

VINCENNES [L-H] - 20 September

Race 1 - PRIX VELLEDA - 2700m WALK-UP D21 Monte. Purse EUR €39,000.

- 1. **JAZZ DU DIGEON** Was disqualified on debut at Le Croisé-Laroche on February 28. Not seen since. Leading driver so consider.
- 2. **JAZZY THOURJAN** Safely held last time at the first run of the campaign when 14.0L from the winner in sixth over 2175m at this track. Facing a tough assignment this time around.
- 3. **JORECAR DE FORGAN** Was disqualified last start at this track on August 29. Consistent prior to that run.
- 4. **JOKER JOLI** Finished seventh at his latest appearance at this track. More needed.
- 5. **JOS DU JAL** Finished third at Pornichet two runs ago then improved to score last time out at Laval by 4.1L. Can play a role in the finish.
- 6. **JACK DRY** Scored a fine win at Cabourg two runs ago then couldn't follow it up at this track last time finishing 15.7L away from the winner. Could make amends.
- 7. **JINGLE DES BROUETS** Was disqualified last start at this track on September 13. Overlook the last run.Maiden with place claims.
- 8. **JAMES OF CARLY** Is racing well with a sequence of three minor placings the latest a second at this track beaten 0.8L. Gets his chance.
- 9. **JOSCAN KERDREUX** Didn't make an impact when fifth at this track beaten 8.9L. Finishing behind the placegetters.
- 10. **JOKER D'ARBAZ** First up since finishing fourth at this track seven months ago. Can be thereabouts.

Summary: JAMES OF CARLY (8) finished runner-up the past three starts including over course and distance in latest. Major claims. JOKER D'ARBAZ (10) drops in grade following a 26L fourth at this venue tackling the G3 Prix Edouard Marcillac last February. Market will help determine readiness on reappearance. JOS DU JAL (5) won a Class E mounted race at Laval in emphatic fashion and is hard to dismiss. JAZZ DU DIGEON (1) is worth a market check with Eric Raffin booked.

Race 2 - PRIX DE BEAUCAIRE - 2100m MOBILE C28 Harness. Purse EUR €44,000.

- 1. **JUPPY UP** Is getting close to a win after finishing in the money at his past two starts most recently at Cabourg beaten 0.8L. Leading chance again.
- 2. **JYPSON KALOUMA** Scored two runs ago at Cabourg then didn't back it up last time when beaten 6.2L at Cabourg. Has claims.
- 3. **JULES ET JIM** Has been in sound form lately with four top-five finishes in succession the latest a third at this track. Racing well and will be tough to beat.
- 4. **JIGSAW PUZZLE** Finished runner-up at Cabourg two starts ago then couldn't repeat at Vichy last time but he was only 1.2L off the winner. Sure to be there at the business end.
- 5. **JE T'AIME** Failed to threaten when resuming last start finishing fifth at Pornichet and beaten 15.0L. Capable of testing this line up.
- 6. **JACKPOT DES BORDES** Was disqualified last start at this track on September 8. Forgive the recent mishap. Top pick if at his best.
- 7. **JEAN MADRIK** Didn't make an impact when 12th at Enghien. Better than last start and deserves another chance.
- 8. **JAFAR CHARENCEY** Made significant improvement last start when third at this track beaten 0.8L. Could go forward again.
- 9. JEWEL HEMSSON Disqualified last start at Enghien. Forgive the latest run. Can turn things around.
- 10. **JOYAU DE RIVERIE** Not a threat last start when fifth over 2000m at Rambouillet beaten 4.8L. Not keen on his chances in this line-up.
- 11. **JEU DE CARTE** Was disqualified last start at this track on September 13. Consistent prior to that run.

Summary: JULES ET JIM (3) backed up a Class E success at Cherbourg with a good third in a Class D walk up at this venue. Top chance. JUPPY UP (1) finished runner-up in a pair of Class D races of late. Obvious appeal with Eric Raffin taking the drive. JIGSAW PUZZLE (4) is respected following a close up fourth in a Class B at Vichy. Notable claims. JEAN MADRIK (7) holds claims on best form.

