**C1 - PRIX JACKY SOUSSI - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
22,000**

- 1. LESLIE DE VANDEL** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Not fully barefoot this time but can earn some money
- 2. LA REINE MARGOT** - Very consistent and finished third in Class E at this track over 2925m on 31 January. Can get involved with the finish again
- 3. LA BREVINOISE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class D at this course over 2700m on 10 February. Can be competitive in this line-up
- 4. LADY DU VALLON** - Returned to form with a Class E victory at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Capable of following up
- 5. LIKE A BIRD STAR** - Off form and finished 9th in Class D at this course over 2700m on 10 February. Barefoot this time but others are preferred
- 6. LISBETH** - Did not show her best when 6th in Class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 18 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. LAIA D'AVRIL** - In good shape and was runner-up in Class E over this track and trip on 16 January. Should contest the finish
- 8. LOVELY LA CHENAIE** - Did not show her best when 9th in Class E at Marseille-Borely over 2300m on 8 November. Should need this run returning from a break
- 9. LEGENDE SEVEN** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Toulouse over 2950m on 7 July. Should need this run returning from a break
- 10. LHOCHEMA** - Continues to shine and was runner-up in Class E at this track over 2925m on 31 January. Just as good this distance. Big chance
- 11. LIKE THAT** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in Class E at this track over 2925m on 12 February. Might play a minor role at very best
- 12. LILIBETH SMART** - Not reliable and finished 7th in Class E at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 14 February. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role

Summary: LHOCHEMA (10) continues to win her races. She was a good winner over this track and trip in her penultimate start and is clearly the one to beat. LA BREVINOISE (3) was an easy winner at Marseille-Vivaux and could also be a threat over this shorter distance, as she has some fair recent form and can get involved with the finish. LAIA D'AVRIL (7) is in very good form and is another that has to be considered a possible winner.

**C2 - PRIX DU PUY EN VELAY - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR
€ 26,000**

- 1. KAIPIRINHA** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class G at this track over 2925m on 17 February. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 2. KATSOUKA** - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 February. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
- 3. KATHLEEN D'ECOTAY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in class F at Vincennes over 2175m on 24 December. Returns barefoot and is capable of being successful
- 4. KIARA DES MONTES** - Did not show her best when 8th in class E at this track over 2925m on 10 February. Capable of bouncing back to win
- 5. KLAIRE DE PLAY** - Only modest of late and finished 5th in class F at this course over 2700m on 28 January. Remains barefoot but needs to do more to score
- 6. KALIE TEJY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class F at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 13 February. Can be a lively danger this track and trip
- 7. KIERA MAGIC** - Not reliable but was 4th in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Remains barefoot and can get involved with the finish
- 8. KENTUCKY VALLEY** - Not disgraced when 5th in class E at over this track and trip on 3 February. Capable of making the frame
- 9. KOKONUT BAINDOR** - Unreliable and finished 6th in class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Returns barefoot but is on a long losing streak and others make more appeal
- 10. KAMELIE DU CAMPUS** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 13 February. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
- 11. KATE DU RIL** - Has struggled of late and finished 13th in class F at Vincennes over 2700m on 11 February. Has been victorious three times so far and can bounce back to score barefoot this time
- 12. KANDY CHAMPOSULT** - Disqualified in class E at Marseille-Vivau over 2650m on 13 February. Victorious back in August but others make more appeal

Summary: KATE DU RIL (11) has struggled of late, but she does have a good record when barefoot and can bounce back with a victory. KIARA DES MONTES (4) is clearly better than her last run would suggest and can get involved with the finish this time. KIERA MAGIC (7) is not reliable, but she would not be a surprise winner on her best form. KALIE TEJY (6) has only been modest of late but can do better over this track and trip.

