

## R4 LA CAPELLE [L-H]

### C1 - PRIX ALSH - LES BOUT'CHOUX - 2750m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 6,000

**1. J'ADORE DES FANES** - A decent 3rd in at Tongres in Belgium over 2650m on 14 July. She is in good form and it will be interesting to see if she can perform at that level in France

**2. KARYNDO ROBSEN** - Disqualified in a Class G over 2600m at Le Touquet on July. He has performed well at both this level and at this track and is the one to beat

**3. JANGO ANGELE** - Disqualified in a Class A Claimer over 3125m at Savenay on 14 July. Did finish 2nd in his previous start so could place

**4. JUST LIKE A DREAM** - Finished 7th in a Class G over 1800m at this track on 7 July. Should be good enough to place in a race at this level

**5. KILLER DE BEAULIEU** - Disqualified in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 22 June. Not short of ability but will have to be at his best to have a winning chance

**6. JESSY DE DAUX** - Unplaced in a Class G at Le Croise-Laroche over 2825m on 8 December. Form is poor and she is best passed over

**7. IRVING DE BAILLY** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Class G at Chartres over 2825m on 17 June. Has finished midfield in his last few starts and will struggle but will race unshod behind this time

**8. JUPITER DU PERCHE** - Disqualified last time out in a Class G at Enghien over 2875m on 9 July. He does have his issues and will race fully shod this time with padded shoes in front so should perform a lot better

**Summary:** KARYNDO ROBSEN (2) stands out in a field at this level and appears to have found the perfect race to notch up a second victory. The main challenger could be KILLER DE BEAULIEU (5) who is a capable performer but will need to produce his best form to be a threat. JUST LIKE A DREAM (4) has strong place prospects as does JUPITER DU PERCHE (8) but he will need to behave.

## C2 - PRIX ALSH - LES P'TITS LOUPS - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 18,000

1. **NAKANO BELLO** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in a Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 9 July. Did win well prior to that so deserves another chance
2. **NAPHIL MIJACK** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2550m at Les Andelys on 5 July. There is room for improvement needs to be respected
3. **NET ESPOIR** - Disqualified in a Class F at Montier En Der over 2300m on 5 July. Won his previous start and looked dangerous before making his mistake
4. **NIRVANA DE CHENU** - Disqualified last time out in a Class H at Questembert over 2500m on 12 July. That was his first official run and he could improve for the experience
5. **NEVER CRY** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2200m at Clairefontaine-Deauville on July. He finished 3rd in his previous start and cannot be ignored
6. **NEXIUS** - A excellent winner of his debut in a Class H over 2300m at Abbeville on 12 July. This well-bred half-brother to Galius could have more to come
7. **NEBRASKA** - A strong 2nd in a Class G at St Aubin Les Elbeuf over 2750m on 7 June. That was an improvement on his first two runs so could make further impact
8. **NARUTO CASH** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class G at Moulins La Marche over 2225m on 28 June. That was a top-class effort and with Alexandre Abrivard in the driver's seat, must be a massive contender
9. **NAMIR** - Disqualified in a Class F over 2850m at Carentan on 11 July. That was his first run and he will need to do better this time
10. **NEMO PRESTANCE** - Disqualified in a Class G over 2550m at Gournay-En-Bray on 10 May. That was his first run and he will still need to prove himself

**Summary:** There was a lot to like the debut win of NEXIUS (6) on the grass at Abbeville. He is a well-related half-brother to Galius and could quite easily follow up. The same could apply to NARUTO CASH (8) who won well at his second attempt. NEVER CRY (5) has ability but will need to behave. NAKANO BELLO (1) faulted twice after a debut win but deserves another chance.

