- **2. JAGUAR WIT -** Unreliable and was 8th in a Class B race at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 29 November. Did better before that and has a place chance
- **3. IMPARTIAL** Unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Vincennes over 2100m on 31 October. Capable of playing a minor role when smart
