**C1 - PRIX DU PRINTEMPS - 2500m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR €
18,000**

- 1. MERANO BLEU** - Only modest of late and was 7th at Mons over 2300m on 17 February. Did better last year and has a place chance
- 2. MAGNUM DE RATILLY** - Disqualified last time out in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 23 February. Capable of improvement and could make the frame
- 3. MAXIM D'HERTALS** - Holding form and finished fourth in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 23 February. Should fight out the finish
- 4. MOJITO CENE** - Returned from a break and finished 5th in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 23 February. Fitter this time and can contest the finish
- 5. MAKE A WISH** - Returned from a lengthy break and finished 7th in Class G at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 15 March. Fitter this time and can be competitive
- 6. MAGIC FOOT** - Only modest of late and was 6th in Class F over this track and trip on 1 March. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 7. MANGO KALOUMA** - Has improved this year and was victorious last time out at Aby over 2140m on 5 February. Can double up back in his first start on French soil
- 8. MAMBO NAY** - Finished 8th on debut in Class G at Abbeville over 2300m on 11 May. Should need this run returning from a break
- 9. MY WAY ROBSEN** - Returned from a break with a disqualification in Class G at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Capable of improvement but others make more appeal
- 10. MEDOC** - Finished 11th in Class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 30 November. Did better on debut but could need this run returning from a break
- 11. MIKY DE VANDEL** - Not disgraced when 5th on debut in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 14 October 2024. Returns from a lengthy break and should need this run

Summary: A very open-looking first event. MANGO KALOUMA (7) has shown improvement this year and could score for Eric Raffin on his debut in France following a solid last start success in Aby. MOJITO CENE (4) showed improvement after a break and could have more to offer fitter this time. He is also barefoot this time. MAKE A WISH (5) proved in need of his last run and, with improvement likely, he can contest the finish. MAGNUM DE RATILLY (2) seems better than the last-start disqualification and is capable of making the frame.

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**C2 - PRIX DES BOURGEONS - 2500m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR
€ 18,000**

- 1. MA CHOUCYOU** - Not reliable and was fourth at Mons over 2300m on 31 December. Returns from a break and more is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. MORGANE DU MOULIN** - Disqualified in a class F at Graignes over 2700m on 22 February. Remains barefoot and is better going right-handed. Has a chance
- 3. MAGIA LA TRIGALE** - Disqualified in a class F at this track over 2500m on 1 March. Remains barefoot but has struggled this year and others are preferred
- 4. MAM'ZELLE FRO** - Not reliable and finished 7th in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 2 March. Unshod behind and fitter this time. Has a place chance
- 5. MOON D'AVRIL** - Yet to win a race but has been a runner-up in 6 of 8 starts, the latest in a class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Can go one place better
- 6. MANGALYA** - Not reliable but was third in a class F over this track and trip on 1 March. Can be competitive once again
- 7. MERVEILLE DU JOUR** - Showed what she is capable of when successful in a class H at Bihorel-les-Rouen over 2500m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- 8. MUSANIA DE WARNOC** - Has not shown much so far and was 10th in a class G at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Tries barefoot but needs major improvement to win
- 9. MINIE DE TOUCHYVON** - Needed the last run when 9th in a class G at La Capelle over 2750m on 8 March. Fitter this time but needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. MYSTIQUE DU NORD** - Disqualified in a class G at Chartres over 2800m on 16 November. Returns from a break and is probably best watched for now
- 11. MIA DU BLEQUIN** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class E at Amiens over 2400m on 9 December. Tries barefoot but others make more appeal
- 12. MY FIRST DU NOYER** - Disqualified at Mons over 2300m on 10 December. Has yet to show much and needs to find a few lengths to win

Summary: MOON D'AVRIL (5) has been unlucky not to have had a winning turn yet. She has a couple of disqualifications to add to her numerous runner-up performances, but she should prove hard to beat in this line-up. MORGANE DU MOULIN (2) fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out but can do better going right-handed again. MERVEILLE DU JOUR (7) tackles tougher this time but was a good winner last time out. MANGALYA (6) is unreliable but is also not out of it.

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**C3 - PRIX DES FLORAISSONS - 2500m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR
€ 21,000**

- 1. LAMSOU SAN** - Knocking at the door and was runner-up at Mons over 2300m on 17 February. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish
- 2. LOOKING BOY** - Showed improvement and was a barefoot winner in a class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 23 February. Remains barefoot and could follow up
- 3. LAPIN AGILE** - Off form and finished 8th in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 24 February. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 4. LOCKI DU FER** - Needed the last run when 9th in a class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 2 March. Fitter this time but others make more appeal
- 5. LESS TIME** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a class F at Caen over 2200m on 12 March. Should be competitive in this line-up
- 6. LE MAGNIFIQUE** - Unusually competitive and finished third in a class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 29 December. Returns from a break but can be a lively danger if fit enough
- 7. LUNDU DE LOU** - Finished 9th in a class F at Caen over 2200m on 12 March. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
- 8. LUCAS D'AVRIL** - Disqualified in a class F at Saumur over 2700m on 8 March. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 9. L'AMIRAL DU SAPTEL** - Successful in a class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 24 November when barefoot. Not fully barefoot this time so could need this run
- 10. LISANDRO DE LOU** - Consistent and was third in a class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 23 February. Remains barefoot and can get into the mix of things again
- 11. LEAD ME ON** - Has struggled this year and finished 8th in a class F at Caen over 2200m on 12 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

