- **3. EDO GRIF** Put in a fine performance when 2nd of 8 finishers in a 2700m Class E here on 6 September and can again finish close
- **4. EXPLOIT KRONOS -** Ran good 3rd of 11, a place behind EDO GRIF (3), in a 2700m Class E here a fortnight ago. Is clearly the better horse though and can bring home the bacon this time
- **5. ECTOR ZL -** 3rd of 6 over a mile in Turin 2 weeks ago but in this category can expect to have few friends
- **6. MAN OF STEEL (GER) -** Capable sort but eliminated in last 2, latterly a 2100m Class D here 3 weeks ago. Matthieu Abrivard reining this time but others still easier to trust
- **7. KIWI DE L'OISON -** 5th of 11 in a 2700m Class E at La Capelle late last month. Would have imposed had he stayed focused and redemption is on his agenda
- **8. KEL DIABLO ERGEE -** 3rd of 9 in a 2500m Reims Class E last weekend but takes on a better lot here and will have his work cut out
- **9. KAIROUAN GLAM -** Complicated type that was eliminated in a 2700m Vincennes Class E on 6 September. Has never delivered in the day's configuration and is unlikely to start now

Summary: A veritable model of consistency, the German EXPLOIT KRONOS (4) has acquitted himself well in both French starts and, unshod-behind this time, can break his French duck. He will have company though in the form of the similarly performant EL BAIO (2) who makes his French bow with Alexandre Abrivard in the bike, and EDO GRIF (3) who finished ahead of Benjamin Rochard's horse last time. KIWI DE L'OISON (7) is seldom far from the action when barefoot and focused and Clement Duvaldestin will be keen to make up for his latest run.
