C1 - PRIX OFFICE DE TOURISME PAYS DE THIERACHE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F Amateur Riders - Mounted - EUR € 23,000

- 1. ICARE DU FAOUE** - Victorious in a class H mounted race at Elbeuf over 2750m on 7 June. Has improved of late but this it's a tougher race
- 2. KANDISSIME** - Disqualified in a class G at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 4 June. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of earning some money
- 3. JUST BE GOOD** - A winner of a class F mounted race at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Does like that course but remains barefoot and has claims
- 4. ITEM BUISSONAY** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a harness claimer at Vincennes over 2850m on 26 May. Remains barefoot nut needs to find a few lengths to win
- 5. KEROS DE BEAULIEU** - Successful in a mounted race at Durtal over 2825m on 25 May. Much improved this year and can be a threat
- 6. ILEPSON** - Finished 6th in a class G mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 4 June. More if needed to win this race
- 7. KARTER LEWIS** - In good shape and was fourth in a class G mounted race at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 4 June. Can make the frame once again
- 8. KOH I NOOR** - Finished 9th in a class D at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Capable of being a lively danger back under the saddle
- 9. JUMBO DE LUNESE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a class E mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 10 June. Remains barefoot and should fight out the finish
- 10. JANARDAL CLUB** - Only modest of late and finished fifth in a class F harness race at Reims over 2500m on 6 June. More is needed to beat these rivals

Summary: A very open looking first event. Likely to improve on his fifth at Caen, JUMBO DE LUNESE (9) remains barefoot and should fight it out with KOH I NOOR (8), who returns to the mounted race discipline after some time. JUST BE GOOD (3) is in top form but will need to keep his action together to play a leading role. KARTER LEWIS (7) has found a new lease of life in this discipline and should give another good account.

1. **NOUVELLE HISTOIRE** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class E at Graignes over 2700m on 6 June. Only win was on grass and others are preferred
2. **NOVA DU FER** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in a class E mounted race at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Others make more appeal
3. **NIKITA DU BOUFFEY** - Successful in a class F at Le Touquet over 2600m on 24 May. Liked the grass that day and others make more appeal
4. **NOUCHKA WIND** - Has some fair form and finished third in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on 16 May. Capable of earning some more money
5. **NIJNI NOVGOROD TEK** - Did not show her best when 6th in a class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. Did win on debut and cannot be written off
6. **NEBULA DANICA** - Not reliable and finished 8th in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 7 April. Returns from a short break and could need this run
7. **NACREE DE QUARO** - A winner on debut in a class F at Laon over 2225m on 17 May. Looked good that day and is capable of following up
8. **NUIT MAGIQUE** - Knocking hard at the door and was runner-up in a class F at Amiens over 2900m on 16 May. can challenge for top honours again
9. **NASHVILLE MENCOURT** - Successful on debut in a class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 31 May. Did all that was asked of her that day and could double up
10. **NORMANDIA** - Disqualified in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2200m on 11 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
11. **NINA D'AUVERS** - Only moderate of late and finished 9th in a class F at this track over 2750m on 24 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
12. **NIZZA PRESTANCE** - Finished third on debut in a class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 2 March. Returns from a break but must be respected. Place chance
13. **NIGHT DE REUX** - Much improved last run when third in a class D at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. Can be competitive once again
14. **NEREIDE SIBEY** - Disqualified in three of four starts so far, the latest in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 29 April. Can contest the finish when smart
15. **NINA JOMUNA** - Disqualified in a class E at Amiens over 2900m on 11 June. Not easy to trust but is capable of an upset if staying in stride
16. **NEW GIRL DU CHENE** - Not reliable and finished finished 7th in a class D at Vincennes over 2200m on 9 June. Can be a threat to these rivals when smart

Summary: Plenty in with a chance in this competitive and evenly matched field. An impressive winner on debut, NACREE DE CARO (7) is narrowly preferred to NUIT MAGIQUE (8), who is still seeking a first success after two runner-up efforts. NASHVILLE MENCOURT (9) scored with more authority than the margin suggests and is also a leading contender for victory. Everything will come down to her behaviour with NEREIDE SIBEY (14), who is capable of the best as well as the worst.

