# C1 - PRIX DES MESANGES - 2050m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 26,000

- **1. JERICHO -** Unreliable but was third last time out in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 January. Can contest the finish again
- **2. JOJO TOONS -** Not reliable but did run well when runner-up in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 January. Can go one better this time
- **3. JUJUBEE -** Has struggled of late and was 7th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 4 January. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **4. JOB DES LOUANGES -** Holding form and was fourth in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 January. Has a winning chance
- **5. JASMIN BLANC -** Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Vincennes on 20 December. Unreliable and others are preferred
- **6. JACINTHE DU BOIRON -** Continues to win races and is hat-trick-seeking after two solid wins, the latest being in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2550m on 20 December. Has a winning chance
- **7. JET DES PRES -** In good form with some nice wins of late, the latest in Class F at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Not out of it
- **8. JOCE JISCE -** Mostly moderate form of late and was 8th in Class D at Vincennes over 2175m on 3 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. JASMIN DE LA COUR -** Disappointig form of late and was 11th in Class F at Beaumont-de-Lomagne over 2400m on 1 December. Others make more appeal

**Summary:** JOB DES LOUANGES (4) is holding form well and that level of form should ensure a big run from him and he could be the one to beat. JOJO TOONS (2) is not reliable but likes this shorter distance and can fight out the finish again. JERICHO (1) was ahead of JOB DES LOUANGES (4) when they last met and is clearly not out of it. JACINTHE DU BOIRON (6) has already won 8 times and is another to consider.

- **1. KAPITAN D'HERIPRE -** Finished 6th in a class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 18 November. Remains barefoot. At best can play a minor role
- **2. IVRE DE TOI -** Fourth in a Mounted class F at Argentan over 2875m on 26 December. Remains barefoot. Has disgualification issues but if wise can play a role in the finish
- **3. JOGGER KILY -** A winner in a class F at Toulouse over 2950m on 7 January. Remains barefoot. Holding form well and is capable of making the frame again
- **4. KISS ME SIMON -** Third in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2850m on 1 December. Remains barefoot. Deserves to be respected and can go close to winning
- **5. JEDI DES BROUETS -** Well beaten 9th in a Mounted class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 10 January. Major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- **6. HARLEQUIN -** Finished 6th in a class E at Montauban over 2400m on 29 December. Reverts to barefoot. Track suited and can contest the finish
- **7. GALOPIN DE BLOT -** Finished 8th in a class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 3 January. Unreliable and the last victory was on this track in April last year
- **8. GAUDI TIT -** A runner up in a class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 12 December. Remains barefoot. Improving sort who is not out of it
- **9. KARAKA WOOD -** Fourth in a class B at Vincennes over 2850m on 15 December. Reverts to barefoot. A consistent sort who has sufficient means to fight for victory
- **10. GOOD LUCK TIT** Disqualified in the last two, the latest in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 November. Must be wise
- **11. FANDANGO GLYCINES -** Disqualified in a Mounted class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 14 December. Must be wise and needs to find a few lengths

**Summary:** KISS ME SIMON (4) was third in a better race than this last time out at Vincennes and should make a bold bid at beating these rivals. KARAKA WOOD (9) is consistent and is barefoot and ready to fight out the finish. GAUDI TIT (8) is improving and has a decent finishing turn so should be in the mix of things again. JOGGER KILY (3) remains in good shape and is not out of it.

