The latter has been gelded and could reward followers this time. BUGLE BOY and ASHIKULE show good pace and should be in the money. First-timers to consider as well.

PREVIEW: PRECOCIOUS was gaining nicely at the wire when runner-up, beaten 0.75-lengths on debut. The daughter of Ideal World should relish the extra and can open her account. Both SPLASH OF COLOUR and MIGHTY MARY gave the impression that they are looking for distance after not speeding up on sprint debuts. The pair have drawn well and could get a lot closer. TAYLOR'S VERSION stayed on nicely in third when stepping up to 1200m last time. She should enjoy a less frantic pace and should not go backwards over the extra. TAKE IT AS RED didn't do badly against elders last. ONCIDIUM is a well-bred newbie.
