- **1. MILLEMIA IMPERIALE -** In good form and was third in Class F at this course over 2750m on 31 May. Has a place chance in this line-up
- **2. MAHINA DE WALLIS -** Winner in Class F at La Rochay -Posay over 2600m on 1 June. Showed what she is capable of that day and is not out of it
- **3. MANGALYA -** Has disqualification issues but was runner-up in Class F at Bernay over 2800m on 1 June. May be better on the grass
- **4. MISS STORY -** Finished 5th in Class D at Nancy over 2600m on 30 May. Won on debut before that but may prefer a shorter distance
- **5. MAESTRIA DE YEDRAG -** Disqualified at Chartres on 1 June. Has been disqualified twice in just four start but did also win her penultimate start so could surprise
- **6. MAJESTE DU MENIL -** Disqualified At Reims on 9 June. Has run well at this track before and is capable of contesting the finish
