

R2 AGEN LA GARENNE [R-H]

C1 - PRIX ISIDORE BERGUA - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class G Amateur Drivers - Harness - EUR € 6,000

1. **ILLUSTRE JULRY** - Has not won for some time but gave a particularly good account at Vichy 10 days ago and must not be underestimated
2. **IDEE FIXE BREIZH** - Is confirmed at the venue but has looked decidedly ordinary this term and is unlikely to create an upset
3. **ILDO DES CHAMPS** - Has form in the amateur category but has struggled to make any impact this year and can be passed over
4. **IMPEC DE BERTRANGE** - Back to the amateur division after a pair of maintenance runs in the professional ranks. Has nothing to prove under these conditions and from the 4 slot will be no pushover
5. **IEUSSEC EXPRESS** - Ran 5th of 16 on his return to the category at Beaumont-de-Lomagne a month back. Has been reconfigured for his return to Agen and from the 5 slot can give this a good go
6. **JASMIN DE COEUR** - Sprang something of a surprise when 5th in a Langon Class F 8 days ago. Has no Agen references but breaks in front and even sporting shoes cannot be discounted
7. **GAPACHE DE HOUELLE** - Won under these conditions last November but has not been as sharp since, and even with shoes off will have few friends
8. **JEU ROYAL** - Presents excellent credentials in the amateur division and over track and trip. Is forced to start wide but is plainly at the top of his game and can bring the fight to JUNKY DE CHENU (15)
9. **IDYLLE DU DIGEON** - Unremarkable mare returning to the amateur division after being well-beaten at Issigeac last month and in this company will have nothing to offer
10. **HAMBRIN D'ARANAU** - Unplaced in 2 since winning over track and trip 3 months ago. Is reunited though with Adeline Haret who imposed with him that day and will have his supporters
11. **HIMALAYA DU FORT** - Has done nothing noteworthy since imposing at Toulouse last September and can be confidently disregarded
12. **JUNINIO FLEURY** - Returns to the provinces after running 6th in a Vincennes Class F 2.5 weeks ago. Simply excels at Agen and even with shoes fitted still looks dangerous
13. **ICARE DE BANVILLE** - Kicked the year off nicely but has since come off the boil and the draw will do him no favours
14. **INSTINCT DU RENARD** - Surprise 5th in a Langon Class G 8 days ago, however a repeat seems most improbable
15. **JUNKY DE CHENU** - Debuts in the amateur category following a pair of fresheners. The talented Cyril Baty reins and can win this if he successfully navigates the draw
16. **HARCADY** - Has been enjoying a good run of form in both amateur and professional ranks recently. Has previously won here but the draw will limit his chances

Summary: JUNKY DE CHENU (15) has a pair of races under his belt since returning from a lengthy break. He is new to the amateur division, and starts on the back line, but is a cut above most here and can impose. JEU ROYAL (8) is better-placed in front, however, and has already won twice under these conditions. ILLUSTRE JULRY (1) has been holding his own lately and is unlikely to be far from the action. IMPEC DE BERTRANGE (4) imposed over course and distance in April and is ideally-positioned behind the car.

C2 - PRIX DE MOIRAX - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class D - Harness - EUR € 23,000

- 1. NINO DU PLESSIS** - Got off the mark in Toulouse 2 months ago but has struggled since and must first get his house in order
- 2. NACRE DE MOUTIERS** - Quality future prospect that lost her maiden status at Meslay-du-Maine on 28 May. Should take well to Agen conditions and will have every chance of confirming
- 3. NAELIE DU GUESCLIN** - Has started to make good on her promise following a tricky start to her career. Inherited success at Langon but was eye-catching all the same and must be considered a player once more
- 4. NEPTUNE DE KACY** - Made up for Bordeaux blip when successful in a 2725m Class F in late-May. Faces a better lot this time but still looks a player
- 5. NOUBA BAROQUE** - Has done nothing but improve since her first steps on the track, latterly beating NAELIE DU GUESCLIN (3) to open her account at Grenade-sur-Garonne 3 weeks ago. Is proven racing clockwise and unlikely to let the side down
- 6. NUMBER ONE PIEMONT** - Has improved for every run this term, latterly runner-up in an Eauze Class E 2 weeks ago, but in this company is unlikely to set off any fireworks
- 7. NOBLESSE MIKA** - Has yet to lose her maiden tag but showed improvement at Niort a fortnight ago. Sports pads for the first time and although not a priority is still worth monitoring
- 8. NOSOTROS GABINLEA** - Sent for a short spell after opening his account at Beaumont-de-Lomagne in early-April. Was eliminated on return to competition but will have progressed for the race and despite the wide draw may still represent the main threat
- 9. NOVA D'ALOUETTE** - Has been raced sparingly since her October debut. Did not enjoy the best of success at Montauban last month and even though reconfigured looks no more than a minor place chance
- 10. NUWA DU PATURAL** - Won a Class F on debut here in February but has made little impact in 3 since. Starts on back row and can expect to have few takers
- 11. NOVA LOUDETTE**s - Steps up in category after beating NOVA LOUDETTE (11) to secure victory in an Issigeac Class G on 24 May. Is on the back line but is still very hard to ignore
- 12. NARCOS SMART** - Opened his account at Castelsarrasin, at 2nd time of asking, but his subsequent performance did little to inspire confidence
- 13. NIKITA DE LAPENCHE** - Unexceptional filly that could manage no closer than 6th to NOUBA BAROQUE (5) in a Class F at Grenade-sur-Garonne 3 weeks ago and can be confidently ruled out

