- **1. DAFNE DI POGGIO -** In good form and was third in Class E at this track over 2700m on 16 January. Should fight out the finish
- **2. DRUJBA -** Disqualified last time out at this course on 16 January. Prefers a shorter trip and others make more appeal
- **3. JAVA DE CASTELLE -** Only modest of late and was 6th in Class E at Bordeaux-Le-Bouscat over 2550m on (January. Others are preferred
- **4. DIVA STARLIGHT -** A bit of a disappointment in Milan when 5th over 2120m on 8 January. Has won at this track and is barefoot. Go close
- 5. JAVA DE BOITRON Has some fair form of late and was not disgraced when 5th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 11 January. Can contest the finish
- **6. JALNA GIRL -** Has disqualification issues and faulted at this track on 27 November. Others make more appeal
- **7. MISS JAJA -** Disqualified at this track on 21 January. Has struggled at this track of late but is capable of a surprise on best form
- **8. JADE HAUFOR -** Disqualified at this course on 11 January. Has struggled of late but is capable of an upset on best form
- **9. MANSKENSTOSEN -** Unreliable and was 7th in Class D at this track over 2700m on 21 December. Can pop up in a place
- **10. JET GIRL -** Very unreliable and was not disgraced when 5th in Class D at Angers over 2350m on 8 January. Needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
- **11. JAFLOSA GIRL -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 27 December. Has lost the way of late and others make more appeal
- **12. JADE RENARDIER -** Does best when barefoot and was unshod and third in Class E over this course and distance on 4 January. Has a winning chance
- **13. JUSSY DE PAUMAR -** Not disgraced when 5th in Class D at this track over 2100m on 31 August. Returns from a break but is not out of it

Summary: DAFNE DI POGGIO (1) quickly reappears after finishing 3rd here over 2700m on Thursday and, if this doesn't come too soon for her, a repeat of that performance should suffice. DIVA STARLIGHT (4) was slightly disappointing although not disgraced in Italy when last seen but should play a leading role if bouncing back to earlier form. After a comeback outing in a mounted race, MISS JAJA (7) isn't underestimated returning to the harness category. Consistent hard-knockers JAVA DE BOITRON (5)and JADE RENARDIER (12) are competitive for a podium finish.

- **3. KISS ME CRAZY -** Well beaten 8th in a class E at this track over 2175m on 7 January. Poor form and has disqualification issues
- **4. KINOHA D'OURVILLE -** Finished 6th in a class E at this track over 2175m on 7 January. Remains barefoot. Can play a minor role at best
- **5. KANELLE -** Disqualified in a class E at this track over 2700m on 3 January. Must be wise to have a chance
- **6. KORALIE D'ISQUES -** A winner in a class F at Toulouse over 2325m on 4 January. Has the confidence and sufficient means to fight for victory
- **7. KALIKA DU LEVANT -** Fourth in a class F at Angers over 3125m on 8 January. Mathieu Mottier will give every assistance from the sulky and has place prospects
- **8. KAMTCHATKA -** Third in a class E at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2650m on 9 January. Unreliable and needs to find a few lengths
- **9. KORSICANA -** Fifth in a class E at Laval over 2850m on 5 October. Might need the run-back. Can surprise and play a minor role

- **2. KOALA DU HIDOUX -** Disappointing recent form and was 9th in Class E at Vincennes over 2100m on #1 December. Others are preferred
- **3. KALIBRE -** Yet to win a race but is holding form and was fourth in Class F at Le Mans over 2850m on 16 December. More is needed to beat these rivals
- **4. KELROC -** Has yet to win a race but is holding form and was fourth in Class E at Toulouse over 2950m on 10 January. Might play a minor role at best
- **5. KALL ME CENSERIE -** Very unreliable and was disqualified last time out at Pontchateau over 2800m on 22 December. Capable of an upset when in the mood

KAIROUAN GLAM (7) has undeniable means but is seldom far from a fault, so this is again a question of wisdom for him. KADOR D'OURVILLE (8) and KALL ME CENSERIE (5) complete the shortlist.

- **3. LUKAS D'OLIVERIE -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 7 January. Hard to trust but remains barefoot and is capable of scoring
- **4. LEADER DE SEVRE -** Showed some improvement when fourth last time out in a Class D Mounted race at this course over 2200m on 7 January. Not out of it in this line-up
- **5. LOVI CADENCE -** Has struggled of late and was 6th in Class D at this course over 2200m on 7 January. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **6. LYNX ATOUT -** Not disgraced when 5th last time out in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2200m on 7 January. Barefoot for the very first time and could be the surprise package of the race
- **7. LENNON D'ANS -** Yet to win a race and was disqualified last time out at this track on 7 January. Hard to trust and others are preferred
- **8. LOTUS PAULOIS -** Disqualified last time out at this track on 7 January. Yet to win a race and needs to find a few lengths to win
- **9. L'ARTISTE ZEN -** Holding form and was not disgraced when 5th in a Class D Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 6 December. Better this distance and has a big winning chance

Summary: L'ARTISTE ZEN (9) returns to the scene of his last success lightened in his shoeing, so it should pay to side with him ahead of LUKAS D'OLIVERIE (3), who probably would've won last time had he not faulted. Unshod LEGO DES BROUETS (2), a last-start winner at Cabourg, and LEADER DE SEVRE (4), after a a reassuring 4th here a fortnight ago, appeal most of the remainder.

- **2. LISTEL D'URZY -** Showed what he is capable of with a barefoot win in Class F at Rouen-Mauguenchy over 2850m on 13 January. Remains unshod and is not out of it
- **3. LIEUTENANT COLUMBO -** Yet to win a race but is consistent and was runner-up last time out in Class F at Cordemais over 2825m on 5 January. Could earn some minor money
- **4. LAFAYETTE DU BOURG -** Showed what he is capable of with a barefoot win last time out in Class F at Abgers over 2425m on 12 Remains unshod but is taking on tougher this time
- **5. LONDON RECALL -** Improving and was victorious in his second start, in Class E at Cabourg over 2725m on 2 January. Can follow up

Summary: Brand new trotter, LONDON RECALL (5) showed his quality in Cabourg and is starting at Vincennes with legitimate ambitions. Unshod on all four feet for the first time, LUX DE LA MESLIERE (9) is capable of doing it from start to finish. THE ANGEL AIMEF (6) is better than its last failure. At best physically, LISTEL D'URZY (2) is also competitive for the first places.

Summary: IQUITO PLANCHETTE (11) wouldn't be winning out of turn after finishing 2nd in back-to-back recent starts, the latest at this level over 2850m. He deserves to get his head in front and is preferred to BEAUTIFUL DAY(ITY) (10), a recent Quinté+ scorer over 2100m on the big track. GO TO AMERICA (14), runner-up here last month over 2700m, and veteran Italian mare ASSIA LUIS (12) aren't out of it either, despite conceding valuable ground from the start.
