- **1. FAKIR DE LARRE -** Unreliable but was 3rd in class E at this track over 2925m on 21 July. Remains barefoot and can make the frame
- **2. HERBU DU FERRON -** Unreliable but was 4th in class E at this track over 2700m on 16 August. Has shown improvement and could play a minor role
- **3. INSERT DES MONTS -** Disqualified in class E at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2700m on 16 August. Unreliable and needs major improvement to win
- **4. FOX DU RIB -** In good shape and was runner-up in class F at Hyeres over 2850m on 13 August. Has not won this year but can get involved with the finish
