C1 - PRIX RAYMOND FOUARD - 2175m (a1m1/4) - Gr3 - Harness - EUR € 80,000

- 1. MYSTERY QUEEN** - Remains at the top of her game and was runner-up in a Group 2 at this course over 2700m on 6 June. Can get involved with the finish once again
- 2. MISTRAL DU GOUTIER** - Finished fourth in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 22 May. Does seem at very best over further than this distance and others make more appeal
- 3. MAGICO DE LOU** - Finished 7th in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 22 May. Did win a Group 3 at the beginning of the year but has only been modest since and others are preferred
- 4. MAKE YOUR DAY** - Unreliable this year and finished 8th in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 6 June. Remains barefoot but needs to do more to beat these these rivals
- 5. MY PRINCESS** - Returned to form and was fourth in a Group 2 at this course over 2700m on 6 June. Remains barefoot and might earn some minor money
- 6. MONZON NORMAND** - Has only been fair of late and finished fifth in a Group 2 at this course over 2700m on 6 June. Might need to do a bit more to score this around
- 7. MIDWAY LADY** - Not as reliable as most of her rivals but was third in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 6 June. Capable of playing a minor role
- 8. MAGNUM DU CHOQUEL** - Disqualified in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 6 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of contesting the finish when staying in stride
- 9. MENTOR DE PLAY** - Extremely consistent this year and was runner-up in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 6 June. Should fight out the finish once again
- 10. MAGIC MAN** - Successful in a pair of Group 2s of late, the latest at this course over 2700m on 6 June. Drops in distance but is the one to beat
- 11. MAESTRO VRIE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 6 June. Is a recent Group 1 winner so is a real threat if smart

Summary: Unbeaten when racing in this shoeing configuration, MAGIC MAN (10) is taken to maintain that record and can confirm the form with MENTOR DE PLAY (9), whom he has already accounted for. The talented MAESTRO VRIE (11) has the ability to match the principals, provided he remains focused throughout. Better than his latest effort, MAGNUM DU CHOQUEL (8) is worth another chance and could easily bounce back into contention.

C2 - PRIX RMC (PRIX DE NESLES) - 2100m (a1m1/4) - Class C - Harness - EUR € 68,000

1. **HALL BLACK MESS** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a Group 3 at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Has a good record with Eric Raffin and could be a lively danger
2. **HAUTBRION COLMI** - Showed some improvement when fourth in a class C at Toulouse over 2150m on 15 May. Distance suited and could earn some more money
3. **HUGO OCCAGNES** - Off form and finished 13th in a class A at Erbray over 3200m on 14 June. Battling to regain best form and others make more appeal
4. **GAMIN DES ISLES** - Very consistent last year and was third in a class D at Royan La Palmyre over 2475m on 10 August. Remains barefoot and could earn some more money if fit enough
5. **GENERAL DU NORD** - Has struggled of late and was unplaced in a class A at Erbray over 3200m on 14 June. Drops in distance but needs major improvement to score
6. **I STILL LOVING YOU** - Has been at his best this year and was third in a class C at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Has claims if staying smart
7. **IPALIO** - Only modest of late and finished tenth in a class C at Enghien over 2875m on 13 June. Remains barefoot but is battling to regain best form
8. **HERMES LUDOIS** - Did not show his best when 7th in a class A at Erbray over 3200m on 14 June. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
9. **HAPPY DANOVER** - Has only been fair of late and finished fifth in a class C at Enghien over 2875m on 13 June. Might play a minor role this time around
10. **GEDEON DAIRPET** - Disqualified in a class D at Bordeaux-Le Bouscat over 2550m on 16 December. Returns from a break and should need this run
11. **FILOU SMILING** - Has really struggled of late and was unplaced in a class A at Eauze over 3000m on 7 June. Needs to do a lot more to beat these rivals
12. **IDOLE D'OURVILLE** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a class D at Cagnes-sur-Mer over 2150m on 8 March. Returns from a break and could need this run
13. **IF I TELL YOU** - Does best when barefoot and was runner-up in a class C at Enghien over 2875m on 13 June. Remains barefoot and has a place chance in this line-up
14. **HAPPY FACE** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class C at Enghien over 2875m on 13 June. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role at very best
15. **HORIZON D'EYMY** - Not reliable and was fifth at Waregem over 3500m on 9 June. Has disqualification issues and needs to find a few lengths to score
16. **IDOLE JALLERIE** - Returned from a couple of disqualifications with a victory in a class D over this course and distance on 5 June. Remains barefoot and should contest the finish
17. **GRAZIELA D'EL** - Showed some improvement when fifth in a class E at Jallais over 2975m on 14 June. Has won over this track and trip and is not out of it
18. **HEUREUX DE FLEUR** - Remains in goosd shape and was third in a class D at this track over 2850m on 5 June. Did win over this track and trip earlier this year and can score again

