- **2. BUSTOPHER JONES -** A modest 7th on debut in a Conditions race at Lyon-La Soie over 2150m on the 6 of April. Others are preferred in this line-up
- **3. MIA GRANDE -** Third in a Conditions race Lyon-La Soie over 1800m on the 24 of March. The latest two races have been third. Debut on grass and could suit
- **4. MILL LANE -** Not disgraced whenthird in a Conditions race at Mons over 1500m on the 25 of March. Improved in the latest effort and will need to confirm
- **5. SILVER SPUR -** Disappointing 7th in a Conditions race Chantilly over 1800m on the 14 of November. Trying the grass for the first time and was a runner-up on debut.
- **6. TWO O'CLOCK JUMP -** Finished 7th in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on the 22 of March. Has scope to improve and can play a role
- 7. NATIVE PEARL Finished 5th in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1600m on the 5 of March. Entered in the Poule dEssai and Prix de Diane (Gr1) and faces a much easier task
- **8. SAHARA GOLD** Did not show much when 10th in a Conditions race at Chantilly over 1600m on the 28 of March. Moderate debut effort and must improve on that
- **9. VEGA -** On debut was 6th in a Conditions race at Pornichet-La Baule over 1700m on the 27 of March. Has scope to improve and can have a say
- **10. PEBBLESSHINYBRIGHT -** Good third in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on the 22 of March. She has sufficient means to fight for the victory
- **11. FASHIONABLY -** Fourth in a Conditions race at this track over 1800m on the 22 of March. She made her debut on this track and was just behind PEBBLESSHINYBRIGHT (10). Can go close
- **12. EURASIENNE -** Finished 8th in a Conditions race at Toulouse over 2100m on the 4 of March. Yet to show and others are preferred
- **13. WILD N'BEAUTIFUL -** A 3-year-old colt by Jimmy Two Times out of Wild Angel who makes his debut. Watch the betting
- **14. FREEZE -** A 3-year-old gelding by Toronado out of Fair Breeze who makes his debut. Watch the betting
- **15. CARELESS -** 3-year-old filly by Manduro out of Meerschweinchen who makes her debut. Watch the betting

Summary: FASHIONABLY (11) finished an encouraging 4th on debut on this course and is likely to fight for victory, as improvement is expected with the benefit of that experience under the belt. NATIVE PEARL (7) has Group I entries to her name and is, despite two disappointing previous outings, ought to acquit herself competitively in a race of this nature. Runner-up to the excellent Calandagan on debut, SILVER SPUR (5) has legitimate claims too on his reappearance having been gelded. PEBBLESSHINYBRIGHT (10) and VEGA (9) complete the shortlist.

- **2. MANOIR -** Fourth last time out in a Handicap at Pornichet-La Baule over 1700m on the 27 of March. A versatile sort who performs on the sand and grass. Should make a bid for victory
- **3. LA VUELTA -** Improving and was third in a Handicap at Compiegne over 1600m on the 29 of March. Can make the frame
- **4. LAMAJESTIK -** Probably needed the last run and was 8th in a Conditions race at Compiegne over 2000m on the 10 of March. She has been placed on this track in Claimers and can earn
- **5. WALDLADY -** Needed her last run and finished 6th in a Conditions race at Strasbourg over 2000m on the 22 of March. Twice has been a runner-up at this track in Claimers. Might place
- **6. LA TOUR DU BOIS -** Fourth in a Handicap last time out at Chantilly over 1900m on the 28 of March. Improved in the latest effort and can go close
- **7. ROXANA OF CECCA -** Was 6th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on the 1 of April Others are preferred in this line-up.

- **11. SWEETYDANCER -** Disappointing two starts this year and finished 7th in a Conditions race at Saint-Cloud over 1600m on the 16 of March. Probably needed the last start and can improve

Summary: After finishing 4th in a tougher race on the PSF at Chantilly last time, it could pay to side with LA TOUR DU BOIS (6) who proved her efficiency on turf last year when 4th on debut at Le Pin au Haras on soft ground. She will, however, be tested by MANOIR (2) whose consistency and versatility will stand him in good stead. LA VUELTA (3) confirmed the improvement of her previous start (5th) with an encouraging 3rd last time and is likely to make her presence felt too with a repeat of that performance. Of the rest, ROUDOUDOU (1) appeals most.

- **3. TATOO** Capable of better and was 7th in a Handicap at Argentan over 1900m on the 11 of April. Third run back and will be fitter. Can be involved
- **4. ZELZEFYR -** Unplaced in a Handicap last time out at Deauville over 1900m on the 9 of April. Poor form and best to pass by

She will, however, have to thwart the likely challenge of LOVER WITH A G (9), another joint top-rated entrant whose rider also takes 1,5kg off the back. DORIANELLO (6), a winner on this track last year, makes the trip for this commitment with legitimate ambitions too. TATOO (3) completes the shortlist.

- **4. PINK VALENTINE -** Capable of better and finished 7th in a Handicap at Deauville over the 1400m on the 10 of April. The penultimate start was a winner and can't be ruled out

Veteran GLICOURT (14), twice a winner over this course and distance, is ideally positioned in the starting stalls and has the means to play a leading role too, having finished an encouraging 4th over this track and trip last month. ISEULT (3), after a much-needed comeback run, veteran mare CRISTAL MARVELOUS (1), and MAGIC SWORD (2) could also resurface in a race of this nature.

- **3. BARBUDA -** Modest last two runs and was 9th in a Handicap last time out at Deauville over 1300m on the 15 of December. Been on a break since and has sufficient means to fight for the victory.
- **4. SWEET AS -** Unreliable and was 8th in a Handicap at Deauville over 1400m on the 10 of April.Well-drawn and will be an advantage but is not the most consistent sort

BARBUDA (3) is, like the selection, also favourably positioned in the starting stalls, so has legitimate ambitions here on her seasonal reappearance. TWO TWO TWO (5), although out of sorts, isn't incapable of making her presence felt either, having finished 4th over track and trip last year off a mark 4kg higher than her current rating. SWEET AS (4) and JAVA JAMES (12) appeal most of the remainder and are competitive for the places.

Summary: Inconsistent of late, although particularly efficient with Australian blinkers, TEMPO (6) seems the most likely winner of this race, especially if judged on the form of his last start (2nd) in a 1300m PSF handicap at Chantilly last month. RUE MIA (8) fits a similar profile, though, having finished 3rd on the turf at Chantilly last Monday, so should fight for victory. WAHAYEB (11) lines up here in good form and physical condition with legitimate ambitions too, after finishing 3rd over course and distance on her handicap debut last month. Last-start winner WAITING CALL (9) ought to remain competitive despite a resultant penalty.

MITARC (9), who won this race last year, has been primed to make a bold defence of his title after two pleasing comeback runs, which include an encouraging last start (3rd) at Compiegne over 2000m. Consistent PSF performer IVISHAK RIVER (5) has sound references on turf and isn't without a chance either.