### C3 - PRIX ALSH - LES P'TITES CANAILLES - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. L'AUDACE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class E at Vittel over 2700m on 14 July. Will face a much tougher task this time and will struggle to be competitive
- 2. LARABIEN** - Disappointed when 14th in a Class D at Vincennes over 2700m on 5 June. His last two runs have been poor but he has an excellent starting position behind the gate and could redeem himself
- 3. LIPINSKA** - Finished 7th in a Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 23 June. Her previous 4 starts have produced 2 wins and 2 seconds so it could be best to put a line through her last run
- 4. LE CHEF** - Excellent runner-up in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 29 June. He finished ahead of LEAD ME ON (5) on that occasion and will be driven by a talented apprentice this time
- 5. LEAD ME ON** - Won a Class E over 1800m at this track on 7 July. Following his narrow defeat by LE CHEF (4) in his penultimate he showed a lot of courage to win his next start
- 6. LOVI CADENCE** - Winner of a Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 28 June. Earlier form was poor and she has a lot more to do now but if she can bring the confidence from that win into this race she could place
- 7. LOVE SHACK** - Was fifth in a Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. He has placed in both starts at this course and will race with padded shoes all round
- 8. LUKARI DE FONTAINE** - A competitive 4th in a Class E at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. He is in good form and racing without shoes this time has a winning chance, despite drawn widest of all
- 9. LEBOSS D'HAVAROCHE** - Was second in a Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Has proven himself at this track and is expected to be competitive again
- 10. LOKI DE BEAUCAMPS** - Disqualified in a Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. One needs to overlook his last run as he is a lot better than that and has the talent to win a race at this level
- 11. LAURENE DE BAILLY** - Only modest of late, finishing 13th in a Class E at Laval over 2850m on 11 June. Recent form has been poor but she will race unshod this time
- 12. LE BOSS DANOVER** - A promising 3rd in a Class E over 1800m at this course on 7 July. Finished behind LEAD ME ON (5) so could provide some place value for bettors
- 13. LIBERTY AVENUE** - A moderate 9th in a Class E over 800m at La Capelle on 7 July. She is well held by others on her last start
- 14. LORD DES GRANGES** - A mediocre 7th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 30 April. Will race fully shod but on form looks unlikely to trouble the leading contenders
- 15. LA MISS ROYALE** - Was fifth in a Class E at Enghien over 2150m on 23 June. She was disqualified in her 5 previous starts but could have a place chance if she can remain focused
- 16. LOUPIAC DE GODREL** - Finished 10th in a Class E at Cabourg over 2750m on 10 July. Will race unshod in front which was the configuration used in his last victory

**Summary:** Although disqualified last time at this course LOKI DE BEAUCAMPS (10) is a lot better than that and undoubtedly has the ability to win a race of this nature. There is not much to choose between LE CHEF (4) and LEAD ME ON (5) based on their run at Enghien on 29 June but the former could have the edge again. LARABIEN (2) is better than his last race and on earlier form should have a say in the finish.

## C4 - PRIX ALSH - LES JUNIORS - 2750m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 21,000

- 1. MELIUS AVIS** - Was fourth in a Class E at La Capelle over 2750m on 19 June. Rarely too far behind the winner so could place on a good day
- 2. MAESTRO DE PAGERIE** - Ran fifth in a Class E at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. Unlikely to provide a threat to the leading contenders
- 3. MY LADY DE CAHOT** - Disqualified in a Class E over 2750m at this course on 7 July. She either wins or gets disqualified, generally the latter, so it will all depend on how she behaves. Will have padded shoes in front
- 4. MASTER KING** - Finished 4th in a Class E over 2750m at this course on 26 July. Seems to finish 4th and 5th at this course so could place
- 5. MILORD DU LORAUULT** - A mediocre 9th in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 27 June. He finished 4th at this track in his previous start behind MEDELLIN ELLIS (12) and that gives him a place chance
- 6. MIDNIGHT DU VICLAU** - Finished 8th in a Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on 26 May. Last few runs have been somewhat mediocre and she will need to find more
- 7. MERGINIO** - Victorious in a Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 26 June. Last two runs have been excellent and he is expected to be in the mix
- 8. MEC DE MUTRECY** - A decent third in a Class E at Laval over 2850m on 5 July. He fought all the way to the line last time and this looks the ideal field for him
- 9. MISTER D'AVOINES** - Disqualified in a Class E at Chartres over 2800m on 17 June. He seems unlikely to provide any threat in this line-up
- 10. MAESTRO VET** - Finished 5th in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 27 June. Is running consistently well and must be respected.
- 11. MARIEKE'S BOY** - Unplaced in a Class D over 2400m at Waregem in Belgium on 8 July. Will battle to feature in this company
- 12. MEDELLIN ELLIS** - A solid fourth in a Class E at Enghien over 2875m on 27 June. He edged out MAESTRO VET (10) on that occasion and can do so again

**Summary:** Often it is about finding the right race for a horse and that appears to be the case for MEC DE MUTRECY (8) who has the ability to outrun this field. There is little to choose between MEDELLIN ELLIS (12) and MAESTRO VET (10) on their last run but the former is preferred. MERGINIO (7) comes off a decent win and could double up.