Summary: The outcome of this contest could hinge on the behaviour of I STILL LOVING YOU (6), whose ability is not in question but whose chances will depend largely on maintaining his discipline throughout. HEUREUX DE FLEUR (18) also appeals despite a difficult draw on the outside of the front line. IDOLE JALLERIE (16) faces a similar obstacle from an equally unfavourable starting position. HALL BLACK MESS (1) is worth noting with Eric Raffin back aboard and should benefit from a much more favourable draw.

C3 - PRIX BERTRAND DELOISON - 2850m (a2m) - Class A - Harness - EUR € 90,000

1. **KISS ME HONEY** - Remains in very good form and was runner-up in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Remains barefoot and can earn some more money
2. **RIKITA JP** - Disqualified in a class B over this course and distance on 29 May. Remains barefoot and has been in good form this year. Has a place chance
3. **JALENDRA DE MALAC** - Needed her last run when 8th in a Group 2 over this track and trip on 6 June. Reverts to barefoot and can be competitive in this line-up
4. **IRON DU GERS** - Unreliable and finished 6th in a class B at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Likes this course and is capable of an upset on best form
5. **COLBERT WF** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 13 June. Needs to find a few lengths to beat these rivals
6. **IMPERATOR D'ELA** - Disqualified at Solvalla over 3140m on 30 May. Remains barefoot but is battling to find best form and others make more appeal
7. **HOMARD LAND** - Very consistent this year and finished third in a class A at Granville over 3100m on 24 May. Should fight out the finish once again
8. **HABIT DE SOIREE** - Off form and was unplaced in a class B at this course over 2100m on 11 April. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
9. **NINEPOINTS LASSE** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a class B at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Has disqualifications but is also capable of earning some money when smart
10. **ISOFOU DU CHENE** - Fluffed his lines with a disqualification in a Group 3 at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Unlucky that day and could make amends
11. **JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL** - Showed some improvement when barefoot and runner-up in a class B over this course and distance on 6 June. Not fully barefoot this time but is not out of it
12. **HANNIBAL TUILERIE** - Not reliable and finished fifth in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 22 May. Could be the surprise package of the race
13. **JABALPUR** - Not reliable but was fifth at Solvalla over 1609m on 31 May. Better over a short distance but cannot be ruled out

Summary: Back at a venue where he has enjoyed plenty of success in the past, ISOFOU DU CHENE (10) is expected to leave his latest performance behind and make a bold bid for victory. He will not have things all his own way, however, with JALENDRA DE MALAC (3) likely to pose a significant threat now racing barefoot. HOMARD LAND (7) is entitled to come on for his recent comeback outing at Granville and should be much sharper here. JAZZMAN DEBAILLEUL (11) appears to have returned to something approaching his best form and warrants considerable respect too.

C4 - PRIX D'ESSAI - ETRIER 3 ANS FINALE - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Mounted - EUR € 200,000

1. **NIGHT FOR YOU** - Successful twice in last three starts, including last time out in a class Charness race at this course over 2175m on 2 June. Unreliable but might earn some minor money
2. **NOCARIO JEEP** - Has shown improvement of late and was runner-up in a class A mounted race at this track over 2175m on 9 June. Might play a minor role
3. **NECTAR DE LA FYE** - Yet to win a race and was unplaced in a Group 3 harness race over this track and trip on 5 June. Has a place chance in this line-up
4. **NINA JAVO** - In good form and finished third in a class A mounted race at this track over 2175m on 9 June. Might play a minor role
5. **NEREIDA** - Finished 6th in a Group 2 harness at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Disqualified when last seen under the saddle and others are preferred
6. **NAUTILIO BELLO** - Very unreliable and finished 9th in a Group 3 harness over this course and distance on 5 June. Was a winner the last time seen in a mounted race but this is a tougher task
7. **NEW MONEY** - Successful in a class A mounted race at this track over 2175m on 9 June. Has disqualification issues but is also capable of scoring
8. **NEO VANILLA** - Very consistent this year and finished third in a Group 2 Mounted race at this track over 2175m on 11 April. Might earn some minor money
9. **NATURE DU CHENE** - A winner of a Group 3 mounted race over this track and trip on 26 May. Tougher task but is not out of it
10. **NIKKI BEACH JISCE** - Kept to harness races so far and is unbeaten this year, the latest in a Group 3 over this track and trip on 5 June. Can score again
11. **NIKITA DES CHARMES** - Disqualified four times in a row, the latest in a Group 2 harness race at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Capable of scoring when staying in stride
12. **NYMPHE D'ELLE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Group 2 harness at this course over 2175m on 26 May. Needs to find a few lengths to score
13. **NIZZA ROCCA** - Not reliable but was fourth in a Group 2 mounted race at Caen over 2450m on 9 May. Capable of getting into the mix of things
14. **NASSANDRA** - Has only lost once so far and that was when disqualified in a Group 2 harness race at this course over 2175m on 26 May. Has won under the saddle and must be respected in this line-up
15. **NICKEL DE BAILLE** - Not at all disgraced when fifth in a Group 2 harness race at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Consistent in mounted races and should fight out the finish
16. **NINJA DE L'ENVOL** - Has struggled a bit of late and finished 8th in a Group 2 harness race at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Better under the saddle and should be a real threat