C3 - PRIX CREDIT AGRICOLE COEUR DE THIERACHE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **NEMO DES ARRIS** - Not disgraced when fourth in a class E at Chartres over 2300m on 31 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
2. **NARVIK DU BESSIN** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Chateaubriant over 2300m on 7 June. Quite capable of bouncing back to score
3. **NAGANO DU CAMPDOS** - Knocking loudly at the door and was runner-up in a class G at Elbeuf over 2750m on 17 May. Can earn some more money
4. **NEW FRIEND** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a class E at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Capable of doing better and can be competitive in this line-up
5. **NEO** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2850m on 2 April. Capable of an upset if smart
6. **NAKANO BELLO** - Successful on debut in a class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 31 May. Shows some promise and is not out of it
7. **NOBLE BARRA** - Disqualified in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 5 January. Returns from a break but could earn some money if smart
8. **NOT A BAD DEAL** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class D mounted race at Vincennes over 2175m on 13 May. Others make more appeal
9. **NESPRESSO MIJO** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class E at Cherbourg over 2550m on 14 June. Can earn some money when staying in stride
10. **NYRO D'ERPION** - Finished 9th in a class F at this track over 2750m on 24 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
11. **NELSON SIBEY** - Showed some improvement when scoring in a class G at Jullouville-les-Pins over 2700m on 17 May. Can follow up
12. **NAOS DE BANVILLE** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a class G at Mamers over 2225m on 25 May. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
13. **NOVAK** - In good shape and finished third in a class F at Reims over 2550m on 31 May. Has disqualification issues but can also earn some more money
14. **NEXT LOVE** - A three-year-old colt by Galius out of Tour de Garde who is making his debut. his mother won three of 13 starts. Monitor the betting
15. **NEW LOOK DANICA** - Finished fifth in a class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 12 April. Has only been modest so far and more is needed to score

Summary: NARVIK DU BESSIN (2) is well regarded by connections, but it will all come down to the start. If he maintains the right rhythm, he can get the better of NEW FRIEND (4), who is also seeking redemption after two below-par efforts. NAKANO BELLO (6) made a striking impression when winning on debut. Much improved, NELSON SIBEY (11) can also get involved with the finish over a course and distance that clerly suits.

C4 - PRIX FERNAND FLORIBERT DUBOIS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **MANUREVA TEAM** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 7 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
2. **MASTER PIT** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class F at Reims over 2500m on 15 April. Some good wins before that and can bounce back to score
3. **MONSTER WILLIAMS** - Consistent and finished third in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 30 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
4. **MINOS DE VANDEL** - Improving and was victorious in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 21 May. Looks capable of doubling up
5. **MILOR DES CAILLONS** - Not reliable and finished 6th in a Class E at Caen over 2450m on 27 May. Quite capable of making the frame if at best
6. **MELIUS AVIS** - Showed some improvement when fourth in Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 7 May. Might play a minor role once again
7. **MILLENIUM JOSSELYN** - In good form and finished fourth in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 23 April. Can make the frame once again
8. **MY WAY DE QUELETTE** - Unreliable but was successful last time out in Class F at Toulouse over 2750m on 15 May. Might well follow up
9. **MY PRINCESS HAUFOR** - Showed some improvement when 5th in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 21 May. A bit more is needed to score
10. **MIKA DU NOYER** - Finished tenth in Class E at this course over 2700m on 14 June. Fitter this time but could need one more run
11. **MOMO DES CARREAUX** - Yet to win a race but did finish fourth in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. Can play a minor role
12. **MYSTERIOUS LOVE** - Yet to win a race but is in good form and was runner-up in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 30 May. Can go one place better
13. **MARIO DU CAIEU** - Did not show his best when 6th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
14. **MARQUIS D'ARM** - Not reliable and finished 9th in Class E at Rouen-Mauquenchy over 2150m on 4 June. Successful before that and could be a threat over this distance

Summary: A very competitive looking race. A well-bred colt with scope, MY WAY DE QUELETTE (8) is open to further improvement and can build on his recent success. MILLENIUM JOSSELYN (7) has caught the eye in all three runs this season, is likely to lead the opposition along with MASTER PIT (2), who is better than his sixth in April suggests. MINOS DE VANDEL (4), who has quickly returned to form and can make the frame.

