- Harness - EUR € 6,000**

1. IZZIA HIGHLAND - Only modest of late and finished 8th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. Capable of better and is not out of it

2. INTEL - Disappointing last run when 6th in class E at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 2 November. Capable of better and has claims

3. GIN KAS - Has only been modest of late and was 6th in class G at Lyon-Parilly over 2700m on 11 November. Others make more appeal

4. INDIGO - Unreliable and was 6th in class G at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 1 November. Needs to do more to beat these rivals

5. INDY VET - In very good form and was 3rd in class E at Marseille-Vivieux over 2650m on 2 November. Be right there at the finish

6. GAROU DE BOURGOGNE - Unreliable and finished 7th in class G at Hyeres over 2050m on 9 November. Can be competitive in this line-up

7. HELLINE SERVINOISE - Only modest of late and was 7th in class G at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 November. Needs to find a few lengths to win

8. IVAN LENDEL - Disqualified in class G at Bollene over 2800m on 12 October. Victorious in September but this is a tougher task

9. JOLIE LAURA - Did not show her best when 10th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. Has a place chance on best form

10. HORTANCE FOLLE - Has struggled of late and was 9th in class H at Paray-Le-Monial over 2625m on 16 November. Needs major improvement to win

11. IAKA - Not reliable and was 6th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. Can get involved with the finish

12. HACKER JULRY - Not disgraced when 5th in class F at Paray-Le-Monial over 2625m on 16 November. Quite capable of making the frame

Summary: INTEL (2) did not show his best side last time out at Marseille-Vivieux but he boasts a nice record in the amateur division and has to be hugely respected. A winner at this very same course last month, INDY VET (5) is another one who always enjoys racing in this division and is shortlist material. IAKA (11) does not have much room for maneuver but still brings fair consistent form in the amateur division and must be given consideration. IZZIA HIGHLAND (1) runs barefoot for the first time in an amateur race and could be another one worth a good look in.

C2 - PRIX ICI SAINT-ETIENNE LOIRE - 2000m (a1m1/4) - Class E - Harness - EUR € 16,500

- 1. NOT ALONE** - Only modest so far and was 5th in a claimer at Agen-Le Passage over 2650m on 3 November. More is needed to beat these rivals
- 2. NUIT DES LOUANGES** - Disqualified in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2100m on 5 October. Has not shown much so far and others are preferred
- 3. NAXOS DIBAH** - Not disgraced when 3rd in class G on debut at Montier-En-Der over 2300m on 24 August. Can make the frame
- 4. NEMO DES BROUETS** - Improving and was 3rd in class E at Salon-De-Provence over 2200m on 25 October. Can contest the finish again
- 5. NAFI DE REVE D'OR** - Victorious in Class F on debut at Alencon over 2650m on 19 October. Can double up this shorter distance
- 6. NO QUARTER** - A winner of a Class F on debut at Strasbourg over 2200m on 2 November. Capable of following up with another win
- 7. NOBLE CHARM** - Disqualified in class D on debut at Lyon-La Soie over 2050m on 1 November. Has room to improve but others are preferred
- 8. NOVERRIO** - Showed promise when third in class F on debut at Montier-En-Der over 2025m on 12 October. Can be competitive again
- 9. NIFTY DREAM** - A two-year-old gelding by Fifty Kalouma out of Chance To Dream who is making his debut. His mother did not win a race after 4 starts. Watch the betting
- 10. NOW AND THEN** - A two-year-old colt by Boccador de Simm out of It's Now Or Never who is making his debut. His mother won 4 of her 21 starts. Watch the betting
- 11. NEW YORK D'ATOUT** - Debut attempt for two-year-old filly by Fabulous Wood out of New York Jet. Her mother won 1 of her 20 starts. Watch the betting

Summary: NAFI DE REVE D'OR (5) was a nice winner of her first career start and left an excellent visual impression that day. She has plenty more to offer and can follow up, but the same can be said of NO QUARTER (6) who was very dominant first time up at Strasbourg. NEMO DES BROUETS (4) has a nice progressive profile and has a solid each-way chance. NAXOS DIBAH (3) made a promising debut to his career on turf and should enjoy the switch to a hard surface.