Summary: Undefeated when racing barefoot under harness, NIKKI BEACH JISCE (10) arrives on the back of a commanding success and could be hard to beat if transferring that level of ability to the mounted discipline on debut under the saddle. NINJA DE L'ENVOL (16) and NICKEL DE BAILLE (15) re-oppose here and should again be closely matched. NASSANDRA (14) brings proven Group 2-winning form in this code following her success in the Prix Hémine and is a major contender if reproducing that effort.

C5 - PRIX ALBERT VIEL - 2700m (a1m1/2) - - Harness - EUR € 200,000

1. **NET MONEY** - Only modest of late and finished fifth in a Group 3 over this course and distance on 5 June. Needs to do a bit more to score
2. **NEVER FORGET** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Hard to trust and otehrs make more appeal
3. **NACRE DU MOUTHIEUX** - Disqualified in three of last four starts, including last time out in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
4. **NOT THIS TIME** - Disqualified last time out in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Hard to trust but can earn some money when staying in stride
5. **NOELA JOSSELYN** - Not disgraced when fifth in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Better this distance and might play a minor role
6. **NOVECENTO** - In good shape and was third in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Capable of making the frame once again
7. **NELSON EMGE** - Did not show his best when 6th in a Group 2 at this course over 2175m on 26 May. Has run well at this level before and could earn some money
8. **NORMA JEANE** - Has some fair form and finished fourth in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Might need to do a bit more to beat these rivals
9. **NUEVO CASH** - Disqualified three times in a row, the latest in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Not easy to trust but can earn some money when smart
10. **NEO DE JOUDES** - Five wins in just six starts and was runner-up in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Clearlyb not out of it
11. **NOB HILL** - Returning to best and was fourth in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Capable of scoring this distance
12. **NAT KING COLE** - A winner of a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Better that shorter distance but can get involved with the finish
13. **NAYARA** - Successful in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Clearly unreliable but cannot be ruled out from doubling up
14. **NORMANDIE NIEMEN** - Very consistent and was runner-up in a Group 2 at this course over 2175m on 26 May. Should be right there at the finish once again
15. **NOCIVE DU CHOQUEL** - Remains in very good form and was third in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 26 May. Did win a Group 1 over this track and trip in february and is a serious threat

Summary: A tightly-knit contest where several profiles appeal, with NOB HILL (11) arriving off the back of a pleasing late finish effort and likely to be suited if the pace is selective. NORMANDIE NIEMEN (14) is better judged on her penultimate performance over this course, which was highly convincing, and she clearly remains of major interest. NOCIVE DU CHOQUEL (15) continues to run with consistency and reliability and again looks set to be involved at the business end. NEO DE JOUDES (10) saw his unbeaten record come to an end last time out against NAT KING COLE (12) but remains a sound contender in this class of event.

