## C1 - PRIX DES ASTILBES - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E Race - Harness - EUR € 31,000

- **1. IDAO NAY -** Has struggled this year and finished 8th in Class D at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 3000m on 3 August. Barefoot this time and could improve
- **2. IOHANNA THIEBEN -** Did not show her best when 6th in Class E over this track and trip on 8 August. Can earn some minor money
- **3. IGGY DES RIOULTS -** Disqualified twice in last four starts but was victorious last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 1 August. Can follow up
- **4. IDOLE JALLERIE** On a very long losing run and was disqualified last time out at Bréhal over 2850m on 11 August. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
- **5. INTELLO D'ERABLE -** Disqualified last time out at Bréhal over 2850m on 11 August. Not barefoot this time and others are preferred
- **6. ITALIANO DI PAO -** Remains in good form and finished fourth in Class D over this track and trip on 25 July. Can be a threat yet again
- **7. IENISSE DE BARBRAY -** Very consistent and was runner-up in Class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2875m on 29 July. Be right there at the finish once again
- **8. IPSOS DE BANVILLE -** Showed some improvement when fourth in Class E at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 31 July. Might play a minor role
- **9. ILTON CASH -** Only modest of late and finished 7th in Class F at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 10 August. Capable of an upset on this surface
- **10. IDYLLE COPAISE** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E at Châteaubriant over 2300m on 8 August. Capable of better but others make more appeal
- **11. IDEAL DE SASSY -** On a long losiing run but was third in Class F at Dozulé over 2900m on 13 August. Might earn some minor money
- **12. INEDIT DU PAVILLON -** In very good shape and was runner-up in Class F at Pornichet-La Baule over 2725m on 17 July. Can go one better
- **13. IENA D'ORGERES -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced last time out in Class F at Bréhal over 2850m on 11 August. Unreliable but is capable of an upset

**Summary:** An open-looking race. INEDIT DU PAVILLON (12) has been very good of late and has leading claims once again. ITALIANO DI PAO (6) ran well behind the selection at Segre and should be a threat again. IENISSE DE BARBRAY (7) is knocking hard at the door and will challenge for top honours. IGGY DES RIOULTS (3) is not easy to trust but is quite capable of winning a race of this nature and must be respected.

- **1. KENTUCKY PIYA -** Has disqualification issues but was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2750m on 8 August. Can contest the finish
- **2. KILOU -** Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out at this track over 2750m on 8 August. Capable of winning when staying on the trot
- **3. KINGSTON DU BOURG -** Holding form and finished fourth in Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2775m on 9 July. Can play a minor role
- **4. KEL COPAIN -** Has already won three races this year, including last time out in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 12 June. Be right there at the finish
- **5. KARMA DE BEAUFOUR -** Has struggled of late and was unplaced in Class E over this course and distance on 8 August. Others are preferred
- **6. KINGSTON DU DOME -** In good shape of late and finished 5th in Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 13 August. Has a place chance on best form
- **7. KEKOA -** On a very long losing run and was 5th in Class F at Biarritz over 2950m on 8 July. Might play a minor role

**Summary:** KENTUCKY PIYA (1) is not the most reliable but did run well at this track earlier this month and can go one better if in the same mood. KEL COPAIN (4) goes particularly well for driver Franck Ouvrie and should be a real threat again. KARNO D'ARBAZ (9) picked up a confidence-boosting win at Rouen-Mauquenchy last month and would not be a surprise winner. KILOU (2) has struggled with disqualifications of late but remains a threat.

- **1. LITCHI DU BISET -** Yet to win a race but is knocking very loudly at the door and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2750m on 29 July. Big chance
- **2. LORENZACCIO -** In very good form and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2050m on 8 August. Be right there at the finish
- **3. LIBRIUM** Disappointing last run when 12th in Class E at Rochefort-sur-Loire over 3000m on 3 August. Capable of better and has a place chance
- **4. LIVE YOUR DREAMS -** Has won three times this year, including when barefoot last time out in Class F at Saint-Jean-de-Monts over 2625m on 3 August. Not barefoot this time, but is not out of it
- **5. LE HAVRE -** Has major disqualifiation issues and faulted last time out at this track over 2750m on 18 July. Quite capable of winning when staying on the trot
- **6. LEADER BAROQUE -** Has won twice this year but was only 7th last time out in Class E at Savenay over 3100m on 14 July. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **7. LUGANO DU CADRAN** Unreliable but was barefoot and victorious in Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 18 July. Can double up
- **8. LIEUTENANT COLUMBO -** Yet to win a race but is in good form and was third in Class E at this track over 2750m on 29 July. Might play a minor role