- 1. JIBILIE DU DAMIER Fifth in a class F at Amiens over 2400m on 27 October. Can play a minor role at best
- **2. JESCO DE LA VALLEE -** Disqualified in a Mounted race at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 12 January. Back to a Harness race but needs to improve
- **3. INGALLS -** Well beaten 8th in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 16 November. Others are preferred in this line up
- **4. JUSTE CHOIX -** Finished 7th in a class F at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 18 December. Remains barefoot and has sufficient means to fight for a place on the podium
- **5. JULES ET JIM -** Disqualified in a class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 December. Siuted to a right hand track and is capable of contesting the finish if wise
- **6. JACINTHE DES PRES -** Disappointed when unplaced in a class F at Meslay-du-Maine over 2600m on 19 December. A penultimate start winner when unshod as is the case today
- **7. JINGLE KOP -** Finished 7th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Probably needed the latest and did win four in a row on this track last year
- **8. IZIA NINI -** Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. When wise is competitive and can earn
- **9. INSTINCT DE VETRE -** Well beaten 8th in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 1 December. Others are preferred in this line up
- **10. JUST BEAUTIFUL -** Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. If wise can have place prospects
- **11. JAMES RULES -** Fifth in a class D at Vichy over 2950m on 6 May. Probably best watched for now
- **12. JAMES DE LA VALLEE -** Fourth in a class A at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 16 November. Remains barefoot and is holding form. Can make the frame

- **1. KASTING BLUE -** Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Major disqualification issues and is hard to trust
- **2. KAPORAL DU JOUR -** Finished 7th in a Mounted class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 14 December. At best can play a minor role
- **3. KENAVO DES GLENAN -** A runner up in a class F at Saint-Omer over 2625m on 15 September. Might need the run back
- **4. KRYSTAL DE BERAR -** Finished 6th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. The last victory was on this track and is track suited
- **5. KITUS DE BERTRANGE -** Fifth in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 1 December. Remains barefoot. Seldom far off them recently and can make the frame
- **6. KAISER DE CHANLECY -** Finished 6th in a class E at Nimes over 2750m on 1 December. Probably needed the latest and might still need it
- **7. KAPRICE DE KACY -** Finished 7th in a class F at Salon-de-Provence over 3000m on 9 November. Others are preferred in this line up
- **8. KISS OF THE KING -** Disqualified in a class E at Toulouse over 2325m on 7 January. Must be wise and needs to find a few lengths
- **9. KEFREN BLEU -** Finished 7th in a Claimer at Divonne-les-Bains over 2700m on 12 August. Remains barefoot. Capable of a surprise

**Summary:** KAPITANO DREAM (12) has looked formidable in his last three wins. He has won at this course and there is no real reason to suggest he cannot win again. KITUS DE BERTRANGE (5) is usually competitive and looks likely to be competitive yet again. KEROS DU BAS BOSQ (10) was not disgraced behind KAPITANO DREAM (12) last time out and can contest the finish again. KEEP TIME (14) is unshod so expect an improved performance.

- **2. KOMANIA D'ABY -** Seldom far off them and was 6th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Tries barefoot. Has sufficient means to fight for a place on the podium
- **3. KARIBELLE DE NUIT -** Disqualified in a class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 26 December. Must be wise and is probably best watched for now
- **4. KATINKA D'OCCAGNES -** Finished 6th in a class E at Hyeres over 2850m on 14 September. Needs to find a few lengths
- **5. KALINKA DE VANDEL -** Well beaten 8th in a class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 14 January. Others are preferred in this line up
- **6. KELLY QUEEN -** Fourth in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. David Békaert will give every assistance from the sulky
- **7. KELLE ALLURE -** Unplaced in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. The penultimate start was third on this track and at best can play a minor role
- **8. KEEN DE MAHEY -** Finished 8th in a class E at this track over 2050m on 11 December. Probably better suited to this distance and is capable of making the frame
- **9. KIMBERLEY -** Disqualified in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 1 December. A penultimate start runner up on this track and is not out of it if wise
- **10. KOUBA THE BEST -** Holding form when fourth in a class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 1 December. A runner up in both attempts on this track and can go close again
- **11. KALINKA DU BLEUET -** Finished 7th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Remains barefoot. Needs to find a few lengths to be competitive
- **12. KALOUGA -** Finished 8th in a class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Capable of bouncing back to make the frame

**Summary:** KOUBA THE BEST (10) has got close to winning twice already at this track and with luck in running can go one better this time. KEEN DE MAHEY (8) is better this distance and can fight out the finish. KOMANIA D'ABY (2) will be barefoot for the first time and can get involved with the finish. KIMBERLEY (9) fluffed her lines with a disqualification last time out after a very good penultimate start.