Summary: Most impressive to date, NACRE DE MOUTIERS (2) showed great tenacity to open her account late last month, has been handed a good draw, and looks eminently capable of repeating. NOSOTROS GABINLEA (8) is not the easiest of horses to use but he got off the mark in good order, and with application can give her something to consider. Better-placed behind the car, and winner at Langon 8 days ago, NAELIE DU GUESCLIN (3) returns to racing right-handed and will have her chances if she turns. Facile winner at Grenade-sur-Garonne 3 weeks ago, NEPTUNE DE KACY (4) is well-placed on the front line and can again finish in the mix.

C3 - PRIX DE LAYRAC - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. **MADAGASCAR YAMM** - Started to show improvement at Angoulême on 18 May. Goes barefoot this time but would have better prospects at a lower level
2. **MILANO DE LIGNY** - Undeniably capable but can prove a handful. Returns to racing shod, enjoys a decent draw, and can play a part if Manuel Criado keeps him focused
3. **MOSPEL DU VERGER** - Winner here last autumn, and 5th in 2625m Derby des 4 Ans here on 30 May. Takes a dip in category and is in with a realistic shout of imposing this time
4. **MA FANTASY D'AMOUR** - Gave a good account of herself on comeback, finishing 7th behind MOSPEL DU VERGER (3) in Derby des 4 Ans here late last month. Has a lot going for her this time and should prove competitive at the business end of the race
5. **MENTEUSE PAN** - Made up for return elimination when 3rd in a Langon Class F 8 days ago. Has no handicap to incur this time and from the front row can make a big impact
6. **MAHORA D'OURVILLE** - Useful on a good day but was most disappointing in a Class E at Châtelailon-La Rochelle on 10 May. Comes here fresh, and starts in front, but others still preferred
7. **MAJOR DE LA NOE** - Has failed to deliver in 2 since winning at Monflanquin on 10 May. Has placed in 1 of 2 Agen starts but is still not an obvious choice
8. **MILORD DE LARRE** - Went into last season's break on a hat-trick. Will not be hard-pushed on his comeback and best to keep one's powder dry
9. **MANZONI** - Left a good impression on comeback late last month despite being eliminated. Is sure to have improved for the race and despite a 2nd row draw can still get in on the action
10. **MAGNUS FEELING** - Had been on a good run of form until failing to place in a Class F at Villeneuve-sur-Lot 2 weeks ago. Takes on a good bunch this time and from the back row is unlikely to spice things up
11. **MATRIX DE LA BAIE** - Did everything right on return from a spell when 5th in a Caen Class F 3 weeks ago. Entrusted to Frederic Clozier this time and even from the back line can play a prominent part
12. **MAD MAX DUEM** - Showed significant early promise but appears to have lost his way and the draw will do him no favours
13. **MILADY DU PADOUENG** - Produced a pair of good runs at Castillonès before faulting early in Derby des 4 Ans 3 weeks ago. Has been reconfigured for the occasion and will be reunited with Pierre Geray who has form with her
14. **MON FAVORI** - Looked to be coming good earlier in the spring but was eliminated in last 2 and others easier to trust
15. **MISTER JOHNS** - Won a Class F over longer here in April, and most recently ran 4th in Vichy, but has pulled a rough number and in this company will struggle to make his presence felt
16. **MATIS DU VIGNAC** - Showed marked improvement in a Villeneuve-sur-Lot Class F a fortnight ago but at this level has no possible chance

Summary: Fifth in the Derby des 4 Ans here three weeks ago, MOSPEL DU VERGER (3) sports a fresh configuration for the occasion and is ideally-placed to open his 2026 account. Third at Langon on her first objective of the season, MENTEUSE PAN (5) also benefits from a good draw and, with stride in check, can contest the finish. MATRIX DE LA BAIE (11) left a good impression on his recent re-entry and will have progressed for the race. MA FANTASY D'AMOUR (4) has pulled a good number and will have similarly come on for the run.

