R4 VINCENNES [L-H]

C1 - PRIX HYPERION - 2175m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Mounted - EUR € 40.000

- 1. KROME** - Has found his niche in this discipline and with this shoe fitting, winning consecutive outings recently. Capable of handling the step up in class
- 2. KORRIGAN OLIVERIE** - Versatile sort who has alternated between the two disciplines with success. Won under the saddle four starts back and finished 3rd in this code 3rd under the saddle last time
- 3. KLEMPERER** - Has looked rather ordinary in both codes for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore
- 4. KRONOS D'EOLE** - Unreliable in the harness category but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Best watched for now under the saddle
- 5. KENJI D'AUBERVILLE** - Consistent for the most part with sound form references in this shoeing configuration. Not taken lightly
- 6. KOLONEL** - Unreliable and out of sorts recently but has won over this course and distance. Not to be underestimated
- 7. KAEL DE KERYANN** - Usually does well when avoiding disqualification, winning and finishing 2nd in his last two completed outings (four starts). Will be a factor if remaining wise
- 8. KALONEK DU MONT** - Unreliable but effective in the mounted code so is not incapable of getting into the picture. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- 9. KOPRIORO** - In full possession of his means, having won by a wide margin on this course before finishing 2nd last time out. Winning chance
- 10. KILOU D'YMER** - Confirmed the early promise shown under the saddle by opening his account when reverting to this code last time with this shoe fitting. Unlikely to stop
- 11. KHEOPS DE FREDLAU** - Versatile sort comfortable in both trotting disciplines. Finished 2nd in a harness race last time and was 2nd in his last outing under the saddle three starts back
- 12. KATSUKI** - Complicated but is not incapable of getting into the picture judged on his best references in harness races. Outsider

Summary : An opening contest consisting of young and improving trotters. KOPRIORO (9) has found his niche in the mounted code and renews rivalry with last-start conqueror KILOU D'YMER (10) who sports the same shoeing configuration he did when winning at Enghien last time. They're likely to fight for victory once more, although KAEL DE KERYANN (7) is also capable of chiming in if avoiding disqualification). Versatile KHEOPS DE FREDLAU (11) is consistent in both disciplines and is also likely to give another competitive account of himself.

C2 - PRIX WERINGIA - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR €
40.000

- 1. JOYAU JICEE** - Has regained freshness after rediscovering his form, which includes a last-start 2nd. Should not be underestimated
- 2. JAWAX DE KERYANN** - Consistent for the most part but is most effective when racing unshod, so is best watched for now
- 3. JOAL DU RIB** - Most effective when racing unshod so should bounce back from his last-start sanction. Will show his true colors
- 4. JOSIO DU POMMEREUX** - Tends to do well when avoiding disqualification and did catch the eye when winning last time. Can have a say
- 5. JOSCO DES OMBRES** - Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- 6. JUSTIN DES MARAIS** - Has done well when avoiding disqualification and has caught the eye on occasion. Not easily discounted
- 7. JACK DU BARBEY** - Showed signs of improvement last time and could get a look in here if building on that progress. Outsider
- 8. JAPANESE SUN** - Out of sorts in both codes and is probably more effective under the saddle, anyway. Is best ignored
- 9. JAGUAR D'OBRET** - Seldom finishes far off the mark so could get into the picture, though but has no more than a place chance
- 10. JACOMO DES BOTS** - Struggling to regain any form or spark the improvement needed to be competitive, so unlikely to trouble the judge
- 11. JOKER D'ENFER** - Seldom finishes far off the mark and could get into the picture here but has no more than a place chance
- 12. JUSTIN WOOD** - Consistent for the most part and boasts sound form references. Has the means to have a say in the finish
- 13. JOEY DU NOYER** - Unreliable and seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day, although has no more than a place chance
- 14. JOLIVERT DU GERS** - Consistent sort who impressed on his return to the track recently. Ought to make his presence felt
- 15. JO DIBAH** - Appeared even more effective with this shoeing arrangement last time when winning at Enghien. Can follow up
- 16. JACK SURPRISE** - Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on his best references. Can't be ruled out
- 17. JOLI MANNEQUIN** - Made a pleasing comeback after a layoff and would, undoubtedly, have come on since. Will be competitive
- 18. JAVELOT DE HOUELLE** - Rewarded for consistency with a last-start victory and isn't incapable of confirming his good current form by playing a leading role here

