- **2. IMPERATOR D'ELA -** Last but one when preparing for this in a 2460m Caen Class C 11 days ago. Shoes off this time and will be competitive for a place in the frame

- **7. HABIT DE SOIREE -** 7th of 14, a place behind HELLO PANAME (1), in a 2550m Reims GNT Gr.3 on 9 April. Trainer in the wagon this time but could pleasantly surprise if she doesn't see daylight until the latter stage of the race
- **8. JANGO VICI -** 3rd of 13 in a 2800m Cholet Class C on 28 April. Won his only start at the venue and will be no pushover if he runs to his mark
- **9. HORATIUS D'ELA -** Secured first objective of the year in April before running 3rd of 11 in a 2850m Vincennes Class A a week ago. Forced to incur the penalty this time but must still be retained
- **10. INVICTUS MADIBA -** Did not enjoy a good run 2.5 weeks ago when 9th of 11 behind HEDE DARLING (11) in a 2100m Vincennes Class B. Has not imposed for some time and is unlikely to on this occasion, but can still get a look-in

Summary: In cracking form, entrusted to Franck Nivard, and well-engaged on the second line, JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (14) is very easy to fancy for the win. - **5. IMOKO MADRIK -** 10th of 11, a place behind ILLUMINATI (8), in a 2625m Saint-Omer Class E on 13 April. Shoes back on and will have nothing to offer
- **6. IN AMERICA -** Produced a good effort to come 3rd of 16 in a 2550m Reims Class G on 24 April. Appears to be close to his race and the 25m head-start will do his prospects no disservice
- **7. IVAJALE -** Failed to confirm Mauquenchy performance when 10th of 16 in a 2700m Class F at La Capelle a month back. Should not be too hastily judged though and could yet spice things up
- **8. ILLUMINATI -** Out of the picture in both starts this term, latterly 9th of 11 in a 2625m Saint-Omer Class E on 13 April. By no means the worst horse here but still needs to raise his game
- **9. DANTE GODIVA -** Makes first appearance at the venue after having finished 5th of 6 over 2300m in Kuurne a month ago. Races barefoot but still looks to be out of his depth
- **10. FLAMENCO -** Ran 3rd at Maure-de-Bretagne before coming 15th of 17 in a 3200m Landivisiau Class E on 8 May. Has never delivered here and even though reconfigured is unlikely to garner much support
- **11. IDYLLE DU PERSIL -** Starts for first time since finishing 12th of 13 behind GLOUGLOU D'EMI (12) in a 2100m Vincennes Class E on 28 March, and with shoes on will have few if any takers
- **12. GLOUGLOU D'EMI -** Drops in category after running 7th of 16 in a 2100m Vincennes Class D a week ago. Incurs the penalty but is plainly in good shape and will not be far from the action
- **13. MISTER INVICTUS -** Runner-up in 2 of last 3, latterly a 2700m Vincennes Class D 2.5 weeks ago. Excels in this category when applied and can make this his own
- **14. ANOTHER CREATION -** Serious mare but makes first appearance since October 2023 and is going to need the run
- **15. BAYARD (GER)** Makes Croise-Laroche debut after running 5th of 7 over 2000m at Gelsenkirchen 3 weeks ago. Has solid references at this level, enjoys a super entry, and will be expected to contest the finish

Summary: Although never far from losing his action, MISTER INVICTUS (13) is seldom far off the mark when focused and is eminently capable of winning a race of this nature. BAYARD (GER) (15) is considerably better than his latest run would suggest and rarely disappoints when shipped to France. UN MEC PAASLOO (4) also travels for the occasion and enjoys a front-row break. IN AMERICA (6) left a very good impression at Reims and the Franck Nivard-factor must be taken into account.
