

# TUESDAY, 20/05/25

## C1 - PRIX CORONIS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class A Race - Harness - EUR € 62,000

**1. GIGLIO DEGLI DEI** - Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at Milan on 2 May. Has won three times this year but others are preferred

**2. GRAND TUR JOYEUSE** - Has some fair form and finished third at Milan over 1600m on 25 April. More is needed to beat these rivals

**3. GO BIG EFFE** - Has disqualified issues and faulted last time out at Modène on 22 April. Has some good form in Italy but this does look a tougher race

**4. MONTEQUILLO** - Disappointing form of late and was 7th in Class A over this track and trip on 29 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**5. MY NAME IS BOND** - Yet to win a race but was third in Class D at Cholet over 2800m on 28 April. Capable of playing a minor role

**6. MERCATOR** - Consistent and was runner-up in Class D at Cholet over 2800m on 28 April. Could be competitive in this line-up

**7. GRAN TORINO (ITY)** - Has shown ability in Italy winning his last three starts, with the latest being at Naples over 2100m on 4 April. Could contest the finish

**8. MAGIC MAN** - A winner of two of his four starts so far and ran well when third in Class A over this track and trip on 29 April. Be right there at the finish

**9. MADE IN PRIMO** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 29 April. In good form before that and is capable of an upset

**10. MAGICO DE LOU** - Has struggled of late and was 8th in Class A over this track and trip on 29 April. Others make a lot more appeal

**11. MARQUETY DE BAILLY** - Disqualified last time out at this track 18 April. Battling to find best form and needs to find a few lengths to win

**12. MARADONA ELLIS** - Bounced back to form with a victory in Class C at Enghien over 2875m on 19 April. Should fight out the finish if wise

**13. MARZIPAN** - Has disqualification issues but did run well when runner-up in Class A over this course and distance on 29 April. Can go one better

**14. MARATHON MAN** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 4 January. Showed ability last year and has a chance if fit from a break

**Summary:** A decent opening event. MARATHON MAN (14) returns from a break but showed potential last year and is capable of winning if fit first up. MAGIC MAN (8) continues to improve and should be right there at the finish yet again. GRAN TORINO (ITY) (7) has impressed in Italy recently, and with Eric Raffin in the sulky, he must be respected. MARADONA ELLIS (12) was a good winner at Enghien and can double up.

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**C2 - PRIX IAPETUS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C Race - Harness - EUR €  
46,000**

**1. LITTLE DRAGON** - Has struggled with disqualification issues this year and was disqualified at this course on 13 May. Others make much more appeal

**2. LUCHADOR** - Unreliable and was 9th in Class D at this course over 2100m on 13 May. Better this distance but others are preferred

**3. LEO DES MALBERAUX** - Has struggled of late and was tenth in a Class A Mounted race over this course and distance on 22 September. Likely to need this run returning from a break

**4. LENSOIS DU DOLLAR** - Disqualified in his last two starts, with the latest being at this track on 13 May. Capable of playing a minor role when wise

**5. LOUSTIC D'YVEL** - Unreliable but was victorious in Class D at this track over 2175m on 9 May. Better that shorter distance but could earn some money

**6. LOBSTER DU BELLAY** - Very consistent of late and was runner-up last time out in Class D over this track and trip on 2 May. Has a winning chance

**7. LUGANO DE LOU** - Has struggled of late and was 7th in Class C over this track and trip on 12 April. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals

**8. LANCELOT GRIFF** - Unbeaten in two starts this year, with the latest being in Class D over this track and trip on 25 April. Big chance in this line-up

**9. LOUIS VITTON MIJO** - Has improved of late and was a barefoot winner in Class D over this course and distance on 4 April. Can double up

**10. LOUIS QUATORZE** - In good shape since going barefoot and was runner-up in Class D at Enghien over 2150m on 19 April. Has won over this track and trip and is not out of it

**Summary:** LANCELOT GRIFF (8) is unbeaten in two starts this season. This is a tougher field, but he clearly sets the standard for the race. LOUIS VITTON MIJO (9) was a very easy winner when racing barefoot for the first time, and he remains unshod—a real danger. LOUIS QUATORZE (10) is in good form and can get into the mix. LOBSTER DU BELLAY (6) has been very competitive of late and also warrants consideration.