TUESDAY, 21/11/23

Summary : Lightly raced JO DIBAH (15) has revealed considerable means and he, seemingly, had even more to give in this shoe fitting when resuming winning ways at Enghien recently. He will be hard to beat here with a repeat of that performance. PRETTY MANNEQUIN (17) did not go unnoticed on his comeback and ought to improve for that outing with his shoes removed, so could trouble the selection. JOAL DU RIB (3) is a model of consistency racing unshod and should be competitive for a place on the podium, which could also be said of JOLIVERT DU GERS (14).

C3 - PRIX ARIETIS - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 53.000

1. **INDOCILE** - Finished a reassuring 3rd last month and on that evidence is a serious contender for a leading position
2. **IGUANE DE CAPONET** - Runner-up to a classy horse last time having won consecutive outings. Good chance to resume winning ways
3. **ISOCRATE D'ELA** - Consistent for the most part and ideally positioned behind the autostart so could get a look in if confirming that progress
4. **IDEAL GREEN** - Inconsistent but has finished 2nd in two of his last four starts. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
5. **ILLICO DES BAUX** - Speed specialist who finished a reassuring 2nd last time in a similar race. Likely to play a leading role
6. **IDEAL DE JEAN** - Disqualified in the reference race but remains more than capable of having a say in the finish. Beware
7. **IQUEM** - Inconsistent but did finish a reassuring 3rd last time. Could get a look in if confirming that progress
8. **IN LOVE MESLOIS** - Unfavorably positioned behind the autostart but has the means to stake a claim in the finish. Dark horse
9. **INDIGO PIERJI** - Consistent for the most part and needs only to negotiate a tricky starting berth to have a say in the outcome
10. **IF YOU CAN** - Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on his best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
11. **IDEAL DE CASTELLE** - Unreliable but usually does well when avoiding disqualification. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
12. **IBIS QUICK** - Has sound form references but is most effective when racing unshod, so is best just to watch for now
13. **ICE TEA** - Not the most reliable but isn't incapable of making his presence felt either. Not one to be taken lightly
14. **ICELANDER** - Struggling to regain any form or show signs of improvement needed to be competitive here, so unlikely to trouble the judge
15. **IMBROGLIU MAG** - Has looked distinctly ordinary in both codes for some time now, so his chances appear limited even at this level. Ignore
16. **ICARE DU LEARD** - Versatile sort with solid references in both codes, though is most effective when racing unshod. Watch for now
17. **IMPERIAL MARANDAIS** - Unreliable but not incapable of getting into the picture judged on his best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out

TUESDAY, 21/11/23

Summary : IGUANE DE CAPONET (2) has finished 2nd three times, winning twice, in his last five starts so lines up in full possession of his means and with another great opportunity to resume winning ways. That said, he will have to fight hard with ILLICO DES BAUX (5), a speed specialist, and INDOCILE (1), who finished 3rd in the benchmark race, likely to pose a threat over this reduced distance. Both IN LOVE MESLOIS (8) and IDEAL GREEN (4) complete the shortlist.

