- **1. LEANE DU PARC -** Produced her career-best performance when 3rd of 10 finishers, at 97/1, in a 2050m Cabourg Class E earlier this month but confirmation will have to wait
- **2. LUCIA DI JENILAT -** 4th of 10 finishers, a place behind LOVELY DU VALLON (3), in a 2875m Meslay-du-Maine Class F on 16 May but a repeat seems most improbable
- **3. LOVELY DU VALLON -** In the frame in first 2, including over 2200m on debut here, before faulting in a 2275m Nantes Class E earlier this month but can play a leading role if she stays focused
- **4. LIZA D'HERIPRE -** Showed little in last year's qualification but made no bones about winning a 2725m Lisieux Class F on debut late last month and although unlikely to repeat can still finish in first 3
- **5. L'ETOILE DE ROCHE -** Has started to come good over recent months, latterly 3rd of 8 finishers in a 2900m Bourigny Class G earlier in the month and in this company, will have little to offer
- **6. LOU D'ECROVILLE -** Not totally devoid of talent but drops back in class after coming last but one in a 2925m Cagnes Class A in early-March. Is sure to need the run though and best to wait
- **7. LEGENDE DU BOULAY -** Last of 7 in a 2700m Vincennes Class D mid-May. Has other priorities and can be passed over
- **8. LUNE D'OPALE -** Enjoying a renaissance since starting to race with pads. Surprise 3rd of 13 in a 2550m Reims Class E a month ago but faces a tall order on this occasion
- **9. LADY MORNING STAR -** Has shown decent aptitude so far, latterly winning a 2200m Vitré Class G on 2 June. Has references on a hard surface but, in this company, is not an obvious choice
- **10. LA BELLE MIKA -** Never at her ease when last of 10 in a 2050m Cabourg Class E on 1 June. Should appreciate Caen conditions but must first re-establish her credentials
- **11. LINA DU RIB -** Got off the mark at Laval in good order mid-May, winning a 2850m Class F. Will have come on for the run and is not incapable of confirming

- **14. LUNE DU DOUET -** Has not been seen out since tenaciously winning a 2725m Lisieux Class F 3 months ago. Fitted with 4 pads again though, has been entrusted to David Thomain, and will be afforded every chance

- **2. KOPS GEDE -** Sanctioned in 10 of 12, most recently a 2850m Laval Class E, and has no possible chance
- **3. KENAVO CHANTEREINE -** 2nd of 14 in a 2400m Amiens Class F a week ago but, in this company, will need to be at his best
- **4. KRACK CLEA -** Takes first public steps in the discipline after trotting 5th of 15 in a harness Class F over 2200m here 10 days ago and looks the sort that could pleasantly surprise
- **5. KANOIS DE LATOUR -** Impressive in 3 starts in April before coming last of 7 finishers behind KALIN DU TRESOR (8) in a 2875m Argentan Class E late last month and will need to find more this time around
- **6. KABOTIN CHENEVIERE -** Good 2nd in a Class F over course and distance late-April, first time under the saddle, latterly 6th of 13 in a similar event under harness 3 weeks ago, and with form maintained, will be no easy touch
- **7. KARMA JIEL -** Showed improvement when 3rd of 6 finishers in a 2325m Toulouse Class E 3 weeks ago. Pleased on lone appearance here but others still easier to back

- **3. KOUREION D'ELA -** Solid as a rock this season, latterly winning a 2725m Lisieux Class F on 26 May. Breaks from the 3-spot and looks a leading contender
- **4. KARABOUDJAN -** Versatile type that came in 3rd of 14 in a 2400m Amiens Class F a week ago and, perfectly-positioned in front, can make first 5
- **5. KING TURGOT -** Raced better than his 7th of 12 finishers in a 2850m Laval Class E last week would suggest. Is plainly in fine form and racing barefoot can make all the difference
- **6. KANTOUTSTART -** Made up for his early-May performance when 2nd of 10 in a 2875m Argentan Class E on 26 May. David Thomain stays faithful and is not incapable of getting that maiden monkey off his back
- **7. KARMA KILY -** Returns to the harness code after coming 6th of 8 in a 2850m Laval monté Class E a weeks ago. Trainer in the wagon this time but others still preferred
- **8. KOLMI DES EPINES -** Below-par in last 3 outings, most recently last of 12 in a 2700m Vire Class E 8 days ago, and is not about to influence the outcome

- **4. JETHAN DE MONGOCHY -** Disappointing on monté debut but reassured under harness when 2nd of 12 in a 2900m Arras Class F on 9 June. Sports a new configuration and can get in on the action if form transitions.

- **2. JUDY TURGOT -** Last but one in a 2750m Ecommoy Class E on 18 May. Has been out of sorts since last year and can be passed over
- **3. JEANNE D'AUTHISE -** Moderate 5th of 7 finishers in a 2400m Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne 11 days ago. Has a plum spot behind the car but nonetheless faces a stiff test
- **4. JENKA DE MORMOULIN -** Has hardly stepped a foot out of place this term, most recently 3rd of 14 in a 2400m Amiens Class E last week, and the draw will do her place prospects no disservice

- **2. JAGUAR D'OBRET -** Has 2 races under his belt, latterly 4th of 11 in a 2875m Enghien harness Class D on 25 May. is clearly in form but makes his monté debut in superior company and is unlikely to influence the result
- **3. JUDY BLUE EYES -** Last of 9 behind JAVA WIC (8) in 28 May race of reference. Disappointing on the whole for some time and can be ruled out

- **12. HERMINE DE RHEVE -** Seldom gets her nose in front but gave a fine account of herself when 3rd of 12 in a 2550m Reims Class D on 2 June, and makes her Caen debut with justified ambition
- **13. FILLE DE L'OUEST -** Lost her action in a 2675m Erbray Class F on 9 June. Totally out of the picture this year and needs to reaffirm
- **14. GALANTE DE TILLARD -** In the thick of things for the most part this season, latterly 3rd of 13 in a 2550m Reims Class F on 2 June. Is reunited with Franck Nivard and is not going to be far off the mark
- **15. FELINE DE JANVILLE -** Unplaced in last 2 here, most recently 11th of 16 in a similar event 10 days ago. Is better than the result would suggest and, barefoot for the occasion, can pick up some prizemoney
- **16. HEROINE DES LANDES -** 7th of 15 in a 3000m Nantes Class F a fortnight ago. Defied her odds that day but is not about to repeat

Summary: Very hard to knock when barefoot and focused, GIGI DES NEUF CLOS (10) was back in the winners' circle at Pontchâteau recently and, confirmed at Caen, may well prove the horse to beat. She will nevertheless encounter resistance from HANIKA DU LUPIN (9) who is significantly better than latest results would imply, and HERMINE DE RHEVE (12) who put on a good show at Reims earlier in the month. HEROINE DE GUERRE (4) beat the favourite at Reims last month and is not one to be underestimated.