- **1. MESERIA -** Disqualified on her debut at Portbail over 2650m on 10 August. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- **2. MAYFLOWER DULONRAY -** Has some fair form of late and was runner-up in Class F at Granville over 2400m on 3 August. Tougher task this time
- **3. MOUNTAIN** Hard to trust and was disqualified last time out in Class E over this track and trip on 5 August. Did better before that and is not out of it
- **4. MILADY BEAUTY -** Showed what she is capable of with a Class F win at La Ferté-Vidame over 2750m on 3 August. Can be a threat
- **5. MASTERCLASS D'EARL -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at Enghien over 2875m on 9 August. Might play a minor role at very best
- **6. MAESTRIA DE PADD -** Usually competitive and was not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne over 2650m on 5 August. Could earn some money
- **7. MOLLY WHITE** Disqualified in her last two starts, the latest being at this track on 29 July. More is needed to beat these rivals

- **2. KARAMAZOV -** Has three disqualifications in a row, the latest at Portbail over 2675m on 10 August. Has place chance on best form
- **3. KALLISTO DE LASTEL** Has struggled with disqualifications this year and faulted last time out at this track over 2750m on 8 August. Can contest the finish when wise
- **4. KATANA -** On a long losing run and finished 9th in Class F at Cabourg over 2050m on 18 August. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **5. KOSETTE DU HAMEL -** Well tried this year without winning but did run well when fourth in Class F at this track over 2050m on 15 August. Can get involved with the finish
- **6. KALINE DE SOYORA -** Very unreliable and finished 9th in Class F at Bagnoles-de-l'Orne over 1850m on 15 August. Capable of a surprise when in the right mood

- **2. MIRA DES ILES -** Disqualified in both her starts so far, the latest at Plouescat over 2600m on 3 August. Tries a mounted race and can improve
- **3. MONALYSA DU ROEN -** Only modest of late and was 7th in a Class F mounted race over this track and trip on 5 August. More is needed to win this race
- **4. MARVEL MESLOIS -** Unreliable but did finish third in a Class D mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 28 May. Might play a minor role at the very best
- **5. MATFABEN D'ENJE -** Showed what he is capable of with a Class E mounted race over this track and trip on 29 July. Can follow up
- **6. MELODY LUDOISE -** Has improved of late and was victorious in a Class F mounted race over 2625m on 3 August. Can make the frame
- **7. MADNESS DOLCE -** Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Class F mounted race over this course and distance on 22 July. Capable of making the frame

- **3. NOBEL VENESI** Has been fair so far and finished fourth in Class E over this course and distance on 5 August. Has a place chance
- **4. NAUGHTY BOYWILLIAM -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien over 2250m on 30 July. Did win his penultimate start and is capable of an upset if wise
- **5. NECK OUEST -** Disqualified last time out at Enghien over 2275m on 9 August. Did better on debut and can bounce back to score if staying on the trot
- **6. NELATI DE MORGANE -** Not disgraced when fourth in Class C at Enghien over 2250m on 9 August. Capable of making the frame in this line-up
- **7. NIRVAGO DE LA COUR -** A winner on debut in Class F at Bernay over 2300n on 27 July. Has to prove himself on this surface

**Summary:** NECK OUEST (5) was a disappointment at very short odds last time out. If he stays on the trot this time, he can make amends for his supporters. NIL D'AUTHION (9) makes his debut, but he is well qualified and could be a threat. NEW HAVEN WOOD (8) has not been very reliable so far but has hinted at talent. NIRVAGO DE LA COUR (7) won on debut on the grass and could also be a lively danger trying this surface.

- **1. JAKA DU RUEL -** Only moderate of late and was 8th in a Class H harness race at Questembert over 3125m on 3 August. Might play a minor role back under the saddle
- **2. IPANO STAR -** Disqualified last time out at Bréhal over 2850m on 11 August. Tries a mounted race and others are preferred
- **3. JOTT DU BOCAGE -** Victorious in a Class G mounted race at Graignes over 2700m on 26 July. Can follow up in this line-up
- **4. JEDI -** Disqualified last time out at this track over 2750m on 1 August. In very good form before that and can contest the finish
- **5. IGANA D'ALB** Not disgraced when fourth in a Class F mounted race at Aix-les-Bains over 2725m on 9 August. Does well with this shoe combination and can be competitive again
- **6. HOLESHOT -** Has struggled all year and finished 8th in a Class E harness race at Granville over 3125m on 3 August. Needs major improvement to win
- **7. HESTIA GEDE -** On a long losing run and was 9th in a Class E harness race at this track over 2725m on 5 August. Capable of making the frame

**Summary:** JOTT DU BOCAGE (3) has struck form and was a good winner at Graignes. He sets the standard in this lucky last race. JEDI (4) is clearly better than his last-start disqualification and should fight out the finish if smart. IGANA D'ALB (5) does best with this particular shoe combination and is a threat to these rivals. HESTIA GEDE (7) remains barefoot and could contest the finish again.
