# C1 - PRIX DE CARQUEIRANNE - 1000m (a5f) - TURF - Newcomers Race - Flat - EUR € 23,000

- **1. GO MAN -** Colt by Goken, the dam won one race over 2200m. One to watch on debut as he will likely need further in time. Any market interest should be noted
- **2. THE BLACK STONE -** Colt by Yafa, the dam won over 1600m. From a shrewd trainer who can ready one to strike on debut. Watch the betting exchanges
- **3. WHITE NIGHT -** Filly by Night Of Thunder, the dam won over 1200m and was Listed placed. Nice profile and a bold run can be expected
- **4. CLEA CHOPE -** Filly by Muaarar, the dam was placed a few times. Likely to improve for this debut run. The betting can guide
- **5. ROSE PRAIRIE -** Newcomer by City Light, the dam was placed several times. Likely to improve for this debut run and is best watched in the betting market for clues
- **6. ASTREA -** Filly by Fas, the dam was placed over 1400m. Watch the betting market for any support
- **7. CROQUEMADAME** Filly by Gutaifan, the dam ran twice over middle distances. Stable runners tend to need a run or two for experience. Watch the betting patterns

**Summary:** REMENBER CHOPE (10) looks speedily bred and can be expected to make a bold show on her debut. THE BLACK STONE (2) is from a good stable and will be well-prepared for his debut run. He could be the main threat. WHITE NIGHT (3) looks the part on paper and her trainer is good with newcomers. She will know what is required. TEMADIVA (8) might need further in time judged on her pedigree, although her dam was a useful winner in Pattern race class.

- **1. REACH THE SKY -** He won on his debut over 1800m at Lyon La Soie in a maiden race on February 7th. He will improve and could be dangerous
- **2. DYNAMITIC -** Two nice runs so far, he won on debut over 1500m in November and then was 2nd over 2000m at Marseille Pont De Vivaux on December 7th in a Class 2 race. Capable of making his presence felt
- **3. ZARAKCHIC** Got off the mark on his second start over 2000m at Salon Provence on November 28th. Drops in trip but can feature
- **4. DIOPTASE -** 5th last time out, he won before that over 1500m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on debut in a conditions race on January 13th. One to pay attention too
- **5. STEF LE MAGNIFIQUE -** Good 2nd in a Class 1 race last time out over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer on January 27th. He should be fine with the drop in trip

- **3. MIGUELITO -** No show in 7th over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a maiden on the 25th of February 2025. Would be a shock winner
- **4. THE PLOT -** Finished a clear 6th behind a reopposing sort over 2150m at Cagnes-Sur-Mer in a maiden on the 25th of February 2025. Held on form