## C3 - PRIX FABRICIUS - 2850m (a2m) - Class D Race - Harness - EUR € 46,000

**1. KITTY RANAISE** - Unreliable all year and was 9th in Class E at Laval over 2850m on 30 April. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals

**2. KARLA JALLERIE** -

**3. KYOKA BOCNEUF** - Has struggled in her two starts this year and was 12th in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 8 May. Barefoot this time but others are preferred

**4. KULTA** - Finished 15th in her only start of the year in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 8 May. Needs major improvement to win

**5. KENISA** - Holding form and was fourth in Class D at this track over 2700m on 5 April. Can get involved with the finish yet again

**6. KOSMOPOLITAINE** - Disqualified last time out at Caen on 4 May. Unreliable but is capable of earning some minor money when in the mood

**7. KATOUCHKA** - In very good shape and was runner-up in Class E at this course over 2700m on 3 May. Should be competitive yet again

**8. KISS ME BEJI** - Only modest of late and was 7th in Class D at Caen over 2450m on 4 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**9. KARVINA D'ELA** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in Class D at Chartres over 2825m on 27 April. Others are preferred

**10. KALLISTEE** - Unreliable and was tenth in Class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 25 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**11. KALIAKIE PHEDO** - Has already won three times this year and was runner-up in Class E at Cherbourg over 2625m on 21 April. Has a winning chance

**12. KALINKA MOYA** - Unreliable and finished 7th in Class D at La Capelle over 2700m on 4 May. Better over a shorter distance and others are preferred

**13. KELLY CHARLY ERA** - Unreliable but was victorious last time out in Class E at this track over 2700m on 3 May. Not out of it in this line-up

**14. KISS ME DU RUEL** - Very unreliable but was third in Class D over this course and distance on 22 April. Might play a minor role

**15. KLASSICA DESBOIS** - Needed her only run of the year when 7th in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 8 May. Fitter now and is capable of an upset

**16. KAROLENE D'ETANG** - Disappointing form of late and was 11th in Class E at Le Mans over 2950m on 8 May. Barefoot this time and capable of making the frame

**17. KIMMERIDGIENNE** - Bounced back to form with a good runner-up performances in Class D over this track and trip on 22 April. Can contest the finish

**18. KAPELLA VET** - Very consistent and was runner-up last time out in Class D at Pontchâteau over 2800m on 16 April. Can go one better this time

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**Summary:** KAPELLA VET (18) arrives in fine form for this competitive race and gets the vote to score. KIMMERIDGIENNE (17) hasn't been as reliable as her rival but does have Eric Raffin in the sulky, which is a major plus. KAROLENE D'ETANG (16) has been disappointing of late, but she is barefoot this time, so a much better performance is expected. KATOUCHEKA (7) has improved recently and is capable of a strong finish and she could go one better this time.

## C4 - PRIX LOUIS SAUVE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Gr3 Race - Mounted - EUR € 90,000

**1. JEZABELLE BIE** - Has struggled in both her starts this year and was 13th last time out in a Class D harness race at this track over 2100m on 2 May. Better this distance and can make the frame

**2. GOOD GIRL MARCEAUX** - Disqualified last time out at Rambouillet over 2800m on 11 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win this race

**3. KALIF LANDIA** - Unreliable this year and was 9th in a Group 2 harness race at this course over 2850m on 3 May. Better under the saddle and can contest the finish

**4. GRINDELWALD** - Has only been modest of late and was 7th in Class A at this track over 2850m on 18 April. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**5. IMPALA DE VAL** - Remains in very good form and was victorious last time out in a Group 2 Mounted race over this course and distance on 18 April. Can complete the hat-trick

**6. HALFA** - In good form and was third in a Group 2 Mounted race over this course and distance on 18 April. Be right there at the finish

**7. EXTREME DESBOIS** - In good shape and was a winner last time out in a Group 3 Mounted race at this track over 2850m on 3 May. Can double up

**8. FIRE CRACKER** - Very consistent and was victorious last time out at Avenches over 2400m on 25 April. Tougher task this time around

**9. FILWELL** - Not disgraced when 5th in a Group 2 Mounted race over this course and distance on 18 April. Capable of better and has a winning chance

**Summary:** IMPALA DE VAL (5) has been in very good form of late and can follow up on recent Group 2 success. He is highly effective over this course and distance. FILWELL (9) wasn't far behind that rival last time out and should be a threat this time. KALIF LANDIA (3) will do better back under the saddle and is capable of contesting the finish. EXTREME DESBOIS (7) is consistent for his age and cannot be ruled out.