1. **LAY UP** - Did not show his best when 6th in a Group 2 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Reverts to barefoot but is at best over the shorter distances
2. **LASKA DU LEVANT** - Victorious in a class B mounted race over this track and trip on 9 June. Has disqualification issues but is also not out of it
3. **LEMON FLEURY** - Returned from a break in good form and was runner-up in a Group 2 mounted at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Reverts to barefoot and should make a bold bid at victory
4. **LUCKY SIBEY** - Disqualified in 7 of last 8 starts, including in a class B harness race at Agen-le-Passage over 2625m on 30 May. Hard to trust and others make more appeal
5. **LYZIA DES AGETS** - Not reliable but was fourth in a Group 2 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Remains barefoot but may need to do more to beat these rivals
6. **LOOPING DAY** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Group 2 at this course over 2700m on 29 May. Not easy to trust and others are preferred
7. **LAMBADA DU GOUTIER** - Disqualified in three of last five starts, the latest in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Capable of scoring when staying in stride
8. **LARA DU LERRE** - Unreliable but was fifth in a Group 2 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 29 May. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
9. **LAKANA DE FELLIERE** - Not reliable and finished 9th in a Group 2 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Remains barefoot and might play a minor role
10. **LOVISSIME** - Unreliable and finished 7th in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Reverts to barefoot but more is needed to score
11. **LOULOU DE MYE** - Disqualified in a Group harness 2 at this track over 2175m on 6 June. Needs to do a lot more trying a mounted race
12. **LIBERTE DU GOUTIER** - Successful in two Group 2 mounted races of late, the latest at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Remains barefoot and could complete the hat-trick
13. **LISBONNE DRY** - Not reliable but was third in a Group 2 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 29 May. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
14. **LIONHEART** - Kept to harness races of late and finished 7th in a class A at Vichy over 3625m on 1 June. Reverts to barefoot and will be a threat back under the saddle

Summary: A compelling rematch is on the cards between LEMON FLEURY (3) and LIBERTE DU GOUTIER (12), who finished ahead of him on 29 May. The former is expected to have come on significantly for that run and could well reverse the form under more favourable circumstances this Sunday. The highly consistent LIONHEART (14) has been carefully targeted for this big race and looks another major contender. LASKA DU LEVANT (2) brings recent winning form at a slightly lower level and looks an interesting prospect despite the rise in grade.

1. **IBISCUS MAN** - Successful in a class B at this track over 2850m on 6 June. Vey unreliable but is capable of earning some money
2. **FIFTYFOUR** - Disqualified twice in a row, the latest in a Group 2 at this track over 2850m on 6 June. Not easy to trust and others make more appeal
3. **HARMONY DU RABUTIN** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Group 3 at this track over 2850m on 22 May. Remains barefoot and could earn some money
4. **COBRA KILLER GAR** - In good shape and finished fourth in a Group 2 at this course over 2850m on 6 June. Reverts to barefoot and might play a minor role
5. **KEEP GOING** - Not reliable and finished 8th at Solvalla over 1609m on 31 May. Capable of doing better and is not out of it
6. **FREE TIME JEPSON** - Victorious twice in a row the latest in a Group 1 at Naples over 1600m on 3 May. Reverts to barefoot and could earn some money
7. **HORCHESTRO** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Group 2 at this track over 2850m on 6 June. Remains barefoot and can contest the finish once again
8. **IBIKI DE HOUELLE** - Victorious twice in a row, the latest in a Group 2 at this track over 2850m on 6 June. Remains barefoot and can complete the treble
9. **KRACK TIME ATOUT** - Disqualified at Solvalla over 1640m on 30 May. Reverts to barefoot and is capable of improvement. Has a place chance in this line-up
10. **FULTON** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a Group 3 mounted race at this track over 2175m on 2 June. Tougher task this time
11. **HOOKER BERRY** - Finished 6th in a Group 2 at this track over 2850m on 6 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of getting involved with the finish for this driver
12. **IDAO DE TILLARD** - Unplaced in a Group 1 at Solvalla over 1609m on 31 May. Remains barefoot and is a multiple Group 1 winner. Can score again

Summary: This revamped Prix René Ballière looks set to revolve around IDAO DE TILLARD (12), who is worth another chance after his flop in Sweden and is particularly interesting with the four shoes removed once again for only the fifth time in his career. His main danger could be IBIKI DE HOUELLE (8), who was an impressive Group 2 winner last time at this track. HOOKER BERRY (11) commands respect with Jean-Michel Bazire back in the sulky. KEEP GOING (5) is capable of playing a major role if running up to the standard of his penultimate effort.

