- **2. MAGIC TUNIS -** Only modest of late and was 11th in a handicap at Chantilly over 1900m on 16 May. Needs to find a few lengths to win
- **3. LADY MANA -** Has lost the way this year and was 12th in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 9 June. Needs major improvement to win
- **4. AL HABISSET -** Unreliable but was third in a handicap at Salon-de-Provence over 2400m on 9 June. Can be competitive in this line-up
- **5. POP LIFE -** Disappointing form of late and was 12th in a handicap at Marseille-Borély over 1700m on 26 May. Capable of earning some minor money
