10. KERSIGAN** - Finished third in a class E at Enghien over 2875m on the 8th of March. Not barefoot and mainly been competing in Mounted events
- 11. KENAVO HERBLINAIE** - Finished third in a class A at Nantes over 3000m on the 20th of November. Last seen in November and might need the run back
- 12. KHEOPS JENILAT** - A winner in a class D at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on the 11th of September. Probably will need run back after the absence
- 13. KURAPIKA DU PONT** - Was 8th in a class D at Enghien over 2875m on the 8th of March. Others are preferred in this line up
- 14. KING OF DAY** - Was 8th in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on the 27th of November. Probably will need the run back after the absence
- 15. KALAMITY DE CHENU** - Fourth in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on the 16th of February. First time on a right-hand rope. Competitive if taking to the track
- 16. KINSHASA DE CHENU** - Was third in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on the 16th of February. Capable of making the frame at good odds

Summary: KALAMITY DE CHENU (15) takes on a right-hand track for the first time. One of the leading lights. KENTUCKY FIRST (8) performs well on the right-hand track and deserves to be respected. KEKOA (5) has the advantage of winning at this track and will have a say. KIKOU D'ALEXIANE (3) is consistent and not out of it. KAYNE RICHER (7) is another who deserves to be mentioned

- 1. JACKPOT DE PLOMB** - Finished 8th in a class E at Pontchateau over 2800m on the 8th of March. Tries barefoot and is one to take note of
- 2. JACKPOT D'AXEL** - Finished 7th in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on the 28th of November. Not barefoot and might need the run back
- 3. JENKO DU HENNEQUIN** - Disqualified in a class E at Graignes over 2700m on the 25th of February. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 4. JOB DE CHOISEL** - Disqualified in a class E at Laval over 2850m on the 28th of September. Probably will need the run back after the absence
- 5. JOLI FOUGERAY** - Was 9th in a class D at Montauban over 2400m on the 24th of September. Been on a break and returns shod
- 6. JUST RAPID** - Was third in a class E at Laval over 2850m on the 29th of February. Improving and should be cherry ripe being the third run back
- 7. JOKER DU MATCH** - Finished 7th in a class F at Cabourg over 2750m on the 27th of December. Returning shod and others are preferred
- 8. JUMPER MATIDY** - Disqualified in a class F at Cabourg over 2750m on the 9th of December. has disqualification issues and best to pass by
- 9. J'ARRIVE WELL** - Disqualified in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on the 26th of November. Take note of the shoeing arrangement and can be involved
- 10. JANOU POULOT** - Finished 9th in a class E at Amiens over 2400m on the 29th of October. Had a long break and might need it
- 11. JOW PIQUENARD** - Unplaced in a class E at Samur over 3250m on the 22nd of October. Might need the run back after the absence
- 12. JUMP WITH ME** - Disqualified in a class E at Nantes 3000m on the 20th of February. Poor last three attempts and others are preferred
- 13. JOYAU BLUE** - Disqualified in a class F at Laval over 2850m on the 7th of March. Could be good value in an open-race
- 14. JAZZY ABSOLUTE** - Finished 9th in a class D at Vichy over 2150m on the 5th of August. Probably will need the run
- 15. JUMBO DE JA YO** - Finished 6th in a class D at Cabourg over 2750m on the 18th of October. Remains barefoot and might need the run back
- 16. JACKSON DU TRESOR** - A second in a class E at Machecoul ov2700m on the 11th of February. In good form and deserves to be respected
- 17. JUST FOR FUN** - Disqualified in a class E at Caen over 2200m on the 4th of March. Ignore the last effort and remains barefoot.
- 18. JEUNE AMI** - Unplaced in a class E at Nantes over 3000m on the 19th of January. Would have needed the last start and can improve to make the frame

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Summary: JUST RAPID (6) is having the third run back and should be ready to go close. JUST FOR FUN (17) remains barefoot and has sufficient means to fight for victory. JACKSON DU TRESOR (16) is shod but will have his supporters. JOYAU BLUE (13) could be the value in the race and in an open event, JACKPOT DE PLOMB (1) is another worth a mention

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**C4 - PRIX ANTIGONE - 2600m (a1m 1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
17,500**