Summary: LOOKING BOY (2) was a good barefoot winner at Le Croisé-Laroche last month and is a confident pick to follow up. LE MAGNIFIQUE (6) returns from a break but is consistent and will not go down easily. LAMSOU SAN (1) got close to winning twice in a row in Belgium and can get involved in the finish once again. LE MAGNIFIQUE (6) has not been disgraced in a couple of races lately and can also be considered a possible victor.

C4 - PRIX DES VERGERS - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. JUDOPOCK** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 23 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 2. KRAKEN CASTELETS** - Returned to form and was runner-up in a class F at this track over 2500m on 1 March. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish once again
- 3. KONG D'HOLLOW** - Only modest this year and finished 9th in a class B at Vincennes over 2100m on 22 January. Has a good record with this shoeing and can score
- 4. IDAO NAY** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a class F at Enghien over 2875m on 13 March. Keeps that shoeing and could make the frame
- 5. HORSE DE GRAMMONT** - Needed the last run when inplaced in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 24 February. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
- 6. INSIDE MAN** - Off form and finished 8th in a claimer at Vincennes over 2700m on 16 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 7. JALDO D'OCQUE** - Not reliable but was a barefoot winner in a class D at Caen over 2450m on 9 March. Remains barefoot and can follow up
- 8. GREFFIERS FLINOIS** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class E at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 8 December. Remains barefoot and could play a minor role at very best
- 9. KAISER** - Holding form and was not disgraced when fifth in a class D at Caen over 2450m on 2 March. Can be competitive in this line-up

Summary: KONG D'HOLLOW (3) has been a disappointment in his two starts this year, but he does have a good record with this shoeing and gets the narrow vote to score. KRAKEN CASTELETS (2) only found one better on the day at this track at the beginning of the month and could be a threat again. JALDO D'OCQUE (7) is unreliable but was a good winner at Caen and remains barefoot and capable of doubling up. KAISER (9) is consistent and also capable of shining brightly.

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**C5 - PRIX DES ARBRES - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Mounted - EUR €
24,000**

1. LOVER WINNER - Finished third at Turin over 1600m on 5 October. Returns from a break and tries a mounted race for the first time. Might place

2. SAMMY BOY (BEL) - Did not show his best when 6th in a Class D harness race at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March. Capable of better and is not out of it trying a mounted race

3. ROCKY OASIS - Finished tenth in a Class D harness race at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March. Barefoot and back in a mounted race so must be respected for that. Might earn

4. NAPOLI (HOL) - Not reliable and finished 7th in a harness race at Wolvega over 2100m on 21 February. Capable of earning some money

5. SEVEN SEAS S - Has only been modest of late and finished 8th in a Class D harness race at Enghien over 2150m on 6 March. Can do better trying this discipline and has a place chance

6. L'AS DE COEUR - Unreliable and finished 6th in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

7. LE CADOR DE SIMM - Disqualified last time out in a Class D mounted race at Enghien over 2875m on 6 October. Returns from a break but is not out of it if fit enough

8. LOU DES COUPERIES - Returned to form and was third in a Class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. Does well with this shoeing and has claims

9. LICARI - Did not show his best when 8th in a Class E harness race over this track and trip on 1 March. Can bounce back to score under the saddle

10. KILLER DE BEAULIEU - Returned from a short break and was 8th in a Class F harness race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 23 February. Has been disqualified in his last two mounted races and others are preferred

11. LAURO FLIGNY - Off form and was 9th in a Class E harness race at Caen over 2450m on 9 March. Capable of doing better and can be a threat

Summary: LICARI (9) is better in mounted races, so his last run in a harness race is best ignored. He is a confident pick to bounce back and score. LE CADOR DE SIMM (7) returns from a break but can get involved in the finish if fit enough. LAURO FLIGNY (11) has struggled of late but is capable of being a threat if he shows his best form. LOU DES COUPERIES (8) is fit and competitive in this company, so must be respected in this line-up.

