# Race 1 - PRIX EMILE ALLIX COURBOY - 2700m WALK-UP B400 E Harness. Purse EUR €75,000.

- 1. **BILO JEPSON** Improved to third at this track last time out on the back of a mediocre ninth two runs ago at this track. Sure to be there at the business end.
- 2. **DIVINE MONCEAU** Has struggled to recapture form, the latest effort a sixth at Cagnes-sur-Mer. Others preferred.
- 3. **INGO** Was mediocre when 5.5L away in ninth most recently at his first run back from a spell at this track. Not this time.
- 4. **AL CAPONE STECCA** Struggling to find form and has been out of the winners' list at his last 18 runs. Last start finished tenth at this track. Not doing enough.
- 5. **VINCERO'GAR** Was disqualified last start at this track on January 9 2021. Prefer to see him perform well before recommending.
- 6. **BORDEAUX S.** Last raced at this track on January 29 when he was disqualified. Prepared to overlook until his racing manners improve.
- 7. **GASPAR DE BRION** Registered another win last start at this track by 0.4L, making it two victories from his past three starts. Should be in the finish again.
- 8. **EL GRECO BELLO** Made a return to the winners' list two back then failed to back it up last time out, finishing sixth at this track. Rates well on best form and worth including.
- 9. **FAKIR DE MAHEY** Finished 7.5L back in 12th at his latest run at this track. Can do a lot better in this suitable contest.
- 10. **DEESSE NOIRE** Continued a long run without winning when fourth at this track last time out. A better run is on the cards.
- 11. **GAMAY DE L'ITON** Improved to finish second at this track most recently following a mediocre tenth at this track the run prior. Looks hard to beat.
- 12. **FALCO D'HAVAROCHE** Finished third at this track two starts back then couldn't repeat the dose at this track last time, finishing 16L from the winner. Winning prospects.
- 13. **GOELAND D'HAUFOR** Finished runner-up at this track last start after he missed the top-three but wasn't disgraced two back at this track. Sure to be in the mix.

**Summary**: Nine-time course winner GASPAR DE BRION (7) looked good when battling off the solid Oracle Tile in a Class B track and trip European event last outing. Major appeal with an excellent record without shoes. FALCO D'HAVAROCHE (12) latest outing with shoes on is easily ignored and he's better judged on a good third behind two subsequent scorers in the G3 Prix de Brest here prior. Notable claims. GAMAY DE L'ITON (11) goes well here and should feature on the back of a sound 0.75L second in the G3 Prix Jean Rene Gougeon a month ago. The third in that event BILO JEPSON (1) must enter calculations and GOELAND D'HAUFOR (13) is respected with five wins from ten starts over course and distance.

## Race 2 - PRIX DU FINISTERE - 2700m WALK-UP E67 RST E Monte. Purse EUR €39,000.

- 1. **IQUITA VILI** Has not been racing well, including a poor effort last time when a long way back in sixth at this track. Has the job ahead.
- 2. **INES PICARDE** Safely held last time when 4.8L from the winner in sixth at this track. Not keen on her chances in this field.
- 3. ISABELLA DIMJY Is a 27-start maiden who was beaten 3.7L at Nantes last time. Capable of going close.
- 4. **ILVICA DE HOUELLE** Finished runner-up at this track last start after she missed the top-three but wasn't far away two back at this track. Will be right in the thick of things.
- 5. **HIMALAYA FORGAN** Continued a long run of outs when sixth, 21L from the winner at Mauquenchy three weeks ago. Not going well enough.
- 6. **IENA DODVILLE** Was disqualified last start at this track on April 9. Prefer to see her perform well before recommending.
- 7. **ISLANDE MIKA** Has been down the track at her past two starts since winning at this track, the latest effort a seventh at this track. Best form puts her right in this.
- 8. **IDEALE DE BONNEFOI** Struggling to find form and has been out of the winners' list at her last 37 runs. Last start finished ninth at this track. Can be competitive if at her best.
- 9. **ISIS D'ALESA** Was not a factor when resuming last start, finishing tenth at this track and beaten 6.4L. Open to sharp improvement.
- 10. **HEVA BLONDE** Form only moderate and has been without a win now for 33 runs. Last start finished ninth at this track. Can be competitive if at her best.

