- **1. KENAVO TUILERIE -** Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Caen on 13 March. Capable of bouncing back to score driven by Eric Raffin
- 2. KERLAZ D'AVE On a very long losing run but was third last time out in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 13 March. Can contest the finish
- **3. KIWI DES MALBERAUX -** Has struggled of late and finished 6th in Class F at Caen over 2200m on 13 March. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. KEZIO JOSSELYN -** Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Amiens on 16 March. A good winner of his penultimate start and has a winning chance
- **5. KYROC D'ERPION -** Unreliable and finished 6th in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 3 March. Fitter this time and could earn some minor money
- **6. KRAPO LILA -** On a long losing run but is threatening to win and was runner-up last time out in Class E at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2700m on 24 February. Clearly not out of it

- **3. PRIVATE BANKER SB -** On a very long losing run but was third last time out in a Mounted race at Mons over 2275m on 11 March. Could play a minor role
- **4. ETOILE DU OZ -** Not disgraced when barefoot and 5th in a Class E Mounted race at Vincennes over 2700m on 28 February. Should be competitive in this line-up