**C4 - PRIX DE LA JEUNE CHAMBRE ECONOMIQUE D'AGEN - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness -
EUR € 21,000**

- 1. KIRKENESSE** - Had been enjoying a productive run of form before being prepped at Toulouse earlier in the month. Sports a new configuration and will be no easy touch
- 2. KING OF PARADISE** - Ended 2025 on a low note and has picked up this season where he left off
- 3. KWINIE JIHAIME** - Gave a good account of herself at Toulouse recently, her first target of the year. Has a lot going for her here and must be considered a contender
- 4. KARL SPEED** - Made up for Royan clinker when successful on turf 2 weeks ago. Occupies a good spot on the front line and will be expected to go close once again
- 5. KARESSE D'EURVAD** - Produced something of a surprise when 4th in a Langon Class F 8 days ago, however a repeat seems most unlikely
- 6. KENZO A TROIS** - Pulled off the hat-trick on re-entry when dominating a Class E at Les Sables-d'Olonne on 2 June. Will have come on for the run and has every chance of repeating
- 7. KITALPHAR** - Got back in the game 10 days ago when 2nd in a Graignes claimer, however in this category will have nothing to contribute
- 8. KURLING ATOUT** - Returns to racing clockwise after some modest left-handed runs. Starts wide on front row but is not one to be overlooked
- 9. KATHY DU PERCHE** - Has held her own since returning to competition in April. Is not about to win this but can pick up a first-5 cheque
- 10. KOKI DE SPERETOUT** - Has shown noticeable improvement over recent months, latterly 4th in a Grenade-sur-Garonne Class D, but would have better prospects in the amateur division
- 11. KINGSTON DU GOSIER** - Previously a good sort, and has placed under these conditions, but has plainly lost his way and can be confidently disregarded
- 12. KOBALT** - Springs the occasional surprise but was trounced in his last 2. Shoes back on and no concern

Summary: Sent for his winter break after winning 2 on the trot, KENZO A TROIS (6) got straight back down to business at Les Sables-d'Olonne early this month and looks set to take all the beating. Manuel Criado will still be mindful of KARL SPEED (4) who imposed at Gémozac a fortnight back, and a freshly re-shod KIRKENESSE (1) who is considerably better than her Toulouse performance would suggest. KWINIE JIHAIME (3) ran 3rd on that occasion, has been handed a good draw, and makes her Agen bow with a realistic chance of finishing on the podium.

C5 - PRIX DU MEETING DE BIARRITZ - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 27,000

1. **MISTER DU CHOQUEL** - Ran 2nd to MARVELOUS SPORT (12) at Beaumont-de-Lomagne before imposing at Hyeres 3.5 weeks ago. Pleased on sole Agen start but in this category will need to find more
2. **MAGNUM DAIRPET** - Has not once finished out of first 4 in last 7 starts. Has won under these conditions and although unlikely to repeat, is still good enough to challenge for a place in the frame
3. **MIKADO PIEMONT** - Already twice a winner this year but was well-beaten in last 2 and will have few friends
4. **MORETIME DU CAMPUS** - Serious sort with nothing to prove at this level. Faces a less-elevated lot this time and from the 4 slot can make this his own
5. **MOODY DE VIVE** - Placed twice in April before running 5th in a Vincennes Class C a month ago. Is well-positioned on the front line and, winner of his only start here, must be considered a priority
6. **MAMJACK SACHA** - Not the easiest of horses to gauge but is no slouch when applied. Starts on front row and can get in on the action if Lilian Bertin keeps her trotting
7. **MILANTERA** - Has turned a corner over recent weeks, placing in both disciplines. Has yet to deliver racing clockwise but in present shape is easy to like for a first-5 payout
8. **MISTER ROYAL** - Has not won for the past year but has been giving a good account for past 2 months and will be well-backed to finish close
9. **MISTER JENILOU** - Won 2 on the trot, including over course and distance, but was eliminated at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 17 May. Is in decent shape though and despite the draw is still worth keeping an eye on
10. **MONTENEGRO** - Left a good impression when 4th in Derby des 4 Ans here 3 weeks ago. In this company though may struggle to make his mark
11. **MAC VENESI** - Has thrived for the most part this spring but disappointing in last 2. Stays shod for the occasion and others preferred
12. **MARVELOUS SPORT** - Surprise winner of a Class E at Beaumont-de-Lomagne on 17 May but failed to confirm a fortnight later and is taking on too much
13. **MARQUIS MARANDAIS** - Has not been seen out since running 3rd to MISTER JENILOU (9) in a Class D over course and distance 2 months ago, and will have little to contribute

