- **1. BREIZH SKY -** Excellent last run over 1400m at this course on the 26th of May in a Group 3. Should go close to winning. Respect
- **2. MOUNT ATHOS -** Finished 3rd over 1400m in a Group 3 at Parislongchamp on the 26th of May and can place again. Place chance
- **3. KING GOLD -** Raced in Dubai over 1200m in a Group 1 on the 30th of March finishing 8th. Strong each way chance
- **4. SADALBARI -** Finished 3rd in a Handicap last time and will be completely outgunned here. An outsider that has it all to do
- 5. EXXTRA Won a Group 3 over 1400m on the 26th of May at this very course and can follow up. Good chance
- **6. KIMI ORENDA -** Ran 5th over 1200m at Saint-Cloud on the 25th of last month and can get a little bit closer. Include in the guartet

**Summary:** KING GOLD (3) has been competing in Group races for a while and has not been disgraced. A huge effort can be expected from him. His last run was in Dubai in March. KELINA (8) was a Group 1 winner at her penultimate start and can go close. Strong each way claims. EXXTRA (5) boasts a recent Group 3 victory at this track and can follow up. Include in everything. BREIZH SKY (1) has solid form and a very strong place chance.

- **1. MY FLINDERS -** Placed 4th over 1850m in Handicap class at this track last time out and is a must for all bets. Quartet definite
- **2. DAYSANIYA -** Placed 2nd three starts back but has been dismal since. An outsider that is hard to fancy. Pass by
- **3. RED NUDE ROUGE -** A tad erratic but on best form is a big runner. Placed 4th over 1350m last time. Strong each way chance
- **4. JIEPIES MELODY -** She is running huge races, finished 2nd over 1600m in a Handicap at Compiegne on the 24th of May and rates tough to beat. Win
- **5. ELZADA** Has absolutely no form to speak about and can be passed by, Finished 11th last time at Saint-Cloud. No

RED NUDE ROUGE (3) is a tad erratic but has solid form and on very best efforts, can threaten all the way home. Big chance. RUBIS GOLD (17) won a cozy race at Chantilly last time and it would be absolutely no shock any all, if he were to follow up. MY FLINDERS (1) finished 4th last time and can confirm that. She is a must for the majority of your bets.

- **1. VILLA CASTELLO -** Improving, finished 4th over 1800m at Compiegne late last month and has to be taken seriously. Strong place
- **2. NEVERSLAND -** Fair debut finishing 6th over 1800m at this track on the 15th of October last year. Will probably need this run. Prefer others
- **3. SPEEDY GONZALEZ -** Can improve on debut when 10th over 2100m at Chantilly in April, but will need to. Place claims
- **4. AMARENA DODVILLE -** Finished 6th on debut at Compiegne over 1600m and will need to produce more to feature. Happy to ignore for now
- **5. MARINELLA -** Never shone in a claiming race last time and would be a shock winner. Impossible to fancy against these

- **1. PEANUT ROYALE -** Current form has been on the decline and completely unimpressive. She is hard to fancy and would be a shock winner
- **2. PEARL HARBOUR -** Placed 4th at Compiegne over 1800m earlier this month and can place again. Respect and include
- **3. MALLORCA SUN -** Only managed 5th over 1400m last time in a weak claiming race. Much more needed here and can be ignored
- **4. BOW LANE -** He is taking time for his next win, finished 5th over 1400m in a Handicap last time and needs to do plenty more for the win
- **5. KHABESA -** Never too far adrift the action but does have a few lengths to find to make the frame. Pass by
- **6. HERODION -** Current form leaves a lot to be desired as has been on the decline over various distances. No
- **7. MINOTAUROS** Has won his last two impressively and has an undeniable chance of reeling off the hat trick. Can win
- **8. KICK BOXING -** Attractive effort finishing 2nd over 1600m in a Handicap here at this track and can go one more. Serious chance

