- **1. HELIOS DJEMA -** Capable trotter making first appearance since finishing 8th of 12 in a 2850m Vincennes Class D on 18 November and will have nothing to contribute
- **2. IVANA DES RACQUES -** Last of 14 when prepping for this in a 2450m Caen Class D conditioner on 10 March. Is considerably better than that though and the choice of driver bodes well for her place prospects
- **3. IXELLE BLEUE -** Produced a pair of good right-handed performances before finishing 8th of 16 in a 2850m Laval Class E a week ago. Starts in front, has previously delivered for her driver, and is not incapable of setting the cat among the pigeons
- **4. IVOIRE PRESTANCE -** Starts for first time since finishing 8th of 13 in a 2850m Vincennes Class C late-November. Shod to preference this time and looks a player on first start for new yard
- **5. JOLIE STAR -** Sanctioned when going well in a 2700m Vincennes Class B on 4 February. Dependability not her strong suit but has won twice racing clockwise and should not be written off
- **6. GALINETTE BLEUE -** No slouch on a good day but has not raced since finishing 6th of 8 min a 2600m Cavaillon Class E late-October and is going to need the outing
- **7. JET EXPRESS -** Capricious but talented type making first start since finishing 8th of 16 in a 2700m Vincennes Class B on 8 November. May be a race shy but still has the wherewithal to finish in the mix
- **8. JOURNEE REVEE -** Imposed at Vincennes 2 months ago, then ran 2nd to a very good horse in a 2700m Class B at the same venue early-February. Pleased on lone start here and is easy to like for the win
- **9. FEELING BOY -** Sanctioned in a 2825m Class D at Le Croise-Laroche 11 days ago. Is in decent shape though, appreciates Argentan, and despite the handicap could still get a look-in
- **10. IMPERATOR D'ELA -** Fine servant with nothing to prove at this level but will race shod for comeback and best to keep one's powder dry
- **11. HELIOS SI -** Hardy element that was sanctioned on re-entry in a 2450m Caen Class D early this month. Still in conditioning-mode and best to wait

Summary: As solid as a rock in three of her last four starts, JOURNEE REVEE (8) drops marginally in category after putting on a good show in Paris and, ideally-engaged on the front line, can wrap this up. François Lagadeuc will still want to be wary of reconfigured 2nd-row starter IALTO D'HERTALS (14) who has been knocking at the door lately, and the better-placed, and shod, JET EXPRESS (7) who will be no easy touch if sufficiently fit. IVANA DES RACQUES (2) may not be known for her reliability but she has 2 runs under her belt and the engagement of Anthony Barrier speaks volumes. IXELLE BLEUE (3) sports 4 pads after her Laval conditioner and returns to a track she likes with a good hand to play.

- **1. JUAN PERRINE** Made a solid ridden debut 3 weeks ago, coming 2nd of 11 in a 2850m Laval Class E. Takes on a better lot this time but enjoys a front-row start and still has the wherewithal to finish in the mix
- **2. JAVA WIC -** Did not enjoy the best of trips when 4th of 10 in a 2450m Caen Class G a fortnight ago. Enjoys a 7kg allowance, starts in front, and looks a player
- **3. JADE DU PARC -** 6th of 10 behind JAVA WIC (2) in a 2450m Caen Class G a fortnight ago. Won her only start at the venue but in this company will need to find more
- **4. HIRONDELLE FEE -** Takes first public ridden steps after having been sanctioned in a 2800m Vire Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Is new to the venue and, while patently useful, may just have too much to do

- **3. MANILLE D'ERABLE -** Courageous 5th of 14 in a 2450m Caen Class F a fortnight back. David Thomain will be delighted with the draw and can impose
- **4. MISS SCARLET -** 8th of 12, a place behind MADONE ROCHEL (2) in a 2150m Vire Class E 2.5 weeks ago. Has ground to make up and, while not a priority, is well-situated on the front line and can get a look-in
- **5. MISS DE LA FERME -** Lost her action early in a 2450m Caen Class F on 6 March. Has significant talent though and will be no easy touch if focused

- **7. HIBOU D'ERPION -** Faithful servant for the most part but has not raced since coming 3rd of 12 in a 2800m Strasbourg Class E last August. Shoes on and best to wait
- **8. HILLONA DE NESLE -** Returns to the provinces after having run 4th of 14 in a 2100m Vincennes amateurs Class F late-February. Forced to break wide though, has never delivered under harness here, and a minor place prospect at best
- 9. JUDY MATIDY Unseen since running 3rd of 16 in a 2650m Bordeaux Class C on 20 October.
 Will be race-rusty though and not an obvious choice
- **10. HOMERE DES NOUES -** Capable trotter making first appearance since running 7th of 14 in a 2625m Paray-le-Monial Class F late-October. On back row and with shoes on will have nothing to contribute
- **11. JAVA DAIRPET -** 8th of 9 finishers in a 2175m Vincennes monte Class D on 11 February. Here for a change of scenery and poses no danger
- **12. INDIC -** Unseen since running 3rd of 11 in a 2150m Enghien Class D late-September. Always runs on his merits though and looks a serious proposition
- **13. IDEAL DE SASSY -** Hardy individual making first start since coming 3rd of 14 in a 2500m Reims Class F last October. Boasts decent Argentan references but still best to hold off
- **14. IMPERATOR D'EM -** Starts for first time since coming 6th of 16 in a 2800m Vire Class E on 20 November and has nothing going for him here
- **15. SIDNEY CELEBER -** Sports 4 pads for first time after being sanctioned in a 2200m Caen Class D 9 days ago. Eric Raffin maintains faith though and can play a leading role if he successfully navigates the start
- **16. IKYTA DE LA VALLEE -** Tricky mare making first appearance since being sanctioned in a 2150m Enghien Class D late-September. Shoes on and is not about to influence the outcome

Summary: It took numerous runs and 15 months since leaving Scandinavia before MAGGIORE (SWE) (3) opened her French account, but was so impressive at Agen that she could well confirm. At Cherbourg last month though, JOKER DE CHOISEL (1) looked like the horse he was last spring and even though starting on the rail, still looks the main threat. A reconfigured SIDNEY CELEBER (15) has been handed a tough draw but is significantly better than his formcard would suggest and Eric Raffin will be keen to set the record straight. Also on the back row, INDIC (12) has not been seen out since September but is plainly in race-mode and will be competitive for the win.
