- **1. HOBBY DU LOISIR -** Finished 7th in a class G at Ecommoy over 2750m on the 31 of March. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **2. HARRY D'YVI -** Fourth in a class E at Villedieu-les-Poeles over 2800m on the 1 of April. Has not won for some time but can play a minor role
- **3. HOSTO DES DURIEZ -** Unplaced in a class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on the 7 of April.Remains barefoot and happy to pass by
- **4. HATAO DU PERCHE -** Third in a class H at Orleans over 3400m on the 1 of April. Reverts to barefoot and has decent form.
- **5. HOLD UP DARCHE -** Third in a class F at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on the 10 of April. Improved after the break and can confirm
- **6. HELVAMOSA -** Was 7th in a class E at La Capelle over 2750m on the 24 of March. Unplaced since winning in December and others are preferred

- **3. LISA D'OURVILLE -** Third in a class F Ecommoy over 2750m on the 1 of April. Performed well on the grass ar Ecommoy and now tries the sand. Can have a say
- **4. LISBETH -** Disqualified in a class F at this track over 2400m on the 6 of April.A debut runner up that can go one better
- **5. LAURE DE MORANZY -** Good third on debut in a class F at this track over 2400m on the 6 of April. She has track experience and that will be a benefit. Can go close
- **6. LIBERTY STARDUST -** Was 7th in a class F Ecommoy over 2750m on the 1 of April. Yet to place in seven starts
- **7. LAZIE PONT VAUTIER -** Disqualified in a class F at this track over 2400m on the 6 of April.Major disqualification issues and best to pass by
- **8. LADY PLANCHETTE -** Finished 7th in a class F at Lignieres over 2100m on the 14 of April. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **9. LEVE TOI -** Third in a class F at Strasbourg over 2200m on the 1 of April. The latest was the best effort so far and can show more

- **4. L'ARC -** Only found one better on debut in Class G at Bihorel-lès-Rouen over 2500m on 17 March. Should fight out the finish
- **5. LOVELY FAST -** Only fair so far and was 5th last time out in Class F at Rambouille over 2000m on 7 April. Nore is needed to win this race
- **6. L'INTOUCHABLE -** Two fair runs so far and was 5th last time out in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 18 March. Might play a minor role

- **2. KISS ME DUSSAC -** Delicate but seldom finishes far off the mark when avoiding disqualification confirmed as much by finishing 4th in consecutive starts in December, the latest over course and distance on 16 December. Dark horse
- **3. KWALETYTIME -** Progressive filly with sound references at Mons, which include finishing 2nd in 4 consecutive outings before back-to-back 230mm victories the latest on 22 February. Not taken lightly
- **4. KALINE DES RACQUES -** Showed early promise but lost her way with four consecutive unplaced appearances, the latest (9th) at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 December
- **5. KABALVA -** Finished a reassuring 2nd over 2825m at Vire on 31 March and could have a role to play here if confirming that improvement
- **6. KISMIE DE MEMARTIN -** Delicate but has undeniable means confirmed as much by winning over 2525m at Les Andelys on 31 March. Keep safe
- **7. KHALEESI DE MALAC -** Battling 15-start maiden who is hard to recommend on the evidence on her last-start 10th in a claimer over 2100m at Vincennes on 5 April
- **8. KIRANIE DES NOES -** Improving lightly raced filly who finished 2nd to KALLIOPE DU CAIEU (12) last time on this course over 2900m on 6 April. Can turn the tables
- **9. KLAMA DE NAVARY -** A tricky customer with sufficient means to make her presence felt in a race of this nature if remaining wise. Absent since finishing 13th over 2700m at Vincennes on 16 November
- **10. KOCAINE BOND -** Races unshod behind for the first time in her career after a much-needed comeback outing (9th) at Graignes over 2700m on 14 April. Has legitimate claims
- 11. KARABANE DE BLARY Inconsistent but isn't incapable of staking a claim either, especially in a race like this. Mustn't be condemned for her recent failure over 2675m at Lisieux on 16 March
- **12. KALLIOPE DU CAIEU** Delicate but has undeniable means, which she has confirmed by winning consecutive recent outing in this configuration (barefoot) the latest over 2900m on this course on 6 April.

Summary: KIRANIE DES NOES (8) and KALLIOPE DU CAIEU (12) fought out the finish on this course in a recent meeting (6 April), which went the way of the latter, but the former is good value to turn the tables on these conditions. KOCAINE BOND (10), in this shoe fitting for the first time, has the means to pose a threat, which also applies to KISMIE DE MEMARTIN (6) who has been impeccable since she joined Anthony Dollion's stable. KABALVA (5) completes the shortlist.

- 2. KOLOSSE RHODES Confirmed the improvement of his previous outing (4th) by finishing 3rd in this barefoot configuration over 2500m at Reims on 21 March. Keep safe
- **3. KANADA DES RACQUES -** Consistent for the most part and seldom far off the mark when remaining wise. Didn't go unnoticed in either comeback outing (finished 6th in both), the latest over 2900m on this course on 6 April
- **4. KIT ANGOT -** A 16-start maiden unlikely to open his account here after a recent failure (disqualification) over 2900m at this venue on 6 April
- **5. KOVE DU CHENE** Battling 19-start maiden who is hard to recommend on the evidence on his last-start 7th over 2700m at Graignes on 17 March. Others preferred
- **6. KEZIO JOSSELYN -** Complicated but has the means to stake a claim in a race of this nature if avoiding disqualification. This will again be a question of his wisdom after a recent failure (sanction) at Reims on 8 April
- **7. KEVIN DES OUBEAUX -** Delicate seldom finished far off the mark when avoiding disqualification confirmed by his reassuring 3rd at Nancy over 2600m on 14 April. Confirmation required
- **8. KIKLOVE ATOUT -** A tricky customer with sufficient means to make his presence felt in a race of this nature if remaining wise. Finished 2nd over 2900m on this course in his last start on 6 April
- **9. KLARCK DE VANDEL -** Runner-up in his last two starts, including over 2625m on his reappearance at Châtelaillon-la-Rochelle on 31 March. Candidate for success
- **10. KELLER DE L'ITON -** Delicate but has undeniable means and usually performs well when avoiding disqualification, winning once and finishing 2nd twice in 3 completed outings (5 starts). Runner-up at Le Most-Saint Michel on 10 March
- **11. KERIDO D'ALOUETTE -** Consistent, lightly raced sort with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 4th over 3150m at Saint-Brieuc on his reappearance on 26 March. Will be a factor

Summary: Victory is likely to go the way of either KLARCK DE VANDEL (9), plated in front and unshod behind for the first time, or consistent KERIDO D'ALOUETTE (11), who represents a stable in very good form. KELLER DE L'ITON (10), however, caught the eye when 2nd on his reappearance and, on the evidence of that encouraging comeback, also has legitimate winning claims for success. KEZIO JOSSELYN (6), for whom this will again be a question of wisdom, and progressive KODEX (12), in his bid to complete a hat-trick, aren't without a chance either.

- **4. JERIKA DE KERYANN -** Has disqualification issues and was 9th last time in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 12 April. Hard to trust and others are preferred

- **4. ILUCE DE BEAUCAMPS -** Disappointing recent form and was 11th last time out in Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 30 March. Needs to do more to win this race