## C5 - PRIX ILMATHAR - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class C Race - Mounted - EUR € 46,000

1. **LIBERTY DELO** - Unreliable but did run well when runner-up in a Class D Mounted race over this track and trip o 2 May. Has a place chance
2. **LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE** - Battling to find best form and was 9th in a Class D harness race at Enghein over 2150m on 19 April. Others are preferred
3. **LUCIA PERRINE** - Unreliable but was a barefoot winner in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 13 May. Could make the frame
4. **LIMA MARY** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 13 May. Did better in her penultimate start but needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
5. **LOVE'S SECRET** - Only modest form of late and was 6th in Class C at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 4 May. Others make more appeal
6. **LOUVE ANGEL** - Only modest of late and was 5th in a Class c Mounted race over this course and distance on 22 April. More is needed to win this race
7. **LA SEGNORA PIYA** - Disqualified in her last four starts, with the latets being at Caen on 10 May. Probably best watched for now
8. **LITTLELOU MATIDY** - Has disqualification issues and faulted last time out at Caen on 10 April. Quite capable of contesting the finish when wise
9. **LOVE D'AUTHISE** - In good shape and was runner-up in a Class D Mounted race over this track and trip on 6 May. Might play a minor role
10. **LUTECIA ELLIS** - Disqualified last time out at Caen on 10 April. Unreliable but is capable of a winning if finding her best form
11. **LAKANA DE FELLIERE** - At the top of her game and was victorious last time out in a Class D Mounted race over this course and distance on 2 May. Can complete the hat-trick
12. **LASKA DU LEVANT** - Very consistent this year and was runner-up in a Class C Mounted race over this course and distance on 22 April. Should fight out the finish again
13. **LABEL DE TILLARD** - May have needed his only run of the year when 7th in a Class C Mounted race at Vincennes over this track and trip on 22 April. Hard to trust and others are preferred
14. **LEONCE DU CLOS** - Has only been modest this year and was 7th in a Group 3 Mounted race over this course and distance on 1 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
15. **LOLA DAIRPET** - Has struggled all year and was 6th last time out in a Group2 Mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 10 May. Others are preferred
16. **LOLO DU VELO** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 22 April. Not easy to trust but can bounce back to win over this track and trip

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**Summary:** LAKANA DE FELLIERE (11) has made excellent progress this year. She has won her last two starts impressively and can complete the hat-trick. LOLO DU VELO (16) fluffed his lines with a disqualification last time but has won four of his six starts and is a quality performer when behaving. LASKA DU LEVANT (12) is very consistent and should be right there in the mix again. LUTECIA ELLIS (10) is not reliable but could still make the frame.

## C6 - PRIX MARCEL PERLBARG - 2700m (a1m1/2) - Class A Race - Harness - EUR € 62,000

1. **TULIPE OASIS** - Finished fourth last time out at Mons over 2275m on 13 May. Has a tough task to beat these rivals this time
2. **GINEAH DANCE** - Has been very consistent in Italy and was 5th last time out at Turin over 1600m on 20 April. More is needed to win this race
3. **GESTODAMORE ROSA** - Very consistent in Italy and was third at Milan over 1600m on 25 April. Might play a minor role at very best
4. **MYRENA** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 22 March. Vry consistent form in Italy before that but others are preferred
5. **MIDNIGHT MOLLY** - Has struggled of late and was 6th in Class A over this course and distance on 2 May. Others make much more appeal
6. **MAGGY JENILOU** - Very hard to trust and was tenth in a Group 2 over this track and trip on 9 May. Needs major improvement to win
7. **MYSTERY QUEEN** - Has some good form and was fourth in Class A over this course and distance on 2 May. Be right there at the finish once again
8. **MIRATISSIME** - Finished 7th in a Group 2 Mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 10 May. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred
9. **MORNING NEWS** - Has some fair form and finished 5th last time out in Class A over this track and trip on 2 May. Can fight out the finish again
10. **MOSTRA DE BANVILLE** - Has disqualification issues but was third in Class A over this track and trip on 2 May. Has a winning chance
11. **MANHATTAN RAIN** - Unreliable but was victorious in Class B at Caen over 2200m on 10 May. Better over a shorter distance but could earn some money
12. **MADNESS** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 5 January. Returns from a break but is capable of an upset
13. **MOSAIC LIFE** - Has yet to win a race but was fourth in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 22 March. Not out of it in this line-up
14. **MIRISS DE GUEZ** - Disqualified last time out at this track on 9 May. Better over the shorter distances but can get involved with the finish

**Summary:** MOSTRA DE BANVILLE (10) has shown mixed form this year but has done enough to earn the vote to win. MIRISS DE GUEZ (14) has disqualification issues but is talented when behaving and is capable of winning. MORNING NEWS (9) is more reliable than those two rivals but has yet to get off the mark. MYSTERY QUEEN (7) continues to be competitive in her races and is another possible winner.