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**C3 - PRIX PIERRE DESIRE ALLAIRE - 2925m (a2m) - Gr3 - Harness - EUR
€ 80,000**

- 1. COOL KRONOS** - Holding form and finished 4th in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 20 December. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
- 2. GREAT OF MADRIK** - Disqualified in class B at Cagnes-Sur-Mer over 2925m on 12 February. Remains barefoot and is capable of playing a minor role
- 3. HEROS DES MOTTES** - Not disgraced when 5th in class B at over this course and distance on 12 February when barefoot. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 4. ILLUSION JIPAD** - Showed some improvement when 4th in class B over this track and trip on 12 February when barefoot. Not this time and has disqualification issues. Can earn some money
- 5. GIMY DU POMMEREUX** - Off form and finished 11th in class A over his course and distance on 21 January. Needs to do more to score
- 6. GALA DE CRENNES** - Battling to find best form and was 8th in class A over this course and distance on 21 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 7. ISTER MAN** - Victorious in class A over this course and distance on 21 January. Remains barefoot and complete a hat-trick
- 8. INVICTUS MADIBA** - Has struggled of late and was 15th in class A at Vincennes over 2100m on 7 February. Victorious back in August and is capable of an upset on best form
- 9. HUDO DU RUEL** - A runner up in his last three starts, the latest in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 28 January. Should be right there at the finish once again
- 10. FLOREAL** - Off form and was 14th in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 8 January when barefoot. Needs to do more to score
- 11. IGREC DE CELLAND** - Not at his best when 8th at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 26 December. Better this distance and is not out of it
- 12. FAKIR MERITE** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 28 January. Others make much more appeal
- 13. GENDREEN** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at Vincennes over 2100m on 24 January when barefoot. Not this time but can be a real threat when smart

Summary: ISTER MAN (7) is right back to his very best. He was an impressive winner over this course and distance last month and can complete a good hat-trick. HUDO DU RUEL (9) has been unlucky not to win one of his last three starts and chased home that rival on that occasion, and will be a threat again. IGREC DE CELLAND (11) is better than his last run would suggest and is not out of it. GENDREEN (13) can bounce back and make the frame if staying on the trot this time around.

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**C4 - PRIX DE PERPIGNAN - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
22,000**

- 1. LINAS** - In good shape and was runne- up in class E at this course over 2925m on 10 February. Can go one place better
- 2. L'AMERICAIN** - Showed some improvement when 5th in class E over this track and trip on 28 January. Might play a minor role at very best
- 3. LEADER RASTID** - Victorious in class E at this track over 2925m on 10 February. In good shape and has claims this shorter distance
- 4. LATINO PURA VIDA** - Finished 6th in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February when barefoot. Likely to improv and could contest the finish
- 5. LOMAC GEDE** - Did not show his best when 7th in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2925m on 28 January. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
- 6. LEKEVIN DESBOIS** - Unreliable but was 4th in class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 26 January. Quite capable of making the frame
- 7. LOU PANTAIL** - Disqualified in class D at Vincennes over 2100m on 5 February. Victorious in December when barefoot and is racing without shoes and quite capable of bouncing back to score
- 8. LASER DE JOUDES** - In good form and finished 3rd in class at this track over 2925m on 28 January. Should be competitive once again
- 9. LELOUP VALLEE** - Did not show his best when 6th in class E at this track on 28 January. In good form before that and can upset
- 10. L'ULTIME ESPOIR** - Disqualified in class F at Nantes over 3000m on 16 December. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 11. LOOK DES VALLEES** - Victorious in class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 8 February. Has shown improvement and might just follow up
- 12. LABEL D'HERMES** - Finished 4th in class E at this track over 2925m on 18 December. Could need this run returning from a break
- 13. LUCIFER** - Did not show his best when 8th in class D at this track over 2700m on 7 February. Returns barefoot but is on a long losing streak and others are preferred

Summary: LOU PANTAIL (7) fluffed his lines with a fault at Vincennes. He is quite capable of bouncing back to win a race of this nature and is a confident pick. LATINO PURA VIDA (4) is capable of improvement and can contest the finish. LOMAC GEDE (5) is barefoot this time around, so expect improvement and he will be a threat. LEKEVIN DESBOIS (6) is unreliable but did not run too badly last time out and is another to consider.