Summary: A generous colt with solid right-handed references, MORETIME DU CAMPUS (4) may not have been seen out since running 2nd in a Vincennes Class C 3 months ago but he is plainly in race-mode and can wrap this up if he takes to the new conditions. Nicolas Bazire will nonetheless be keeping a watchful eye on MOODY DE VIVE (5) who has been knocking at the door. MISTER ROYAL (8) is close to his race and has the profile for Agen. Winner here in January, MAGNUM DAIRPET (2) has continued to give his best and is unlikely to be far off the mark.

C6 - PRIX DE SAINTE COLOMBE EN BRUILHOIS - 2625m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 24,000

- 1. LIANG DU PATURAL** - Sports a new configuration after losing his action at Issigeac on 24 May but is once again being aimed too high
- 2. LAIKA CARISAIE** - Handy mare that imposed last time here. Has just the one race in her since the winter break but is competitively-shod this time and can play a small role
- 3. LEGRAND BRILLOUARD** - Will be shod as he was when 2nd under these conditions earlier in the year. Always gives his best and in current form should be able to pick up some prizemoney
- 4. LITTLE QUEENIE** - Failed to confirm good Montauban run when trounced in a Villeneuve-sur-Lot Class F 2 weeks ago and can be passed over
- 5. LUNA BLACK** - Won a mobile start Class G here in April, returns to the venue following a pair of conditioners, and with shoes off for the occasion can give this a good go
- 6. LOVELY TOUCHYVON** - Unbeaten in 2 starts since moving yards. Returns to a hard surface on a three-timer and is not about to disappoint
- 7. LUIGI PAN** - In the frame in last 2, latterly 2nd in a Monpazier Class D late last month. Starts in front, goes barefoot again, and should be good enough to make first 5
- 8. LEVYLAND** - Looked top be getting back in shape in April but failed to impress in last 2 and is unlikely to spring any surprises
- 9. LUEUR DE LOIRON** - Has done nothing but improve since switching stables. Is new to Agen but will be no soft touch if she takes to the new profile
- 10. LEOPARD** - Gave a fine account of himself to come 2nd in an Eauze Class E a fortnight ago. Benefits from a superb entry on the front row and will be expected to figure prominently
- 11. LOUXOR BOCAIN** - Not the most reliable but can trot. Has previously won at the venue but the extra 25m will do him no favours
- 12. LOCKWOOD EFJI** - Honest individual that consistently gives what he can. Boasts an excellent Agen record and even with an extra 25m to travel cannot be ruled out
- 13. LINADA BELLA** - Has been a write-off since imposing here in January 2025 and can be ignored
- 14. LUCIFER DU CAIEU** - Has not won for some time but enjoys a wonderful entry here. Is sure to have enough work in him and even from the 2nd row can return to victorious ways

Summary: On the back row but still nicely-engaged here, LUCIFER DU CAIEU (14) has not once disappointed going clockwise and, fully-fit or not, he will be well-backed to win this. LUEUR DE LOIRON (9) has turned a corner though since moving to the Simon Laloum yard and the excellent entry stands her in good stead. Similarly well-engaged in front, LEOPARD (10) put on a good show at Eauze recently and looks competitive once more. Arguably better on turf, LOVELY TOUCHYVON (6) has nevertheless excelled for her new trainer and can again go close.

C7 - PRIX DU CREDIT MUTUEL - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 28,000