**Summary**: Three-time mounted scorer ILVICA DE HOUELLE (4) finished runner-up in a Class D here seventeen days ago. Obvious appeal. ISIS D'ALESA (9) was third behind two subsequent winners in a Class D mounted event at this venue in November. Easy to ignore her recent driven run and she looks interesting with Mottier a positive booking. Both of ISLANDE MIKA (7) mounted wins have come over course and distance and she rates highly back in the saddle. ISABELLA DIMJY (3) holds place claims.

- 1. **JEDEO DES VAUX** Finished third at this track last start after he was unplaced two back at this track. Solid top-three prospects.
- 2. **JOGGER STAR** Finished 7.3L back in fifth at his latest appearance at this track. Hard to have on those efforts.
- 3. **JOHN MAGIC** Finished third at Argentan two starts ago then franked that effort with a win last time at Graignes, scoring by 1.6L. Looks hard to beat.
- 4. **JAPON YAMM** Was mediocre when 87L away in seventh most recently at his first run back from a break at this track. Expect to see a much better run.
- 5. **JAPPELOU** Last raced at this track on February 21 when he was disqualified. Prepared to overlook until his racing manners improve.
- 6. **JUST ORLANDO** Is racing consistently with a sequence of two minor placings, the latest when second at this track, beaten 2.9L. Rates highly.
- 7. **JOKER D'AMARO** Has been ticking along well, last start finishing third at this track. Should be in the finish again.
- 8. **JUPITER FRANCE** Last raced at this track on February 24 when he was disqualified. Forgive the latest run. Well placed to make amends.
- 9. **JOUR DE GLOIRE** Much better effort last time when he broke his maiden by 3.6L at Mauquenchy. Big chance of back-to-back wins.
- 10. JEAN DES GLENAN Tackled a richer race last start when beaten 35L at this track. Must do a lot more.
- 11. **JOKER THOURJAN** Last raced at this track on February 14 when he was disqualified. Overlook the most recent outing. Can turn things around.
- 12. **JOJO TOONS** Has been racing well since returning, scoring first-up then finishing second, beaten 4.4L at Argentan last time. Fitter and still lightly raced so expect he has more to offer. Expected to measure up.
- 13. **JOKER DE CHOISEL** Resumed last start with a second at Argentan, beaten 0.8L. Fitter and sits high among the chances.
- 14. **JOKER DARLING** Resumes after showing some good form last campaign, winning on two occasions. Well-placed and should be in the finish.

**Summary**: JOUR DE GLOIRE (9) built on a promising barefoot debut fourth when making all to take out a Class E by 4.5L at Mauquenchy early last month. Expected to measure up with further progress on the cards. JUST ORLANDO (6) finished second in a Class E here when having his first outing in this shoeing combination. Going the right way and is tough to rule out in what looks a suitable affair. JOKER D'AMARO (7) finished third in a course and distance Class E contest last-time-out and JOJO TOONS (12) is interesting with first-time pads fitted.

## Race 4 - PRIX DE VIRE NORMANDIE - 2200m WALK-UP B25 Monte. Purse EUR €51,000.

- 1. KEV DE JAFA Finished 10L back in fourth at his latest run at this track. Hard to have on those efforts.
- 2. KAYA DREAM Bounced back last start when third at this track, beaten 3.3L. Expected to go well again.
- 3. **KINGDOM KAT** Is seeking a breakthrough win after placing at both career starts, the latest when beaten 2.8L into second at this track. Leading chance again.
- 4. **KLAIRON DE TILLARD** Was DQ in the G3 Prix Edouard Marcillac on mounted debut but remains of interest in a new shoeing combination.
- 5. **KOZYR DU PRE** Has been racing well with a couple of minor prizes to his name recently, the latest when runner-up, beaten 4.5L at this track. Prefer others on this occasion.
- 6. KING STALLION Disqualified last start at this track. Forgive the recent mishap. Top pick if at his best.
- 7. KIARA DU RIED Comes here off a last-start win at this track. This looks a far sterner test.
- 8. **KANDORA BELLA** Was disqualified last start at this track on February 16. Forgive the recent mishap. Looks ideally placed.
- 9. **KINDER QUICK** Has won his last two starts, most recently at this track by 4.5L. Rates highly and can make it three straight.
- 10. **KELANIE LORRAINE** Was a winner two back at this track then couldn't back it up last time when 20L away in fifth at this track. Use the win two back as a guide to her prospects.