# C5 - PRIX PERPLEXITE - 2200m (a1m1/2) - TURF - Divided Handicap - Flat - EUR € 28,000

- **1. ASTROLOGER -** Rewarded for his consistency with a last-start maiden success over 2400m at Wissembourg on 8 June. Could have more to offer sent handicapping
- **2. PROBABLY ME -** Has already established himself in the handicaps and has sound form references/credentials at this level, including a last-start 4th in a 2100m handicap at this venue on 23 May. Will be a factor
- **3. MON FLAMANT -** Caught the eye, despite an unfavourable trip, when 3rd on handicap debut over 2100m at this venue on 23 May. Winning chance
- **4. HONEY BADGER -** Consistent performer in conditions races on both surfaces not beaten far in each of his 4 starts (2 on PSF). Didn't go unnoticed when 6th over 2300m at Angers on 4 May
- **5. RUE CUSTINE -** Last-start winner of a 2100m claimer at Saint-Cloud on 10 May. Reverts to the handicaps under a 1,5kg penalty
- **6. VERA -** Improving last-start winner over 2200m at Dieppe on 29 May. Open to further progress on handicap debut
- **7. CHESS -** Consistent colt with sufficient means to make his presence felt on handicap debut, having finished 4th in each of his 3 starts the latest over 2400m in a conditions race at Saint-Cloud on 14 May
- **8. INTUITION -** Not beaten far in 3 claimers recently, the latest (5th) over 2000m at this venue on 6 June. Dark horse
- **9. VILLA DES ARTS -** Returned to form with an encouraging 2nd over 2400m in a conditions race at Saint-Cloud on 14 May. Not taken lightly on her handicap debut
- **10. CHESTER SKY -** Consistent Adrien Fouassier-trained gelding with sound references in handicaps on both surfaces. Didn't go unnoticed when 7th in a 1600m handicap at this venue on 26 May

- **2. STRASSIA -** Promising and unexposed filly open to further progress. Acquitted herself well (4th) in a 2400m Group III at Chantilly on 2 June finished behind MOSAIQUE (8) that day
- **3. LAVENDER LACE -** Exciting prospect whose chances at this level shouldn't be underestimated, with improvement likely after a winning debut over 2000m at this venue on 26 May. Keep safe
- **4. LE COMBAT CONTINUE -** Improving sort who has appreciated racing beyond 2000m, winning back-to-back 2200m races at (latest on 18 May) at Lyon-Parilly. Dark horse
- **5. WHERE I WANNA BE -** Finished a well-held 3rd in a recent (25 May) Listed race over 2000m at Goodwood on her reappearance. Ought to have improved with the benefit of that comeback outing
- **6. CHASUBLE -** Revealed considerable means in 3 starts on PSF and showed her versatility/effective on turf when finishing 3rd in a 2200m Class 2 conditions race at Nantes on 30 May has more to do
- **7. OUR GOLDEN ONE -** Finished 5th (of 5) in a 2000m Listed race at Newbury on 18 May. Wasn't beaten far that day but will have to improve to make her presence felt
- **8. MOSAIQUE -** Progressive filly. Confirmed the promise/improvement of her maiden win by finishing 3rd in a Group III at Chantilly over 2400m on 2 June. Winning chance