1. **JAFLO GEMA** - Honest mare that has been acquitting herself competitively over recent months. Returns to the harness code in very good shape and has a reasonable chance of imposing
2. **JEU MAJYC** - Capable on a good day but has done nothing of note since returning from the winter break and is unlikely to influence the outcome
3. **JAGUAR DU LONDEL** - Has failed to make any impact in 6 starts this year and can be ruled out
4. **JEEN LOVER** - Missed out by little when 3rd in a Toulouse Class F 2 weeks ago. Enjoys a good spot behind the car and will be competitive when it matters
5. **JADE GERBEHAYE** - Was going good-guns when denied a run at Toulouse 2 weeks ago . Form is not in question and redemption may well be on the cards. Chance
6. **JOYEUX DU VIVIEN** - Can prove a handful but has shown a liking for racing barefoot. Is well in on the front row here and can play a prominent role if he stays in stride
7. **JASPER QUESNOT** - Ran 6th of 15 on comeback in a Beaumont-de-Lomagne Class F on 17 May. Will have improved for the race, presents fine Agen credentials, and must not be overlooked
8. **JASMIN PHIL** - Reliability not his strong suit but is proven in this category and can finish in the mix provided Thomas Ducos keeps him out of trouble
9. **JOSIO DU POMMEREUX** - Won under these conditions earlier in the year, and latterly ran 3rd at Eauze. Is shod as he was when victorious here in January but others still preferred
10. **JAVANAISE DE FARS** - Has returned modestly from a year-long absence. Faces first objective of the season but is still not an obvious choice
11. **JOLIE FLEUR OR** - A complete write-off so far this year and makes her Agen debut with limited ambition
12. **JURA** - Good servant for the most part but has come off the boil recently and has shown no sign of a return to form

Summary: JAFLO GEMA (1) may not have won for some time but she has had some near misses this term and, after a monte conditioner at Caen, could well get her nose in front this time. Seldom disappointing when applied, JADE GERBEHAYE (5) suffered misfortune in Toulouse earlier in the month and Matthéo Gergouil will be eager to set the record straight. Placed in 2 of 3 under these conditions, JEEN LOVER (4) gave an encouraging account that day and must be taken seriously. JOYEUX DU VIVIEN (6) was unable to confirm his Saint-Malo success when eliminated at Lisieux, but with Maxime Grasset at the helm can put things right.

C8 - PRIX D'ETE - 2575m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 30,000

- 1. IRIS INTENSE** - Got back in the game at Amiens 9 days ago. Trainer could not have wished for a better entry and Lilian Bertin will be determined to make hay. Claim
- 2. INVICTUS DU DOLLAR** - Never far from losing his action but showed at Toulouse in early-April that he is not to be ignored when focused and will have his supporters
- 3. HEURE BLEUE** - Has done nothing but improve lately, most recently winning a Salon-de-Provence Class E 3 weeks ago, and from the 3 slot is not incapable of doubling up
- 4. ITONO DE MILLAC** - Should not be too hastily-condemned for recent Amiens run. Is plainly in shape, ran 2nd on sole Agen run, and from the 4 slot looks dangerous
- 5. HASHTAG DE TAGOR** - Got off the mark last December but has made little impact since and is not about to change his ways
- 6. HOUSTON DE CUIGNY** - Has struggled somewhat over recent months but is reunited with Max Beauvais who won with him in Bordeaux last February and starting in front will only work to his advantage
- 7. GAVROCHE DU GADE** - Surprise 3rd at Cagnes earlier in the spring but has done nothing of note since and can be passed over
- 8. ISERE** - 4th in a 3000m Class A at Eauze 2 weeks ago on first start for new yard. Breaks wide this time but with form maintained should not disappoint. Chance
- 9. FASTER WIC** - Has failed to impress in either of 2 return runs and with shoes fitted will have nothing to contribute
- 10. GRANITA DES BOIS** - Won over shorter here in April but was unable to confirm when trounced by HEURE BLEUE (3) at Salon-de-Provence 3 weeks ago and others easier to back
- 11. HARLEY DE QUARO** - Modest element that has not made the frame since January 2025 and latest effort did nothing to reassure
- 12. IVAN DU JAYLE** - Disappointing for the most part this season. Showed modest improvement last time but still has too much to find
- 13. HORIZON DU THAY** - Gave a reassuringly good account when 3rd in a Langon Class F 8 days ago. Has pulled a rough number here but with form maintained can play an important part
- 14. HARLEM DE L'ITON** - Serious for the most part but has yet to get into his stride this term and is not a priority
- 15. HAMOUR TEJY** - Has shown better aptitude for the monte discipline and will have nothing to offer
- 16. I AM EAGLE** - Ran encouraging 3rd in a Beaumont-de-Lomagne Class D a month ago. Is confirmed at Agen but is biting off more than he can chew this time

Summary: Terrifically-engaged here, IRIS INTENSE (1) makes his Agen bow in excellent shape and most certainly has the wherewithal to win a race of this nature. Lilian Bertin will still want to be wary of ISERE (8) who left a good impression at Eauze recently, on her first start for the Feyte stable, and the better-placed HEURE BLEUE (3) who imposed at Salon-de-Provence just 3 weeks ago. Runner-up that day, ITONO DE MILLAC (4) was never at his ease at Amiens next time, but is confirmed here and must be respected.