1. **KITA JADOR** - Was third in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on the 27th of February. Unlucky in the latest effort and is in good condition
2. **KAMARO** - Finished 8th in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on the 1st of March. He will find this easier than at Vincennes
3. **KANSAS QUICK** - Disqualified in a class F at Cabourg over 2200m on the 4th of March. This quality colt finds a great opportunity to return to winning ways
4. **KADIX** - Disqualified in a class E at Toulouse over 2750m on the 10th of March. Remains barefoot and has been a runner-up twice in her last three efforts
5. **KASIMIR DU BOIS** - A winner in a class F at Reims over 2500m on the 25th of February. A recent winner that will find this tougher
6. **KRISTAL DES MOYEUX** - Finished 9th in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on the 21st of February. Tries barefoot and can improve
7. **KARAT DEFF** - Was second in a class E at Vire over 2825m on the 17th of July. Had a long break but has consistently been in the finish
8. **KALOU LA TRIGALE** - Disqualified in a class F at Caen over 2200m on the 4th of March. Others are much preferred in this line up
9. **KLEIN BLUE** - Was 9th in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on the 27th of February. Others are preferred in this line-up
10. **KELLY DES LUCAS** - Unplaced in a class E at Cabourg over 2750m on the 22nd of August. Probably will need the run back
11. **KAVIASE** - Unplaced in a class E at Laval over 2850m on the 29th of February. Ignore the latest effort and can contest the finish
12. **KRACANTE A JOJO** - Finished 8th in a class E at Laval over 2850m on the 29th of February. Might need the run back
13. **KLEBER LE FOL** - A winner in a class F at Josselin over 2600m on the 6th of August. Has won two in a row but has been on a long break
14. **KLAUR VET** - Disqualified in a class F at Laval over 2650m on the 7th of March. Probably needed the last start
15. **KADOR DU RABUTIN** - Unplaced in a class E at Vincennes over 2700m on the 20th of November. Might need the run back
16. **KASHMIRE TONIC** - A winner in a class F at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on the 25th of February. has shown ability but also has disqualification issues

Summary: KANSAS QUICK (3) is a quality colt and will have many supporters and can return to winning ways. KADIX (4) appears as the main danger but does have disqualification issues. KASHMIRE TONIC (16) does not have the best of positions behind the car. He does have sufficient means to fight for victory. KAVIASE (11) if ignoring the latest effort can make the frame.

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**C5 - PRIX DES RAMEAUX - 2600m (a1m 1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
23,000**

- 1. IROISE DE MADKER** - Proved in need of her come back run when 11th last time out in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 3 March. Capable of improvement and is not out of it
- 2. IDYLLE PIYA** - Has disqualification issues and was 9th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 6 October. Returns from a break and could make the frame
- 3. IALTA DE VANDEL** - Clearly in need of both runs this year and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 7 March. Barefoot this time and can bounce back to score
- 4. IRONIE D'HERIPRE** - Unreliable but did run well when runner-up last time out in Class F Mounted race at Caen on 7 March. Better in that discipline and others are preferred
- 5. IMAGE DE FLAM** - Unreliable but was a barefoot winner last time out in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 11 March. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- 6. ICONE PLANCHETTE** - Unreliable of late but could be worth ignoring her last run at Cherbourg on 3 March. Capable of making the frame
- 7. ISERNIA** - Unreliable and was well beaten last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 21 September. Might need this run returning from a break
- 8. IMPERATRICE HEDEN** - Struggling of late and was 9th last time out in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 3 March. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 9. IPSIE DE LA LUNE** - Unreliable of late and was 6th last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 21 February. Capable of better this shorter distance
- 10. INFANTE DU BUISSON** - Showed some improvement when fourth last time out in Class E at Caen over 2200m on 11 March. Might play a minor role
- 11. ITALIA JADOR** - Unreliable of late but was not disgraced when third last time out in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 9 March. Place chance
- 12. IZIA DE MONGIVAL** - On a long losing run but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 11 October. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 13. IBIZA DU CHERISAY** - Returned to her best when a barefoot winner last time out in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 24 February. Not out of it
- 14. INASTIE DANICA** - Very unreliable but is coming off a win in a Mounted race at Vincennes on 27 June. Likely to need this returning from a break
- 15. ISIS JENILOU** - Struggling to find best form and was 10th last time out in Class E at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2850m on 29 October. Others are much preferred
- 16. ISIA DU CHENE** - Unreliable and was 12th last time out in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2050m on 12 February. Better this distance and is barefoot. Might place

Summary: IMAGE DE FLAM (5) returned to form with a barefoot win last time out. She remains unshod and can double up. IALTA DE VANDEL (3) is barefoot this time so is sure to improve on some modest recent efforts and could be a threat. IROISE DE MADKER (1) needed her last run and is capable of good improvement. IPSIE DE LA LUNE (9) could be a surprise package this shorter distance.