C4 - PRIX HESTIA - 2700m (a1 11/16m) - Class - Mounted - EUR € 35.000

- 1. JUNIOR DU GRENIER** - Has won consecutive starts in this discipline, including at Chabourg last time out. Not taken lightly
- 2. JACADY SLY** - Tends to do well when not disqualified and did catch the eye when winning and finishing 2nd before his disqualification last time
- 3. JACARANDA** - Seldom finishes far off the mark when applied so could get into the picture, though has no more than a place chance
- 4. JAMY** - Complicated but is not devoid of resources. Races fully unshod for the first time and could have more to offer in this configuration
- 5. JEWEL D'HERMES** - Sanctioned in each of his last three starts in the harness category but did win in his only outing under the saddle two starts back. Keep safe
- 6. JACOBSON** - Consistent for the most part in harness races so cannot be discounted switching to the mounted code now
- 7. JEDEO DES VAUX** - Has finished 4th in consecutive outings under the saddle recently, though has no more than a place chance here
- 8. JABLO DU CHENE** - Complicated but has undeniable means and is likely to be a factor if avoiding disqualification. Not to be underestimated
- 9. JAFF DE MESLAY** - Unreliable but seldom finishes far off the mark on a going day, so could get a look in here on his best form with all shoes removed
- 10. JALIENORTH GAME** - Has looked distinctly ordinary for some time now, so his chances are limited even at this level. Ignore
- 11. JAGUAR DU RIB** - Has his issues at the start but has is undeniably capable of winning a race like this if getting off on the right foot. Winning chance
- 12. JEWEL CASH** - Sanctioned in each of his last three starts in the harness category, although did win when last seen in this code two starts back. Keep safe
- 13. JERICHO DE JARY** - Struggling to regain any form or spark the improvement needed to be competitive here, so unlikely to trouble the judge
- 14. JUMANJI BROUETS** - Finished 4th when switched to the mounted code last time but has no more than a place chance. For the lovers of outsiders
- 15. JIPET DE CREPIN** - At the top of his game winning two of his last three starts in the harness category. Warrants respect in his first outing under the saddle
- 16. JOJO DE L'AUNAY** - Unreliable but is not incapable of getting into the picture judged on his best references. Hard to trust but is as hard to rule out
- 17. JOULE DE LA FYE** - Seldom far off the mark and finished 5th when switched to the mounted code last time. For the lovers of outsiders
- 18. JET DES MALBERAUX** - Sanctioned in each of his last three starts, although was unlucky when disqualified last time. Retains the means to bounce back and fight for victory

TUESDAY, 21/11/23

Summary : JAGUAR DU RIB (11) is complicated, especially at the start, but he possesses a big 'engine' and need only remain wise to assert his authority over this bunch. JET DES MALBERAUX (18) fits a similar profile in that he too has the means to win a race of this nature if avoiding disqualification. JIPET DE CREPIN (15) has revealed his quality with two wins from his last three appearances in harness races so warrants the utmost respect in his first start in this category. JABLO DU CHENE (8) and JEWEL D'HERMES (5) are not the easiest customers around but have the means to get into the picture too.

C5 - PRIX KLIO - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 38.000

1. **LEADER DE CERISY** - Finished 4th five starts back but regressed in the four outings since, disqualified in the last two. Ignore
2. **LINDSTEDT** - Will appreciate this mode of departure so is capable of bouncing back to form. Can get into the picture
3. **LITTLEKING FOXGLEN** - Complicated sort with no form to be recommended in a race of like this. Others make more appeal
4. **LAGNU MAG** - Seldom far off the mark and is not incapable of getting into the picture, though has only a place chance
5. **LUDIVER DES VAUX** - Seldom far from a fault so needs to demonstrate better application to have a say here. Watch for now
6. **LORD DES FANES** - Finished 3rd in the benchmark race at the start of the month and on that form is likely to be a factor here
7. **LIVRE BLANC** - Unreliable but did finish 2nd four starts back, so could get a look in here on that form
8. **LUCIFERMORNINGSTAR** - Trained by a skilful man, so cannot be taken lightly in his first start at Vincennes. Warrants respect
9. **LUCKY JACKSON** - Beaten by a quality colt last time and will play a leading role here on that evidence. Winning chance
10. **LE SENS DE PADD** - At fault twice recently when expected to be competitive so should not be hastily condemned. Keep safe
11. **LEO DES MALBERAUX** - Deserves a mention given the esteem in which he is held by connections. Not one to be underestimated

Summary : LUCKY JACKSON (9) and LORD DES FANES (6) finished 2nd and 3rd respectively behind a quality sort last time at this venue, so are likely to fight for victory here on that form. LUCIFERMORNINGSTAR (8) is capable of chiming in judged on his brst references. THE MEANING OF PADD (10) is not without a chance and ought to be competitive for the places.