**Summary:** MOSAIQUE (8) confirmed the form and improvement of her Saint-Cloud success last month by following up with a good 3rd in a Group III race at Chantilly last time. She finished ahead of STRASSIA (2) on that occasion and is worth siding with here at the expense of that rival. Well-bred LAVENDER LACE (3) is an interesting runner open to any amount of improvement after a debut win over 2000m at this venue. - **1. DSCHINGIS DREAM -** Lightly raced colt with undeniable means boasts sound references/form credentials, including a last-start 3rd in a competitive conditions race over 2350m at Angers on 29 May. Not taken lightly on handicap debut
- **2. BENIMARU -** Has improved with each outing and confirmed as much with a last-start win over at 1950m Châteaubriant on 12 May. Makes his handicap/Quinte+ debut off a relatively high opening mark but has to be respected
- **3. MEAUTIS -** Consistent colt with sound references/form credentials, albeit without winning. Caught the eye when 5th on handicap/Quinte+ debut before showing his form/well-being with a good 3rd over 1950m at this venue on 30 May dark horse
- **4. MISSION ALPHA -** Improving last-start winner at this venue over 2000m on 9 May. Pitched into a handicap/Quinte for the first time off a relatively high opening mark but is dangerous to discount
- **5. SPINELLO -** Improving, unexposed colt with undeniable ability finished 2nd in consecutive conditions races over 2400m at Saint-Cloud, the latest on 14 May. Not taken lightly on his handicap/Quinte+ debut
- **6. DAY TRADER -** Has won twice in the handicaps, the latest at Evreux over 2500m in April, but appeared to struggle under a 4kg penalty when only 5th over 2700m in a handicap at this venue on 23 May. For another day
- **7. VAZIRHAN -** Opened his account on handicap debut over 2400m at Lyon-Parilly and confirmed that form/improvement (under a 4kg penalty) by finishing 5th in his first Quinte+appearance over 2100m at this venue on 23 May
- **8. KING TREZY -** Consistent colt with solid form references/credentials, albeit without a victory. Finished an eye-catching 3rd in his first handicap/Quinte+ start over 2100m, behind STAR OF THE NIGHT (9), at this venue on 23 May
- **9. STAR OF THE NIGHT -** Won back-to-back 2000m races, the latest a handicap at Saint-Cloud, before finishing a close-up 2nd in her Quinté+ debut over 2100m at this venue on 23 May. Candidate for success
- **10. MEHLANGO -** Belatedly opened his account by winning a 2100m handicap at this venue on 23 May and a resultant 2,5kg penalty is unlikely to halt his momentum. Keep safe
- **11. TILILA -** Consistent filly with sound references on PSF, including a Quinte+ 2nd over 1900m at Chantilly in March. Could only finish 8th in her first start on turf in a Quinte+ handicap at Chantilly on 29 April for another day
- **12. AL HABISSET -** Won back-to-back 2400m races on PSF, including her handicap debut at Lyon-La Soie in April. Made little impression when only 8th in a 2100m handicap (her first start on turf) at this venue on 23 May outsider
- **13. MIA MAN -** Finished an encouraging 3rd on his handicap debut at Chantilly (on heavy ground over 2400m) last month but was soundly beaten (8th) over 2700m in his first appearance at this venue on 23 May. Others preferred

- **14. AGORIA -** Revealed considerable means in 3 starts on the PSF but has looked less effective on turf unplaced in both outings in Quinte+ handicaps, the latest (14th) over 2100m at this venue on 23 May. Best watched for now
- **15. GOOSEBUMPY -** Showed promise in 3 starts as a two-year-old but has disappointed this term unplaced in both comeback appearances, the latest (6th) in a 1950m conditions race at this venue on 30 May. Makes handicap debut
- **16. ZARAKIVA -** Unexposed filly who runs well under Sophie Chuette. Best watched for now, though, having finished 5th in consecutive 2400m conditions races at Saint-Cloud, the latest on 14 May

**Summary:** STAR OF THE NIGHT (9) confirmed the form of her handicap victory at Saint-Cloud by only narrowly failing to follow up in her first Quinté+ appearance over 2100m at this venue last month, proving her competitiveness at this level off her current mark. She need only repeat that performance to fight for victory with VAZIRHAN (7), who renews rivalry after an encouraging Quinté debut (5th) in the same race. MEHLANGO (10) opened his account in a 2100m handicap at this venue last time and a resultant 2,5kg penalty is unlikely to halt his momentum. DSCHINGIS DREAM (1), KING TREZY (8), who is closely matched on the form of a recent meeting with the selection, and improving last-start winner BENIMARU (2) are other candidates for a podium berth.

- **2. GAIDAR -** Consistent for the most part and has references on both surfaces, although probably most effective on PSF (both wins on the all-weather). Finished a well-beaten 10th in a 2400m Quinte+ at Chantilly on 4 April
- **3. JAHIDIN -** Finished 2nd in a 1500m PSF claimer in his first start on French soil but has disappointed in 3 subsequent outings the latest (7th) in a 1400m claimer at this venue on 16 May. For another day
- **4. CENTRAL PARK WEST -** Unplaced in consecutive Quinté+ handicaps recently but wasn't beaten far in either, the latest (9th) over 2000m at Marseille-Borely on 27 May. Not taken lightly
- **5. SPEECHMAN -** Consistent, lightly raced and versatile performer with solid form references/credentials on both surfaces, including a last-start Quinté success on PSF over 1900m at Deauville on 9 April. Sets the standard
- **6. ALZIR -** Unplaced in each of his 3 starts, twice last year and, most recently (9th), on his reappearance at Berlin over 2000m on 28 April. Others preferred
- **7. WUKHANN -** Consistent stayer with sound references/form credentials, including a last-start victory at Marseille-Borély over 2600m on 7 June. Keep safe