- 1. **IMPERIAL COGLAIS** Has been outside the top three recently last time out finishing sixth at Le Mont-St-Michel. Place.
- 2. **ISSAMBRES FIX** Ran an improved race second-up to finish second at Mauquenchy. Rates an each way hope here with further improvement.
- 3. **IDEAL DU GROIZEAU** Was far too good last time when an effortless 3.3L winner at Les Sables-d'Olonne. Can go on.
- 4. **ILTON ROYAL** Scored at Saint-Malo two starts back then finished third at Cabourg more recently finishing 10.0L from the winner. Can be prominent.
- 5. **IGGY DE FLORANGE** Last raced at this track on August 29 when he was disqualified. Place at best.
- 6. **IDEAL GREEN** Last raced at La Capelle on August 30 when he was disqualified. Prefer to see him perform well before recommending.
- 7. INDIGO GEDE Is a last-start winner by 0.4L over 2675m at Le Mont-St-Michel. Can go on.
- 8. **IRINO DE GUERON** Bounced back last start when second at Cabourg beaten 5.0L. Heading the right way and is a leading player.
- 9. **IRIS D'AVIGNERE** Has been out of the winner's circle for a long while. Failed to measure up when fifth last time out at Reims. Needs to lift.
- 10. **ICARE DE TROIS** Didn't make an impact when eighth at Bernay. Won previous two including highly impressively at Caen.

Summary: ICARE DE TROIS (10) produced a recent effort which can be ignored. Holds top claims having won his last mounted event by 17L in a Class D at Caen. IRINO DE GUERON (8) finished a good second in a Class E mounted race at Cabourg. Key player now racing barefoot. Another to note is recent Class E mounted winner INDIGO GEDE (7) while ILTON ROYAL (4) is not to be ruled out.

- 1. **ILLICO PRESTO FAC** Three placings in a row the most recent when second at Laval beaten 0.4L. Should be in the finish again.
- 2. **ILMENITE** Was far too good last time when an effortless 3.6L winner at Ecommoy. In fine form and looks a serious player again.
- 3. **INTREPIDE DES BOIS** Was disqualified last start at this track on September 6. Won previous two. Include.
- 4. **ICARUS BOURBON** Registered a fine win at La Capelle two starts ago then couldn't follow it up at this track last time finishing 6.3L away from the winner. Can play a role in the finish.
- 5. **INVICTUS D'ORGERES** Recorded a fine win at Vittel two starts ago then couldn't follow it up at this track last time finishing 5.9L away from the winner. Could bounce back.
- 6. IKARUS FLIGNY Easily accounted for last time when seventh at Feurs. Earlier form consistent.
- 7. **IRISH NICE ELGE** Returned from a spell in top order last start with a win at this track by 3.0L. Will strip fitter and will be hard to beat again.
- 8. **INDIGO BELLO** Finished third at Enghien two starts back then couldn't repeat at La Capelle finishing 7.5L from the winner. Sure to be thereabouts.
- 9. **IGOR VICKING** Is a 25-start maiden who was beaten 5.5L at Cabourg last time. One of the primary contenders.
- 10. **IBISCUS MAN** Has been in top form this time in work including a last-start win at this track by 0.8L. Expected to feature again.
- 11. **ISOFOU DU CHENE** Finished fourth last start over 2700m at La Capelle on the back of a win at La Capelle two runs back. Well-placed in this contest. Capable of playing a major role.
- 12. **INVICTUS DE HOERDT** Accounted for last time when 4.7L from the winner in seventh over 2700m at this track. Provincial winner before that. This is a stronger race.
- 13. **INVISIBLE SAM** Didn't make an impact when seventh at Enghien beaten 8.6L. Outside place chance.
- 14. **ITALIANO DI PAO** Continued strong form of late with a fourth at Cabourg three weeks ago. Bold showing expected again.

Summary: ISOFOU DU CHENE (11) followed up a Class E win at La Capelle with a decent third at the same venue last outing. Three from four over this distance and holds leading claims adopting a new shoeing combination. IBISCUS MAN (10) won a Class E at this venue last start and cannot be ruled out. INVICTUS D'ORGERES (5) has five wins from eleven starts in his career. Dangerous to dismiss. Recent Class F Laval runner-up ILLICO PRESTO FAC (1) is also worth including. ICARUS BOURBON (4) warrants respect back behind the mobile.