**C6 - PRIX DE CARENTAN - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR €
35.000**

- 1. KORRIGAN DU FAYARD** - Has been making good progress lately, so deserves a go at this level. Not underestimated from the front row
- 2. KADOR DE SEVRE** - Unreliable but has the means to make his presence felt from an ideal starting berth. Has a place chance
- 3. KANGOUROU** - Has looked rather ordinary for several weeks/outings now so is hard to recommend. Others make more appeal
- 4. KAVAL BOURBON** - Unreliable but has not gone unnoticed when avoiding disqualification. Could get into the picture here
- 5. KATCHI QUICK** - Has regained his best level and, on current form, starts out at Vincennes with legitimate ambitions. Contender
- 6. KORSIKO** - Consistent for the most part but was sanctioned last time so will need to reaffirm. Best watched for now
- 7. KAKOU CAYENNAIS** - Acquitted himself in a similar contest last time and is likely to do so again here. Not taken lightly
- 8. KUMBI DE PHYT'S** - Undeniably capable of getting into the picture judged on best form but is best watched for now with this shoeing configuration
- 9. KRACUS DE GUEZ** - Has gained wisdom and possesses undeniable means. Need only negotiate tricky starting berth to have a say
- 10. KLAIRON DE TILLARD** - Could get a look in judged on best references but is out of sorts so best watched for now. Others preferred
- 11. KANKAN** - Appreciates this start mode and finished a reassuring 4th last time. Chance if confirming that improvement
- 12. KASTELBRAC** - Win five starts back but has gone off the boil since. Disqualified in the last three, so watch for now
- 13. KRYSTAL PALACE** - Improving sort with undeniable means. Tries this shoe fitting for the first time and could improve for it
- 14. KIYOUNI** - Lost his unbeaten record when sanctioned last time after consecutive victories. Will need to reaffirm
- 15. KEEP TIME** - Capable sort with solid form references that includes a win and finishing 2nd twice in last 3 starts. Dark horse
- 16. KING AULNAIES** - Undeniably capable of getting into the picture judged on best form but is best watched for now with this shoeing configuration

Summary : KATCHI QUICK (5) has regained form recently and is good value here to make a winning Paris debut. Jean-Michel Bazire's KAKOU CAYENNAIS (7) reassured last time and deserves a lot of credit, as does stablemate KRACUS DE GUEZ (9) who has now gained sufficient wisdom. KRYSTAL PALACE (13) is another with claims fitted with this shoeing configuration for the first time. Pay attention to KEEP TIME (15) who is in constant progress.

