A bigger threat may come from OPERA SWING who has opened her account and finished second over track and trip when last seen. WIFE OF WINDSOR, FORT RED and CARLO COLLODI all have earning potential, as does GIMME ACES who is likely to improve going this trip for the first time.

FAST LOVE wasn't disgraced in a 2yo Grade 1 last time out and subsequent gelding may have done him good - respect. TARANTINO has solid handicap form so must be respected too. NORTHERN SONG, SPIRITUAL WIND, and SONIC BURST are other who could get involved.