1. **MAURICIEN** - Finished 10th in a class B harness race at Toulouse over 2950m on 5 June. Tries a mounted race and others make more appeal
2. **MILORD JAVRONNAIS** - Did not show his best when 7th in a Group 2 harness race at this course over 2700m on 6 June. Reverts to barefoot and has a place chance
3. **MALICE CAILLERIE** - Only modest of late and finished 6th in a Group 2 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Needs to do a bit more to score
4. **MILOR DE LA VALLEE** - Showed some improvement when third in a Group 2 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Could earn some more money
5. **MOLLY MADRIK** - Disqualified in a Group 2 harness race at this track over 2700m on 6 June. Consistent before that and could make the frame
6. **MOJITO FRAISE** - Holding form and finished fourth in a Group 2 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 29 May. Tries barefoot and could contest the finish once again
7. **MELODY DE VIVOIN** - Off form and finished 9th in a Group 2 harness race at this course over 2700m on 6 June. Needs to do more to beat these rivals
8. **MADEMOISELLE JANE** - Disqualified in a Group 2 harness at this track over 2700m on 6 June. Battling to find best form and others ar preferred
9. **MOUSTIK LA GOVELLE** - Disqualified in a Group 2 at this track over 2700m on 6 June. Has won a Group 1 under the saddle and can bounce back to score
10. **MANITAS DE TRUCHON** - Has some fair form and finished fifth in a Group 2 mounted race at this course over 2700m on 29 May. Remains barefoot but needs to do a bit more to beat these rivals
11. **MUNHOA VEDAQUAISE** - Successful in a Group 2 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Tries barefoot and is capable of scoring again if staying in stride
12. **MISS DES BESACES** - Very consistent and was runner-up in a Group 2 mounted race at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Remains barefoot and is clearly not out of it
13. **METEORE DE SIMM** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, the latest in a Group 2 mounted at this track over 2700m on 29 May. Tries barefoot and can be a challenger for top honours on best form

Summary: Winner of the Prix de Vincennes (Gr.1) on his debut under the saddle last winter, MOUSTIK LA GOVELLE (9) was unlucky not to score in a harness race last time out. He sets a strong standard and could well wrap up a second Group 1 victory. MUNHOA VEDAQUAISE (11) comes in the race on the back of a decisive success and looks to be progressing at the right time. METEORE DE SIMM (13) could prove a danger if reproducing his best form. The unexposed MOJITO FRAISE (6) also enters calculations, especially racing barefoot for the first time, which could unlock further improvement.

C9 - PRIX JEAN-YVES LECUYER - 2850m (a2m) - Gr3 - Harness - EUR € 90,000

1. **FIRST TIME ROC** - Showed some improvement when runner-up in a class B at this track over 2850m on 22 May. Remains barefoot and could one place better
2. **LEWIS RIVER** - Disqualified in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 6 June. Remains barefoot and could earn some money when staying in stride
3. **LOUIS VITTON MIJO** - Unreliable but was third in a Group 2 at this track over 2175m on 6 June. Not easy to trust but is capable of contesting the finish when smart
4. **OMERTA BOKO** - Disqualified in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Remains barefoot and is capable of earning some minor money
5. **EVERY TIME WINNER** - Only moderate of late and finished 8th in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Remains barefoot but needs to find a few lengths to score
6. **LILAS CASTELLE** - Disqualified twice in last three starts, including in a class A at Laval over 2850m on 15 November. Returns from a break and should need this run
7. **MACAHAN** - Only modest of late and finished 7th at Mantorp over 2640m on 6 June. Remains barefoot and has a place chance on best form
8. **KOTKIE** - Disqualified in a class D at Avignon over 2650m on 24 May. Capable of doing better and might earn some minor money if smart
9. **LASKO DES BROUSSES** - A winner of a class A mounted race at this track over 2700m on 20 February. Returns from a break and could need this run
10. **CAVIAR FROM MINE** - Disqualified in a class A at Toulouse over 2950m on 5 June. Remains barefoot and is capable of an upset on best form
11. **LUNELLA LEMAN** - Disqualified in a Group 3 at this course over 2700m on 13 May. In good form before that and she is clearly not out of it
12. **KEY OF LOVE** - Consistent and finished fourth in a Group 3 at Laval over 2850m on 3 June. Capable of making the frame once again
13. **LORD DELO** - Successful twice in his last three starts, the latest in a Group 3 at this track over 2700m on 13 May. Can win again
14. **KATCHI QUICK** - Completed a hat-trick, the latest in a class A at Enghien over 2150m on 23 May. Can add another win to his tally
15. **LITTLE BROWN** - Unreliable but was third in a class A at Laval over 2850m on 11 March. Remains barefoot and could be competitive yet again

Summary: Winner of five of his last six starts, KATCHI QUICK (14) is equally effective over sprint trips and staying distances and can record another success on his first attempt at Group 3 level. The main dangers are headed by LORD DELO (13), a sound winner of his last start who also boasts a good record when pairing up with Jean-Michel Bazire. LUNELLA LEMAN (11) adds further depth to the contest, having taken the Prix Henri Levesque in convincing fashion against some of the best fillies of her generation. LOUIS VITTON MIJO (3) arrives on the back of a solid third in the Group 2 Prix Jean Le Gonidec. LITTLE BROWN (15) is an interesting contender racing barefoot for the first time.