TUESDAY, 21/11/23

C7 - PRIX TITAN - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 18.000

1. **HOPE** - His only outing in the claimers ended in victory. Has to be taken seriously returning to this level
2. **HERMES DE MARZY** - Winner in this category recently and looks well placed here to follow up. Has a good winning chance
3. **HENRY DE TROUVILLE** - Unreliable although seldom far off the mark on a going day. Has more of a place chance than a winning one
4. **HURACAN** - More effective under the saddle and is probably in this race for conditioning purposes. Watch for now
5. **HELIUM VELCO** - Inconsistent although seldom far off the mark on a going day. Has more of a place chance than a winning one
6. **HACKER DU CHENE** - Has been distinctly ordinary for some time now and is easy to overlook here. Can be confidently ignored
7. **HAKIM GRIFF** - Struggling to regain form or spark the improvement to be competitive in a race of this nature. Others preferred
8. **HARFAN DES GRANGES** - Somewhat reassuring last time and has a theoretical chance here. Chance if confirming that improvement
9. **HOLDEM POKER** - Performing well on short tracks and boats sound form references. Constitutes a good point of support
10. **HONEY MONEY** - Inconsistent but not entirely devoid of resources. Has no more than a place chance in this grade/company
11. **HAPPY NONANTAIS** - Not incapable of acquitting himself competitively in his first appearance at this level. Outsider
12. **HERNANIE DE GODREL** - Struggling to regain form or spark the improvement to be competitive in a race of this nature. Others preferred
13. **HESTIA DU COMTAL** - Unreliable although seldom far off the mark on a going day. Has more of a place chance than a winning one
14. **HAPUNA BEACH** - Awkwardly positioned on the second row but warrants ample credit/respect in this grade/company. Outsider
15. **HEQUILEO JIEL** - Barefooted this time so his candidacy will appeal to fans of outsiders. Not one to be underestimated

Summary : Difficult claiming race to assess given that cases can be made for several participants. HERMES DE MARZY (2) won a similar contest in the provinces recently and is not incapable of going in again, so gets the nod ahead HOLDEM POKER (9) who is fast and confirmed at this level. HAPUNA BEACH (14) lines up in good form and is likely to acquit himself competitively back in this category. HARFAN DES GRANGES (8) has the means to get involved too, despite an unfavorable starting berth.

C8 - PRIX TERCIDINA - 2100m (a1 5/16m) - Class - Harness - EUR € 35.000

1. **KAY LEE DU CAMPUS** - Very unreliable and has disqualification issues. Good last run when runner-up at this course and has a winning chance
2. **KENTUCKY GIRL** - Not disgraced when fourth last time out. Unreliable since winning in January but can contest the finish
3. **KENZA D'AMOUR** - Disappointing of late and has been disqualified when last seen at this course. Might play a minor role
4. **KAVAROLIKA** - Unreliable but has won twice already. A good third at this course last time out and can do even better this time
5. **KALINKA SOMOLLI** - Disappointing last run when seventh. Won her previous starts and can bounce back to score if in the mood
6. **KIVA DU LOISIR** - Unreliable and has yet to win but she has been runner-up three times. Has a place chance in this line-up
7. **KALIDA MANIA** - Disappointing last run when eleventh but is better this distance and can bounce back to score
8. **KARINA STEED** - Yet to win a race but has been runner-up three times. More needed to win but could finish in the money
9. **KATITZI** - Disqualified on debut but has won twice since then. Fair form since then and could finish in the money
10. **KELLE CLASS** - Only win was in March. Unreliable since then and was disqualified when last seen at this course. Others are preferred
11. **KALIFA MESLOISE** - Ignore her last start which was at this course. A good winner of her penultimate start and is not out of it
12. **KALPONE DE GUEZ** - Clearly needed the comeback run when well beaten last time out. Capable of doing better but is best watched this time
13. **KISS CARISAIE** - Disappointing last run when seventh but did win penultimate start. Better over further but could play a minor role
14. **KIGA DE VANDEL** - Much improved last run when runner-up but was disqualified twice at this course before that. Others are preferred
15. **KISS ME DU LIVET** - Has yet to win a race after 15 attempts. In good form of late and could play a minor role
16. **KETTY WINNER AS** - Has won once last year and again this year. Modest form of late and needs to do more to win this race

Summary : A competitive lucky last race. KALIDA MANIA (7) is better this distance and the last run is best ignored. KAVAROLIKA (4) ran well when third last time out and should be a lively danger to these rivals. KALIFA MESLOISE (11) is probably better than the last run would suggest and was a good winner of her penultimate start. KENTUCKY GIRL (2) has been unreliable since winning but is also not out of it.