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**C6 - PRIX DES TILLEULS - 2875m (a2m) - Class D - Mounted - EUR €
26,000**

- 1. INTREPIDÉ DU MAINE** - Struggling of late and was disqualified last time out at Pontchâteau on 18 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. JALISCA DE CHENU** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified at Agen-Le Passage last time out on 4 March. Unreliable but is capable of winning
- 3. JOUR DE VICTOIRE** - Has disqualification issues but did run well when fourth last time out in Class D at Caen over 2450m on 4 March. Capable of winning when in the mood
- 4. IMPACTS LUDOIS** - Disappointing form of late and was 10th last time out in Class F at Durtal2825m on 10 March. Needs to find some lengths to win
- 5. JEANBAT DANOVER** - On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Caen on 14 March. Probably best watched for now
- 6. IORKA DE BELLANDE** - Last win was in 2022 and was 9th last time out in Class F at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 3 December. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- 7. JUNON DE VRIE** - Won twice last year and was 5th last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 March. Capable of winning when in the mood
- 8. JAD DE CALIX** - Has lost his way of late with sic disqualifications in a row with the latest being at Vincennes on 28 November. Returns from a break and others are preferred
- 9. JAMAIQUE PAJELO** - Has major disqualification issues and was disqualified last time out at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat on 9 March. Better in Mounted races and is not out of it
- 10. JADE DU CEDRE** - Unreliable and was 7th last time out in Class D at Caen over 2450m on 4 March. Capable of making the frame
- 11. JOLLITY GABY** - In good form and was fourth last time out in Class F at Cherbourg over 2750m on 5 January. Won penultimate start and can bounce back to score
- 12. JINKOUA D'IRATY** - Won twice last year but has really struggled in recent runs and was 11th last time out in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 16 February. Best watched for now

Summary: JOUR DE VICTOIRE (3) is not easy to trust but ran well when fourth last time out and that form could be good against these rivals. JOLLITY GABY (11) is in good form and should fight out the finish once again. JAMAIQUE PAJELO (9) is hard to trust but is best in Mounted races and can bounce back to win. JALISCA DE CHENU (2) is very unreliable but can win if wise.

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C7 - PRIX DE LA SOCIETE DU TROTTEUR FRANCAIS - 2875m (a2m) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 20,000

1. **JUNON DES ROSES** - Yet to win a race after 16 attempts and was 9th last time out in Class F at Cabourg over 2750m on 18 December. In good form before that and might play a minor role
2. **JAVA LA RAVELLE** - Yet to win a race after 28 attempts but did show improvement when fourth last time out in Class F at Angers over 2350m on 2 December. Needs to do more to win this race
3. **JOY DE PHYT'S** - Knocking hard on the door and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 29 February. Be right there at the finish once again
4. **JACINTHE DES BOIS** - On a long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Cherbourg on 18 February. Place chance on best form
5. **JESSIE PINK** - Disappointing recent form and was 8th last time out in Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 26 November. Best when barefoot and is not unshod this time around
6. **JAVA FAST** - Unreliable and was 5th last time out in Class F at Le Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 10 March. Could be returning to best and is capable of an upset
7. **JELISSA DES MONTS** - Yet to win a race and was 9th last time out in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 30 September. Returns from a break and others are much preferred
8. **JOY DE LA GIRO** - Struggling of late and was 10th last time out in Class F at Angers over 3125m on 14 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
9. **JOLIE MOME CHIC** - Unreliable but did show improvement when fourth last time out in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 27 February. Place chance
10. **JAGAWA MATCH** - Yet to win a race and was well beaten last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 28 October. Others are much preferred
11. **JAVA DE BOITRON** - At very best when barefoot but was runner-up last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 February. Capable of earning some money
12. **JOHANNA JOBYNA** - Has some talent but is coming off two disqualifications in a row with the latest being at Caen on 7 March. Not out of it on best form
13. **JULIA D'AMOUR** - On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes on 4 December. Barefoot and capable of playing a minor role
14. **JET SET DU BELLAY** - On a long losing run since only win but was not disgraced when 5th last time out in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 February. Can make the frame
15. **JAVA DE LANGERON** - Unreliable and was disqualified at Laval last time out on 7 March. Has some ability and can contest the finish if wise
16. **JOYE DE FANTASIA** - Very consistent and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2625m on 12 February. Won penultimate start with this shoe arrangement and can score again
17. **JOVIALE PRIOR** - Consistent of late and was fourth last time out in Class E at Laval over 2650m on 7 March. Not unshod this time and others are preferred