- **1. LITTLE UP -** Has really struggled of late and was 9th in Class D at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 29 August. Likely to need this run returning from a break
- **2. LISTED VOIRONS -** Unreliable but was barefoot and runner-up in Class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Can go one better
- **3. LORD LA GAUCHERIE -** Yet to win a race and was 6th in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 26 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **4. LOOK AT ME** Did not show his best when tenth in Class E at this track over 2700m on 11 December. Barefoot this time and can make the frame
- **5. LOOPING BEN MAX -** Unreliable and was 12th in Class F at this track over 2700m on 11 December. Won his penultimate start and he should be a threat
- **6. LUTIN GEDE -** Not disgraced when fourth in Class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m 26 December. Won his two starts before that and can bounce back to score
- **7. LOVER MAUZUN -** Bounced back to win his latest start, in Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2000m on 14 December. Can follow up if in the same mood
- **8. LET'S GO DES PLANS -** Disqualified last time out at Saint-Galmier on 19 November. Did well in some claimers before that and could play a minor role
- LEJACK DERIG Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class E at this course ver 2700m on 11 January. Others are preferred
- **10. LAPON DE BERTRANGE -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 11 January. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
- **11. LORENZO DU SERAN -** Has struggled of late and was tenth in Class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Others are much preferred
- **12. LAGON DES BROUETS -** Only modest of late and was 6th last time out in Class E at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **13. LANCIANO -** Did not show his best when tenth in Class E at Feurs over this distance on 2 September. Could need this run returning from a break

**Summary:** LUTIN GEDE (6) has shown promise so far. He was not disgraced when fourth last month at Cagnes-sur-Mer last month and can resume his winning ways. LOOPING BEN MAX (5) is clearly better than his last run would suggest and can be a lively danger. LOVER MAUZUN (7) won over a similar distance at Lyon-Parilly and has a winning chance. LISTED VOIRONS (2) is also guite capable of winning this competitive looking race.

- **3. L'ETOILE DE PAME -** Did not show her best when 8th in Class e at this track over 2700m on 11 December. Better this distance and has a winning chance
- **4. LOVELY GAZELLE -** In good form and was runner-up in class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 7 January. Could play a minor role
- **5. LA NUIT JE MENS -** In good form and was third in Class E at Amiens over 2400m on 9 December. Should be competitive again
- **6. LIBERIAN GIRL** Has disqualification issues and was tenth last time out in Class E at Saint-Galmier over 2600m on 19 November. Capable of bouncing back to beat these rivals
- **7. LICORNE DES ARRIS -** A winner of both her starts at Jullianges, with the latest being in Class E over 2425m on 24 August. Returns from a break but has a winning chance if smart

- **3. MOVE SIXTY ONE** Disqualified last time out which was at this course on 11 January. Had some fair form before that and could play a minor role if wise
- **4. MESTA ATALANTE -** Showed what she is capable of when scoring in Class E over this course and distance on 11 January. Can follow up if in the same mood
- **5. MORE AND MORE -** Showed some improvement when runner-up in Class E at Les Andelys over 2525m on 15 September. Returns from a break but could make the frame
- **6. MAGIC DOLLAR -** Won on debut but has struggled since then and was disqualified last time out at this track on 11 January. Others make more appeal
- **7. MODESTO -** Showed some improvement when winning his second start which was at Cabourg over this distance on 13 August. Returns from a break but can score if wise

**Summary:** MODESTO (7) has the ability and was a good winner last time out at Cabourg. He returns from a break but would not be a surprise winner of this lucky last race. MONSEIGNEUR (1) is getting close to a win and should challenge for top honours yet again. MESTA ATALANTE (4) showed improvement when scoring last time out but needs to confirm that run. MORE AND MORE (5) returns from a break but an make the frame.