**Summary**: It was tough not to be impressed with KINDER QUICK (9) who made all for a facile 4.5L success in a Class D mounted event here ten days ago. Top contender for a notable trainer and jockey combination. KANDORA BELLA (8) won a Class C mounted race at this venue prior to being DQ in the G3 Prix Holly du Locton a fortnight back. Hard to ignore. Similar comments apply to KING STALLION (6) who would hold strong claims on 2.5L Class D course and distance win in the saddle two back. KLAIRON DE TILLARD (4) was DQ in the G3 Prix Edouard Marcillac on mounted debut but remains of interest in a new shoeing combination.

## Race 5 - PRIX DE MAUREPAS - 2850m WALK-UP E45 RST E Harness. Purse EUR €39,000.

- 1. **ILIADE** Was lining up for just the second time when out of the money last start at this track, beaten 2.1L. Deserves another chance.
- 2. **CANADIAN KRONOS** Easily accounted for last time when 6.3L from the winner in eighth at this track. Not keen
- 3. **ICONE DE L'ETRE** Finished second last time out at this track to make it two minor placings from the last three outings. Gets her chance to break through.
- 4. **LADY LARISSA** Six-time winner in Sweden. Won in January before a good third last time at Halmstad (Sweden). Profiles nicely and is expected to measure up.
- 5. **CINDERELLA JET** Consistent five-year-old mare with eleven wins and three placings from 21 runs in Italy. Has the right profile for a strong performance.
- 6. IMAGE MAGIC Not a threat last start when fourth at Laval, beaten 4.9L. This looks a far sterner test.
- 7. **INDIE HAUFOR** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Missed out two starts back then was a distant tenth most recently at this track. Deserves another chance.
- 8. **CHANEL DEI VELTRI** Was fair when resuming at this track then turned in a much better effort last time when beaten 1.3L into third at this track. Fitter and should run well.
- 9. **INDES GALANTES** Has been given a let-up of five-and-a-half weeks since finishing tenth at this track when well in the market. Top-three chance.
- 10. **CHEYENNE SELVA** Made a promising French debut last start when runner-up at this track, finishing 0.4L from the winner. Likely improver.
- 11. **INITIALE MACHA** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Missed out two starts back then was a distant seventh last start at this track. Must do a lot more.

**Summary**: CHEYENNE SELVA (10) made a pleasing French debut when runner-up in a Class E European event four weeks ago. Claims if building on that. The third home that day CHANEL DEI VELTRI (8) commands respect with Jean-Michael Bazire doing the steering once more. CINDERELLA JET (5) arrives following four-straight wins in Italy and could feature on French debut. Swedish-raider LADY LARISSA (4) finished a good third at Halmstad last outing and makes plenty of appeal. ICONE DE L'ETRE (3) may place.

## Race 6 - PRIX D'ALENCON - 2175m WALK-UP D185 RST E Monte. Purse EUR €57,000.

- 1. **ELVIS MADJI** Was a winner by 4L at this track last time, his second win from the last six starts. Rates highly on recent efforts.
- 2. **GALA D'URFIST** Tried hard last time to finish 3.8L from the winner in second at Reims. This looks a far sterner task.
- 3. **SELF EXPLOSIVE** Won two back at this track then couldn't repeat the dose last time out when second at this track, beaten 2.2L. Well-placed in this contest. Capable of taking this out.
- 4. **MATEO DE REVE** Was far too good last time when an effortless 2.2L winner at this track. In form and sure to prove hard to beat.
- 5. **FANDANGO GLYCINES** Finished third at Chateaubriant two starts back then couldn't repeat the dose at Saint-Galmier last time, finishing 3.7L from the winner. Sure to be thereabouts.
- 6. **GUAPO MARBOULA** Was beaten 4.7L into third last start at this track. That was his fifth placing from the last five starts. Genuine threat.
- 7. **DIEGO DECOULGENS** Last raced at Chateaubriant on February 7 when he was disqualified. Prefer to see him perform well before recommending.
- 8. **GIUSEPPE** Followed a good second two starts back with a win last time at Angers by 2.5L. Major contender on current form.
- 9. **DUCHESSE DE SASSY** Has been struggling of late and finished fourth last start at this track. Has been without a win for ages and others look to have her measure.
- 10. **FEVE DE BEYLEV** Placed two back then safely held last time when 12th at Laval, beaten 11L. Deserves another chance.

**Summary**: GIUSEPPE (8) made it eight from thirteen in the saddle with a comfortable 2.5L Class E European success at Angers last outing. Genuine chance with Mottier booked reverting to racing barefoot (five wins from seven starts). ELVIS MADJI (1) looked good in winning a Class D mounted event here by 4L nineteen days ago. Leading claims with an unexposed profile in the saddle. The switch back to mounted racing will pose no issues for recent Class E European mobile winner MATEO DE REVE (4) and he needs including with FEVE DE BEYLEV (10).