## C7 - PRIX IDA - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Class D Race - Mounted - EUR € 40,000

- 1. MYRIADE** - Disqualified on her debut in a Mounted race at this track on 15 April. Capable of improvement but others are preferred
- 2. MAFIA** - Has not shown much so far and was 6th in a Class F harness race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 12 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- 3. MADONA DU CLOS** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class E Mounted race at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2200m on 11 May. Could play a minor role
- 4. MATINA D'ORLY** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class G harness race at Abbeville over 2350m on 11 May. Needs to do more back under the saddle
- 5. MARGATE** - Disqualified in her last three starts, with the latest being at Cherbourg over 2625m on 1 November. Could need this run returning from a break
- 6. MARCIE DE L'AUNAY** - Showed some improvement when third in a Class E Mounted race at Maure-de-Bretagne over 2250m on 11 May. Can contest the finish
- 7. MARIT MARIANNE** - Showed some improvement when 5th in a Class F Mounted race at Le Croisé-Laroche over 2825m on 14 April. Could play a minor role
- 8. MADINA MESLOISE** - Has struggled of late and was disqualified last time out at Rambouillet on 11 May. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- 9. MAJESTUEUSE** - Unreliable and finished 8th in a E harness race at Chartres over 2800m on 7 May. Capable of improvement trying a mounted race
- 10. MAJUSCULE** - Yet to win a race but was not disgraced when 5th in Class C at this track over 2700m on 13 May. Has a winning chance
- 11. MY AMERICA** - Has only been modest of late and was 6th in a Class D harness race at La Capelle over 2750m on 4 May. Has some ability and could score trying a mounted race
- 12. MUNHOA VEDAQUAISE** - Showed vast improvement when runner-up in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2700m on 2 May. Should go one better this time

**Summary:** A modest-looking field. MUNHOA VEDAQUAISE (12) showed good improvement when finishing second last time out and looks the likely winner of this event. MARCIE DE L'AUNAY (6) also showed progress last time and should have more to offer. MAJUSCULE (10) has yet to win a race and comes with disqualification issues, but she is not without a chance. MY AMERICA (11) has been disappointing since her debut win but could still make the frame.

## C8 - PRIX GEORGES COURTOIS - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class F Amateur Drivers Race - Harness - EUR € 12,000

**1. ICONE PLANCHETTE** - Very unreliable and was 7th in Class G at this track over 2850m on 22 April. A winner of her penultimate start and could earn some money

**2. FINGALO** - Very consistent all year and was runner-up last time out at Mons over 2840m on 29 April. Can get involved with the finish once again

**3. JOB DU PERSIL** - Unreliable and was 7th in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 16 April. Could play a minor role when in the right mood

**4. HELSINKI GIRL** - Disqualified in her last two starts, with the latest being at Vire 20 April. Battling to find her best form and others are preferred

**5. JISMIE GRIFF** - Not disgraced when 5th in Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 27 April. In very good shape before that and has a winning chance

**6. JASMIN DU NORD** - Has improved of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class F at Reims over 2550m on 16 April. Has a winning chance

**7. JACKMAN** - Has only been fair this year and was 5th last time out in Class D at Rambouillet over 2800m on 11 May. Can contest the finish

**8. ECLAIR DU GOSIER** - Finished 13th in Class G at Rambouillet over 2800m on 15 September. Likely to need this run returning from a break

**9. FRONSAC DE BOMO** - Very unreliable and was tenth in Class F over this track and trip on 29 April. Needs to find a few lengths to win

**10. HEAVEN D'ECAJEUL** - Unreliable but was victorious last time out in Class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 8 May. Just as good this distance and has a place chance

**11. HARRY D'OURVILLE** - Disqualified at this track on 13 May. Good win in his penultimate start and is clearly not out of it in this line-up

**12. HATALANTE DE FLO** - Only modest form again this year and was 6th in Class F at La Capelle over 1800m on 8 May. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**Summary:** A very tricky "lucky last" race. JASMIN DU NORD (6) has improved recently and could win at this level. JACKMAN (7) is not reliable but ran well at Rambouillet and would not be a surprise winner. FINGALO (2) has been very good at Mons and was a winner the last time he ran in France, so he must be respected. HARRY D'OURVILLE (11) faulted last time out but is also quite capable of winning this particular race.