## C5 - PRIX DES ENFANTS DE LA CAPELLE - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

1. **KOSETTE DU HAMEL** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a Class G at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 8 December. Returns from a break and could need this run
2. **KALINE DE LAHAYE** - Finished 7th in a Class E over this course and distance on 14 June. Capable of doing better and has a place chance
3. **KARLA DE PAGERIE** - Not disgraced when fifth at Wolvega over 2100m on 22 May. Might play a minor role at very best
4. **KLARA JACK** - Finished third in a Class F at Mauquenchy over 2850m on 9 November. Consistent but is likely to need this run returning from a break
5. **KALYPSO MI AMOR** - Off form and finished 10th in a Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 26 June. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **KIRUNA DU PONCELET** - Not reliable but was third in a Class F at Montier En Der over 3025m on 5 July. Might earn some more minor money
7. **KLARISSA** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 22 June. Not reliable but is also not out of it
8. **KADOLINE WEST** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in Class F at Laon over 2650m on 7 June. Needs to find a few lengths to score
9. **KELISSA D'AVE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class G at Bernay over 2800m on 12 July. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
10. **KATE DE LA MOTTE** - Disqualified last time out in a Class F at Nancy over 2600m on 19 April. In good form before that and is not out of it if smart
11. **KALYPSO DU CAUX** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a Class H mounted race at Montier En Der over 3025m on 5 July. Inconsistent and is probably best under the saddle
12. **KEPHORA** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class G at Pornichet over 2725m on 2 July. Can go one place better this time around
13. **KALINE DU RABUTIN** - Very consistent and was fourth in a Class F at Vittel over 2725m on 12 July. Is in decent form and should be competitive yet again
14. **KADOLE JULOUROZO** - Disqualified in her last three starts, the latest in a Class F at Elbeuf over 2750m on 14 June. Capable of scoring for Alexandre Abrivard if smart

**Summary:** After a solid runner-up effort at Pornichet, KEPHORA (12) has a fine opportunity to return to winning ways. She will, however, need to get the better of KADOLE JULOUROZO (14), now in the hands of the highly capable Alexis Grimault, and KALINE DU RABUTIN (13), who races barefoot for the first time. KLARISSA (7) looks competitive for a place at this level.

## C6 - PRIX E.F.T.S.E. - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class F - Harness - EUR € 21,000

**1. KING SIZE RENKA** - Victorious in a Class F at Laon over 2850m on 7 June. Has shown improvement of late and cannot be ruled out of the treble

**2. KISS MAKER** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class F at Le Croise-Laroche over 2700m on 22 June. Has a place chance on best form

**3. KAPRICCIO** - Has only been modest of late and finished 6th in a Class E over this course and distance on 14 June. Not reliable but is capable of scoring

**4. KASH ELEVEN** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including last time out in a Class H at Macon-Cluny over 2700m on 5 July. Unreliable and others make mroe appeal

**5. KANSAS DU RIB** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F at Vire over 2825m on 8 June. Victorious in December and can be a threat to these rivals

**6. KRACK TER BLEKTE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in class D at La Capelle over 1800m on 7 July. Needs to improve to beat these rivals

**7. KAPORAL DE VIETTE** - Disqualified in class H at Abbeville over 2300m on 12 July. Battling to find best form and others are preferred

**8. KEFIR COHIAIS** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class F at Reims over 2500m on 20 June. Might play a minor role at very best

**9. KATUDI** - Has some fair form and finished 5th in a Class G at Enghien over 2875m on 16 July. Capable of getting into the mix of things

**10. KLYDE GALAA** - Made short work of rivals in a Class G at Saint Malo over 2950m on 9 July. Victorious in last two starts and could complete the hat-trick

**11. KIKLOVE ATOUT** - In good form shape and finished 3rd in a Class F at Arras over 2900m on 21 June. Can contest the finish

**12. KASHMIR PRESTANCE** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class F at Reims over 2500m on 20 June. Capable of making the frame

**13. KEOPS DU RABUTIN** - Unreliable but finished 3rd in a Class H at Chalons-En-Champagne over 2600m on 14 June. Could play a minor role

**Summary:** Impressive winner of his last two starts, KLYDE GALAA (10) looks capable of completing a hat-trick. KAPRICCIO (3), now fitter with two runs under his belt is ready to strike. KANSAS DU RIB (5), provided he remains focused, appears capable of challenging late on. With a lighter shoeing configuration, KATUDI (9) also has a role to play in a competitive looking race.