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C5 - PRIX REMANENCE (PRIX UCLEO) - 2925m (a2m) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 43,000

- 1. HESCORT LOVE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in class D over this course and distance on 7 February when barefoot. Hard to trust but can earn some money when smart
- 2. INVISIBLE SAM** - Unreliable and was 7th in class D over this course and distance on 7 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 3. HERMES D'ECROVILLE** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in class D over this track and trip on 7 February. Can earn some minor money
- 4. HYDROMEL** - Not reliable and was 8th in class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 1 February when barefoot. Not this time and needs to do more to score
- 5. GRIGRI DU BONHEUR** - Disqualified in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
- 6. GERSHWIN DE CHENU** - Not reliable and finished 5th in class D at Toulouse over 2150m on 22 January. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. IES WE KAN** - Finished 11th in class D at Chateaubriant over 3000m on 7 July. Has major disqualification issues and is likely to need this run returning from a break
- 8. HERODE DU CORTA** - In good form and finished 4th in class C at this track over 2700m on 16 January. Has won his last two starts when racing without shoes and is barefoot and ready to strike
- 9. FRANKLIN PARK** - Finished 9th at Wolvega over 2600m on 31 December when barefoot. Not this time and others are preferred
- 10. IMPULSE JULRY** - Unreliable and finished 8th in class C at Vincennes over 2700m on 25 January. Victorious back in November and could be the surprise package of the race
- 11. HAIDA SAUTONNE** - Not reliable and finished 7th in class B over this course and distance on 12 February. Returns barefoot and could play a minor role
- 12. HOOPER DES CHASSES** - Disappointing of late and was 11th in class B over this track and trip on 12 February. Not reliable but is capable if getting into the mix of things
- 13. HONEY KING** - Unreliable and finished 9th in class B over this course and distance on 12 February. Capable of being a threat if finding his best form
- 14. FEU DE REVOLTE** - Not disgraced when 5th in class B at Vincennes over 2850m on 29 January. Can make the frame this time around
- 15. IRU FUSHI** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest at this course over 2925m on 28 January. Victorious back in December and contest the finish when smart

Summary: A tricky race. HERODE DU CORTA (8) does not always race barefoot, but he has won his last two starts when without shoes and so sets a good standard for this race. IRU FUSHI (15) has had a couple of faults of late but is a threat when staying on the trot. HOOPER DES CHASSES (12) and HONEY KING (13) have been modest of late but are capable of getting involved with the finish when in the right mood.

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**C6 - PRIX D'ALLAUCH - 2150m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR €
22,000**

1. MOONLIGHT DANICA - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Class E at this track over 2700m on 3 February. Can contest the finish barefoot for the first time

2. MANITOBA - Not disgraced when fourth in a Class F at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 13 February. Can make the frame

3. MONEYPIME DUCAMPUS - Victorious last time out at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 13 February. Has major disqualification issues but is capable of following up

4. MIMOSA DE LARRE - Has been disqualified in his last two starts, the latest at Graignes over 2725m on 2 February. Hard to trust but is capable of scoring when smart

5. MISTER DES THUYAS - Yet to win a race but is in good form and was third in a Class E at Toulouse over 2750m on 7 February. Can get involved with the finish once again

6. MALIN DE L'ANTE - Has shown improvement this year and was third in a Class F at Marseille-Vivauz over 2650m on 13 February. Should contest the finish

Summary: A small field of 6 runners and any one of them can score. MOONLIGHT DANICA (1) races without shoes for the first time and could taste victory. MIMOSA DE LARRE (4) is coming off a couple of disqualifications but he will be a threat if he stays in stride. MONEYPIME DUCAMPUS (3) also has major disqualification issues but is another that is quite capable of winning when smart. MALIN DE L'ANTE (6) has improved of late and can make the frame.