- 1. MAFIA RINGEAT** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
- 2. MAJOR DU RUISSEAU** - Unreliable and was uplaced in a class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. A good winner before that and is capable of scoring again
- 3. MAKE FOR JUMP** - in good shape and was fourth in a class D at Vincennes over 2850m on 9 June. Can get into the thick of things once again
- 4. MAJON** - Disqualified in a class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 29 May. Battling to find best form but might play a minor role
- 5. MAZEL TOV DAIRPET** - Bounced back with a victory in a class E at Cholet over 2800m on 9 June. Successful four times in just seven races and can score again
- 6. MUSE DE MONTCEAU** - Off form and finished 8th in a class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Remains barefoot but more is needed to score
- 7. MAROLY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 April. Not easy to trust but is capable of scoring when smart
- 8. MARISA DU CHATELET** - Holding form and finished fourth in a class D at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Can earn some minor money
- 9. MISTER YELLOW** - Finished 6th in a class C at Vincennes over 2175m on 8 February. Returns from a break but can contest the finish if fit enough
- 10. MYSTERE CERIZE** - Victorious in a class E at Vichy over 2950m on 16 May. Not reliable but cannot be ruled out from doubling up
- 11. MILLIUM QUESNOT** - Only modest of late and finished 7th in a class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 30 April. Has a place chance on best form

Summary: An impressive winner on his return at Cholet, MAZEL TOV DAIRPET (5) looks hard to beat if he keeps his action together. Noted on the Paris cinders ten days ago, MAKE FOR JUMP (3) appears best placed to give him most to think about. MYSTERE CERIZE (10), kept fresh since his win at Vichy, also commands attention. MISTER YELLOW (9), has changed shoeing and is capable of improvement and worth a market check.

- 1. LOUNA FIX** - Not disgraced when 5th in class H at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Victorious earlier in June and is not out of it
- 2. LEONE MAGNIFIQUE** - Not disgraced when 4th in class F at Laon over 2650m on 7 June. Has won twice this year but this is a tougher task
- 3. LOOK DAIRPET** - Disqualified in class H at Chalons-en-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Unreliable but is capable of earning some money when smart
- 4. LONELY RIDER** - Unreliable and finished 10th in class F at Le Croise La Rocha over 2700m on 1 June. Needs to do more to score
- 5. LADY DE BEYLEV** - Battling to find best form and finished 8th in class F at Saint-Malo over 2950m on 2 May. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 6. LEPIDOPTERISTE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class E at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Might play a minor role at very best
- 7. L'ASTRE DE NUIT** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class F at Alencon over 2675m on 31 May. Has a place chance on best form
- 8. LORD DU BUHOT** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 7 June. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
- 9. LAIOS DU GOUTIER** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class F at Le Croise La Rocha over 2700m on 1 June. Yet to win a race and others make more appeal
- 10. LA BELLE DE BEYLEV** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class G at Chateaubriant over 3000m on 7 June. Can be a threat if staying in stride
- 11. LAOS JIEL** - Did not show his best when 8th in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 13 May. Could be the surprise package of the race
- 12. LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class E at Graignes over 2700m on 22 May. Can contest the win if in the right mood
- 13. LOOK DU PARCQ** - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class D at Le Croise La Rocha over 2700m on 20 May. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 14. LOKI DE BEAUCAMPS** - Victorious in class E at Strassbourg over 2825m on 6 April. Bounced back to winning ways and can score again
- 15. LOVE SHACK** - Unreliable and was 13th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 July. Quite capable of contesting the finish
- 16. L'AUDACE** - Not disgraced when 4th in class E at Reims over 2550m on 6 June. Capable of earning some minor money once again

Summary: The answer may lie in the second row, where LOKI DE BEAUCAMPS (14), an impressive winner at the start of April, makes plenty of appeal. Despite a short break, he is preferred to LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE (12), who has the ability but not always the willingness. Noted on 7 June, LA BELLE DE BEYLEV (10) is presented with an ideal opportunity to bounce back. LOVE SHACK (15) had excuses last time out and is worth another chance.