## C7 - PRIX DE LA VILLE DE LA CAPELLE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 35,000

**1. HETRE D'OURVILLE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Class E at Chartres over 2825m on 31 May. Has disqualification issues and is best watched for now

**2. JAGUAR DE LAUMAC** - In good form and was second in a Class E at Montier En Der over 3025m on 5 July. Should contest the finish once again

**3. JERICHO DU RIB** - In good form and was runner-up in a Class A at Sable Sur Sarthe over 2800m on 28 June. Has improved of late and could score

**4. IMPARTIAL** - Disqualified in a Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 24 April. Has major disqualification issues and others are preferred

**5. IROKO DU CAIEU** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in class E at this course over 2750m on 7 July. Has a place chance in this line-up

**6. IDREAMIS** - Threatening to win and was runner-up in a Class D at Marseille-Borely over 3000m on 10 June. Can be a threat yet again

**7. JOYCE DES GRANGES** - Did not show her best and finished 8th in a Class D at Cabourg over 2750m on 3 July. Victorious in June and can contest the finish if smart

**8. JALOUZ D'OLIVERIE** - Unreliable but was runner-up in a Class E at Vincennes over 2850m on 19 June. In good form and can go one place better

**9. ILLICO DES BAUX** - Not reliable and finished 7th in class E at this course over 2750m on 7 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score

**10. GREFFIERS FLINOIS** - Has struggled of late and finished 8th in a claimer at Laon over 2650m on 28 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

**Summary:** unner-up in the Trophée Vert leg at Sablé-sur-Sarthe, JERICHO DU RIB (3) looks to have a prime opportunity to go one better here. JAGUAR DE LAUMAC (2), in good current form and will fight it out once more. JALOUZ D'OLIVERIE (8), who recently ran well at Vincennes, appears best placed to challenge for the podium. Racing barefoot, IDREAMIS (6) also has the means to get into the mix of things.

## C8 - PRIX DES ANIMATEURS DE L'ALSH - 2750m (a1m1/2) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 28,000

1. **KADOR JOSSELYN** - Unreliable and finished 4th in a Class E at Vichy over 1609m on 30 June. capable of earning some more minor money
2. **KILLARNEY** - Finished 7th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 9 July. Victorious back in August and has a place chance on best form
3. **KERVELEAN** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 10 March. Returns from a break but could be a danger if fit enough
4. **KOMAN** - Unreliable and finished 10th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 11 July. Did better at this track before that and could be a threat
5. **JET DES BAUX** - Has struggled of late and was 7th in a Class F at Pornichet over 2650m on 8 July. Needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **KILDARE OF LOVE** - Finished fifth in a Class C at Vincennes over 2850m on 18 January 2025. Returns from a lengths break and should need this run
7. **KOKA DU DOUET** - Often competitive and was fourth in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 11 July. Can be competitive once again
8. **JUST A DOLLAR** - Disqualified last time out in a Class F at Vittel over 2700m on 14 July. Unreliable in form but is capable of a surprise when in stride
9. **KAYA DU SAPTEL** - Needed the last run when 6th in a Class D at Enghien over 2875m on 9 July. Barefoot and could contest the finish
10. **J'ADORE D'EURVAD** - Unreliable of late and finished 7th in a Class F at Rambouillet over 2800m on 7 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
11. **JARYCA** - Off form and finished 12th in a Class E at Agon-Coutainville over 3450m on 5 July. Needs to find major improvement to score
12. **KANNABIS JELOCA** - Outclassed the opposition in a Class D at Laval over 2850m on 19 June. In good form and should complete the hat-trick
13. **JUST BUILT** - Finished 12th in a Class F at Erbray over 3200m on 14 June. Battling to find best form and others are preferred
14. **IVAJALE** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Class F at Enghien over 2150m on 23 June. Might need to do a bit more to beat these rivals

**Summary:** A fine recruit for the Harmony Racing stable, KANNABIS JELOCA (12) once again stands out as the one to beat in this lucky last race. KAYA DU SAPTEL (9), now racing barefoot after a comeback run is a danger. The ultra-consistent KOKA DU DOUET (7) is always in the miz and can do so once again. and KOMAN (4), judged on his best efforts, also has the credentials to fight out the finish.