- 1. **HARTEFAX** Finished second last start at this track beaten 3.0L. That result made it two wins and two minor placings from the last five starts. Can go back-to-back.
- 2. **HOTEBO DE BREMONT** Finished second at Ecommoy two starts back then couldn't repeat at this track last time finishing 6.1L from the winner. Finding a few ahead of him.
- 3. **HASARD CERTAIN** Was not a factor when resuming last start finishing fifth at Pornichet. Open to improvement.
- 4. **HAXO DE LA CHAULE** Has been outside the top three recently last time out finishing seventh at Dieppe. Better than last start and can improve.
- 5. **HUDO DU RUEL** Finished third at Le Mont-St-Michel two starts ago then couldn't repeat at Dieppe last time but he was only 1.5L off the winner. Winning claims.
- 6. **HARDY DES LANDES** Didn't measure up two runs ago at Ecommoy but returned to form last time when a winner by 1.1L at Dieppe.
- 7. **HORIZON DE BRY** Was beaten 1.3L into third last start at Divonne-les-Bains. That was his sixth placing alongside three wins from the past 12 starts. Major player.
- 8. **HEAVEN STAR** Won two back at Agon Coutainville then couldn't repeat last time when fourth at Vire beaten 1.6L. Well-placed in this contest. Capable of taking this out.
- 9. **HOBAMA** Finished second at Meslay-du-Maine two starts back then couldn't repeat at Graignes last time. Might find this a bit tough.
- 10. **HARRY COHIAIS** Was disqualified last start at La Capelle on August 30. Put a line through that latest run. Top pick if at his best.
- 11. **HELIER** Missed the placings again last start when eighth at Enghien. More needed.
- 12. **HARING OKINA** Was a winner two back at Mauquenchy then couldn't back it up last time when 7.6L away in seventh at La Capelle. Serious player on best form.

Summary: HARING OKINA (12) is taken to put a below par effort at La Capelle behind him. Major appeal having won a Class F at Mauquenchy prior. HORIZON DE BRY (7) was a good third in a Class E at Divonne. Key chance adopting a new shoeing combination. HARTEFAX (1) produced a solid 3L second at this venue tackling a Class E in latest. One to note. HUDO DU RUEL (5) goes well barefoot and cannot be dismissed.

HARING OKINA (12) - HORIZON DE BRY (7) - HARTEFAX (1) - HUDO DU RUEL (5)

- 1. JAVA ALINA Disqualified last start at Caen. Little shown to date.
- 2. **JOIE D'ATOUT** Seventh most recently at her first run back from a layoff at this track. Hard to have in this line-up.
- 3. **JIOSKA LUDOISE** Was disqualified last start at this track on September 13. Prepared to overlook until her racing manners improve.
- 4. **JACINTHE MAGUET** Didn't make an impact when ninth at Feurs. No form of note.
- 5. **JENNY DAIRPET** Disqualified at Chateaubriant. Second prior to that was a glimmer of hope. Place.
- 6. **JENNA DAIRPET** Has bounced back to form with placings at her last two starts most recently when third at this track beaten 4.9L. Close to a win.
- 7. **JOYEUSE CAUVELIERE** Has been safely held at her past two starts after a solid fourth at Enghien three runs back most recently finishing ninth at this track. Maiden with a chance.
- 8. **JOLLITY GABY** Last raced at this track on September 13 when she was disqualified. Overlook the recent mishap. Winner four starts back.
- 9. **JULIANA DE RETZ** Saluted on debut two runs back then made it two on the trot again at Cabourg scoring by 8.2L. One of the primary contenders.
- 10. **JET GIRL** Last start unplaced at Cabourg. Prior a good run when second at Les Sables-d'Olonne. Close to a win.
- 11. **JINKOUA D'IRATY** Was expected to do more last time out finishing sixth and beaten 8.5L at Castera-Verduzan. Has ability. Include.
- 12. **JOSEFINE DE BAILLY** Missed the placings again last start when eighth at this track. Form not up to scratch.
- 13. **JALIA D'AZERAY** Is racing consistently with a sequence of two minor placings the latest when third at this track beaten 4.2L. Maiden and can be thereabouts again.

Summary: JULIANA DE RETZ (9) is unbeaten in both starts to date. Created a good impression running out a winner of a Class E mounted event at Cabourg by 8.5L. Leading hope. JINKOUA D'IRATY (11) won a Class D mounted event by 7.25L at Biarritz three starts ago. Key chance. JALIA D'AZERAY (13) is one to note following a decent Class D mounted third here. JENNA DAIRPET (6) cannot be ruled out.