- 1. LOLITA DE JEMAX** - Disqualified in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. Has major disqualification issues and is best watched for now
- 2. LAO DE NAPPES** - Improving and was runner-up in class E at Carpentras over 2650m on 4 October. Victorious in September and should be a lively danger
- 3. LOTUS DE CHANTEINS** - Did not show his best when 7th in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November when barefoot. Not barefoot this time and others make more appeal
- 4. LIBRE D'EMOTION** - Unreliable but was 3rd in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. Might play a minor role at very best
- 5. LOLITA D'ECOTAY** - Has struggled of late and was 11th in Class D at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 27 October. Unreliable and others are preferred
- 6. LITCHI JULRY** - Not disgraced when 4th in class F at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 2 November. Victorious in October and has a place chance
- 7. LEADER RASTID** - A winner in Class F at Hyeres over 2650m on 9 November. Not easy to trust but is capable of earning some money
- 8. LOULOU DU SABLIER** - A winner of a Class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. Victorious in two of last three races and is not out of it

Summary: LUPIN D'ETE (13) is a smart horse and showed before that he can run well fresh off a break. He gets the vote ahead of LEXUBERANDS (10) whose last effort at Lyon la Soie did not go unnoticed. LAO DE NAPPES (2) has a nice progressive profile and could have a say in the outcome. LOLLIPOP THE BEST (11) was a game fourth in her last run in this division and has obvious claims on the back of this performance.

- 1. HERMINE DU SABLIER** - Has struggled of late and finished 9th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 15 November. Capable of better but others are preferred
- 2. INES GRIFF** - Showed some improvement when 3rd in class E at Paray-Le-Monial over 2625m on 16 November. Could play a minor role
- 3. ILLUSTRE DE CHENOU** - In good shape and was 4th in class E at Marseille-Borély over 2300m on 14 November. A winner in October and is barefoot. Consider
- 4. INDY DE LANDEMER** - Disqualified in class E at Châteaubriant over 3000m on 11 November. A winner in September but others are preferred
- 5. HARPIE GIBUS** - Has only been modest of late and was 7th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. On a long losing streak and others are preferred
- 6. ITEM DE MONTCIANT** - Not reliable but was 3rd in class E at Lyon-La Soie over 2700m on 11 November. Has a place chance in this line-up
- 7. ISCHIA SAINT CLAIR** - Disappointing of late and was 9th in class E at Lyon-Parilly over 2850m on 9 November. A winner in August but others make more appeal
- 8. INES D'HERMES** - Disqualified in class F at Saint-Galmier over 2650m on 4 November. Capable of a surprise when in the right mood
- 9. HARLEQUIN** - Unreliable and was 7th in class D over this track and trip on 4 November. Needs to do a bit more to win
- 10. HOUPETTE ROSE** - A good 3rd in class D over this track and trip on 4 November. Can get into the mix of things once again
- 11. HELMA DE BUSSET** - Disqualified in class E at Paray-le-Monial over 2625m on 16 November. Victorious in November and is barefoot and ready to strike
- 12. IRIS RIVOISE** - Unreliable and was 6th in class E at Marseille-Vivaux over 2650m on 2 November. May play a minor role at very best

Summary: IRIS FROM (15) was a very good finisher in her last run at Machecoul and ships a long way for this race. She is a tentative pick despite her tricky starting position on the second row. IPPON DE MONTCEAU (14) looked like a potential winner of his last race before a late sanction and is worth another chance. IDEAL DE RIVRAY (13) is not the most reliable performer but he can win a race like that if applied. HELMA DE BUSSET (11) is best judged on her win at this course two starts ago and warrants some consideration too.

KUNG FU FAMILY (15) runs barefoot this Friday and should leave behind his last below-par effort. KOTKITA (14) is expected to show a better side of herself back over a right-handed course and can make amends following a disappointing last run. KINGSTON SPORT (2) is not devoid of ability and could make an impact from a good starting berth on the front line.

- 4. JIPSY DES AIRES** - Knocking very loudly and was runner-up in class F at Lyon-Parilly over 2600m on 27 October. Be right there at the finish

- 3. JEUDI D'AUBRIERE** - Unreliable and was 12th in a Class F mounted race at Mont-Saint-Michel over 2675m on 2 November. Did better before that and could earn some minor money
