- **1. LA HAYE JOSSELYN -** A four-year-old filly by Bird Parker out of Fedorova d'Orgeres who is making her debut. Watch the betting
- **2. LADY DE NEUVY -** Disqualified in both her starts, with the latest being at Cherbourg on 6 April. Probably best watched until improvement is shown
- **3. L'IMPERATRICE -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Amiens on 3 May. Capable of improvement trying a Mounted race
- **4. LENA FOR EVER -** Unreliable but was a good third last tilme out in a Class F Mounted race at Challans over 2900m on 27 April. Has a place chance
- **5. LADY DU PERCHE -** In very good shape and was runner-up in a Class E Mounted race at La Capelle over 2750m on 4 May. Can go one better