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18. JOY PERRINE - On a very long losing run since only win and was 7th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 August in a Mounted race. Likely to need this run returning from a break

Summary: JOYE DE FANTASIA (16) is in good form and was on her penultimate start when with this shoe arrangement so can score again. JOY DE PHYT'S (3) has been runner-up in her last two starts and looks likely to fight out the finish yet again. JOHANNA JOBYNA (12) is hard to trust but is capable of winning when wise. JAVA DE LANGERON (15) is also capable of contesting the finish if smart.

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**C8 - PRIX AROPIZ SEPAL - 2600m (a1m 1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
23,000**

- 1. IOUP LA BOUM** - Very unreliable of late and was well beaten last time out at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 3 March. Best watched for now
- 2. IRRESISTIBLE PAJ** - Last win was in 2022 and was 7th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. Fully barefoot and capable of contesting the finish
- 3. IVANHOE PAULOIS** - Proved in need of the run when 9th last time out in Class E at Vire over 2825m on 3 March. Fitter now and should fight out the finish
- 4. IMTITI** - Better in Mounted races and was third last time out at Le Mans over 2950m on 18 December. Others are preferred
- 5. ITALIANO DI PAO** - On a long losing run but was not disgraced when fourth last time out in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 3 March. Can make the frame
- 6. IRON SPIRIT** - Battling to regain winning form but did run when fourth last time out in Class G at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 9 March. Place chance
- 7. IVOIRE DAIRPET** - Very consistent of late and was third last time out in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 27 February. Be right there at the finish once again
- 8. IQUITO PLANCHETTE** - On a long losing run but did run well when runner-up last time out in Class F at Cherbourg over 2625m on 3 March. Unreliable but can earn some money
- 9. IPSOS DE BANVILLE** - Won twice last year and was 5th last time out in Class F at Cholet over 2800m on 3 March. Capable of playing a minor role
- 10. ISO DE KERYANN** - A bit of a disappointment when 6th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 February. In good form before that and can contest the finish
- 11. INSTALL D'ALOUETTE** - Much improved this year and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 29 January. Not barefoot this time and others are preferred
- 12. IDEAL DE SASSY** - Only fair form of late and was 5th last time out at Argentan over 2875m on 4 November. Might need this run returning from a break
- 13. INDY DE SALSA** - Best when barefoot and is not unshod this time around but did win latest start in Class E at Vincennes over 2700m on 22 February. Capable of winning again
- 14. IDEAL FOUR** - Unreliable and was 5th last time out in Class E at Nantes over 3000m on 27 February. Has won twice in last 5 starts and is not out of it
- 15. ILCAPITANO DU PARC** - Very consistent last four starts and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Challans over 2900m on 8 October. Best when barefoot and is not unshod this time so could need this tun
- 16. INCISIF VAUCEEN** - Unreliable and was 5th last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 30 November. Won three times last year and is capable of an upset

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Summary: A very competitive lucky last race. INDY DE SALSA (13) is in good heart but is at very best when barefoot and is not unshod this time around. He is still capable of winning, though. IVANHOE PAULOIS (3) needed his last run and a much better performance is surely expected. IVOIRE DAIRPET (7) has been very consistent of late and should fight out the finish once again. IRRESISTIBLE PAJ (2) is fully barefoot this time and not out of it.
