JET MIRAGE has clearly improved with the aid of blinkers and was full of running when breaking the maiden tag last time out. FRANKIE TWO SHOES is in good heart and must be respected. MARSH MARIGOLD put behind a modest effort when running well last time out and does have a winning chance.