**Summary:** Versatile SPEECHMAN (5) is equally adept on turf as he is on PSF and is good value to build on his last-start Quinte+ victory on PSF with another success in his first start at this level, despite a 3kg penalty. CENTRAL PARK WEST (4) has finished unplaced in back-to-back Quinte+ races on turf recently but wasn't beaten far in either and remains capable of playing a leading role, with top-rated/top-weighted veteran MONTY (1) also likely to make life difficult for the selection after an encouraging comeback at Compiègne. Consistent last-start scorer WUKHANN (7) completes the shortlist.

- **1. LOUVE PRECIEUSE -** Has won under Maxime Guyon, with whom she is reunited after an encouraging last-start 2nd over 1350m at Wissembourg on 8 June. Keep safe
- **2. GRACEHILL -** Returned to form with a reassuring 3rd over 1350m at Wissembourg on 8 June. Can get a look in with a repeat of that performance
- **3. CHICAGO** Seldom far off the mark since switching to handicaps but needs to spark improvement to be competitive, having finished 7th over 1400m at Compiegne on 12 June
- **4. SALSA CHIC -** Soundly beaten in back-to-back recent handicaps, the latest (11th) over 1300m at Argentan on 5 June. Outsider
- **5. BELCHA -** Capable veteran with references in handicaps off a higher rating seldom far off the mark. Reverts to this category after finishing a well-beaten 12th over 1800m at Nort-sur-Erdre on 2 June
- **6. ALPENGEIST -** Last-start winner of a 1600m handicap at Compiègne on 24 May. Ought to remain competitive under a 3kg penalty
- **7. URAL -** Soundly beaten in back-to-back recent handicaps, the latest (14th) over 1600m at Nantes on 30 June. Others preferred

- **10. SPEED CHOP** Out of sorts and unlikely to trouble the judge after finishing 5th in a minor conditions race over 1600m at Châtillon-sur-Chalaronne on 10 June
- **11. DOS DE MAYO -** Seldom far off the mark but has proven hard to win with (just 1 victory from 30 starts). Back in a handicap after finishing 5th over 1350m in a conditions race at Wissembourg on 8 June
- **12. MANA SIS -** Capitalised on a drop in the weights/ratings to finish 4th in a 1500m handicap at Tarbes on 5 June. Chance if confirming
- **13. ASPHODELE MIA -** Hard-knocking handicapper with sound references in handicaps, including a respectable last-start 6th over 1800m at Compiegne on 7 June. Dark horse
- **14. GARDOL MOON -** Inconsistent mare but isn't incapable of getting into the picture if bouncing back to the form of her 4th in an 1800m handicap at Le Croise-Laroche on 4 April
- **15. AL RASSOUL -** Unreliable veteran with references in handicaps off a higher rating seldom far off the mark. Reverts to this category after finishing a well-beaten 9th in a 1600m PSF handicap at Chantilly on 17 May
- **16. ENJOY THE SILENCE -** Has won on turf and is good in form/physical condition, which he confirmed with a creditable 6th in a PSF handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 11 May. Not taken lightly

- **17. MEARAS STYLE -** Close-up in her last 3 starts, all in handicaps the latest (3rd) over 1600m at Compiegne on 24 May. Will be a factor
- **18. GOFAST -** Soundly beaten (16th) in a handicap over 1800m at Compiegne on 7 June. Hard to make a case for

**Summary:** Veteran ALPENGEIST (6) rediscovered his form and consistency dropped in the weights/ratings and wasn't winning out of turn last time at Compiegne. On the evidence of that victory, a 3kg penalty may not be enough to prevent him from winning again. He will, however, have to thwart the likely challenge of consistent veteran mare MEARAS STYLE (17) who should pose a threat in receipt of 3,5kg. Top-weight LOUVE PRECIEUSE (1) is reunited with Maxime Guyon, under whom she has won, and ought to make her presence felt too. MANA SIS (12) and BLACK PANTHER (8) appeal most of the remainder.