- 1. **FLICFLAC DU LOGIS** Turned in a nice run last start when second at Moulins-la-Marche. Well-placed in this contest. Rates highly.
- 2. **FIRST DE PIENCOURT** Safely held last time at the first run of the campaign when 4.4L from the winner in fifth over 2850m at this track. Facing a tough assignment this time around.
- 3. GREAT KILLS Safely held when seventh at Graignes beaten 7.9L. Improvement needed.
- 4. **GLOIRE ROYALE** Has missed the frame but not been too far away last few most recently finishing fourth at Jullianges.
- 5. **GALANT DE BRUYERE** Has been outside the top three recently last time out finishing fifth at Meslay-du-Maine.
- 6. **FEDEROVKA** Missed the placings last start but was only beaten 1.7L when fourth at Amiens. This looks a suitable race.
- 7. **FORUM** Finished fourth at Beaumont-de-Lomagne last time out to continue a run of very steady form. Bold showing expected again.
- 8. **FREDO DAIRPET** Won two back at Craon and maintained the good form with a minor placing last start at Le Mont-St-Michel. In the money at his last two appearances. Major player.
- 9. **DUC DU GOUTIER** Continued a long run without winning when ninth at this track last time out. Others make more appeal.
- 10. **FLORE GENDREENNE** Has been racing well with a couple of minor prizes to her name recently the latest when runner-up at this track. Ready to win.
- 11. **GAZELLE DU BOURG** Last raced at Enghien 11 weeks ago when she finished 12th. Consider first-up.
- 12. **DERBY D'URZY** Not a threat last start when ninth over 2150m at Cagnes-sur-Mer beaten 7.8L. Earlier form consistent.
- 13. **GOLD D'ECROVILLE** Last raced at this track on September 2 when he was disqualified. Put a line through that latest run. Top pick if at his best.
- 14. **EOLE VERDERIE** Easily accounted for last time when 7.2L from the winner in fifth over 2725m at Graignes. Facing a tough assignment this time around.
- 15. FAN DE PHYT'S Disqualified last start at Vibraye. Little form of late.
- 16. **DYNAMIC LA BORIE** Cruised to a 3.8L win most recently at Divonne-les-Bains. Top chance based on the latest effort.

Summary: DYNAMIC LA BORIE (16) had a subsequent winner in behind when winning a mobile claimer by 4L at Divonnnes. Taken to follow up. Five-time barefoot winner FLORE GENDREENNE (10) was narrowly denied in a Class G amateur event at this track twelve days ago. Hard to dismiss. FREDO DAIRPET (8) won by 4L adopting this shoeing combination at Craon two back. Leading contender. FORUM (7) is also considered.

Race 8 - PRIX CENTAURUS - 2200m WALK-UP C8 Harness. Purse EUR €36,000.

- 1. **KAIROS DE BOMO** Was disqualified last start at Enghien on July 27. Prepared to overlook until his racing manners improve.
- 2. KALEO DU BELLAY Disqualified for galloping. Little shown in two starts.
- 3. KASH MADRIK Last raced at Alencon on September 4 when he was disqualified.
- 4. KASHMIR JADOR Didn't fire on debut last start when tenth at this track.
- 5. **KOSMOS DE SOCERY** Disqualified for galloping on debut at Alencon.
- 6. KRAK DU RIEU Disqualified for galloping on debut at Rambouillet.
- 7. KOCHANU MAG Not a threat last start when ninth over 2175m at this track. This is no easier.
- 8. **KEPI DU HOME** Was lining up for just the second time for fourth again but only beaten 3.3L. Right in this.
- 9. **KASH MARCEAUX** Is a last-start winner by 0.9L over 2000m at Rambouillet. In form and sure to prove very hard to beat.
- 10. **KAKO GASCOGNE** Scored at Villereal last time out after a plain effort at Les Sables-d'Olonne the start before. Improver.
- 11. **KHEOPS SAINT CLAIR** Finished second at Bernay two runs ago then couldn't repeat at Enghien last time finishing 6.5L from the winner. Chance.
- 12. **KRYSTAL DU RUEL** Maiden but experienced with six starts last time out finishing fifth at this track. Can be included.

Summary: KAKO GASCOGNE (10) impressed winning a Class E at Villereal second up. Top hope up in grade. KASH MARCEAUX (9) won a Class E on the grass at Rambouillet last-time-out. Expected to be thereabouts. The booking of Eric Raffin makes KHEOPS SAINT CLAIR (11) interesting and KEPI DU HOME (8) may go well adopting new shoeing combination following a decent fourth in a Class C here.