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**C6 - PRIX DES FLEURS - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
21,000**

- 1. NIRVANA BLUE** - A three-year-old colt by Django Riff out of Evangelina Blue who is making his debut. His mother won 9 of her 33 starts. Must be respected
- 2. NAVY MADRIK** - Finished tenth on debut in a Class F mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 12 March. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 3. NINA DU COJEUL** - Returned from a break and was runner-up in Class F at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 7 March. Can go one place better
- 4. NOBLESSE JISCE** - Has struggled of late and was 9th in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 10 March. Has won over this course and distance and could surprise
- 5. NACRE JADOR** - Showed what she is capable of with a victory in a claimer at Agen-Le Passage over 2650m on 3 November. Returns from a break and could need this run
- 6. NESMILE DU GOUTIER** - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 3 March. Did win on debut and could bounce back to score if smart
- 7. NIKYSTAR D'AUVRECY** - In good shape and finished third in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 2 March. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 8. NITCH DE REVE D'OR** - Victorious on debut when well backed in Class F at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 22 February. Can remain undefeated
- 9. NOUVELLE AVENTURE** - Found betting support when scoring on debut in Class F at Strasbourg over 2200m on 8 March. Should fight out the finish

Summary: A very interesting race. NITCH DE REVE D'OR (8) found a lot of betting support when winning on debut and won well enough. He can double up with another victory. NOUVELLE AVENTURE (9) was also backed to win on debut and got home narrowly under a confident ride. She is a threat once again. NESMILE DU GOUTIER (6) is better judged on a good win in her penultimate start and is not out of it. NIRVANA BLUE (1) makes his debut but his mother did win 9 races so he could be ready for this.

**C7 - PRIX DES JARDINS - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Mounted - EUR €
18,000**

1. MIGHTY KYDE - A four-year-old gelding by Quaker Jet out of Baraka Vimap who is making his debut. His mother won 4 of her 80 starts. Monitor the betting

2. MAMMA MIA OKINA - Has major disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 2500m on 8 March. Remains barefoot and is fitter this time but needs major improvement to win

3. MANON FRAZEENNE - Has struggled so far and was 11th in a Class F mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 5 March. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred

4. MAGIC MAESTRO - Has not shown much yet and was 8th in a Class F harness race at Amiens over 2900m on 15 March. Needs to do more to score

5. MELODY DU CHATAULT - Finished 9th in a harness race at Mons over 2300m on 24 December. Not disgraced in only mounted race on debut and could earn some money

6. MEVOILA VIVANCIERE - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class F mounted race at Angers over 2425m on 28 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score

7. MAKABA GRAUX - Kept to harness races so far and was barefoot when 5th at Mons over 2300m on 17 February. Might play a minor role trying this discipline

8. MUROSIDO DE WARNOC - Hard to trust and faulted last time out in a mounted race at Amiens over 2400m on 13 November. Returns from a break but could contest the finish

9. MAC GYVER - Showed vast improvement when trying a mounted race and was runner-up in Class F at Caen over 2450m on 9 March. Can go one place better

10. MAVERICK DE CONROS - Kept to harness races so far and was disqualified last time out over this course and distance on 1 March. Has a place chance on best form

11. MEC DES RACQUES - Returned to form and was fourth in a Class G harness race at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Could be a threat to these rivals

12. MISS VITARDERIE - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 February. Has claims in a weak race

Summary: MAC GYVER (9) only found one better on the day when trying a mounted race earlier this month. He should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. MUROSIDO DE WARNOC (8) returns from a break but is barefoot so could be ready to strike. MISS VITARDERIE (12) needs to do a bit more to score in a race like this but is capable of making the frame. MEC DES RACQUES (11) was not disgraced in a harness race last time out and could do even better in this discipline.

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C8 - PRIX DES FORÊTS - 2550m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

- 1. KANZA DE NAVARY** - Returned from a break and finished third in a class G at Strasbourg over 2800m on 8 March. Fitter this time and has a place chance
- 2. KOCO PEEL** - Disqualified in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 2 December. Hard to trust but can contest the finish when smart
- 3. INCISO BELLO** - Not disgraced when third in a class G at Arras over 2925m on 5 October. Remains barefoot but is returning from a break and could need this run
- 4. JERIDAN** - Unreliable and finished third in a claimer at Bihorel-les-Rouen over 2525m on 8 March. Remains barefoot but more is needed to beat these rivals
- 5. JACKARY D'OCQUE** - Did not show his best when unplaced in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 2 March. Races without shoes this time and can make the frame
- 6. JOLENCIO DE WARNOC** - Finished 9th in a class G at Arras over 2925m on 5 October. Returns from a break and needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 7. KARYNDO ROBSEN** - Finished 7th in a class F at Amiens over 2400m on 9 December. Returns from a break and is likely to need this run
- 8. JIVAGO DU VIVIER** - Needed the last run when 7th at Mons over 2300m on 3 March. Reverts to barefoot and can bounce back to score
- 9. KIARHA DE NAPPES** - Showed some improvement and was runner-up in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 15 December. Could need this run returning from a break
- 10. JURASSIC** - Needed the last run when 10th in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 23 February. Reverts to barefoot and should be competitive this time
- 11. JACKPOT DE VIETTE** - Needed the last run when unplaced in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on 4 March. Capable of doing better but others make more appeal

Summary: A very competitive race with a number of them being barefoot and ready to strike. JIVAGO DU VIVIER (8) has clearly been targeted for this race so gets a narrow vote to score in this lucky last race. KOCO PEEL (2) has disqualification issues but can be a threat when staying in stride. JURASSIC (10) will come on from the last run and is not out of it. JACKARY D'OCQUE (5) races without shoes so an improved performance is very much on the cards.
