GORGEOUS CAPE is bred for, and should appreciate, the distance, but he will need things to go right as he jumps from a wide gate. ULTRA QUICK impressed when going start to finish over the course and distance in his penultimate start. His last run over 1600m is best ignored. BEACH PALACE and INDECENT PROPOSAL rate dark horses at a venue where both runners have run well.

He too could suddenly prove dangerous at this track although a wide draw is a slight concern. WHEREVERILAYMYHAT was slightly disappointing last time and has had his chances. A 4kg apprentice claim may be just what the doctor ordered to give him his best chance at the win. FASCINATION has run in competitive races and could be up to the task.

The former has shown class and is best weighted but is dropping in distance after her break. DARK MATTER impressed when she tried the minimum trip last time and must be taken seriously along with MAJOR TOMMIE who appeared a bit unlucky not catch the frontrunner last time.

Watch out for youngster CLINTOSTAR who may have won in a close finish but has room for good improvement. MASTER BOMBER and TERMINATOR are capable of decent performances over the course and distance, so watch out.

He may be bred for further but he did what was required to win and must be respected. REAL WAR turned in a useful performance behind CIRCUMBENDIBUS last time and is weighted to give the latter a hard time. CHOCOLATE BOMB seems capable of better. He may prefer the distance and has a plum stall. Specialist ALL THE TIME has also drawn well and could suddenly give of his best.