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C7 - PRIX DE LYON - 2925m (a2m) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 18,500

- 1. NOSTALGIE D'OLMEN** - A three-year-old filly by Boccador de Simm out of Gaïa Olmenhof who is making her debut. Her dam won 6 of her 36 starts. Can contest the finish
- 2. NIGHT OF CARLESS** - Finished fifth on debut in a Class F over this track and trip on 31 January. Capable of improvement and has a place chance
- 3. NANCY ANGANO** - Not disgraced when fourth in a Class F at Hyères over 2050m on 8 February. Likely to improve and can get involved with the finish again
- 4. NINA BOURBON** - Showed some improvement second time around when third in a Class F at Graignes over 2700m on 11 January. Can do even better this time
- 5. NINA DE MALAC** - Showed improvement in her second start when third in a Class F at Hyères over 2050m on 8 February. Can be a threat to these rivals trying a lot further
- 6. NOUMEA COCONUT** - A good third on debut in a Class F over this track and trip on 31 January. Capable of scoring in this line-up
- 7. NANA OASIS** - Has run well in her two starts, the latest when fourth in a Class F over this course and distance on 31 January. Not out of it
- 8. NOISETTE MIKA** - Did not show her best when sixth in a Class E at Graignes over 2725m on 9 February. Did better on debut and has a place chance
- 9. NININE DES FLOTS** - Unreliable and finished seventh in a Class D over this track and trip on 7 February. Might make the frame

Summary: NOSTALGIE D'OLMEN (1) makes her debut. Her mother was pretty good and she has come through qualifying well, so looks the one to be with. NOUMEA COCONUT (6) showed promise on debut and looks likely to do even better this time. NINA BOURBON (4) is improving and can get involved with the finish. NANA OASIS (7) has not been disgraced in either of her two starts and is also capable of making the frame.

C8 - PRIX DE CLERMONT-FERRAND - 2925m (a2m) - Class E Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 8,000

- 1. HOPE COGLAIS** - Has really struggled of late and was eighth in a Class F at this track over 2150m on 7 February. Needs major improvement to win
- 2. HERCULE BRILLOUARD** - Unreliable but did finish fourth in Class G at this track over 2150m on 10 February. On a long losing run but could make the frame
- 3. JEAN MAJYC** - Finished fifth in a Class G at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 13 February. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
- 4. HIRO DE LA LUNA** - Not disgraced when fifth in Class F at Agen-Le Passage over 2575m on 1 February. Unreliable but is capable of a victory
- 5. GAETANE DU VIVIER** - Did not show her best when ninth in a Class G at this course over 2150m on 10 February. Quite capable of making the frame
- 6. JIRENZO** - Unreliable and was seventh in a Class E at this track over 2150m on 7 February. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
- 7. FIFTY WINNER** - Faulted last time out in a claimer at this track over 2700m on 17 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 8. IRON D'ERONVILLE** - Not reliable and is coming off a disqualification at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Can win in this division
- 9. GENIALISSIME** - Off form and was 13th in Class E at this course over 2700m on 31 January. Needs to find a few lengths to score
- 10. HARING OKINA** - Off form and finished 8th in Class D at this course over 2700m on 12 February. Capable of better and has claims of winning
- 11. FARCEUR DE L'INAM** - Has struggled of late and finished tenth in Class D at this course over 2700m on 12 February. Needs major improvement to score
- 12. FAKIR DE LARRE** - Battling to find best form and finished tenth in Class E over this course and distance on 13 February. Others make more appeal
- 13. HARENA DE MARZY** - Has major disqualification issues and is coming off two faults in a row, the latest at this track over 2700m on 12 February. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 14. HAPPY D'AIMTE** - Disqualified last time out at this track over 2150m on 11 January. Very unreliable but is capable of making the frame

Summary: A very tricky lucky last race and anything can happen. IRON D'ERONVILLE (8) is unreliable and was disqualified last time out, but he is quite capable of winning a race of this nature. HARING OKINA (10) has some modest recent form but is also capable of winning in this category. HERCULE BRILLOUARD (2) has not won for some time now but hinted last time out that he could be ready to score. HAPPY D'AIMTE (14) is very unreliable but is one of many others that can shine.