## Race 7 - PRIX DE LUNEVILLE - 2700m WALK-UP E161 Harness. Purse EUR €49,000.

- 1. **FOKKER DE BAILLY** Was safely held last time out in eighth at this track, beaten 2.6L. Won't find this easy. Not keen.
- 2. **HYMNE DU GERS** Deserved his win last start at this track. That came on the back of some consistent form including a close second at his previous outing. Well-placed here and is the one to beat again.
- 3. **HAKIM GRIFF** Turned his form around dramatically last time to score by 1.3L at this track. Fitter for two runs back and expected to measure up again.
- 4. **HOVE PONT VAUTIER** Unplaced two runs back then again missed the placings last start but was only beaten 0.9L when fifth at this track. Can do a lot better in this suitable contest.
- 5. **DEXTER BLUE** Was last produced when 14th at Lyon-Parilly four-and-a-half months ago. Maybe later.
- 6. **GENERAL DE LOIRON** Has bounced back to form with placings at his last two starts, most recently when third at Nantes, beaten 3.4L. Makes appeal.
- 7. **HECTOR DES CHAMPS** Last raced at this track on February 10 when he was disqualified. Prepared to overlook until his racing manners improve.
- 8. **HOBBES** Disgualified last start at this track. Forgive the recent mishap. Looks ideally placed.
- 9. **FAKIR DE GESVRES** Ran a better race last time out when fourth at this track. Rates an each way hope with further improvement.

**Summary**: HYMNE DU GERS (2) was having his first outing without shoes when winning a Class D mobile race recently. Could prove tough to beat with an excellent record here and further improvement possible representing a top stable. HOBBES (8) is three from nine over course and distance. Likely to feature if bouncing back from a recent DQ in a Class C European event here. HOVE PONT VAUTIER (4) cannot be ruled out on the back of a decent fifth in a Class D European contest at this venue. Each-way claims go the way of GENERAL DE LOIRON (6).

- 1. JOYAU Fourth in a Class A mobile race here last outing. Likely more required.
- 2. **JAPAROV LIRE** Impressed when a wide-margin winner of a Class A walk-up here latest. Interesting up in standard with a new shoeing combination tried.
- 3. **JOUEUSE DU MIREL** Held ninth in the G3 Prix d'Orthez at this venue a week-and-a-half ago. Prefer others.
- 4. **JAGUAR DU GOUTIER** Dual course and distance scorer who was a good third in the G3 Prix d'Orthez. Versatile performer who looks a major player.
- 5. **JUST FOR LOVA** Held in the G3 Prix Timocharis five months ago. Opposed.
- 6. **JEEGHA PRIDE** Won the G3 Prix de Riberac at this venue three starts ago. Not dismissed for a leading yard.
- 7. **JUSTIN BOLD** Excellent fourth in the G1 Swc 4 Ans Finale Prix Ourasi on his penultimate outing. Key claims back racing without rear shoes.
- 8. JOSH POWER Sound 1.75L fourth in the G3 Prix d'Orthez at this course. Solid each-way hope.
- 9. JOYFUL DIVA Finished behind some of these when seventh in the G3 Prix d'Orthez. Bit more needed.
- 10. **JET SET BOND** Good sixth in the G1 Championnat Europeen des 3 Ans last season. Easy to ignore last two outings and likely she has more to offer with shoes removed for the first time.
- 11. JUNON DU LEARD Classy mounted performer but looks best watched in a driven event.

**Summary**: Two-time course and distance winner JAGUAR DU GOUTIER (4) is a versatile performer and proved that when third in the driven G3 Prix d'Orthez here eleven days ago. Solid claims. JET SET BOND (10) last two outings are easily ignored and she showed some decent form when sixth in the G1 Championnat Europeen des 3 Ans as a three-year-old. Fascinating contender with shoes removed for the first time representing a top stable. JUSTIN BOLD (7) is tough to dismiss having finished fourth in the G1 Swc 4 Ans Finale - Prix Ourasi in this shoeing combination. Dangerous if bouncing back from a recent DQ (wore shoes). JOSH POWER (8) completes the shortlist on the back of a good fourth in the previously mentioned G3 Prix d'Orthez. JAPAROV LIRE (2) looks interesting.