- 1. LA FOULE** - Not reliable and was tenth in Class D at Amiens over 2400m on 8 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 2. LISBETH** - Faulted last time out in Class D at this course over 2300m on 13 March. Returns from a break but is capable of being a threat if fit enough
- 3. LOUPIAC** - Threatening to win and was runner-up again in Class D at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 20 May. Can go one place better
- 4. LE MAC** - Has struggled this year and finished tenth in Class D at this course over 2700m on 3 May. Needs major improvement to win
- 5. LEADER DU POMMEAU** - Showed some improvement when 6th in Class E at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Has disqualification issues and others are preferred
- 6. LE CAPORAL** - Disqualified last time out in Class E at Montauban over 2400m on 14 May. In very good form before that and can contest the finish when smart
- 7. LUCKY BOY VERTRAC** - Successful twice in his last three starts, including last time out in Class E at Nancy over 2600m on 29 May. Can follow up
- 8. L'INTOUCHABLE** - Disqualified last time out in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 23 May. Battling to regain best form and others make more appeal
- 9. LORD DE CHENU** - Successful five times in a row, the latest in Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 30 April. Can add another win to the tally
- 10. LIBERTANGO** - Very consistent and was runner-up in Class D at Hyères over 2850m on 27 May. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 11. LEGOLAS** - Has struggled this year and was disqualified last time out in Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 31 May. Needs major improvement to score
- 12. LUTIN DES ARRIS** - Not reliable and finished fourth in Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 23 May. Quite capable of scoring when in the right mood

Summary: A very interesting race. The in form LORD DE CHENU (9) will look to extend his impressive winning streak, having remained unbeaten for several months. LE CAPORAL (6) could give him plenty to think about if he keeps his action together. LIBERTANGO (10) is admirably consistent and hard to oppose on current form. LUTIN DES ARRIS (12) is not reliable but hinted last time out that he could be ready to score.

C8 - PRIX DE LA VILLE DE GUISE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. JINGLE GEDE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class G at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 23 December 2024. Has disqualification issues and could need this run returning from a break
- 2. JAVA DU VERTAIN** - Finished 12th in class G at Reims over 2550m on 23 April. Battling to find best form and others make more appeal
- 3. KHOSIAB** - Disqualified in class D at Cholet over 2800m on 9 June. Unreliable as of late and needs to improve to beat these rivals
- 4. KAMIKAZE DRY** - Not reliable and finished 6th in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 1 June. Can make the frame if in the right mood
- 5. JET ME FREE** - Disqualified in class F at Feurs over 2850m on 20 May. Unreliable in form and has disqualification issues. Makes little appeal
- 6. KOKA DU DOUET** - In good shape and was 4th in class E at Amiens over 2900m on 8 June. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 7. KILLARNEY** - Finished 15th in class F at Laval over 2850m on 18 February. Returns from a break and needs major improvement to score
- 8. KAPITANO DE LOU** - In good form and was 3rd in class E at Vichy over 2950m on 1 June. Should be competitive once again and must be respected
- 9. KEMPEL DE GUEZ** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in class E at Les Sables-d 'Olonne over 2775m on 2 June. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 10. J'ADORE D'EURVAD** - Finished 7th in class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 7 June. Victorious back in May and is capable of an upset
- 11. KOBE EIGHT** - Disqualified in class D at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. In good form before that and can bounce back to score if smart
- 12. JETLAG HOPE** - Unreliable and finished 6th at Wolvega over 2600m on 6 June. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
- 13. KETY DU GOUTIER** - Disqualified in class F at Vincennes over 2100m on 19 May. Victorious in January and can be a threat to these rivals if smart

Summary: A very open lucky last race. KOBE EIGHT (11) finds a task within his reach and could take the opportunity to bounce back so gets a narrow vote to score. KETY DU GOUTIER (13) should not be underestimated, much like KAPITANO DE LOU (8), who has returned to his best form in recent weeks. From the front line, KAMIKAZE DRY (4) appeals as the most attractive option and must be given respect in this line-up.
